THE TWINS: Began their six-game homestand with a series loss to the Blue Jays over the weekend, dropping the first two but winning game three...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the first of three against the Rangers, hosting Texas through Thursday afternoon. ☞ Twins are 28-15 in their last 43 games since April 22, second most wins in baseball since that date, and trailing only Detroit (29-15)...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15. ☞ Twins are 7-3 this season after an off-day (that includes two wins in a doubleheader on May 14).

TWINS ENJOY SUNDAY STROLL AROUND THE BASES: The Twins beat the Blue Jays on Sunday afternoon by a score of 6-3, snapping their three-game losing streak — their first win since a 6-1 victory on Wednesday in Sacramento...Joe Ryan (7-2) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs (2 earned) on four hits, with three walks and six strikeouts...Brock Stewart (1.0), Cole Sands (1.0), Griffin Jax (1.0) and Jhoan Duran (1.0) combined for 4.0 scoreless innings out of the 'pen...the final four hitters in the starting lineup combined to go 8-for-15 with three walks and four RBI (Willi Castro - 3 hits, Ty France - 2 hits, Brooks Lee - 2 hits & Christian Vázquez - 1 hit)...Lee and Vázquez went back-to-back in the fourth inning, Lee hitting his fifth homer of the season and Vázquez hitting his second...the offense drew eight walks, matching their season-high, done previously on April 25 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

FILTHY RICH: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson from Triple-A St. Paul...Woods Richardson went 2-0, 4.24 ERA (17.0 IP, 8 ER), with four walks, 19 strikeouts and a 1.12 WHIP in three starts for the Saints since being optioned from Minnesota on May 15...earlier this season, he appeared in eight games (7 starts) for the Twins between April 1 and May 14, going 2-2, 5.02 ERA (37.2 IP, 21 ER), with 14 walks, 35 strikeouts and a 1.54 WHIP in those outings...to make room for Woods Richardson on the 26-man roster, the Twins optioned right-handed pitcher Travis Adams to St. Paul after Sunday's game against the Toronto Blue Jays...Adams was recalled on Friday and did not appear in a game.

RANGER THINGS: The Twins went 5-2 against the Rangers last season, going 2-1 at Target Field, from May 24-26 and 3-1 at Globe Life Field, from August 15-18...the Twins are 10-4 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, outscoring them 74-57...that includes a home record of 5-2.

☞ Since the start of 2021, 23 of 28 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 14 games have been decided by one run.
☞ Rangers starter Tyler Mahle pitched parts of two seasons for the Twins from 2022-23, making just nine starts...he began the 2023 season as part of the Twins rotation until having Tommy John surgery on his right elbow and never appeared again for Minnesota...he was acquired by the Twins via trade with Cincinnati at the 2022 trade deadline, in exchange for Steve Hajar, Christian Encarnacion-Strand and Spencer Steer...he departed via free agency after the 2023 season.

LONE STAR STATS: Notable individuals against the Rangers:

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with two doubles, five home runs, 17 RBI and a 1.176 OPS in 14 career games vs. Texas...he has homered in each of his last two against TEX.
☞ Carlos Correa has an .848 career OPS in 108 games against the Rangers...in his last five games against Texas, he is hitting .450 (9-for-20) with two doubles, four RBI and a 1.005 OPS...he has 21 career home runs vs. the Rangers (108 games), his most against any opponent...21 homers are tied with Shohei Ohtani for the fourth most among actives, trailing Mike Trout (44), Jose Altuve (35) and George Springer (28).
☞ Ty France is hitting .305 (69-for-226) with 10 doubles, 10 home runs, 34 RBI and an .853 OPS in 59 career games against the Rangers...10 homers are his most against any opponent.
☞ Harrison Bader is hitting .343 (12-for-35) with a .933 OPS in 11 career games against Texas.
☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with two home runs and a 1.014 OPS in eight career games against Texas.

GOING ON A TARGET RUN: Twins are 19-10 through 29 home games this season.

☞ They have gone 17-5 in their last 22 home games, since April 15...they are 13-4 in their last 17 home games, since April 25...since April 25, their 13 wins are tied for fifth-most in baseball.
☞ Twins are 6-4 in Target Field series openers...they lost their last one on Friday night against the Blue Jays, snapping a six-game winning streak in such instances.

RAISE YOUR BAGUETTES: Ty France has reached base safely in a career-high 20-straight games...it marks the longest for a Twin this season and longest since Edouard Julien reached in 23-straight from September 6, 2023-March 30, 2024...the last in a *single season* was Byron Buxton with 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023...France's streak is the fifth-longest active streak in baseball...the longest in MLB this season was Kyle Schwarber's 41, from March 27-May 12.
☞ During the streak, France is hitting .316 (24-for-76) with three doubles, one home run, 14 RBI, seven HBP and a .381 on-base percentage.

UNBE-LEE-VABLE: Brooks Lee has hit safely in 10-straight games, extending his career-high...his previous high for a hitting streak was six, done twice, once in 2024 and once earlier this season...the current streak is the longest by a Twin this season and longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long as from Kyle Farmer, who hit in 13-straight, from September 3-22, 2024.
☞ During the current streak, Lee is hitting .317 (13-for-41) with one double, one home run and six RBI.

ROYCE ROLLIN': Over his last six games, since June 3, Royce Lewis is hitting .438 (7-for-16) with two doubles, four RBI, five walks, a .571 on-base percentage, a .563 slugging percentage and a 1.134 OPS...since that date, he has posted a 23.8 walk percentage, which ranks fifth in baseball among players with at least 20 plate appearances...among that same criteria, he has a BB/K ratio of 1.67, 10th-best in baseball.

GOOD WILLI: In his last 20 games, Willi Castro is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with three doubles, five home runs, eight RBI, 10 walks, 15 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .440 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.065 OPS.
☞ Since the start of the Seattle series, May 30, he is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with one double, four home runs, six RBI, 10 runs scored and a 1.306 OPS in seven games.

THE DOKTOR IS IN: Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Jason Dorktorczyk has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week...he made the start on Thursday vs. Palm Beach, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts...he leads the Mighty Mussels staff in strikeouts, with 47...Dorktorczyk was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nevada, Reno.
