#### **Record Pace**

The Brewers are on pace for 99 wins, which would break the regular season franchise record of 96 accomplished in 2011 (96-66) and 2018 (96-67).

#### Separation

The Brewers currently lead the Reds by 12.0 games in the NL Central, which is the largest divisional lead in franchise history.....the largest lead prior to this season was 10.5 games several times in 2011 [last: 9/5/11].

# 31 Flavors

The Brewers (86-55) are 31 games over .500, tying a franchise record.... the team was also 31 games over .500 twice in 1982 - at 92-61 and 94-63 - on the way to its only World Series.

# Road Work Ahead

The Brewers are a Major League-best 46-24 (.657) on the road.....the team is 1 win away from tying the franchise record for road wins in a season.... the 1982 team was 47-33 on the road.

In his last 27 games, **Christian Yelich** is batting .337 (34-for-101) with 2 HR and 15 RBI....he has scored 16 runs during this stretch with a .378 OBP.

# Come Saíl Away

Avisaíl García has hit a career-high 25 HR.....his previous high was 20 in 2019 with the Rays.....García (79 RBI) needs 1 RBI to tie his career high of 80 in 2017 with the White Sox.

THIS EVENING'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 5-game, 6-day road trip to Cleveland (3g) and Detroit (2g).....the Brewers are coming off a 4-2 homestand against St. Louis (2-1) and Philadelphia (2-1)....following this trip, the team returns to American Family Field for its final homestand of 2021, covering 10 games vs. Chicago-NL (3g), St. Louis (4g) and New York-NL (3g)....is the longest homestand of the season.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 40-31 at home, going 12-9-2 in series play.....had seasonhigh 7-game home winning streaks from 6/3-6/13 and 6/25-7/8.....had a season-high 5-game home losing streak from 7/9-7/21.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 46-24 on the road, going 17-4-1 in series play.....had a season-high 8-game road winning streak from 7/7-7/30.....had a season-high 5-game road losing streak from 5/3-5/7.....are 1 win away from tying the franchise record for wins on the road set by the 1982 team (47-33).

<u>ALL-STARS</u>: The Brewers were represented at the All-Star Game by **Corbin Burnes**, **Josh Hader**, **Freddy Peralta**, **Brandon Woodruff** and **Omar Narváez**.....the five players selected tied a franchise record, all consecutively (also 2018 and 2019)....it marked the first time in franchise history that the team had three or more pitchers selected.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as manager (520-467) and sixth full season.....he is second in franchise history in wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617).... under Counsell, the Brewers made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history (2018-20).....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

<u>COACHES</u>: Assistant hitting coach <u>Jacob Cruz</u> (2nd season), hitting coach <u>Andy Haines</u> (3rd season), pitching coach <u>Chris Hook</u> (3rd season), bullpen coach <u>Steve Karsay</u> (3rd season), third base coach <u>Jason Lane</u> (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach <u>Walker McKinven</u> (2nd season) and bench coach <u>Pat Murphy</u> (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach <u>Quintin Berry</u>.

# TONIGHT'S STARTER: #37 - RHP ADRIAN HOUSER (24g, 22gs, 8-6, 3.41)

HOUSER AT A GLANCE: Adrian Houser, 28, will make his 25th appearance and 23rd start.....Houser last started last Saturday vs. St. Louis and earned a 4-0 win in the first complete game of his career (9ip, 3h, 0bb, 7k, 100 pitches).....it was the first 9-inning complete game by a Brewer since Jimmy Nelson on 6/18/17 vs. San Diego, a span of 612 games.....it was the first complete game shutout by a Brewer since Kyle Lohse on 9/24/14 at Cincinnati, a span of 1,011 games (MLB record).....the team is 15-7 in his starts..... he has 5 quality starts.....opponents are batting .230 (102-for-443, 11hr).....he was on the injured list (COVID-19) from 8/7-8/21.....Houser was acquired from Houston with LHP Josh Hader, OF Brett Phillips and OF Domingo Santana for OF Carlos Gómez, RHP Mike Fiers and International Signing Bonus Slot #76 on 7/30/15.

YO ADRIAN! I DID IT!: On 5/8 at Miami, Houser became the 15th pitcher (17x) in the Modern Era (since 1900) to hit a home run, walk nobody and have 10+ strikeouts in a game.

CAREER: Is 15-19 with a 3.84 ERA in 80 games / 51 starts (304.1ip, 130er)....is in his fifth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2015, 2018-21)....is 10-19 with a 4.28 ERA as a starter (250ip, 119er) and 5-0 with a 1.82 ERA in relief (54.1ip, 11er).....underwent "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow on 7/21/16.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 5-9 with a 3.31 ERA in 40 games / 24 starts (144ip, 53er)....is 3-3 with a 2.54 ERA in 13 games / 11 starts this season (63.2ip, 18er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 10-10 with a 4.32 ERA in 40 games / 27 starts (160.1ip, 77er).....is 5-3 with a 4.37 ERA in 11 starts this season (57.2ip, 28er).

CAREER vs. INDIANS: Houser has never faced the Cleveland Spiders, Naps, Indians or Guardians.

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .067 hitter (4-for-60) with 2 HR and 2 RBI....has 3 walks and 44 strikeouts.....has 5 sacrifice bunts. 2021 AT THE PLATE: Is batting .079 (3-for-38) with 2 HR and 2 RBI....has 1 walk and 27 strikeouts.....has 2 sacrifice bunts.
