RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals wrap up their seven-game beerstand homestand with today's four-game series finale with the Colorado Rockies.. St. Louis opened its homestand by taking two of three from division-rival Milwaukee...today is the Cardinals' 13th of 16 straight games without an off-day (Aug. 13-28).

TIME TO FLY: Winners of six of seven and 12 of their last 15. St. Louis sports the best record (12-3) across Major League Baseball since August 9 and the National League's 3rd-best winning pct. (.650, 26-14) since the All-Star break. The Cardinals enter today a season-high 12 games over .500 and in first place in the NL Central, 1.5 games ahead of Chicago.

SWEEP STAKES: A win this afternoon would give St. Louis its:

- 1st Series Sweep of Colorado since: July 24-26, 2017 at Busch Std. (3g).
- 1st 4-Game Series Sweep of Colorado since: Sept. 30-Oct. 3, 2010 at Busch Stadium (final series of the season)
- 8th Series Sweep Overall in 2019: at Pirates (2g-April 1-3); vs. Dodgers (4g-April 8-11); vs. Brewers (3g-April 22-24); vs. Cubs (3g-May 31-June 2); at Pirates (4g-July 22-25); vs. Pirates (3g-Aug. 9-11); at Royals (2g-Aug. 13-14).
- 5th Series Sweep at Busch in 2019: Dodgers (4g-April 8-11); Brewers (3g-April 22-24); Cubs (3g-May 31-June 2); Pirates (3g-August 9-11).
- 3rd 4-Game Series Sweep in 2019: vs. Dodgers (April 8-11 at St. Louis); at Pirates (July 22-25). The Last time the Cardinals completed three different four-game series sweeps in a season was 2010 (all at home): April 26-29 vs. Braves; July 15-18 vs. Dodgers; Sept. 30-Oct. 3, 2010 vs. Rockies.

TAP THE ROCKIES: Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, St. Louis' .735 home win pct. (37-13) vs. the Rockies is its best against any opponent. The Cardinals have defeated Colorado in 11 of their last 12 home games (May 18, 2016-present) and are 28-6 (.824 win pct.) at Busch Stadium vs. the Rock Pile over their last 34 meetings (since Sept. 30, 2010).

HOME SWEET HOME: The Cardinals are 9-1 (.900) at home in August, with only Houston (.909, 10-1) sporting a higher home win pct in MLB. Overall this season, St. Louis is 39-24 at Busch Std. with a .619 home win pct. (3rd in NL)... Lasts season, the Cardinals were 35-28 in their first 63 home games.

MOLINA MILESTONES: Last night, Yadier Molina caught his 150th career shutout, 4th-most all-time in MLB history since 1900, trailing Carlton Fisk (157), Gary Carter (168) and Yogi Berra (184). Molina makes his 1,917th appearance at catcher this afternoon to tie Benito Santiago for 11th all-time in MLB history, and is two career RBI from 900, two career walks from 500, and 16 hits from tying Ozzie Smith (1,944) for 7th all-time in Cardinals history.

TAKE CARE OF BUSINESS: Beginning tomorrow, 20 of St. Louis' remaining 33 games are vs. the NL Central (CHI 7; MIL 6; CIN 4; PIT 3). The Cardinals are 33-23 in divisional play in 2019, including a 18-6 record since the All-Star Break.

TODAY IN CARDINALS HISTORY (August 25): 1942: Mort Cooper hurls a complete game while allowing one run over 14 innings as the Cardinals defeat the Brooklyn Dodgers, 2-1 in 14 innings at Busch Stadium I. **Terry Moore** singles home Marty Marion for the game-winner. 1995: The Cardinals defeat the Rockies, 8-3 at Coors Field as both leadoff hitters - St. Louis' Bernard Gilkey and Colorado's Trenidad Hubbard - homer in the 1st inning, marking the first time this has happened in the National League since 1986 (also involving St. Louis with Curt Ford and Phillies' Jeff Stone on June 20 at Veterans Stadium)

Dexter Fowler played first six seasons with the Rockies (2008-13)...originally selected by Colorado in the 14th round of the 2004 MLB Draft...is the Rockies franchise record holder in career triples (53)...traded by Colorado with cash to Houston for Brandon Barnes and Jordan Lyles (Dec. 3, 2013).

Marcell Ozuna's cousin, Pablo Ozuna, played in 17 games for the Rockies in 2003.

Paul DeJong made his MLB debut at Colorado (May 28, 2017)...became the 9th Cardinal in history to homer in his first MLB at-bat, a pinch-hit 9th inning solo home run off Greg Holland

Harrison Bader (July 25, 2017 at Busch Stadium) and **John Brebbia** (May 28, 2017 at Coors Field) both made their MLB debuts against the Rockies.

Matt Wieters (junior) and Charlie Blackmon (medical redshirt-tendinitis in throwing arm) were teammates at Georgia Tech Univ. in 2007.

Cardinals Asst. GM & Scouting Director Ran**dy Flores** pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado. Andrew Miller and Bryan Shaw were teammates on the 2016 AL Champion Cleveland Indians.

Rockies manager Bud Black previously managed **Miles Mikolas** (2012-13) while in San Diego, where he made his MLB debut under Black.

Tim Melville graduated from Wentzville Holt High School, where he was the Aflac National Player of the Year as a junior.

Dom Nuñez and Cardinals 2016 1st rounder **Dylan Carlson** were teammates at Elk Grove (Calif.) High School in 2013.

Rockies bullpen coach **Darren Holmes** pitched in five games for St. Louis during the 2000 season.

MLB.com Cardinals reporter Anne Rogers previously worked as a Rockies Associate Reporter under **Thomas Harding** in 2018.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter Derrick Goold is originally from Boulder, Colo...attended Centaurus High School in Lafavette, Colo...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations John **Mozeliak** began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in baseball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant in scouting operations following the 1995 season... graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Sr. Special Asst. to the GM Bob Gebhard served as the Rockies' first GM (1991-99). hired **John Mozeliak** in 1993...worked as a special assistant to former Cardinals General Manager Walt Jocketty in St. Louis after leaving the Rockies in 1999...resides in nearby Centennial, Colo.

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 18th start (23rd appearance) of the season, and the 145th start of his career (150th appearance).
- Is facing the Rockies for the first time since the 2016 season.
- Is 1-0 with a 1.06 ERA (17.0/2 ER) in his last four home appearances (2 starts) dating to June 4, with 17 strikeouts, 2 walks and just one HR allowed.
- Needs one win for 60 career wins. His .608 career winning percentage (59-38) ranks 8th all-time among Cardinals with 90 or more decisions.
- Is making just his 2nd home start since 6/21 outing vs. LAA, a 5-1 win. Six of his last eight appearances (4 starts, 2 relief) have come on the road.
- Is 5-6 with a 5.15 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0 with a 5.68 ERA in five relief appearances. However, he is 1-0 with a 1.54 ERA in his last four relief appearances following a six-run outing (1.0 IP) in his first relief appearance of the season at PHI (5/29).
- Is 4-5, 5.40 ERA in 11 road starts (14 app.) and 2-1, 4.91 ERA in six starts (8 app.) at Busch Stadium in 2019.

LAST TIME OUT

 Blanked the Brewers for 4.0 IP last Tue. (8/20) in his first start at Busch Stadium since June 21. Cardinals posted back-to-back 4-run innings in the 6th & 7th for a 9-4 win.

- Has returned to the starting rotation twice this season after being sent to the bullpen; first on June 10 at Miami after two appearances out of the bullpen and earlier this month (8/15) after three relief appearances (7/19-27).
- Went 2-2 with a 2.84 ERA (25.1 IP) and 17 strikeouts in five June games (four starts).
 Was the 13th-lowest ERA in the NL and the lowest June ERA in his career.
- Is averaging 5.86 run support average, which would lead St. Louis and rank 11th in the National League, but does not have enough qualifying innings.
- Has thrown 3.0 innings or more in each of his last two relief appearances with the most recent tossing 4.2 innings vs. HOU (7/27) holding the Astros to one run on six hits.
- Allowed just two 5th inning runs, but was saddled with 2-1 loss, as the Cardinals were held to just two hits on 8/15 at Cincinnati.
- Earned the win at CIN (7/19) tossing 1.2 scoreless innings as the Cardinals rallied from a 7-0 deficit with 10 runs in the 6th inning for a 12-11 win. It was his first relief win since 8/19/13 at MIL, and the Cardinals largest comeback win since 2002 (8 runs at CIN).
- Threw a season-high 7.0 innings at SD (6/28) allowing two runs in a 3-1 Cardinals loss at PETCO Park; his longest outing since tossing 8.0 scoreless innings vs. PIT on June 3, 2018 at Busch Stadium after carrying a no-hitter into the 9th inning.
