**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals and Seattle Mariners play the second game of a three-game weekend series/homestand this afternoon at Busch Stadium ... After losing last night's series opener, 3-2, the Cardinals have now dropped six of their last seven to Seattle, including five in a row.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals enter today in 4th place in the National League Central, 2.5 games back of first place Chicago and Cincinnati ... Today's game is their second of a season-high 17 straight without an off day (April 24-May 10).

**DIVISION ON DECK:** Following tomorrow's game, the Cardinals fly to Pittsburgh for a four-game series with the Pirates for their first divisional game, Game No. 28 on the schedule ... The only other time St. Louis played its first divisional game this late into the season was May 7, 1993 at Philadelphia's Veterans Stadium (also Game No. 28), when the Cardinals were one of seven teams in the National League East Division.

• The Cardinals host the Brewers in Game No. 35 on May 4, tying the 1998 Redbirds for the latest St. Louis has played its first home divisional game ... But as their 19th home game, this sets a franchise record for latest to play their first home divisional game. - *Elias Sports Bureau*

**CLOSE CALLS:** St. Louis is 11-3 in games decided by two runs or fewer in 2026; only the Reds (11-0) are better ... Last night, the Cardinals dropped its first one-run game of the season (5-1 record), marking the longest they've gone into a season without surrendering a one-run defeat since 1946 in Game No. 27.

**WORKING OVERTIME:** St. Louis is an MLB-best 5-0 in extra inning affairs, its best start since the 2004 Cardinals started their season 6-0 in extras.

**A HARD FOUR:** Victor Scott II's first four RBI this season have come without being knocked via hit (three sacrifices and one bases loaded walk) ... Scott II is the only position player to accomplish this feat in the Expansion Era (1961-present) and joins Rockies pitcher Denny Stark in 2003 (BB, SF, GO, BB) as the only two overall. - *Elias Sports Bureau*

**0.00'BRIEN:** Seattle native Riley O'Brien is off to a torrid start in 2026, going 3-0 with a perfect 0.00 ERA, seven saves, 15 strikeouts, and no walks in 13 games ... One of seven qualifying Major League relievers with a perfect 0.00 ERA, O'Brien ranks among MLB leaders in saves (T-2nd), appearances (T-9th), games finished (9, T-5th), WHIP (0.45, 3rd), and BR/9 (4.73, 4th).

**HURTS SO GOOD:** The top five Major League leaders in hit by pitches include JJ Wetherholt (6), Iván Herrera (6), CJ Abrams (6), Willson Contreras (5), and Brendan Donovan (5) ... 2014 Jon Jay (20) was the last Cardinal to lead MLB in hit by pitches.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING:** Masyn Winn, who has 10 RBI over his last six games, is slashing .400/.436/.629 (14-35) over a nine-game hitting streak, T-3rd longest active in MLB and the 2nd-longest of his career behind an 18-gamer in 2024 ... Iván Herrera is batting .321 (9-38) over his current season-best seven-game hitting streak and riding an 11-game on-base safely streak, the longest active on the team.

**PINCH ME:** The Cardinals (1-for-15) and Mariners (1-for-21) are a combined 2-for-36 (.056) in pinch hit opportunities this season ... José Fermín's double on April 19 at Houston accounts for the Cardinals lone pinch hit.

**BAZOOKAS:** Cardinals outfielders have thrown out eight baserunners this season, most in Major League Baseball ... Jordan Walker's four assists lead MLB, while Nathan Church has two, and Thomas Saggese and Victor Scott II each have one.

**THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (April 25, 2015):** Lt. Mitch Harris makes his MLB debut with 1.1 scoreless relief innings while striking out his first batter faced (Adam Lind) in a 5-3 win at Milwaukee ... Harris becomes the first graduate of the United States Naval Academy to appear in a Major League game since Nemo Gaines in 1921.

#### SEATTLE CONNECTIONS

**Riley O'Brien** was born in Seattle and resides in Shoreline, WA... graduated from Shorewood (WA) High School...pitched two seasons at Everett (WA) Community College (2014-15)...traded by Cincinnati to the Mariners for Luis Chevalier (April 17, 2022) and pitched in one game for Seattle (May 7, 2022 vs. TB)...2023 PCL Post-Season All-Star for AAA-Tacoma...acquired by the Cardinals from the Mariners for cash considerations (Nov. 5, 2023).

**Ramón Urías's** younger brother, **Luis Urías**, played in 41 games for the Mariners in 2024.

**Ryne Stanek** pitched in 46 games for Seattle during the 2024 season before traded to the Mets for OF Rhylan Thomas (July 26, 2024)...originally drafted by Seattle in the 3rd round of the 2010 MLB draft, but did not sign to attend the University of Arkansas.

**Brant Brown** coached parts of six seasons over two stints in the Mariners organization (2013-17, 24), previously serving as the Mariners Bench Coach/Offensive Coordinator (2024), Offensive Coordinator (2017), and Minor League Outfield Coordinator (2013-16).

**Brendan Donovan** played four seasons in St. Louis (2022-25), here won the 2022 Rawlings Utility Gold Glove Award and was a 2025 NL All-Star...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 7th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...traded to Seattle as part of the three-team trade with Tampa Bay, with St. Louis receiving SHP Jurrangelo Cijntje, OF Tai Peete, OF Colton Ledbetter, and two Comp. Round B Draft picks, and the Rays receiving INF Ben Williamson from Seattle (Feb. 2, 2026).

**Randy Arozarena** played in 19 games for St. Louis in 2019 and parts of three minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (2017-19)...originally signed with the Cardinals as an international free agent (Aug. 1, 2016)...traded to Tampa Bay with José Martínez, and Cardinals Compensation draft pick A (INF Alike Williams) in exchange for Matthew Liberatore, Edgardo Rodríguez and Rays Compensation draft pick B (RHP Tink Hance) on Jan. 9, 2020.

Mariners Pitching Strategy Coach **Trent Black** was born in St. Louis...graduated from nearby Columbia (Ill.) High School.

**Patrick Wisdom** played in 32 games for St. Louis during 2018 debut season...originally selected by the Cardinals in the Supp. 1st round (No. 52) of the 2012 MLB Draft, as compensation for Octavio Dotel signing with Detroit...traded by St. Louis to Texas for **Drew Robinson** (Dec. 11, 2018).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in Seattle in 1995, including all 11 postseason games.

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray** worked for the Seattle Mariners for three seasons (1993-95).

Cardinals Director, Pitching **Matt Pierpont** worked four seasons in Seattle's organization (2021-24), most recently as minor league pitching coordinator.

Mariners broadcaster **Aaron Goldsmith** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Principia College in Elsay, Ill...began broadcast career in 2007 with the nearby Gateway Grizzlies in the independent Frontier League.

Mariners broadcaster **Rick Rizos** is a 1975 graduate of Southern Illinois Univ. in Carbondale...previously served as a broadcaster for the Memphis Chicks (AA-Expos) from 1978-80.

**TODAY'S GAME:**

- Cardinals 26-year-old Opening Day southpaw starting pitcher makes his team-leading 6th start of the season this afternoon.
- Today's game marks his 126th career Major League appearance and his 59th career start.
- The Cardinals are 14-14 in his 28 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 10-10 with a 3.74 ERA (142.0 IP/59 ER) with 10 quality starts.
- **LOOKING TO EXPAND:** St. Louis is 4-1 in his games started this season with wins over TB, NYM, WSH & HOU - all four former MLB Expansion teams as are the Mariners.
- Has pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his first five starts.
- He received one run of support in three of five starts and two runs of support on April 7 at Washington. His 2.14 3.00 average run support ranks T6th-lowest in NL.
- Of his 28 hits allowed, 10 have come in the 5th inning, as have 2 of his 5 HR's allowed.

**LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, April 19 at Houston):** ND, W, 7-5; 6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 4 SO, 0 HR, 82 pitches).

**2026 HIGHLIGHTS:**

**SPACE DUST:** Worked a season high 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on three hits, taking a ND in the Cardinals 7-5 extra inning win on 4/19 at HOU to complete the series sweep of the Astros.

**FIRST TO 100:** Threw a career high 105 pitches in 9-3 loss vs. CLE on 4/13 in 5.0 IP; He is the lone Cardinals pitcher to reach the 100 pitch plateau thus far.

**CAPITOL RALLY:** Had his shortest start of season (5.0 IP) on April 7 at WSH but threw a season-high 92 pitches; left the game trailing 4-2 but the Cardinals rallied to win 7-6 in 10 innings.

**NO FOOLING:** Held the Mets to one run in his second start on April Fools Day, a day after **Andre Pallante** and company shut out New York. Retired the first 12 Mets batters (first time a Cardinal vs. NYM since 1968) and carried a no-hitter through 4.2 innings, longest of his career.

**LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER:** Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

**LEFTY LIFT-OFFS:** Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that Libby was born. He became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

**CAREER:**

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020 that included **Randy Arozarena**, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP **Tink Hence**.
- Is a career 13-22 with a 4.76 ERA (280.0 IP) in his 58 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.
- Has limited left-handed batters to a .248/.306/.376 (89-359) with a .682 OPS average over his Major League career.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year, his first season of play in the Cardinals organization.

**LIBERATORE vs. SEATTLE:**

- Is making his 2nd career start (3rd appearance) vs. the Mariners.
- Suffered a 5-3 loss at Seattle in his last meeting on 9/9/25, allowing 5 runs over his 4.0 IP, including HR's by Randy Arozarena & Josh Naylor at T-Mobile Park.
- His lone prior meeting vs. SEA at Busch Stadium came in 2/3-inning relief appearance on 9/6/24 when he allowed 2 runs via a 2-run HR by Dylan Moore
- Has struggled with 4-12 mark in his 22 career Interleague starts, but Cardinals have won 5 of his last 8 after losing in 12 of his first 14 starts vs. the A.L.

**RUN COLLECTOR:** Has scored multiple runs in four games this season, tied with **Jordan Walker** for the team lead. Ranks 3rd among MLB rookies with 19 runs scored, the most by a Cardinals player through their first 25 career games since **Aledmys Diaz** had 20 in 2016.

**NO PAIN, NO GAIN:** Was hit by pitch in 5 consecutive games (4/15-20) setting the franchise record and tied for the 2nd-longest streak in MLB history with **Doc Gessler** (Brooklyn, 1903), one behind **Carlos Quentin** (2008, CWS) for the MLB record. Is T-1st in MLB with six HBP this season.

**TABLE SETTER:** Reached base safely 15 times over his last eight games with only five hits (5 walks, 5 HBP). Has a .415 OBP since April 14.

**GETTING THE IDEA:** Leads all MLB rookies with 271 pitches taken (2nd in MLB).

**ANOTHER DAY, ANOTHER FIRST: Walked and was hit by pitch in three straight games. Is the only player in Cardinals history to have a streak of three games reaching by drawing a walk AND getting hit by pitch. Tied for the all-time MLB all-time lead with six other players, most recently Isaac Paredes in 2023 with Tampa Bay.**

**LOOKIE AT THE ROOKIE:** Hit a pair of home runs vs. CLE (4/14), his first multi-HR game and first by a Cardinal since **Masyn Winn** (4/30/25 at CIN). Was the 6th Cardinals lead-off second baseman and first since **Tommy Edman** (5/26/21 at CWS) with a multi-HR game. Last Cardinals with a multi-HR game was **Dylan Carlson** vs. MIL (9/30/21) and left-hander was **Chris Duncan** at CIN (8/10/06).

**SOUTHPAW SWATTER:** His left-on-left multi-HR game was the first by a Cardinal since **Matt Carpenter** belted three off Jon Lester (2) and **Brian Duensing** (1) at Wrigley Field (7/20/18).

**THE NOTES WRITE THEMSELVES:** Recorded his first career walk-off hit with a two-RBI knock in the 10th inning vs. TB (3/28). Was the first Cardinals rookie with a walk-off since **Lars Nootbaar** (8/25/21) vs. DET also in the 10th inning.

**INTERLEAGUE:** Has reached base safely in each of his last seven Interleague games since 4/13 vs. CLE, going 7-for-24 (.292) with a .996 OPS in that span. Has reached base safely in 14 of his 16 career Interleague contests.
