THE TWINS: Began their six-game homestand with a series loss to the Blue Jays over the weekend, dropping the first two but winning game three...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the first of three against the Rangers, hosting Texas through Thursday afternoon.

◆ Twins are 28-15 in their last 43 games since April 22, second most wins in baseball since that date, and trailing only Detroit (29-15)...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.

◆ Twins are 7-3 this season after an off-day (that includes two wins in a doubleheader on May 14). TWINS ENJOY SUNDAY STROLL AROUND THE BASES: The Twins beat the Blue Jays on Sunday afternoon by a score of 6-3, snapping their three-game losing streak — their first win since a 6-1 victory on Wednesday in Sacramento...Joe Ryan (7-2) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs (2 earned) on four hits, with three walks and six strikeouts...Brock Stewart (1.0), Cole Sands (1.0), Griffin Jax (1.0) and Jhoan Duran (1.0) combined for 4.0 scoreless innings out of the 'pen...the final four hitters in the starting lineup combined to go 8-for-15 with three walks and four RBI (Willi Castro - 3 hits, Ty France - 2 hits, Brooks Lee - 2 hits & Christian Vázquez - 1 hit)...Lee and Vázquez went back-to-back in the fourth inning, Lee hitting his fifth homer of the season and Vázquez hitting his second...the offense drew eight walks, matching their season-high, done previously on April 25 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

FILTHY RICH: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson from Triple-A St. Paul... Woods Richardson went 2-0, 4.24 ERA (17.0 IP, 8 ER), with four walks, 19 strikeouts and a 1.12 WHIP in three starts for the Saints since being optioned from Minnesota on May 15...earlier this season, he appeared in eight games (7 starts) for the Twins between April 1 and May 14, going 2-2, 5.02 ERA (37.2 IP, 21 ER), with 14 walks, 35 strikeouts and a 1.54 WHIP in those outings...to make room for Woods Richardson on the 26-man roster, the Twins optioned right-handed pitcher Travis Adams to St. Paul after Sunday's game against the Toronto Blue Jays...Adams was recalled on Friday and did not appear in a game.

RANGER THINGS: The Twins went 5-2 against the Rangers last season, going 2-1 at Target Field, from May 24-26 and 3-1 at Globe Life Field, from August 15-18...the Twins are 10-4 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, outscoring them 74-57...that includes a home record of 5-2.

◆ Since the start of 2021, 23 of 28 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 14 games have been decided by one run.

◆ Rangers starter Tyler Mahle pitched parts of two seasons for the Twins from 2022-23 making just nine starts...he began the 2023 season as part of the Twins rotation until having lommy John surgery on his right elbow and never appeared again for Minnesota... he was acquired by the Twins via trade with Cincinnati at the 2022 trade deadline, in exchange for Steve Hajjar, Christian Encarnacion-Strand and Spencer Steer...he departed via free agency after the 2023 season.

GOING ON A TARGET RUN: Twins are 19-10 through 29 home games this season.

◆ They have gone 17-5 in their last 22 home games, since April 15...they are 13-4 in their last 17 home games, since April 25...since April 25, their 13 wins are tied for fifth-most

in baseball.

◆ Twins are 6-4 in Target Field series openers...they lost their last one on Friday night against the Blue Jays, snapping a six-game winning streak in such instances.

RAISE YOUR BAGUETTES: Ty France has reached base safely in a career-high 20-straight games...it marks the longest for a Twin this season and longest since Edouard Julien reached in 23-straight from September 6, 2023-March 30, 2024...the last in a *single season* was Byron Buxton with 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023...France's streak is the fifth-longst active streak in baseball...the longest in MLB this season was Kyle Schwarber's 41, from March 27-May 12.

During the streak, France is hitting .316 (24-for-76) with three doubles, one home run, 14 RBI, seven HBP and a .381 on-base percentage

UNBE-LEE-VABLE: Brooks Lee has hit safely in 10-straight games, extending his career-high...his previous high for a hitting streak was six, done twice, once in 2024 and once earlier this season...the current streak is the longest by a Twin this season and longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long was from Kyle Farmer, who hit in 13-straight, from September 3-22, 2024. **◆** During the current streak, Lee is hitting .317 (13-for-41) with one double, one home run and six RBI.

ROYCE ROLLIN': Over his last six games, since June 3, Royce Lewis is hitting .438 (7-for-16) with two doubles, four RBI, five walks, a .571 on-base percentage, a .563 slugging percentage and a 1.134 OPS...since that date, he has posted a 23.8 walk percentage, which ranks fifth in baseball among players with at least 20 plate appearances...among that same criteria, he has a BB/K ratio of 1.67,

GOOD WILLI: In his last 20 games, Willi Castro is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with three doubles, five home runs, eight RBI, 10 walks, 15 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .440 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.065 OPS.

◆ Since the start of the Seattle series, May 30, he is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with one double, four home runs, six RBI, 10 runs scored and a 1.306 OPS in seven games.

THE DOKTOR IS IN: Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Jason Doktorczyk has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week... he made the start on Thursday vs. Palm Beach, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts...he leads the Mighty Mussels staff in strikeouts, with 47...Doktorczyk was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nevada, Reno.

Rumfield, and finally an RBI double from Bryan De La Cruz, scoring Rumfield...marks his first time allowing three-plus home runs in a single game in his professional career.

MINOR LEAGUE RECAP: Was optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 15, following the doubleheader at Baltimore...marked his fifth stint with the Saints...went 2-0 in three starts with St. Paul, posting a 4.24 ERA (17.0 IP, 8 ER) with four walks, 19 strikeouts and a .227 (15-for-66) opponent batting average.

THIS AIN'T TEXAS: Is facing the Texas Rangers for the second time in his career...sole start came on August 16, 2024 at Globe Life Field where he earned the win in Minnesota' 4-3 victory...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR), two walks and one strikeout in 5.0 innings of work.

SWR is 2-0 in six career starts against American League West opponents...has posted a 3.52 ERA (30.2 IP, 12 ER), with 11 walks and 30 strikeouts...AL West batters are hitting .167 (18-

for-108) against him...his BAA against the AL West is his lowest against any division, and his ERA is his second-lowest, behind just the AL Central (15 starts, 3.48 ERA).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Woods Richardson has gone 3-2 with a 4.23 ERA (83.0 IP, 39 ER), 8.67 K/9, 3.14 BB/9 and 1.19 HR/9 in 17 games (16 starts) at home compared to 4-6 with a 4.68 ERA (98.0 IP, 51 ER), 7.35 K/9, 3.49 BB/9 and 1.38 HR/9 in 21 road games (20 starts).

◆ SWR is 2-0 in three starts at home this season, posting a 2.40 ERA (15.0 IP, 4 ER) with one walk and 13 strikeouts...has allowed a home run in all three home starts.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through eight major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .342/.395/.562 in 73 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .250/.329/.447 in 76 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.9 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 42.6 compared to righties' 93.7 mph and 53.7 percent.

This whiff rate is at an all-time high of 24.7 percent (lefties, 21.8 percent; righties, 26.8 percent)... compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 47% of the time...primarily uses his slider against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:
