- ♦ The D-backs hosted the Mariners in their previous 2 matchups, in 2020 (1-2) and 2018 (1-2)...this is the seventh home series at Chase Field (7-11).
- ♦ Madison Bumgarner is 2-1 with a 1.65 ERA (6 ER in 32.2 IP) in his last 5 home starts.
 - Has gone 0-1 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER in 16.0 IP) in 2 career starts vs. Mariners...lost his last start on June 17, 2015 @ Safeco Field (2 ER in 8.0 IP).
- ♦ Ketel Marte's .427 average (32-for-75) vs. left-handers leads the Majors (min. 75 PA), ahead of Trea Turner/WSH-LAD (.395), David Fletcher/LAA (.364), Buster Posey/SF (.360) and Charlie Culberson/TEX (.357).
