AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their six-game road trip tonight with the first game of a three-game set at the Athletics (through Sun)...are 3-0 on the road trip after sweeping a three-game series at Kansas City...after this road trip, will return home for a six-game homestand, featuring three-game sets vs. Cleveland (Tues.-Thurs.) and Boston (6/5-7).

- Their 34-22 (.607) record is the second-best in the American League and the fifth-best record in the Majors.
- Have won each of their last four games (since 5/24) and six of their last nine games (since 5/18)...**are 26-15 in their last 41 games (since 4/13)**.
- Have won or split 10 of their last 13 series (7-3-3 since 4/13) and 13 of their 18 series this season (10-5-3).
- The Yankees'+89 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the third-best in the Majors.

WHERE WE LEFT OFF: The Yankees completed a three-game sweep of the Royals with a 7-0 win on Wednesday at Kauffman Stadium...**RHP Gerrit Cole** (6.2IP, 4H, 0R, 0BB, 10K) earned his first win of the year after striking out 10 batters over 6.2 scoreless innings...**DH Ben Rice** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 triple, 3RBI, 1BB) reached base three times and drove in three of the Yankees' seven runs, hitting a go-ahead RBI triple in the fourth inning and a two-run single in the seventh inning...**RF Aaron Judge** (0-for-3, 1RBI, 1SF) drove in a run in the fourth inning with a sac fly...**1B Paul Goldschmidt** (2-for-4, 1R, 1RBI, 1BB) recorded his second straight multi-hit game and reached base three times, including a bases-loaded walk in the seventh inning...**3B Ryan McMahon** (2-for-4, 2R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his fifth HR of the year with a two-run shot in the eighth inning...**RHP Fernando Cruz** (1.1IP) and **RHP Camilo Doval** (1.0IP) were both scoreless in relief.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF **Ben Rice** reached base three times and drove in three of the Yankees' seven runs on Wednesday at Kansas City, hitting a go-ahead RBI triple in the fourth inning and a two-run single in the seventh inning...has reached base in 7-of-11PA over his last two games, going 5-for-9 with 4R, 1 double, 1 triple, 4RBI and 2BB.
► Has hit .290/.383/.623 (53-for-183) with 40R, 11 doubles, 1 triple, 16HR, 37RBI, 27BB/21BB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 51 games this season...has reached base safely in 38-of-47 starts.

PITCH PERFECT: Yankees pitchers tossed their seventh shutout of the season and second in their last four games on Wednesday at Kansas City (also 3/25 at San Francisco, 3/27 at San Francisco, 3/31 at Seattle, 4/19 vs. Kansas City, 4/21 at Boston and 5/24 vs. Tampa Bay)...**have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of their last seven games (since 5/20), including 2ER-or-fewer in five of those games, posting a 1.57 ERA (63.0IP, 11ER) over that span.**

- Have held opponents to a .146/.214/.188 (7-for-48) slash line with RISP over their last seven games.
- Have posted an AL-best 3.14 ERA this season and rank second in the Majors, trailing only Los Angeles-NL (3.12).

COLE TRAIN: RHP **Gerrit Cole** earned his first win of the season on Wednesday at Kansas City after striking out 10 batters over 6.2 scoreless innings (4H, 0BB)...**has not allowed a run 12.2 in innings this season.**

- Marked his 63rd career double-digit strikeout game and franchise-record 28th as a Yankee...was his first game with at least 10K since 8/10/24 vs. Texas (10K)...has recorded double-digit strikeouts in 49 games since the start of 2019, marking the most in the Majors over that span (next: Max Scherzer-32)...his 57 games with at least 10K since the beginning of 2018 are also the most in the Majors over that stretch (next: Max Scherzer-50).
- His 23 games with at least 10K and 0BB are the fifth-most in Major League history, trailing only Randy Johnson (36), Max Scherzer (31), Curt Schilling (27) and Clayton Kershaw (27)...his 21 such games since the start of 2018 are the most in the Majors (next: Max Scherzer and Zack Wheeler-15)...has recorded at least 10K and 0BB in 10 starts as a Yankee, the most in franchise history (next: Mike Mussina-seven).
- Struck out 10 batters on Wednesday despite throwing only 79 pitches...became only the second Yankees pitcher in the last 25 years (since 2002) to throw fewer than 80 pitches in a game and record at least 10K (also Domingo Germán's 78 pitches and 11K on 4/15/23 vs. Minnesota).

GOT YOUR NUMBER: INF **Jazz Chisholm Jr.** has hit .455/.571/.091 (5-for-11) with 1 double, 2HR and 3BB in his career vs. the Athletics' RHP Luis Severino...**OF Aaron Judge** has hit .500/.556/1.000 (4-for-8) with 1 double, 1HR and 1BB in his career against Severino...**INF/OF Cody Bellinger** has hit .333/.333/.417 (4-for-12) with 1 double against Severino in his career.

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have allowed 2R-or-fewer in each of their last seven starts (since 5/20), posting a 1.27 ERA (42.2IP, 6ER) over that span...have allowed 1R-or-fewer in five of their last six starts (since 5/21).

- Have posted a 2.98 ERA (308.1IP, 102ER) and 305K in 56 starts this season...**have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 48 of their 56 starts this season, tied with Milwaukee for the most in the Majors...also marks their second-most in franchise history through their first 56 games of a season,** trailing only their 49 starts in 2022.
- Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in each of their last eight starts (since 5/19) and 16 of their last 17 starts (since 5/9).
- **Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.317), opponents' OPS (.596) and HR/9.0IP (0.73),** rank second in ERA (2.98, second in AL), WHIP (1.09, first in AL), opponents' BA (.209, first in AL) and opponents' OBP (.279, first in AL), third in strikeout rate (24.5%, second in AL), tied for fourth in strikeouts (305, tied for second in AL), fifth in innings pitched (308.1, third in AL), sixth in K/BB (3.05, third in AL) and K/9.0IP (8.90, third in AL), and seventh in BB/9.0IP (2.92, fourth in AL).

ALL RISE: OF **Aaron Judge** has hit .301/.415/.653 (53-for-176) with 37R, 9 doubles, 1 triple, 17HR, 47RBI, 33BB, 2HP and 1SF in 48 career games vs. the Athletics...has hit 7HR in his last 14 games vs. the A's (since 4/24/24).
► Has reached base in 7-of-17PA over his last four games (since 5/24), going 5-for-14 (.357) with 1R, 2 doubles, 1HR, 4RBI, 2BB and 1SF over that span.

BRONX BOMBERS: Yankees batters outscored the Royals, 26-4, during their three-game set at Kansas City...also hit 8HR during the series.

GOOD AS GOLD: INF **Paul Goldschmidt** recorded his second straight multi-hit game and reached base three times on Wednesday at Kansas City, including a bases-loaded walk in the seventh inning...**has hit .311/.393/.554 (23-for-74) with 12R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 4HR, 12RBI, 8BB and 2HP over his last 22 games (since 4/26).**

- Has hit .353/.560/.647 (6-for-17) with 2 doubles, 1HR, 11RBI, 6BB and 2HP with RISP this season...as a Yankee (since 2025), has batted .317/.417/.429 (40-for-126) with 8 doubles, 2HR, 45RBI, 20BB/51BB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF **Jazz Chisholm Jr.** is batting .400/.471/.667 (18-for-45) with 8R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR, 6RBI, 6BB and 2SB over his last 12 games (since 5/13).

- Has reached base multiple times in eight of his last 11G (since 5/15).

McMAHON OF THE HOUR: INF **Ryan McMahon** hit his fifth HR of the year with a two-run shot in the eighth inning on Wednesday at Kansas City...is hitting .286/.286/.619 (6-for-21) with 3R, 1 double, 2HR, 5RBI and 1SB over his last six games (since 5/19).

MERRY GRISHMAS: OF **Trent Grisham** reached base twice on Wednesday at Kansas City after entering the game as a pinch hitter...is batting .458/.519/.708 (11-for-24) with 4R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 2RBI and 3BB over his last seven games (since 5/19).

HIP HIP JOSÉ: INF/OF **José Caballero** has reached base safely in 26 of his last 31 games with a PA (since 4/13), batting .301/.357/.466 (31-for-103) with 15R, 5 doubles, 4HR, 10RBI, 6BB, 3HP and 8SB over that span.

CRUZ CONTROL: RHP **Fernando Cruz** tossed 1.1 scoreless innings on Wednesday at Kansas City...**has not allowed a run in each of his last eight games (9.0IP) and 14 of his last 15 games (since 4/25), going 2-1 with a 0.61 ERA (14.2IP, 1ER) and 17K during that longer stretch.**

- Has not allowed a run in 22 of his 26 games this season, going 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA (23.0IP, 5ER) and 30K.
- Has stranded 17 of his 21 inherited runners this season.

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF **Cody Bellinger** is hitting .303/.397/.596 (30-for-99) with 16R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 22RBI, 16BB, 2SB and 1SF over his last 27 games (since 4/28).

- In 22 career games vs. the Athletics, has hit .352/.408/.489 (31-for-88) with 16R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR, 11RBI, 9BB, 1SF and 1SB.
- Has hit .319/.386/.489 (15-for-47) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 22RBI, 7BB and 3SF with RISP this year.
- According to FanGraphs and Sports Info Solutions, leads all Major League LF in DRS (12) and is tied for fifth in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (11, tied for second in AL).

HIGH VOLTAGE: INF **Anthony Volpe** is batting .310/.394/.517 (9-for-29) with 7R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 7RBI, 4BB and 2SB over his last eight games (since 5/17)...has reached base in 18-of-41PA over his last 10G (since 5/15), posting a .439 OBP during that stretch (9H, 9BB).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP CARLOS RODÓN (0-2, 4.15 ERA)

LHP Carlos Rodón will make his fourth start of the season in tonight's series opener at the Athletics...the 33-year-old will make the start on extended seven days' rest...made his last start on 5/21 vs. Toronto, taking his second loss of the season despite allowing just 1R/ER in 5.0IP (3H, 3BB, 7K, 0HR)...missed the first 40 team games of the season...was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day injured list on 5/10...made three rehab starts with High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, posting a 3.38 ERA (16.0IP, 13H, 7R/6ER, 3BB, 16K, 3HR)...was placed on the 15-day injured list on 3/25 (retroactive to 3/22) recovering from left elbow surgery...underwent a left elbow arthroscopy procedure on 10/15/25...the procedure was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache at the Kerlan-Jobe Surgery Center in Los Angeles, Calif...went 18-9 with a 3.09 ERA (195.1IP, 132H, 74R/67ER, 73BB, 203K, 22HR) in 33 starts last season...set career highs in wins, starts and innings pitched...was named to his third All-Star team and first as a Yankee (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco)...opponents batted .188/.272/.321 (132-for-701, 22HR); LH .177/.257/.285 (28-for-158, 5HR); RH .192/.277/.331 (104-for-543, 17HR)...recorded 203K, his second-most in a single season in his career (237K in 2022 with San Francisco)...since 2021, ranks fifth in the Majors with an 10.69 K/9.0IP ratio...is also tied for seventh in double-digit strikeout games (21) over that span, trailing only Dylan Cease (27), Kevin Gausman (25), Blake Snell (25), Gerrit Cole (25), Zack Wheeler (23) and Corbin Burnes (22)...has recorded at least 10K and 0BB in nine games, tied for the fifth-most such games in the Majors during that stretch, trailing only Wheeler (13), Gausman (12), Jacob deGrom (11) and Cole (10)...has pitched over parts of 12 Major League seasons with the Chicago White Sox (2015-21), San Francisco Giants (2022) and Yankees (2023-26)...has finished in the top-six of Cy Young voting three times (fifth in 2021 and sixth in 2022 and '25)...is a three-time All-Star (2021-22, '25)...has made six Opening Day rosters (2016, '19-22, '24-25)...began the 2017, 2018, 2023 and 2026 seasons on the injured list...was originally selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 16th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play three seasons at North Carolina State University (2012-14)...was selected by the Chicago White Sox in the first round (third overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft...signed a six-year Major League contract with the Yankees extending through the 2028 season on 12/21/22.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his last start on 5/21 vs. Toronto, taking his second loss of the season despite allowing just 1R/ER in 5.0IP (3H, 3BB, 7K, 0HR)...retired 14 of his final 18 batters faced...allowed his only run on an RBI double to Daulton Varsho in the first inning.

ROAD RULES: Will make his third road start of the season...in two road starts this season, is 0-1 with a 5.63 ERA (8.0IP, 5ER) and 10K.

- As a Yankee (since 2023), has gone 17-17 with a 4.44 ERA (237.1IP, 117ER) and 263K in 45 road starts.
- Made 18 starts on the road in 2025, going 8-5 with a 3.18 ERA (104.2IP, 84H, 44R/37ER, 41BB, 110K, 9HR)...tossed at least 6.0IP in 12 of those starts...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 13 of those starts...went 4-1 with a 2.25 ERA (36.0IP, 30H, 10R/9ER, 12BB, 28K, 2HR) over his last six road starts (8/6-9/20)...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in all six starts.

VS. ATHLETICS: Has made nine career starts vs. the A's, going 5-1 with a 2.75 ERA (55.2IP, 45H, 17R/ER, 15BB, 54K, 5HR)...has allowed 2R-or-fewer in seven of those starts.

- Made one start vs. the Athletics last season, allowing 4R/ER in 6.0IP without recording a decision at Sutter Health Park in Sacramento (8H, 0BB, 10K, 2HR).
- Has made six starts at the Athletics, going 3-1 with a 3.63 ERA (34.2IP, 34H, 14R/ER, 11BB, 38K, 4HR).

ALL THAT'S LEFT: In his career, left-handed batters have hit just .215/.289/.331 (215-for-1,001)...has also surrendered just 24HR.

- His 9.91 K/9.0IP ratio since his Major League debut in 2015 ranks fourth among left-handed pitchers in that span (min. 1,000.0IP), trailing only Chris Sale (11.72), Blake Snell (11.20) and Robbie Ray (10.82).
- Since 2015, his 1.426K are the fifth-most among active left-handed pitchers...his 28 double-digit strikeout games over that stretch among lefties are the fifth-most in the Majors, trailing only Sale (74), Ray (40), Clayton Kershaw (39) and Snell (38).

2026: In three starts this year, is 0-2 with a 4.15 ERA (13.0IP, 8H, 7R/6ER, 11BB, 17K, 0HR)...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of those starts.

- Has held opponents to a .178/.345/.267 (8-for-45) slash line this season...has not allowed a HR to his 59 batters faced.
- Has allowed 3H-or-fewer in each of his three starts, allowing just 4XBH.

2025: Went 18-9 with a 3.09 ERA (195.1IP, 132H, 74R/67ER, 73BB, 203K, 22HR) in 33 starts...**set career highs in wins, starts and innings pitched**...was named to his third All-Star team and first as a Yankee (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco).

- Opponents batted .188/.272/.321 (132-for-701, 22HR); LH .177/.257/.285 (28-for-158, 5HR); RH .192/.277/.331 (104-for-543, 17HR).
- Finished sixth in the AL Cy Young Award voting.
- Recorded 203K, his second-most in a single season in his career (237K in 2022 with San Francisco)...became the 17th pitcher (22nd time) in franchise history to record at least 200K in a single season...his 203K were the sixth-most by a left-handed pitcher in franchise history, trailing only Ron Guidry (248K in 1978), CC Sabathia (230K in 2011), Al Downing (217K in 1964), Randy Johnson (211K in 2005) and Whitey Ford (209K in 1961).
- Ranked second in opponents' BA (.188, first in AL), was tied for second in wins (tied for second in AL) and games started (tied for first in AL), tied for fourth in innings pitched (tied for second in AL), sixth in opponents' SLG (.321, third in AL) and opponents' OPS (.593, third in AL), and 10th in strikeouts (fourth in AL) and opponents' OBP (.272, seventh in AL)...also ranked seventh in the AL in strikeout rate (25.7%) and WHIP (1.05), eighth in ERA, ninth in K/9.0IP (9.35) and 10th in HR/9.0IP (1.01).
- Allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 22 of his 33 starts and one-or-zero ER in 14 starts...his 22 starts of 2ER-or-fewer were tied for the seventh-most in the Majors (tied for fourth in AL)...made six scoreless starts.
- Became the first pitcher in franchise history to eclipse 200K while surrendering less than 140H in a single season.
- Made his second career Opening Day start and first with the Yankees on 3/27 vs. Milwaukee (also 2019 with Chicago-AL)...earned the win after allowing only 1R/ER in 5.1 innings (4H, 2BB, 7K, 1HR)...was the 60th different pitcher to start on Opening Day for the Yankees and the 18th left-handed pitcher...along with Nestor Cortes in 2024, marked the first time the Yankees have had two different left-handed pitchers start consecutive Opening Days since Tommy John (1989) and Dave LaPoint (1990).
