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WHEN...	NATIONALS NEWS
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RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD

The Washington Nationals wrap up a three-game series against the Colorado Rockies today at Coors Field...Washington is 11-5 in rubber games this season...With a win today, the Nationals would secure their third consecutive series win against the Rockies at Coors Field since June 21-23, 2024.

- The Nationals fell to the Rockies last night, 8-7...**CJ Abrams** recorded his third career multi-homer game finishing the night with 4 RBI, a walk and two runs scored.
- Following this series, the Nationals will return home and enjoy a day off on Thursday before starting a six game homestand beginning on Friday against the Arizona Diamondbacks.

OUT OF THIS WORLD

CJ Abrams has hit safely in 14 of his last 16 games, including four doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, five walks, two stolen bases and 10 runs scored during that span.

- Abrams has homered in three straight games for the third time this season, joining **James Wood** and **Munetaka Murakami** as the only three players in Major League Baseball to record three separate three-game homer streaks this season.
- He is one home run away from tying Ian Desmond (25, 2012) for most home runs in a season by a Nationals (2005-pres.) shortstop.

THUNDER FROM DOWN UNDER

Since July 1, **Curtis Mead** is hitting .400 (22-for-55) with six doubles, one triple, three homers, nine RBI, seven walks, two stolen bases and 12 runs scored in 14 games...He has hit safely in 11 of the 14.

- He leads the National League among third baseman in doubles (6), tied for first in triples (1), second in hits (18) and sixth in slugging percentage (.604) since July 1.

ROAD WARRIORS

The Nationals are 12-3-1 in road series this season and 31-20 (.608) on the road overall, tied for the second most road wins in Major League Baseball with the Yankees and behind only the Dodgers (33)...The .608 road winning percentage is third in all of baseball behind the Dodgers (.627) and Brewers (.612).

- Washington has won three consecutive road series and eight of its last nine series away from home.
- The Nationals have not lost a road series since June 21 against Tampa Bay.
- Washington's three road series losses are all separated by more than a month this season (4/1 at PHI, 5/10 at MILA, 6/21 at TB).

HOMERS EVERYWHERE

Washington has hit 149 home runs this season, the most in Major League Baseball...The 149 homers are the second-most in team history (2005-pres.) through 102 games behind only the 2017 Nationals (156 HR).

- The Nationals have clubbed 112 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball, 16 more than the Phillies (94)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals are one of two clubs in Major League Baseball to have three players with at least 20 home runs this season along with the Chicago White Sox.

POP FROM THE TOP

James Wood is 24-for-69 (.348) with a .489 on-base percentage (19 BB) and a .797 slugging percentage (5 2B, 3B, 8 HR) in his last 18 games...He's reached safely in 39 of his last 74 plate appearances (22 H, 17 BB, 11 SO).

- He clubbed his Major League leading 10th leadoff home run on July 12 vs. New York (AL)...His 10 leadoff homers are the most in a season in franchise history (MON/WSH).
- Wood has 13 career leadoff homers, one shy of matching **Trea Turner's** Nationals record (2005-pres.) 14 and two shy of tying **Brad Wilkerson's** franchise record (MON/WSH) 15.

NOT ON THE LIST? SORRY.

A few exclusive lists containing several Washington players include:

- CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** are two of only three players in baseball with at least 20 home runs and at least 15 stolen bases this season...Wood is the only player in the 25 HR/15 SB club.
- There are 18 players in Major League Baseball with at least 20 home runs and at least 60 RBI...**James Wood**, **CJ Abrams** and **Luis García Jr.** are three of the 18...No other team has three players on the list.

LUIS! LUIS!

Luis García Jr. is in the midst of a career year, already hitting a career-high 20 home runs and closing in on his career-high of 70 RBI in 2024...He ranks in the National League in slugging percentage (4th, .546), RBI (T5th, 68) and home runs (T13th, 20).

- García Jr. has been arguably the best hitter in Major League Baseball since May 24, leading the league in RBI (46), third in slugging percentage (.671) and home runs (17) and sixth in OPS (1.000).
- His 11 home runs in his last 24 games are tied for second in MLB since June 19.
- He is 24-for-69 (.348) with four doubles, a triple, seven homers, 19 RBI, four walks and 11 runs in his last 18 games.
