TODAY'S GAME: SF searches for a win this evening in the 305 after coming from behind to take the first game of the series last night, 4-3...a win tonight would mean a series victory, something that has eluded the Giants in Miami since taking two-of-three here in 2016.

- ▶ SF has not won a series at Miami since the 2016 season (six consecutive series without a win)...according to *Stats, LLC*, this streak is SF's longest in Miami all-time, and tied for its second-longest active streak on the road against a single opponent (having not won their last seven series in Seattle).
- ▶ The Giants are facing a left-handed starter tonight for just the third time so far this season in Marlins LHP Ryan Weathers...the only other times SF has seen a lefty starter this year have been April 1 at the Dodgers (James Paxton) and April 10 vs. Washington (Patrick Corbin)...they're scheduled to get another lefty in tomorrow's finale in A.J. Puk.

TIDBITS FROM LAST NIGHT'S DUB: The Giants overcame an early 3-0 deficit last night in their 4-3 win...with the win, four of the Giants seven wins so far this season have been in come-from-behind fashion.

- ▶ **RHP Camilo Doval** notched his second save of the young season last night with his four-out save...it was Doval's first action in eight days and just his fourth appearance so far this season...the save was Doval's eighth career 4+ out save and first this year...he had four such saves in 2023.
- ▶ SF went 3-for-6 with four RBI last night with runners in scoring position...after starting out the year going 17-for-87 (.195) w/RISP through their first 12 games, the Giants are now 14-for-42 (.333) w/RISP in their last five games dating to last Wednesday.

EXORCISE THE DEMONS: SF improved to 10-17 (.370) here at loanDepot park since 2015 with last night's win...the .370 winning percentage is SF's second-worst in any road facility they've played at least 20 games in since 2015.

FOOT ON THE GAS: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. was 1-for-3 yesterday and extended his on-base streak to 11 games dating to April 3.

- ▶ Wade has reached base in 15 of 17 games this season, and is slashing .372/.471/.512 with seven runs, three doubles, a home run and four RBI.
- ▶ He ranks fourth in the Majors in batting average and on-base percentage entering play today (min. 45 PA).

- ▶ In his brief MLB career, Wade has excelled during the season's first month, slashing .294/.444/.521 in 45 March/April games with a 19.1% walk rate...Wade's .965 OPS in March/April is by far the best of any month in his career (May - .798, June - .840, July - .734, August - .655, September/October - .751).

JORDAN 4s: RHP Jordan Hicks takes the hill tonight in Miami for his fourth start of the campaign...he's allowed just two earned runs in 18.0 innings in his three prior starts...in the SF-era (since 1958), Hicks is one of seven players with two earned runs or fewer and 18.0+ innings pitched through three career starts with the Giants...the last to do it before Hicks was **RHP Ryan Sadowski** in 2009 (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ The Giants are 3-0 in Hicks' first three starts with the club.
- ▶ Entering play today, Hicks is averaging 95.5 mph with his sinker, which he's used 56.6% of the time so far this year according to *Statcast*...the only other starter to use a sinker more often than Hicks thus far has been STL's Steven Matz, who's used his 57.4% of the time.

JHL DELIVERS: OF Jung Hoo Lee went 2-for-4 with a run scored and an RBI in last night's win...both of Lee's hits last night were 95+ mph off the bat, giving him 30 hard-hit balls for the season, tied for sixth-most in MLB entering play today.

- ▶ Over Lee's last seven games dating to April 7 (of which he's hit safely in all of them) he's slashing .323/.364/.387 with two doubles, two walks, two steals and six runs scored.

COME TOGETHER: SFs bullpen worked 3.0 scoreless innings last night and now has a 2.90 ERA in its last 10 games dating to April 5 with opponents hitting .204 and logging a .597 OPS off the unit in that time.

- ▶ The 2.90 ERA in that span is fifth-best in the NL and ninth-best in the Majors.
- ▶ In SF's first seven games, the bullpen had a 7.46 ERA.

CONFORTABLE ENVIRONMENT: OF Michael Conforto has had solid success against the Marlins in his nine-year MLB career, slashing .289/.406/.557 with 56 runs, 17 doubles, 20 home runs and 59 RBI over 93 games.

- ▶ At loanDepot park, Conforto has a .277/.388/.485 slash line with six home runs and 24 RBI over 42 games.

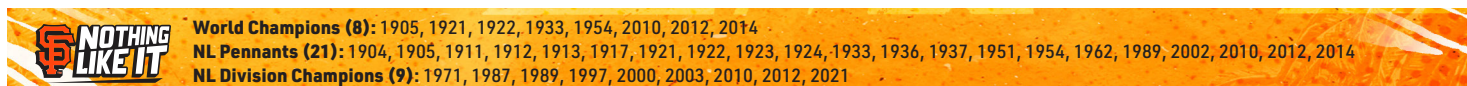

- ▶ The only game that will start earlier will be the final game of the season vs. St. Louis at Oracle Park, which is scheduled to begin at 12:05 p.m. PT as all teams across the league start their games at the same time on the season's final day.

WELCOME TO SF: Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million...he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

PUSH TO START: Is transitioning from a relief role into a traditional starting role...has made 11 career starts entering today...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

LAST OUTING: Earned the win as he tossed 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits and two walks with two strikeouts in the Giants 7-1 victory over the Nationals on April 10...the Giants have won each of his first three starts.

OFF AND RUNNING: Is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA, 13 strikeouts and a 0.83 WHIP over his first three starts...became the seventh Giants starter since 1912 to pitch 5.0+ innings and allow one earned run or fewer in each of his first three starts with the franchise joining **LHP Carlos Rodón** (first four starts in 2022), **RHP Al Worthington** (first four starts in 1953), **RHP Anthony DeSclafani** (first three starts in 2021), **RHP Bill Swift** (first three starts in 1992), **RHP Mike LaCoss** (first three starts in 1986), and **RHP Sailor Stroud** (first three starts in 1915) (*Elias*).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Has thrown 74.2% first-pitch strikes over his first three starts...the last two seasons he threw an average of 58% and 59% first-pitch strikes (SIS).

VS. THE MARLINS: Is 0-2 with a 1.26 ERA, three saves and a .208 opponents average over 12 career games (one start)...his one start came on April 21, 2022 at Miami where he threw 3.0 innings and allowed one run on two hits and two walks.

MR. EFFICIENCY: Is averaging 13.9 pitches per inning so far in 2024, seventh-fewest among 101 pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched this season.

SMALL SAMPLE SIZE THEATER: Right-handed hitters have gone 3-for-34 (.088) versus Hicks thus far in 2024...lefties, on the other hand, are 9-for-28 (.321).

FEEL THE HEAT: Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league... he has thrown 4,351 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 (38.6%) clocked at over 100 mph...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

2023 SEASON: Made 65 relief appearances between the Cardinals (40 games) and Blue Jays (25 games), posting a combined 3.29 ERA (24er, 65.2ip) with 12 saves...his 81 strikeouts, 11.1 K/9.0ip, and 28.4 strikeout percentage were all career bests...threw 470 pitches at 100+ MPH (42.2% off his total pitches) and 24 pitches at 103+ MPH, both second in MLB to Jhoan Duran.

RISP MANAGEMENT: Last season, opponents combined to hit just .211 (16-for-76) off him with runners in scoring position and just .121 (4-for-33) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

DIABETIC PHENOM: Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself... Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them when he pitches.

#58 NICKAVILA ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/13 at TB; 1.0ip, 2h, r, er, bb, k (25 pitches)

- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- ▶ Has appeared in just three of SF's 13 games since having his contract selected on April 1.
- ▶ Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- ▶ Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.
- ▶ Attended San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton) before playing his 2019 season at California State University, Long Beach... would go on to be selected in the 26th round of the 2019 draft by SF.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/15 at MIA; SV, 1.1ip, h, 2k (27 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his second save of the season last night.
- ▶ The outing marked his eighth career 1.1ip+ save...since his debut in 2021, only five MLB relievers have recorded more such saves.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only **Rod Beck** in 1997 had more (29) before the break.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/13 at TB; 1.0ip, 2k (20 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last four outings, Miller has struck out eight hitters over 4.1 innings and held batters to just one hit in 14 at-bats (.071).
- ▶ Has appeared in seven games for SF, allowing six runs in 7.0ip.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

Last Game: 4/14 at TB; 0.1ip, k (9 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in six games for SF so far, allowing two runs over 5.0innings of work with five strikeouts.
- ▶ Is 1-0-3 with a 2.00 ERA and 15 strikeouts (9.0ip) in 11 career appearances vs. the Marlins.
- ▶ Averaged 15.95 SO/9 this spring after striking out 13 of 38 batters faced.
- ▶ Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with a 3.83 ERA and averaging 11.15 SO/9 (64k, 51.2ip).
- ▶ Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).
- ▶ His .211 opposing average in 2023 was the second-lowest in his career (had a .206 opponent's average in 2018 with MIN).
- ▶ Allowed just four earned runs in 27 road games (23.1ip) last season...his 1.54 road ERA was seventh-lowest in the NL (min. 20.0ip).

#71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/15 at MIA; 1.0ip (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in seven of SF's first 17 games, allowing three runs (two on HRs) in 6.1ip.
- ▶ Averaged just 5.64 pitches per inning this spring.
- ▶ Appeared in 68 games in 2023, his third consecutive season appearing in 68+ games.
- ▶ His 84.4 mph average exit velocity in 2023 was second-best in MLB.
- ▶ Rogers' 27.6% opposing hard hit rate was eighth-best in the Majors.
- ▶ 45 of his 60 strikeouts last year came with his slider, with batters hitting .187 off the pitch.
- ▶ Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (269g).

#65 LANDEN ROUPP ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Changeup, Cutter
