**THE TWINS:** After completing their season-long 10-game, 11-day roadtrip with a record of 5-5 (1-2 at Tampa Bay, 1-2 at Seattle and 3-1 against the A's), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a loss to the Blue Jays last night...today, the Twins will continue the homestand with the second of three against Toronto...they will complete the series tomorrow afternoon then enjoy an off-day on Monday...beginning Tuesday, the Twins will host the Rangers for three games through Thursday afternoon.  
✂ Twins are 27-14 in their last 41 games since April 22, trailing only Detroit (28-14) for the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.  
✂ Twins have gone 9-4 against AL East opponents, going 2-1 against Boston, 6-0 against Baltimore, 1-2 vs. Tampa Bay and 0-1 against Toronto.

**FRIDAY NIGHT BLUES:** The Twins lost to the Blue Jays last night at Target Field by a score of 6-4...Twins had a 3-0 lead through three innings but allowed the Jays to score six unanswered runs...Bailey Ober (4-2) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs on five hits (2 HR) in 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits and were led by Royce Lewis who set a season-high by reaching four times, going 3-for-3 with a walk and an RBI...the defeat marked the Twins first loss in a series opener since April 14 vs. New York-NL (were 6-0 since).

**TRUE NORTH:** The Twins and Blue Jays are playing the second of six games this season...their next series will be three games at Rogers Centre from August 25-27.  
✂ Including the 2023 Postseason, the Twins have gone 8-4 in their last 12 games against the Blue Jays, dating back to June of 2023.

✂ Including the 2023 Postseason, the Twins have gone 4-2 against Toronto in Minnesota over their last six games here.

✂ The Twins have won three consecutive series against the Blue Jays, dating back to June of 2023...a loss today would give Minnesota its first series loss to Toronto since May 26-28, 2023 at Target Field, when they lost two of three.

✂ In 32 career regular and Postseason games against the Blue Jays, Carlos Correa is hitting .323 (40-for-124) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 25 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage, a .556 slugging percentage and a .961 OPS...he has reached safely in 17-straight.

✂ In seven career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with one home run, three RBI and an .830 OPS.

✂ In eight career regular season and Postseason games against the Jays, Royce Lewis is hitting .536 (15-for-28) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, a .594 on-base percentage, a .929 slugging percentage and a 1.522 OPS...he has reached safely in all eight.

**"GAUS-MAN! GAUS-MAN! GAUS-MAN!":** The Twins have scored 18 runs (17 earned) on 24 hits over Kevin Gausman's last four starts against Minnesota, which includes Game 1 of the ALWCS in 2023...notable career (regular and Postseason) numbers against Gausman: Royce Lewis is 5-for-7 (.714) with two home runs...Ty France is 6-for-17 (.353)...Trevor Larnach is 3-for-9 (.333).

**STARTER STRENGTH:** Twins starting staff has gone 19-10, 3.12 ERA (282.1 IP, 98 ER) with opponents hitting .231 and 17 quality starts in their last 53 games since April 8...below are their MLB ranks since that date:

**C4, EXP-'LOS-IVE:** Over his last 28 games, since April 25, Carlos Correa is hitting .301 (31-for-103) with five doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .466 slugging percentage and an .802 OPS — Twins 19-9 in those games...in his 24 games prior to April 25, he hit .167 (14-for-84) with six doubles, one home run, five RBI, a .274 slugging percentage and a .496 OPS — Twins went 8-16 in those games.

✂ In 11 games since returning from the 7-day concussion IL, Correa has posted an .890 OPS, while slugging .564.

**WINNESOTA:** Twins are 18-9 through 27 home games this season, winning 12 of their last 15 and 16 of their last 20 at Target Field.

✂ Pitching staff in their last 15 home games has posted a 2.50 ERA (137.0 IP, 38 ER) with opponents hitting .222 and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio of 9.6...in that span, the starters have gone 6-2, 2.71 ERA (83.0 IP, 25 ER) with a .231 BAA and the relievers have gone 6-1, 2.17 ERA (54.0 IP, 13 ER) with a .208 BAA.

**LARNING TO FLY:** Trevor Larnach hit his 10th home run of the season last night, giving him double-digit home run totals for the second-straight season...his career-high in homers is 15, set in 2024...with that homer, he also tied Byron Buxton for team lead...over his last 24 games, Larnach is hitting .309 (30-for-97) with six doubles, one triple, five home runs, 13 RBI, 16 runs scored, a .546 slugging percentage and an .896 OPS.

**FROM PARIS WITH LOVE:** Ty France has reached base safely in a career-high 18-straight games...it also marks the longest for a Twin this season and longest since Carlos Correa's 19-game steak from June 26-September 22, 2024...during the streak, France is hitting .319 (22-for-69) with two doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, six HBP and a .373 on-base percentage.

**STRICT-LEE BUSINESS:** Brooks Lee has hit safely in nine-straight games, extending his career-high...his previous high for a hitting streak was six, done twice, once in 2024 and once earlier this season...the current streak matches Harrison Bader (April 26-May 7) for the longest by a Twin this season...Minnesota's last double-digit hitting streak was from Kyle Farmer, who hit in 13-straight, from September 3-22, 2024.

✂ During the current streak, Lee is hitting .289 (11-for-38) with one double and five RBI.

**THAT'S WHAT I'M TONKIN ABOUT:** Reliever Michael Tonkin is schedule to begin his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul tonight at CHS Field against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...Tonkin has missed the entire season with a right shoulder strain.

**HBD RAMON BORREGO!:** Twins first base/infield coach Ramon Borrego is celebrating his 47th birthday today.

⚔ Making his 13th start of the season and the 95th of his career (98th appearance)...is facing Toronto for the first time in his career.

⚔ Last pitched on June 1 and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 walk-off loss in Seattle...allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with one walk and 10 strikeouts over 8.0 innings.

⚔ Is 1-3 with a 3.04 ERA (26.2 IP, 9 ER), two home runs, 10 walks and 20 strikeouts in five starts at Target Field this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched on June 1 in Seattle opposite Luis Castillo but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 walk-off loss...allowed one run on one hit (1 HR) over a career-high-tying 8.0 innings, with one walk and 10 strikeouts, his season high and fourth time in his career he's reached double-digit strikeouts in an outing...lone run allowed was via Cal Raleigh's solo home run in the seventh inning...threw a career-high 110 pitches; marked his third career outing with a pitch count above 100.

⚔ Prior to his start, the last Twin to throw 110-or-more pitches while allowing one-or-fewer runs and striking out 10-or-more batters was Kenta Maeda on August 18, 2020 (115 pitches, 1 R, 12 K).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Took the loss on May 26 at Tampa Bay opposite Zack Littell, a 7-2 Twins defeat...allowed two runs on five hits, walking none and striking out five over 5.1 innings...faced three batters over the minimum through his first five innings of work...with one out in the sixth, allowed a single and a double; both runners scored on Jonathan Aranda's home run, hit off Brock Stewart in relief.

⚔ This season, relief pitchers have inherited 10 of Paddack's runners and have allowed five to score.

⚔ His 71.1 percent strike rate was his highest in a start this season and his highest since May 19, 2024 at Cleveland, when 72 of his 100 pitches (72.0%) thrown were strikes.

**RUN IT UP:** In his five starts since May 9, Paddack has gone 7.0-or-more innings three times, including his 8.0 in his outing on June 1...in that five-game stretch, he has posted a 1.64 ERA (33.0 IP, 6 ER) and a 0.79 WHIP; opposing batters are slashing .188/.221/.274 in 117 at-bats...prior to his last five starts, Paddack had never pitched more than 33.0 innings over any five-game stretch, his previous career-high being 32.0 innings in five games between April 12-May 6, 2019 with San Diego.

⚔ At the close of play last night, June 6, just 17 other pitchers in baseball this season have recorded three-or-more outings with one-or-fewer runs allowed and 7.0-or-more innings pitched.

**FACING TORONTO:** Is making his first career start against Toronto...after the game, he will have faced every team in Major League Baseball except his former and current teams, the Padres and the Twins.

**EAST BOUND AND DOWN:** Paddack is making his 12th career start against the American League East; 11 career games against the AL East is tied with the AL Central for his fewest against any division in baseball...below are some of his career numbers against the American League East compared to the AL Central and AL West divisions:

**ADDITIONALLY:** In three starts against the AL East this season, Paddack is 1-1 with a 2.60 ERA (17.1 IP, 5 ER), three walks and 10 strikeouts (5/4 at BOS, 5/15 at BAL, 5/26 at TB).

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In five starts at Target Field this season, is 1-3 with a 3.04 ERA (26.2 IP, 9 ER), two home runs, 10 walks and 20 strikeouts, compared to 1-2 with a 3.96 ERA (38.2 IP, 17 ER), six home runs, 10 walks and 30 strikeouts in seven road starts...since joining the Twins in 2022, is 5-5 with a 3.89 ERA (88.0 IP, 38 ER), 11 home runs, 21 walks and 85 strikeouts in 18 appearances (17 starts) at Target Field.

⚔ In his career, Paddack has a .278 (98-for-353) opponent batting average and .735 OPS at Target Field.

⚔ Has not faced the American League East at home since May 14, 2024...in two career starts against the American League East at Target Field, is 1-1 with a 4.09 ERA (11.0 IP, 5 ER), one home run, three walks and 10 strikeouts.

**PLATOON SPLITS:** This season, left-handed hitters are batting .217 (28-for-129) with four home runs, 10 walks, 20 strikeouts and eight RBI against Paddack, while righties are batting .234 (26-for-111) with four home runs, ten walks, 30 strikeouts and 15 RBI...in his career, lefties are slashing .241/.288/.410 with 37 home runs and a 3.36 strikeout-to-walk ratio against Paddack, while righties are slashing .255/.294/.432 with 38 home runs and a 5.46 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

⚔ Left-handed batters in the American League East are hitting .282 (33-for-117) with one home run, 11 RBI, eight walks, 19 strikeouts and a .692 OPS against Paddack in his career, while right-handed batters in the AL East are hitting .296 (32-for-108) with six home runs, 21 RBI, six walks, 24 strikeouts and an .868 OPS.

**THE ARSENAL:** In 2025, Paddack has relied on a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is his pitch repertoire and results:

⚔ With 1070 pitches thrown this season, Paddack has an 18.7 percent strikeout rate and a 7.5 percent walk rate...batters are chasing 32.3 percent of his pitches, whiffing 21.5 percent of the time and hitting the ball hard 45.9 percent of the time.

⚔ His overall pitching run value of 6 ranks in baseball's 78th percentile, while his fastball run value of 8 ranks in the 93rd percentile.

⚔ In his previous start on June 1 at Seattle, threw 110 pitches and averaged 88.6 mph...induced 17 whiffs, his most in a start since he recorded 19 whiffs on May 8, 2024 vs. Seattle...17 whiffs are tied for the fourth most by a Twins starter this season (also Joe Ryan on 5/2)...his 29.8 percent whiff rate was his highest mark in an outing since June 5, 2024 at New York-AL (32.4%).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2025: 6-2, 2.91 ERA // CAREER: 39-28, 3.80 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is set to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale against the Blue Jays at Target Field...last pitched on June 2 against the Athletics in Sacramento; earned his sixth win of the season and fifth straight, after allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR) over 5.0 innings, walking a season-high three batters and striking out four...in two career games against the Blue Jays, is 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA (13.0 IP, 4 ER), one home run, one walk and 11 strikeouts; is facing Toronto at Target Field for the first time in his career.
