**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners begin a 6-game road trip with the first of 3 games against the Kansas City Royals...Seattle will also travel to Sacramento (3 G, 5/25-27) to take on the Athletics on the trip...the Mariners previously wrapped up a 6-game homestand where they hosted the Chicago White Sox (2-1) and San Diego Padres (0-3)...tonight's tilt will be televised live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call and **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners won Wednesday's series finale against the White Sox by a 5-4 score, securing the series win...the Mariners are 14-12 over their last 26 games since April 22.

- **Memorable Firsts** - **Colt Emerson** and **Jhonny Pereda** became the first duo to hit their first career home runs as consecutive team homers for the Mariners since Wladimir Balentien and Jeff Clement in games one and two of a doubleheader on Sept. 26, 2007 vs. Cleveland.
- **Naylor May-Hem** - In 19 games during May, **Josh Naylor** is batting .307 (23x75) with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 1 home run, 7 RBI, 7 walks and 8 stolen bases, reaching base at a .366 clip with a .753 OPS.
- **Ounch!** - Mariners batters rank 2nd in the Majors with 36 HBP this season, trailing only the St. Louis Cardinals (37 HBP).

**RECENT ROSTER MOVES**...the Mariners announced today that OF **Victor Robles** was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List (right pec strain, retroactive to April 7) and INF/OF **Connor Joe** was optioned to Triple-A Tacoma...additionally, RHP **Matt Brash** was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (right lat inflammation) on Wednesday and made his first appearance since April 29 in Wednesday's series finale against the White Sox...in a corresponding move, LHP **Robinson Ortiz** was optioned to Triple-A Tacoma (post-game May 19).

**WALTER'S WORLD**...since making his MLB debut in 2021, **Logan Gilbert** is 49-40 with a 3.63 ERA (360 ER, 892.0 IP), 193 walks and 941 strikeouts...during that span, he leads American League starters in strikeouts and ranks 3rd in innings pitched...Gilbert has also recorded 73 quality starts since 2021, ranking 4th in the American League and T-12th in the Majors...over his last 5 starts against the Royals (2023-c), Gilbert is 2-1 with a 3.49 ERA (11 ER, 28.1 IP), 10 walks and 31 strikeouts.

**ALL HAIL J-ROD**...in 26 career games against the Royals, **Julio Rodríguez** owns a .376 (41x109) batting average with 18 runs, 8 doubles, 5 home runs, 26 RBI, 7 stolen bases and 9 walks, reaching base at a .424 clip and slugging .587 (1.011 OPS)...his average is the highest against any individual opponent Rodríguez has faced in his career...in 10 career games at Kauffman Stadium, he is batting .422 (19x45) with 5 doubles, 1 home run, 14 RBI, 3 stolen bases and 4 walks...since April 10 of this season, Julio has been stellar, batting .292 (45x154) with 23 runs, 10 doubles, 8 home runs, 19 RBI, 11 walks, 5 stolen bases and an .856 OPS in 38 games.

**REALLY GOOD ARMS**...the Mariners pitching staff has been solid this season, posting a combined 3.64 ERA (184 ER, 454.1 IP) with an MLB-fewest 132 walks and 443 strikeouts...among Major League pitching staffs they rank 1st in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.36), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.61), 7th in ERA, T-8th in WHIP (1.23) and 10th in strikeouts...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 292.0 innings pitched and ranks 4th in strikeouts (277)...the Seattle bullpen ranks 4th in the Majors in ERA (3.10).

**RANDY! RANDY! RANDY!**...**Randy Arozarena** is batting .302 (55x182) with 36 runs, 13 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 21 RBI, 14 stolen bases, a .393 OBP and slugging .467 for an .860 OPS in 51 games this season...Randy ranks T-5th in MLB in stolen bases this season and among AL left fielders (min. 100 PA as LF), he ranks 2nd in average, 3rd in OBP, 2nd in slugging, 2nd in wRC+ (151) and 1st in fWAR (2.0)...Randy has been scorching hot as of late, batting .413 (19x46) with a 1.130 OPS in his last 13 games (5/8-c).

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW, COLT EMERSON!**...**Colt Emerson**, the Mariners top prospect and the #3 overall prospect in baseball (*Baseball America*) was recalled from Triple-A Tacoma on Sunday for his MLB debut...he has reached base safely in all 4 Major League games he has played:

- **The Debut** - At 20 years, 301 days, Colt became the youngest Mariner to make his MLB debut since Félix Hernández (19 years, 118 days, 8/4/05 at DET)...he is the 12th-youngest player overall to debut for Seattle.
- **Sense of the Dramatic** - Emerson became the 11th player in Mariners history to homer for their first career hit...he is also the first Mariners player to hit a 3+ run homer for their first career homer since **Julio Rodríguez** (5/1/22 at MIA).
- **Young Man** - Colt became the youngest Mariners player to homer since José López (20 years, 294 days, 9/13/04 vs. LAA) and is the 7th Mariners player age 20-or-younger to homer, joining López, Orlando Mercado, Marc Newfield, Chris Snelling, Alex Rodríguez and Ken Griffey Jr.

**SEE YOU HERE NEXT WEEK**...following the current road trip, the Mariners return to T-Mobile Park for a 6-game homestand against the Diamondbacks (3 G, May 29-31) and Mets (3 G, June 1-3)...featured on the homestand is '90s weekend (May 29-31) with '90s Fireworks Night on Friday, **Julio Rodríguez** '90s Jersey Night on Saturday and '90s Pin Day on Sunday, as well as Pride Night on June 1.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...**Jhonny Pereda** hit his first career home run in Wednesday's game against the White Sox on a go-ahead solo shot in the 7th inning, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Pereda became the 7th player in Mariners history to hit their first career homer on a go-ahead home run in the 7th inning or later?...he joins Manny Castillo (8/26/1982), **Dan Wilson** (6/11/1994), Shane Monahan (8/3/1998), Ichiro Suzuki (4/6/2001), Justin Leone (7/15/2004) and Mike Zunino (6/14/2013).

### ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 22

- **1981** - The Mariners turn the third triple play in their history...Rangers Mario Mendoza lined to SS Rick Auberach, who stepped on second to put out Johnny Grubb, then threw to 1B Bruce Bochte to put out Pat Putnam in the eighth inning.
- **1985** - Matt Young retired the last 16 batters of the game, and 26 of his last 27, as the Mariners dealt the New York Yankees a 4-1 loss at the Kingdome. Young surrendered a triple and a double to two of the game's first three hitters, but allowed only one hit the rest of the way, while walking just one and striking out a career-high 10 batters.
- **2011** - Félix Hernández tied a career-high with 13 strikeouts over 8.0 innings in a 6-1 win over the Padres to complete a 3-game sweep...Hernández did not walk a batter, becoming the 4th pitcher (6th time) in club history to strikeout at least 13 batters without issuing a walk...also marked Mariners starters 9th straight game of at least 7.0+ innings pitched and 2-or-fewer runs allowed, longest streak in club history and longest by an AL team since the 1974 Baltimore Orioles (10 G).
- **2018** - The Mariners recorded their 4th extra-inning win of the season and their 1st extra inning contest on the road with a 3-2 win over the Athletics. A two-run homer by Mike Zunino tied the score in the 7th inning, and Guillermo Heredia recorded the game-winning RBI in the top of the 10th...Edwin Díaz recorded his 16th save of the season, tossing a 1-2-3 inning to complete the Mariners victory.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- Gilbert, 29, is making his 11th start of the season and 1st against the Royals...it is the 157th start of his career and 9th career start against Kansas City.
• Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau on June 16, 2018.
• Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
• Named the 2022 and the 2024 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
• Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2024.

LAST TIME OUT...L#4 on May 16 vs. San Diego, threw 6.2 innings, allowing a season-high 7 runs (7 ER) on 5 hits (3 HR) and 2 walks while striking out 5 batters.

REIGN OF TERROR...owned a 3-game streak of starts against the Royals with 7+ strikeouts and 4-or-fewer hits allowed entering his last start against KC (8/6/23-7/2/25)...is 1-of-7 MLB players all-time to have a 3 game streak of such starts against the Royals...is 1-of-6 pitchers in MLB since 2021 to have 2+ starts against the Royals with 4-or-fewer base runners allowed over 7.0+ IP, along with Luis Castillo...in 4 starts at Kauffman Stadium, Gilbert is 2-0 with a 7.36 K/9...has allowed 2-or-fewer runs with 5+ strikeouts and 1-or-fewer walks in 2-of-4 starts at Kauffman.

THE ROAD SO FAR...will be making his 4th road start of the season...enters the game with a 1.59 ERA with a 0.824 WHIP and a K/BB of 18.00 over 3 road starts (17.0 IP) this season...has recorded quality starts in 6 of his last 9 road games (8/13/25-c)...his 38 starts with 6+ strikeouts and 2-or-fewer walks in away games since 2021 ranks 5th in MLB...owned a 10.34 K/9 in away games in 2025 to rank T-9th in MLB (min. 50.0 IP)...owns 450 career strikeouts in away games ranking 6th most in Mariners history, just trailing Mike Moore (452), and leading AL starting pitchers since 2021...his 1.125 career WHIP on the road ranks 10th in AL since 2021 (min. 300 IP).

LEFTY SPLITS...ranks 4th in K/9 (11.6) against left-handed batters in MLB in 2026 and 11th in K/BB (3.1) in the AL (min 20.0 IP)...ranks 1st in strikeouts (477), T-7th (.218) in opponent batting average, 6th in K% (27.8) and 5th in WHIP (1.07) against lefty batters among AL pitchers since 2021 (min. 200.0 IP).

IN COMMAND...made his 48th start with 7+ strikeouts and 1-or-fewer walks at Chicago-AL on May 10...his 48 such start are 3rd most in MLB since 2021...also in his May 10 starts, allowed only 1 base runner for his 7th career start with 2-or-fewer base runners allowed over 6.0+ innings...he leads the MLB in such games since 2021.

MASTER OF THE CRAFT...among all-time starting pitchers with over 900 strikeouts, he ranks 6th in K/BB (4.88)...ranks 6th in the AL in 2026 with a 4.75 K/BB and is tied for 7th in BB% (5.2%) with Bryan Woo (min. 50.0 IP)...is 1-of-3 pitchers to have finished the season in the top-10 in the AL in K/BB multiple times in the last 3 seasons ('23,'25) alongside Woo ('24,'25) and Tarik Skubal ('24,'25).

HEY BATTER BATTER SWING...his 130 swing and misses in 2026 are the T-7th most in the AL while his 2,039 career swing and misses rank 5th in MLB since 2021...owns a 43.7 career whiff rate on his splitter, ranking 3rd among pitchers with 1000 splitters thrown since 2021.

PLAYING THE LONG GAME...has thrown 6.0+ innings in his last 3 starts...is his longest streak of such games this season (last: 3, 8/24/25-9/5/25)...his 83 career starts with 6.0+ innings thrown are 3rd most in AL since 2021 while his 26 games with 7.0+ innings are 8th most...owns a .844 WHIP on pitches 76-100, ranking 9th best in AL with a 9.28 K/9 and a .179 (7x39) opponent batting average.

QUALITY CONTROL...has thrown a quality start with 1-or-fewer walks issued in 58 career games (last: 5/10 at CWS), tied for 4th-most such games in MLB since 2021, matching rotation-mate George Kirby...his 26 quality starts without a walk are T-5th-most in MLB since 2021...

KEEPING COOPERSTOWN COMPANY...ranks 11th in WHIP (1.064) all-time among starting pitchers in MLB that have recorded over 900 strikeouts, trailing Hall of Famer's Walter Johnson's 1.061 and Christy Mathewson's 1.058 WHIP...his base runners allowed per 9 innings (9.86) ranks 10th among all-time starting pitchers with 900+ strikeouts (min. 100 GS), behind Walter Johnson (9.84) and just ahead of Chris Sale (9.93) and Pedro Martinez (9.94).

AMONG THE GREATS...his 3.63 career ERA (360 ER, 892.0 IP) is 6th-best among pitchers in Mariners history (min. 500 IP), trailing Randy Johnson, Félix Hernández, Hisashi Iwakuma, and James Paxton who each hold a 3.42 career ERA, and George Kirby (3.57)...his 941 career strikeouts are now 5th-most in Mariners history, after eclipsing Mike Moore's 937 strikeouts in his last start...he also ranks 1st in WHIP (1.064), 3rd in K/9 (9.494), trailing James Paxton's 9.545 and Randy Johnson's 10.585 career K/9 mark, and 2nd in K/BB (4.876) only behind George Kirby's 6.174 (min. 500 IP).

AMONG THE LEAGUE...his 941 strikeouts since 2021 lead the American League while his 892 innings pitched are 3rd most and his 156 starts are 2nd in the AL across that span.

150 FOR THE M'S...made his 150th career start with the Mariners on April 12 vs. Houston Astros...he is the 7th pitcher to make 150 starts in a Mariners uniform...his 909 strikeouts rank second among Mariners pitchers' first 150 career starts, only behind Mark Langston (916 K)...ranks 9th in wins with 48 over a players' first 150 games pitched with the Mariners.

- **IL Time** - Placed on 15-day Injured List (right lat inflammation) on May 1 (retroactive to April 30) and reinstated on May 20.
- **2025 Totals** - Went 1-3 with 4 saves, a 2.47 ERA (13 ER, 47.1 IP), 18 walks, 58 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP in 53 relief appearances...held opponents to a .236 average while recording 21 holds.
- **Splendid Start** - Last season did not allow a run in his first 19 appearances (5/3-6/30, 2025), setting a franchise mark for most consecutive scoreless appearances to begin a season, surpassing the 16-game mark set earlier in the season by teammate **Andrés Muñoz**.
