YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the Rangers, 11-2, in the series opener...Tied a season high with four home runs, including the first of the campaign from **Heston Kjerstad**, the 16th different Oriole to go deep this year...**Corbin Burnes** allowed one run and tied an 0's season high with 7.0 innings to become one of 13 pitchers this season with at least nine wins, including **Grayson Rodriguez**.

ALL-STAR VOTING: MLB announced the finalists for the 2024 MLB All-Star Game yesterday... The second phase of voting, which begins on Sunday, June 30th at 12:00 p.m. ET at MLB.com/vote, features the top two vote-getters at each position in each League (and the top six outfielders in the NL; next four outfielders in the AL after leading vote-getter Aaron Judge) based on vote totals from Phase 1, which ran from June 5-27; fans can vote once per day, as opposed to five times in Phase 1...Six O's advanced as finalists at their respective positions; Baltimore has not had multiple starters in an All-Star Game since Adam Jones and Nelson Cruz in 2014.

② Adley Rutschman led AL catchers and ranked third in the AL with 2,791,952 votes; he will match up with Kansas City's Salvador Perez; he's seeking his second All-Star nod (2023) and first starting assignment and would become the third 0's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with Gus Triandos in 1958 and 1959, and Terry Kennedy in 1987; Matt Wieters was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).

③ Gunnar Henderson led AL shortstops with 2,664,120 votes; he will face Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr.; he's vying for his first career All-Star selection and would be the first Orioles shortstop selected to the Midsummer Classic since Manny Machado in 2018.

⑤ Ryan Mountcastle led AL first basemen with 2,296,697 votes; he meets Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr.; he's seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first 0's first baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Chris Davis in 2013.

② Jordan Westburg ranked second among AL third basemen with 1,478,679 votes, behind Cleveland's Jose Ramírez (2,336,628); he's seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first O'rioles third baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Machado in 2016.

② Anthony Santander finished fourth among AL outfielders with 1,478,034 votes behind New York-AL's Aaron Judge (3,425,309) and Juan Soto (3,000,121), and Cleveland's Steven Kwan (1,723,074), and ahead of Houston's Ky

WHAT'S TRENDING: At 51-30 (.630), the Birds own the third-best record in MLB, behind the Guardians (.646, 51-28), and Phillies (.654, 53-28)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 152-91 (.626), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors during that time...The 0's are 235-170 (.580) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.584, 236-168), Braves (.618, 249-154), and Dodgers (.645, 262-144).

- HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 136 home runs and are one of three clubs with 100+ homers this season, along with the Yankees (119) and Dodgers (111)...The Birds have homered in 25 of the last 26 games, including a club-record 22 consecutive games from June 1-23.
 The O's have hit 57 home runs this month, the most homers in June in club history, ahead of the 56 long balls in June 2016; that trails only the 2022 Yankees (58) and 2023 Braves (61) for the most in the month of June in MLB history, and are tied for the second-most in any month in O's history with August 2017, trailing only May 1987 (58); besides the Braves in June 2023, the only other MLB team with more than 60 home runs in a month is the Yankees in August 2019 (74).
 The 136 homers are the most through 81 games in team history; Baltimore is the 10th MLB team since at least 1901 with 136+ home runs in the first 81 games of a season and the first since Atlanta hit 153 last season.
 The O's are 44-20 this year when homering, 35-6 when hitting multiple home runs, 19-5 when hitting at least three, and 5-2 when hitting four.
 Baltimore has an MLB-best seven players with at least 10 home runs: Gunnar Henderson (26), Anthony Santander (21), Adleg Rutschman (15), Jordan Westburg (13), Colton Cowser and Ryan Mountcastle (11), and Ryan O'Hearn (10); no other team has more than five such players this season.
 Henderson and Santander are one of two duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season (CLE's José Ramírez and Josh Naylor).
 The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; Gunnar Henderson has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with Cedric Mullins (2021), trailing only Brady Anderson (12, 1996).

- TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson ranks second in MLB with 26 homers, trailing only New York-AL's Aaron Judge (30)...He's among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see box at right).

 Observed Henderson owns a career-best 34-game on-base streak since May 22, the longest active streak in MLB; marks the longest on-base streak by an 0's batter since Nick Markakis' 38-game streak from July 5 to August 18, 2009, and the longest by a batter 23 years old or younger in Orders between
 - Orioles history. He leads MLB with 72 runs scored this season, the most runs through the first 81 team games of a season in 0's history; the only players in team history to lead the AL in runs are **Frank Robinson** in 1966 (122) and **Cal Ripken**, **Jr.** in 1982 (121); Robinson is the only player in Orioles history to lead MLB in runs, when he tied with Atlanta's Felipe Alou. Had a career-long 14-game hitting streak from June 6-21, the longest hitting streak by an 0's batter since **Anthony Santander** had a 16-game streak from July 16 to August 6, 2022.

SUMMER SLUGGER: Anthony Santander leads MLB with 12 home runs this month, tied for the most in the month of June in Orioles history with Boog Powell (1964), Rafael Palmeiro (1998), Albert Belle (2000), and Chris Davis (2013)...He is the first Oriole with at least 12 home runs in a month since Manny Machado in August of 2017 (also 12)...Trails only Jim Gentile (15 in August 1961), Nelson Cruz (13 in May 2014), and Frank Robinson (13 in July 1966) for the most home runs hit in a single month by an Orioles

Santander's 82 home runs since the start of 2022 are the most by a switch hitter, third in the AL, and 11th in MLB; the only AL players to hit more in that span are Houston's Yordan Alvarez (84) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (129).

MONTHLY DUES: The Orioles have clinched a winning record in June, the team's ninth consecutive winning month (min. 10 games played) since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the 0's since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the Elias Sports Bureau...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors; Atlanta had its streak of 11 straight winning months since June 2022 snapped with a 13-14 record in May.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue a seven-game homestand with the second game in a four-game series against the Rangers...The final two games will be nationally televised, with Saturday on FOX's Baseball Night in America and Sunday on ESPN's Sunday Night Baseball...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, this will be Baltimore's 35th appearance on Sunday Night Baseball (15-19).

AGAINST TEXAS: The Orioles and Rangers are meeting for the first time since the 2023 ALDS this weekend with four games at Camden Yards...Baltimore travels to Texas for a three-game series after the All-Star break from July 19-21...Since the start of 2021, the 0's are 14-6 (.700) against the Rangers, including a perfect 6-0 in 2022...Texas swept the ALDS in three games against the 0's last year, winning the first two games at Oriole Park, on the way to the franchise's first World Series title.

<u>ROSTER MOVES:</u> The Orioles recalled left-handed pitcher **Matt Krook** and placed right-handed pitcher **Corbin Burnes** on the Paternity List...Infielder/outfielder **Nick Maton** has cleared outright waivers and accepted an assignment to Triple-A Norfolk after yesterday's game.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the 0's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 366 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers.

CITY CONNECT FRIDAYS: The Orioles will wear their City Connect jerseys at each Friday home game throughout the regular season...This year, every City Connect Friday will be dedicated to a Baltimore City public school...To learn more, visit Orioles.com/CityConnect.
