### 70 Wins

The Braves collected their 70th win of the season on Sunday, and need to go no worse than 20-22 (.476) over the rest of the season to match last season's NL East-winning 90 victories.

This Braves team is the quickest to  $70~\mathrm{wins}$ since 2013, when that club reached the mark in game No. 115.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets open a three-game series tonight with the 11th of 19 matchups between the teams this season...The teams will meet for another three games next week, August 23-25, at Citi Field for Players' Weekend.

- This marks New York's final trip to Atlanta this season...The Braves have not lost a series to the Mets at SunTrust Park over the last two years... They are 3-0-2 in series play against the Mets here over this stretch.
- After dropping their first two games to the Mets this season, the Braves have won six of eight with New York, while averaging 6.9 runs (55 total runs) against the NL-East rival.
- LH Max Fried is set to the face the Mets for the ninth time in his career and for the fifth time as a starter...The lefty is 1-1 with a 2.49 ERA (7 ER/25.1 IP) against the Mets, including 1-0 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP) this season...Fried has never allowed a home run to the Mets.
- RH Zack Wheeler is 6-4 with a 3.42 ERA (28 ER/73.2 IP) in 12 career games, all starts, against the Braves, including 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (6 ER/12.0 IP) this season...The Smyrna Ga. native is 3-3 with a 3.73 ERA (17 ER/41.0 IP) over seven games in Atlanta, but lost his last start here on June 17 after allowing five runs, four earned, in 6.0 innings.

BACK HOME: The Braves are set to play 18 of their next 24 games here in Atlanta, where the club is 32-25 (.561) this season.

- The Braves have not won a series at SunTrust Park since the All-Star break, going 0-1-2 in three sets against Washington, Kansas City and Cincinnati.
- They last won a set here on July 5-7, winning two of three from the Marlins.
- Overall, the Braves are 10-4-4 in series play here

WHEELER VS. FREEMAN: 1B Freddie Freeman is 12-for-24 (.500) with two home runs, 12 walks and a 1.524 OPS in 37 plate career plate appearances against RHP Zack Wheeler.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today selected the contract of OF Rafael Ortega from Triple-A Gwinnett and optioned RHP Patrick Weigel to the Stripers.

- Ortega, 28, has spent the entire season with Triple-A, batting .285 (123-for-431) with 21 home runs in 111 games.
- Ortega's first appearance will be his Braves debut after he played in 41 games with Miami last season.
- If Ortega plays, he will become the 45th player to appear in a game this season for Atlanta.
- Weigel had two different stints with Atlanta over eight service days, but did not pitch for the Braves.

LOOKING FOR 30/30: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. enters tonight's game with a National League-most 28 stolen bases this season, leaving him two shy of the fifth 30 home run/30 stolen base season in Braves franchise history...The Mets have allowed 102 stolen bases this season, the most in the majors by far...The next closest team is Los Angeles (AL) with 77 allowed.

- Acuña Jr. is also looking to become the second player in baseball history to have at least 30 home runs and 30 stolen bases in a season prior to his 22nd birthday...The only player to do so was Mike Trout, who had 30 home runs and 49 stolen bases as a 20-year-old in 2012.
- Only three Braves have gone 30/30 at any age, with OF Ron Gant doing it last in 1990 and 1991.
- OF Hank Aaron was the first to do so, accomplishing the feat in 1963, while OF Dale Murphy also did it in 1983.

30/30 BY TEAM GAME: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. stands two stolen bases away from a 30/30 season, and today is team game No. 121...The quickest a Braves player has ever recorded a 30/30 season is team game No. 149, set by Ron Gant in 1991...The quickest major leaguer to accomplish the feat in the modern era was Cincinnati's Eric Davis, who needed just 105 team games and 90 personal games in 1987.

Gant needed 154 games for his first 30/30 season in 1990...Hank Aaron used 160 team games for the first 30/30 season in Braves history, while Dale Murphy accomplished the feat in 153 team games during the 1983 season.

INCIARTE IMPRESSES: OF Ender Inciarte went 2-for-3 with a three-run home run on Sunday in Miami, and since returning from the 10-day injured list on July 18, the outfielder owns a .395 on-base percentage and

Inciarte went hitless in his first five games back from injury (0-for-8), and since his July 26, when he got his first hit, he is 17-for-55 (.309) with 10 walks, eight strikeouts, and a .988 OPS.

SCORELESS BULLPEN: Four Braves relievers combined to throw 3.0 scoreless innings on Sunday, helping Atlanta preserve a 5-4 win...The game marked the first time the Braves bullpen was not scored upon since August 2 vs. Cincinnati.

- In the eight games between, the bullpen allowed 25 runs, 24 earned, over 25.2 innings for a 8.42 ERA...They also gave up 42 hits and 11 walks over this stretch.
- Opposing teams had a .419 batting average on balls in play against the Braves bullpen over the eight games.
- RHP Luke Jackson earned his 18th save of the season Sunday, just the Braves' second over their last 25 games...RHP Josh Tomlin has the other.

### Tonight's Game

- ★ Set for his 23rd start and 25th appearance of the season...Makes his 32nd career start and his 48th career appearance.
- Æ Has won each of his last four starts dating to July 14, setting a new career-long winning streak...Had won three straight twice before.

  - ★ His 13 wins are most in the National League by a left-hander, and tied for most
    in the majors among lefties...BOS's Eduardo Rodriguez has also won 13 games.
  - Atlanta is 16-8 in his starts as a team, including 9-2 in his last 11 turns.
- Has received 108 runs of support this season, and is averaging 8.08 runs of support per 9.0 innings.
  - His 8.08 run support average is most in the majors, and his 108 total runs are tied for sixth in the majors and rank third in the NL...Only German Marquez (113) and Robbie Ray (109) have gotten more.
  - Fried has gotten at least four runs of support in 13 of his 22 starts on the season, and is 11-1 over those those 13 games...Atlanta is 11-2 as a team in those starts.
- ✓ Makes his fifth career start and ninth career appearance against New York, and his
  third this season...Is 1-1 with a 2.49 ERA (7 ER/25.1 IP) over his first eight games.
  - In two starts this season, is 1-0 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP) and 12 strikeouts...Made one start here at SunTrust Park, June 19, and got the win after allowing eight hits and two runs in 6.0 innings of work.
- A Is 3-for-6 at the plate in his last three starts, and is batting .205 (8-for-39) on the season.
  - His eight hits are tied for ninth most in the majors by a pitcher, and he leads all pitchers with 10 runs scored.

### 2019 Recap

- A Tallied his second career 10-strikeout game, fanning 10 batters in just 5.1 innings on August 7 at Minnesota.
  - ${\cal A}$  Struck out a career-best 11 batters on June 30, 2018 at St. Louis.
- - Was his second career stint on the Braves' injured list due to a blister...Missed from July 6 to July 29 of last season with a blister on his left third finger.
- Appeared in 20 games before the All-Star break, and set full-season career highs in wins (9), games (20), starts (18), innings (98.2) and strikeouts (97).
  - Went 9-4 with a 4.29 ERA (47 ER/98.2 IP) before the break...His nine wins were the most by a Braves lefty before the All-Star break since 2013, when both Paul Maholm and Mike Minor had nine...No Braves left-hander has won more since Tom Glavine had 11 wins at the break in 2002.
  - Æ His nine wins were second most by a left-hander in the National League...

    Only the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu won more (10 wins).
- ✓ Made his third career start against the Cubs, 6/25, and allowed two hits and two
  runs over 6.0 innings to earn the win...Walked a career high five and fanned eight.
  - ✓ Is 3-0 in his career against Chicago, winning all three of his starts...Is the first
    Braves starter to earn the win over Chicago in consecutive starts since LH
    Mike Minor, who won six straight over the Cubs from 8/22/10 to 7/12/14.
- Allowed a career-most five runs and a then career high-tying nine hits over just 4.0 innings, 6/4 at PIT... Was left with a no-decision after Atlanta rallied for a 12-5 win.
- A Made his first career start against Pittsburgh, 6/4, and allowed nine hits and five runs over 4.0 innings...Marked his fourth start of the season in which he has never previously faced the opposing team.
  - A Had also never faced Arizona (April 16), Cleveland (April 21) or San Diego (May 1) before this season.
- Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings to earn his sixth win of the year, 5/17 vs. MIL...Allowed just two hits and two walks while fanning five.
  - ✓ Doubled and walked in Atlanta's nine-run sixth inning, becoming the first Braves pitcher to reach base safely twice in an inning since Greg Maddux on 4/8/99...The double Fried hit was his first extra-base hit of his career.
- Allowed seven hits and two runs over 6.0 innings, 4/16 vs. ARI...Walked one and struck out three.
  - Opened the season with 16.2 innings without allowing an earned run, before Arizona scored twice in the fourth...It was the longest streak without an earned run to open the season by a Braves pitcher since 2013 (Paul Maholm, 25.1 IP).

### Ierry Blevins • LHP • 6-6 • 190 • 35 vrs • #50

- Is 1-0 with 3.42 ERA (9 ER/23.2 IP) in 31 games with Atlanta...Twenty-six of his 31 appearances have been scoreless, including 13 of his last 15.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.
- Allowed four earned runs in 1.0 inning, 5/7 at LAD...Has a 1.99 ERA (5 ER/22.2 IP) in his other 30 games.
- Seventeen of his 31 appearances have been less than 1.0 inning.
- Holding left-handed batters to a .154 (6-for-39) average with 12 strikeouts...Righties are 12-for-49 (.245) with 15 strikeouts.
- Atlanta acquired him from the Oakland A's on 4/28 in exchange for cash considerations...Was designated for assignemnt by Atlanta on 5/14 and re-signed to a major league contract on 5/18

### Shane Greene • RHP • 6-4 • 200 • 30 yrs • #19

#### Holds: 1 1st Batter/Retired: 5/1 Inherited Runners/Scored: 4/4 Saves/Opp: 0/2

- Is 0-1 with an 11.25 ERA (5 ER/4.0 IP) in five games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.14 ERA (10 ER/42.0 IP) in 43 games on the season...He has converted 22 of 27 save opportunities
- Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save...Allowed runs in each of his first three appearances with Atlanta...Has also allowed all four of his inherited runners to score.
- Acquired from Detroit on 7/31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...Prior to joining the Braves ranked fourth in the American League with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball to San Diego's Kirby Yates among qualifying relievers.
- Was 0-2 with 22 saves and a 1.18 ERA (5 ER/38.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 12 walks in 38 games out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season.
- Originally drafted by the Yankees in the 15th round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of Daytona State College in Florida, Greene made his major league debut with New York in 2014.

- Is 6-2 with a 3.67 ERA (22 ER/54.0 IP) in 52 games this season...Has converted 18 of his 25 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019...His seven blown saves are tied for second most in the majors.
- Per Statcast, has an expected batting average of just .212 and an average exit velocity of 87.0 mph...Opponents are officially batting .271 (58-for-214).
- Logged his fourth hold of the season on 8/8 at MIA, his first since 4/27 vs. COL.
- Earned his 18th save, 8/11 at Miama...Has four saves of at least 1.1 innings.
- Left-handers have just 15 hits in 78 at-bats (.192) against him...Righties are hitting .316 (43-for-136).
- Has fanned 71 batters in 54.0 innings for a career-best 11.83 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
