### THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

APRIL 14, 2021

Five years ago today the Giants beat these Reds, 3-0, back at Oracle Park behind a strong start from former Reds ace **Johnny Cueto** (5.2ip, 0r). **RHP Logan Webb** actually came out of the bullpen that day (1.0 scoreless inning) while **Donovan Solano** had two hits. SF beat Reds starter Tyler Mahle that day.

**THE RIVER...:** After losing Sunday afternoon's finale in Baltimore 6-2 to drop the series (2-1), the Giants had an off day here in Cincinnati yesterday and open up a three-game series with the Reds tonight on the banks of the Ohio river.

- ▶ SF enters this series four games under .500 at 6-10 (.375) through 16 games...it's the sixth time since the 2015 season the Giants have started a year with a winning percentage of .375 (or worse) through 16 games...the other years were 2024 (6-10), 2023 (5-11), 2018 (6-10), 2017 (6-10) and 2015 (6-10).
- ▶ This is the Giants first series of the year with the Reds after the two clubs went 3-3 against one another in 2025...the Giants took two-of-three here in Cincinnati to open the 2025 season and the Reds took two-of-three in SF just over a week later.
- ▶ The Giants have won each of their last two series here at GABP dating to 2024 and are 3-1-1 in their last five series here dating to 2021 with the only series loss coming in 2022.

**RAYGUN: LHP Robbie Ray** makes his fourth start of the season in the series opener tonight... SF's lefty has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his first three starts of the young season with the Giants as a team going 2-1 in those games.

- ▶ The 34-year-old last threw seven days ago at home against the Phillies in the Giants 6-0 win...Ray blanked the Phils through 6.2 innings, allowed just three hits, walked three and struck out a season-best tying seven.
- ▶ Overall, Ray has not allowed a run in his last 10.0 innings dating to the 3rd inning of his start against the Mets back on April 2.
- ▶ He's 3-2 with a 4.42 ERA (18er, 36.2ip) in seven lifetime starts against Cincinnati and has won both of his starts against the Reds as a Giant...both of those outings have come here in the Queen City in 2024 and 2025.
- ▶ Overall, six of Ray's seven career starts against the Reds have come at GABP, where he has a 4.40 ERA (15er, 30.2ip) in those games...his teams are 4-2 in those starts.

**HIT OR MISS...:** After a four-game stretch where SF had an uptick offensively (21 runs on 45 hits from last Monday-Friday), the Giants scored four total runs on 17 hits in two losses to the Orioles over the weekend.

- ▶ Entering play today the Giants are averaging 3.19 runs/game, lowest in the National League and second-lowest in the Majors just ahead of the White Sox (3.06)...they've also drawn the fewest walks in MLB (33), hit the fewest homers (eight) and have the third-lowest OBP (.288).
- ▶ SF's eight homers through 16 games are its fewest through the first 16 games of a season since 2008 (seven).
- ▶ On the flip side, the Giants .243 team average and 129 hits are both 10th-best in MLB...with RISP, SF is hitting .272, 14th of 30 MLB clubs.
- ▶ The Giants have recorded 62 hits over their last six games (.298 average)...it's the club's most hits over a six-game stretch in April since 2016 (*spans entirely in April*) (Stats, LLC).
- ▶ In six wins this season, the Giants offense is averaging 6.0 runs per game and slashing .327/.365/.531 (.896 OPS)...in the club's 10 losses, they're averaging less than two runs per game (1.5) and slashing a collective .188/.235/.241 (.477 OPS).

**TAKE THE RED PILL:** The Giants have homered in each of their last 12 road games against the Reds beginning with an Evan Longoria homer on May 28, 2022...the streak is the Giants' second-longest here in Cincinnati all-time behind a 16-game streak from 1976-1978 (Stats, LLC).

- ▶ The Giants that have homered in that 12-game streak are **IF Matt Chapman**, OF Michael Conforto, **OF Jerar Encarnacion**, Longoria, IF Tyler Fitzgerald, IF Wilmer Flores, **OF Heliot Ramos**, C/OF Blake Sabol, **IF Casey Schmitt**, OF Austin Slater and IF LaMonte Wade Jr.

**ON THE CASE: IF Casey Schmitt** rides a five-game hitting streak into tonight's game, one shy of the longest of his career (a six-gamer from July 29-August 4 of last year).

- ▶ Schmitt is 11-for-19 (.579) during his current five-game streak with four XBH (including his first HR of the year on Sunday in Baltimore).
- ▶ His 11 hits match the most over a five-game span in his career (also May 2023) and match the most hits in a five-game span by any Giants player since 2022 (Stats, LLC).

**WITH THE GIANTS:** The 2021 Cy Young Award winner enters his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors...the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

**LAST START:** Snapped the Giants' four-game losing skid last Tuesday night with his outstanding pitching performance...tossed 6.2-scoreless innings, allowing just three hits with seven strikeouts in the Giants 6-0 victory over the Phillies...each of his first three starts came at Oracle Park.

**FAST START:** According to *Stats, LLC*, Ray's 2.08 ERA through three starts is his lowest through his first three starts of a season since 2017 with the D-Backs (1.96)...he also enters this outing having not allowed a run in his last 10.0 innings dating to his outing against the Mets on April 2...the 10.0-inning scoreless streak is his third longest since joining SF behind a pair of 14.0-inning streaks last season...he's had four streaks in his career reach 15.0 innings (most recently 18.0 innings in June/July 2022).

**AGAINST THE REDS:** Is slated to make his eighth career start against Cincinnati...has posted a 3-2 record with a 4.42 ERA (18er, 36.2ip), 49 strikeouts and a .204 opponents average against over his seven career outings against the Reds...has allowed eight home runs (1.96 HR/9.0) over his 36.2ip against the Reds...his last start against Cincinnati came on March 30, 2025 at Great American Ball Park in the Giants 6-3 victory...six of his seven career outings against the Reds have come at Great American Ballpark...his only start that didn't was August 8, 2015 when he was with the D-Backs.

**LOOKIN' SHARP IN CACTUS LEAGUE:** Made six starts in Arizona's Cactus League this spring and posted a 2-0 record with a 1.37 ERA (3er, 19.2ip)...he struck out 21 batters, allowed just five hits and posted a 0.86 WHIP overall his six outings...had a two-start stretch from March 9-15 where he did not allow a hit (9.0 total innings) hit one, walked four and struck out 12...his last start came on March 21 against Cleveland where he threw 5.0 innings and allowed one run on three hits with six strikeouts.

**2025 RECAP:** Was selected to the NL All-Star team for the second time in his career (also 2017 with the Diamondbacks), pitching the best first half of his 12-year MLB career, as he posted his lowest career ERA (2.65) before the break (min. nine starts)...overall he started 32 games for SF, finishing the year with a 11-8 record and 3.65 ERA after posting a 5.54 ERA in 12 starts after the break...the 3.65 season ERA was his lowest since his Cy Young season in 2021 (2.84) and fourth-lowest in his 12-year career.

**LUCKY CHARM:** The Giants won each of Ray's first nine starts in 2025, making him the first Giants starter to have the team win each of his first nine starts of a season since **Bill Swift** in 1992 (11 wins to start the season).

**CHANGING THINGS UP:** Last spring, he told reporters that he added a changeup to his pitch mix after connecting with 2024 AL Cy Young Tarik Skubal in the offseason to learn about his grip...Skubal sent Ray pictures, video and was available to chat with him about the pitch...Ray threw it 399 times (13.0% of the time) through 32 starts last year (all to righties), with batters going 17-for-73 (.233) with 16 strikeouts off the pitch.

**LEFT ON READ:** Left-handers slashed .188/.282/.318 off him last season...the .188 average was third-best in the National League, trailing LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (.174) and SD's Nick Pivetta (.185).

**FAST AND FURIOUS:** Batters hit .208 (75x361) off his four-seamer last season, his most used pitch (52.0%)...the pitch had a +9 run value, his highest of any pitch since 2022 (slider)...additionally, Ray's 108 strikeouts with a four-seamer were most in the NL and ranked second in the Majors behind only MIN's Joe Ryan (109).

**GOOD LUCK CHUCK:** The Giants were 22-10 in his starts last season...the .688 winning percentage ranked as the second-best record of any NL team behind the same starter, trailing only the Phillies 23-9 (.719) record with Cristopher Sánchez on the mound...it also tied NYY's Max Fried for the third-best team record among starters in MLB, (other: Boston's Garret Crochet at 23-9).

# TYLER MAHLE RHP #54

2026 RECORD: 0-2, 4.30 ERA

- ▶ Is coming off his best start as a Giant...threw 5.2 shutout innings last Wednesday vs. Philadelphia and held batters to three hits with four walks and six strikeouts.
- ▶ Will face his former team for the first time in his career... Mahle was drafted by the Reds in 2013 & went 31-38 with a 4.35 ERA in six seasons (114 games) with Cincinnati.
- ▶ The Reds are the only MLB team he's yet to face...the veteran has faced all other 29 clubs in his 10-year career.

### #47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper  
**Last Game:** 4/11 at BAL; 1.1ip, 3h, r, er, 3k (29 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-12 (.167) with two walks and four strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (69-for-381) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 7-for-12 with three XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup  
**Last Game:** 4/12 at BAL; 1.0ip, h, bb (20 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in seven of SF's first 16 games.
- ▶ Has allowed runs in one of his seven games and has issued at least one walk in five of seven contests (seven walks in 8.1ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 7-for-19 (.368) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 1-for-10 (.100).
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

### #93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter  
**Last Game:** 4/12 at BAL; 0.2ip, h, r, er, bb, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ With his win last Wednesday, at age 33 years and 56 days old, he became the oldest pitcher in the San Francisco era (since 1958) to earn their first career MLB win as a member of the Giants.
- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's 16 games, tossing 7.1-innings.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 41.0 innings dating to June 11, 2023, which is the ninth longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball  
**Last Game:** 4/11 at BAL; 0.2ip, h, r, er, bb, 2k, hr (17 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed his first hit and run of 2026 on Saturday at Baltimore...has thrown 6.0 innings overall with nine strikeouts and three walks.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup  
**Last Game:** 4/12 at BAL; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in six of SF's 16 games, allowing four runs in 5.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 50.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fourth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

### #46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter  
**Last Game:** 4/10 vs. BAL; 1.0ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, k, hr (18 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with RHP José Buttó being placed on the IL... logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants MGR Tony Vitello while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside RHP José Buttó and OF Drew Gilbert in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.
- ▶ Went 6-4 with a 3.62 ERA (39er, 97.0ip) with 111 strikeouts over 21 games between Triple-A Sacramento and Triple-A Syracuse.

### #74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Slider  
**Last Game:** 4/12 at BAL; 0.2ip, 3h, r, er, 2k (20 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in six of SF's first 16 games
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.
- ▶ Enjoyed his best stretch of the 2025 season from July 4-September 3 where he posted a 1.64 ERA (4er, 22.0ip) in 23 games.

### #67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider  
**Last Game:** 4/10 at BAL; 1.0ip (11 pitches)

- ▶ His next strikeout will be the 100th of his career.
- ▶ Five of his seven appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.
