NIGHT OWL: Has gone 3-1 with a 2.25 ERA (7 ER/28.0 IP) in eight night appearances (5 GS) this season.

HOME SWEET HOME: Owns a 1-0 record with a 1.88 ERA (5 ER/24.0 IP) in seven appearances (4 GS) at Oriole Park this season; five of his seven home outings have been scoreless, including two starts.

SIGH OF RELIEF: Has registered a 1-0 record with a 0.90 ERA (1 ER/10.0 IP) in seven relief outings this season compared to a 2-2 record with a 3.12 ERA (15 ER/43.1 IP) in nine starts.
