**RAYS REPORT**—The Rays continue their final road trip before the All-Star break today at Target Field, a three-city, 10-day trek through Minnesota (0-2, two to play), Detroit (3G) and Boston (4G)...have lost six of their last eight games, but have still won 12 of 21, 18 of 30, 27 of 42 and 39 of their last 66 following a 9-14 start...are 3-4-1 in their last eight series after going 7-1-1 in their previous nine (May 9–June 8)...are tied for the third-best record in the majors since May 20 (27-15), trailing the Astros (29-13) and Blue Jays (29-14)...are tied for third in the AL/tied for fifth in MLB in run differential (+67)...are tied for second in the AL East, 3.0 GB the first-place Blue Jays, their largest deficit since entering play on June 16 (35)...they spent 19 days within 2.5 games from June 16–July 4, but never claimed first...have been in second or third for the last 43 days...on the season, they have spent two days in first, 36 in second, 28 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ✦ The Rays were walked off for the second straight game in yesterday's 6-5 loss, this time on a squeeze bunt by **Brooks Lee**, it was the fourth loss on a walk-off bunt in franchise history, joining May 2, 2018 at DET (**John Hicks**), July 4, 2015 at NY (**Ramón Flores**) and May 28, 2014 at TOR (**Anthony Gose**).
- ✦ This marks their first time dropping consecutive games in walk-off fashion since July 8-9, 2022 at CIN and their first time vs. an AL club since June 19-20, 2021 at SEA.
- ✦ The Rays led, 5-1, before the Twins rallied for four runs in the 6th, their fourth loss this season after leading by four runs or more (last: June 27 at BAL)...they have held a lead at some point in four of their last six losses.
- ✦ Tampa Bay recorded three a season-high three sacrifice flies, its most since Sept. 11, 2021 at DET (3)...the club's 26 sac flies are tied for fourth most in the AL.
- ✦ After driving in a pair of runs yesterday, Rays 7-8-9 hitters lead the majors in RBI (56) and RISP average (.349/30-for-86) since the start of June.
- ✦ Over the last 13 games, the Rays rotation has a 3.15 ERA (71.1IP, 25ER) while the bullpen has recorded an 8.44 ERA (42.2IP, 40ER)...the pen has yielded multiple runs in six of the last eight games.
- ✦ The Rays have now dropped three consecutive series for the first time since Aug. 23–Sept. 1, 2024...this marks their first series loss at Target Field since June 10-12, 2022.
- ✦ The Rays are 20-16 on the road, third in the majors behind the Tigers (26-20) and Dodgers (23-18)...having played the most home games (53) and fewest road games (36) to this point, 15 of 21, 27 of 36 and 33 of their next 47 games will come on the road.

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—Prior to today's game, the Rays recalled **RHP Joe Boyle** from Triple-A Durham and optioned **LHP Joe Rock** to Durham...Boyle is expected to pitch bulk innings in relief today behind starter **Drew Rasmussen**...this marks the 25-year-old's second stint with the Rays, joining April 13-14, when he threw five hitless innings in a spot start on April 13 vs. ATL...in that outing, he became the second pitcher in franchise history to record five hitless frames or more in his Rays debut, joining **Nathan Eovaldi** on May 30, 2018 at OAK (6.0IP)...Boyle retired 13 straight batters to begin the outing.

- ✦ Boyle, who ranks third among full-season minor leaguers in opp. average (.160) and fifth in ERA (1.85), was named International League Pitcher of the Month for June after going 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA (30.0IP, 6ER) and 49 strikeouts, the most in the minors and most by any Triple-A pitcher in a calendar month since AZ **Zac Gallen** in May 2019 (50SO).
- ✦ A three-time IL Pitcher of the Week recipient in 2025, Boyle was acquired in a five-player deal with Athletics involving **LHP Jeffrey Springs** on Dec. 14, 2024.

**WHAT'S AT STAKE**—The Rays need to win today in order to *avoid*:

- ✦ Their fourth straight road loss, matching a season high (also: April 4-22).
- ✦ Being swept for the fourth time, joining April 4-6 at TEX, April 29–May 1 vs. KC and May 6-8 vs. PHI...the four sweeps would tie for fifth most in the AL.
- ✦ Their ninth time being swept by the Twins and first at Target Field...they were last swept by Minnesota from July 17-20, 2006 at the Metrodome.
- ✦ Their first season series loss to the Twins since 2022 (2-4), dropping them to 14-9-4 all-time in season sets against Minnesota.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY!**—After **Junior Caminero's** 22nd birthday yesterday, **Brandon Lowe** celebrates his 31st today...this marks his first career start on his birthday...he has appeared on his birthday in each of the last two seasons, but did not start either game.

**MINNEAPOLIS MAYHEM**—Each of the Rays last six games at Target Field have been decided in the final at-bat, their longest streak at any ballpark, home or away, in franchise history (Stats Perform)...they are 3-3 during the streak, which began with a 5-4 win on Sept. 13, 2023 when **Randy Arozarena** hit a go-ahead solo homer in the 9th...they have played seven consecutive one-run games in this ballpark, matching Aug. 3-20, 2018 at Tropicana Field for their longest streak at any venue...including home games, 10 of the Rays last 14 games against the Twins dating back to Sept. 12, 2023 have been one-run affairs, ahead of the Astros (8G) for their most one-run games vs. any club in that span.

- ✦ The Rays have played in four straight one-run games overall, their second-longest streak this season behind June 4-8 (5G), on the heels of a streak of 17 straight games decided by multiple runs, their longest since Aug. 29–Sept. 21, 2004 (20G).
- ✦ Four of the Rays last five games have been decided in the final at-bat after they went 18 straight games without a last at-bat win or loss from June 10-29...their 21 such games are fifth most in the AL/sixth most in the majors.

**IN THE RECORD BOOKS**—**Brandon Lowe** singled in the 5th inning yesterday to extend his hitting streak to 20 games, tying **Yandy Díaz** (June 7-28, 2024) for the longest streak in franchise history...it also marks the longest active streak in the majors and the third hitting streak of 20 games or more this season, joining **KC Bobby Witt Jr.** (22G, April 8–May 1) and **CLE José Ramírez** (21G, May 6-28)...Lowe is batting .367/.419/.633 (29-for-79) with 3 2B, 6 HR and 14 RBI since the streak began on June 11, ranking third in the AL in average over that span behind Díaz and **HOU Cam Smith** (.382)...Lowe also has a career-best 22-game on-base streak, the longest active run in MLB, ahead of COL **Tyler Freeman** (20G).

- ✦ Lowe is 18-for-43 (.419) with 1 2B, 3 HR and 8 RBI over an 11-game road hitting streak, the longest by a Ray since **Randy Arozarena** (11G) from June 1-21, 2024...Arozarena also holds the most recent longer streak (12G, Aug. 19 [G2]–Sept. 16, 2023).

**ALL-STAR CALIBER**—Pitchers and reserves for the All-Star Game in Atlanta will be announced tonight at 5:00 p.m. E.T. during ESPN's 2025 MLB All-Star Selection Show presented by PRO SPIRIT...the Rays have several deserving candidates:

- ✦ **Jonathan Aranda** leads AL first basemen in average (.315), on-base pct. (.394) and OPS (.874) while ranking second in bWAR (2.7) behind TOR **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** (2.8).
- ✦ Despite his 27-game on-base streak coming to an end yesterday, **Yandy Díaz** still leads MLB with 43 hits since the start of June, and his .377 (43-for-114) average in that span is second behind COL **Tyler Freeman** (.392).
- ✦ **Brandon Lowe** paces MLB second basemen in slugging pct. (.489), OPS (.813), home runs (T1st, 19), RBI (50), extra-base hits (T1st, 30) and total bases (154).
- ✦ **Junior Caminero** is the AL leader among third basemen in slugging pct. (.511), home runs (21), extra-base hits (40), RBI (55), runs scored (52) and total bases (166).

**BASH BROTHERS**—**Junior Caminero's** 21 HR are tied with DET **Riley Greene** for third in the AL behind SEA **Cal Raleigh** (35HR) and NYY **Aaron Judge** (32HR) while **Brandon Lowe's** 19 HR are tied for seventh...they are looking to become the first pair of Rays teammates to both reach 20 HR before the All-Star break in franchise history...only one infield duo in MLB accomplished the feat last season: **CLE Josh Naylor** (22HR) and **CLE José Ramírez** (23HR)...entering play today, only three pairs of teammates in the majorshave both reached 20 HR: **AZ Corbin Carroll** (20HR)/Suarez, **CHC Pete Crow-Armstrong** (23HR)/**CHC Seiya Suzuki** (24HR) and DET **Riley Greene** (21HR)/DET **Spencer Torkelson** (20HR)...Caminero and Lowe rank first and third in homers among AL infielders.

- ✦ With 19 2B, Caminero is one two-bagger shy of becoming the first player in Rays history with 20 2B and 20 HR before the Midsummer Classic...since the first All-Star Game in 1933, only five players have turned the trick at age 22 or younger: ATL **Ozzie Albies** in 2018 (29 2B, 20HR), WSH **Bryce Harper** in 2015 (21/26), LAA **Mike Trout** in 2014 (26/22), STL **Albert Pujols** in 2002 (25/21) and CIN **Jonny Bench** in 1970 (23/28).

**TODAY'S START**—Drew Rasmussen will make his 18th start of the campaign and sixth on the road...marks his 68th start (117G) of his career and 35th on the road (58G)...has earned the win in three straight road starts, and the Rays are 7-2 in his last nine outings overall...min. 75.0 IP, ranks among AL leaders in WHIP (8th, 1.00), opp. OPS (9th, .597) and opp. average (10th, .212)...is two innings shy of 400.0 for his career...signed a two-year contract extension through 2026 with a club option for 2027 on Jan. 7, 2025.

**LAST TIME OUT**—He worked only three innings and threw 54 pitches in his shortest start of the year on June 30 vs. ATH at Steinbrenner Field in a 6-4 loss (ND, 3.OIP, 5H, 4ER, BB, 2SO, HR)...allowed a walk and a double in the opening frame, and both runners came around to score on **Shea Langeliers'** three-run homer...threw 22 pitches in the 1st, but retired the side in order on nine pitches in the 2nd...was tagged for another run after yielding three straight singles to open the 3rd, but limited the damage to the lone tally after getting a strikeout and GIDP...needed 23 pitches to get through the frame, leading to his departure after three innings...avoided the loss after the Rays four-run rally in the 4th tied the game.

- ✦ His four runs allowed matched a season high, joining April 24 at AZ and June 14 at NYM.
- ✦ It marked the second time this season he failed to complete five innings, joining May 6 vs. PHI (4.1IP)...was his shortest outing as a traditional starter since Aug. 7, 2022 at DET (3.OIP).

**NORTH STAR STATE**—Across five career appearances (2GS) opposite the Twins, Rasmussen is 1-1 with a 4.11 ERA (15.1IP, 7ER)...this includes a 3.48 ERA (10.1IP, 4ER) in the two starts...he started against Minnesota at Steinbrenner Field on May 28, working six innings of one-hit, shutout ball with one walk and five strikeouts in a 5-0 win...this marks his second start/appearance at Target Field, joining a 9-4 loss on June 10, 2022 in which he was charged with a career-high three unearned runs (L, 4.1IP, 9H, 7R-4ER, 2BB, 3SO, 2HR).

- ✦ He is 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (16.OIP, 3ER) in three starts vs. AL Central clubs this season, holding opponents to a 9-for-54 (.167) clip...he has thrown 11.0 scoreless frames across his last two starts opposite the division (May 28 vs. MIN & June 25 at KC).
- ✦ Since the aforementioned start at Target Field in 2022, Rasmussen has turned in a 2.21 ERA (36.2IP, 9ER) in his last eight starts against AL Central teams.

**HOME(S) AWAY FROM HOME**—Rasmussen has earned the win in three consecutive road starts, matching the longest streak of his career (also: Sept. 7-29, 2021) and marking the second-longest streak by a Rays pitcher this season behind **Zack Littell's** four-start run from April 27-May 31...he has pitched to a 2.25 ERA (16.OIP, 4ER) during the streak...this marks his third start in a visiting AL ballpark this season—he is 1-0 with a 0.90 ERA (10.OIP, 1ER) in the other two (April 6 at TEX & June 25 at KC).

- ✦ His runs allowed on the road this season by outing: 1, 4, 0, 4, 0.

**DAYTIME DREW**—Min. 125.0 IP, Rasmussen's 2.07 career ERA (134.2IP, 31ER) in day games is third lowest among active pitchers, trailing CLE **Emmanuel Clase** (1.73) and TEX **Jacob deGrom** (2.01)...he has a 2.37 ERA (38.OIP, 10ER) this season, eighth among AL pitchers (min. 35.OIP)...his career daytime ERA is 1.28 runs lower than his mark in night games (3.25).

**RASON A ROLL**—Of his last nine starts, five have been scoreless, and he has allowed two runs or fewer in seven of them...Rasmussen is 6-1 with a 2.28 ERA (47.1IP, 12ER) and 0.95 WHIP in that span, holding opponents to a .205/.263/.295 (34-for-166) line with 39 strikeouts...over that stretch (since May 17), it marks the fourth-best WHIP in the AL and ties the fifth-best ERA (min. 45.OIP).

**SLUG STOPPER**—Rasmussen has allowed only six extra-base hits across his last seven starts (3 2B, 2HR) holding opponents to a .306 slugging pct. in that span...min 75.0 IP, his .327 opp. slugging pct. on the season ranks ninth in the AL...he has recorded eight starts of 5.0 IP or more with no extra-base hits allowed, tied with DET **Tarik Skubal** for the most in MLB.

**FROZE HIM**—Rasmussen ranks sixth in the majors with 33 called strikeouts, behind NYY **Will Warren** (40), STL **Sonny Gray** (39), CLE **Tanner Bibee** (35) and HOU **Hunter Brown** (34)...over his last seven starts, 16 of his 31 strikeouts have been looking...his 18 called strikeouts on sinkers are tied with TOR **Chris Bassitt** for the AL lead—it also ties the third-most called strikeouts on any individual pitch in the Junior Circuit, trailing four-seam fastballs belonging to DET **Jack Flaherty** (23) and Warren (20).

**HEAT CHECK**—Rasmussen throws fastballs (cutter, sinker, four-seamer) 89.0 pct. of the time, the highest rate among major league starters (min. 500 pitches thrown in starts), ahead of MIL **Chad Patrick** (85.5%)...among all pitchers with 500 or more pitches thrown this season, only NYY **Tim Hill** (95.7%) and BOS **Kenley Jansen** (91.0%) have a higher usage rate on heaters than Rasmussen.

- ✦ Opponents are hitting .210 (61-for-291) against his fastballs in 2025, including a .157 (14-for-89) clip against his cutter.

**GOING STREAKING**—Rasmussen's 23.0 scoreless inning streak from May 17-June 3 was tied for the fifth-longest single-season run in club history, trailing runs by J.P. Howell (27.1IP, 2012), Alex Cobb (24.2IP, 2014), Kevin Kelly (24.1, 2024) and Taj Bradley (24.OIP, 2024)...only Cobb's and Bradley's streaks came as starting pitchers...Rasmussen tallied five scoreless innings or more in a franchise-record four consecutive starts during the streak.

**BEST OF THE BEST**—Min. 300.0 IP, Rasmussen's 2.73 ERA (365.2IP, 111ER) since debuting with the Rays on June 19, 2021 ranks third in the majors behind NYY **Max Fried** (2.61) and ATL **Reynaldo Lopez** (2.73)...over that timeframe, he also leads the AL in opp. slugging pct. (.321) and opp. OPS (.587), is third in WHIP (1.02), opp. on-base pct. (.265), fourth in FIP (3.02), and ninth in opp. average (.217).
