THE GRAPEFRUIT GANG: The St. Louis Cardinals enter their 134th season of play in the National League and are conducting their 28th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2025) ... On Monday, March 24, the Cardinals break camp in Florida and fly to Memphis to play an exhibition with the Triple-A Redbirds at AutoZone Park at 6:15 p.m. CT.

CARDINALS SIGN RHP PHIL MATON: The Cardinals announced today that they have signed free-agent righthanded reliever Phil Maton (pronounced MAY-tahn) to a one-year contract for the 2025 season, and designated LHP Bailey Horn for assignment to make room on the team's 40-player Major League roster.

- The Chatham, III. native, who grew up a St. Louis Cardinals fan, went 3-3 with a 3.66 ERA in a combined 71 games with the Mets and Rays last season and appeared in six postseason games during New York's advance to the NLCS ... Maton has appeared in 26 career postseason games, including the 2021 World Series with the Houston Astros.
- Maton will be issued uniform no. 88, while coach Packy Naughton switches to no. 86 ... Canadian RHP Dave Wainhouse is the only other player in Cardinals history to wear uniform no. 88 (nine games in 2000).

ROBY OPTIONED; WETHERHOLT & MOSQUEDA RE-AS-SIGNED: The Cardinals reduced their Spring Training roster to 48 players yesterday after re-assigning INF JJ Wetherholt and LHP Oddanier Mosqueda to minor league camp before the game and optioning RHP **Tekoah** Roby to Memphis (AAA) following the game.

- · Roby, 23, logged a 3.00 ERA and 0.89 WHIP in four Spring games while striking out 10 over 9.0 IP.
- The 22-year-old Wetherholt homered on March 2, drew six walks, and swiped three bags in 10 games during his first Big League camp.

WEST PALM BEACH BIRDS: The Cardinals are 23-19-4 all-time at the CACTI Park of The Palm Beaches since the stadium opened in 2017 (2-2 this season), 2nd-best by any visitor behind the Miami Marlins (27-10-6).

The Redbirds are 6-12-3 vs. the Houston Astros in West Palm Beach.

SPRING BREAKOUT: As part of MLB's second annual Spring Breakout showcase, the top Cardinals prospects will be hosted by the Marlins top young talent tomorrow at 11:10 a.m. CT at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium.

- The exhibition will be televised on FanDuel Sports Network, with father and son, Chip and Stefan Caray, calling the game together for the first time.
- St. Louis will have 16 of its top 30 prospects participating, with four of the top five and 12 of the top 20
- OF Joshua Baez was added to the Cardinals roster yesterday ... Baez was named to the 2024 All-Spring Breakout Second Team after hitting a 455 ft. homer in the inaugural event.
- 2024 Baseball America & Minor League Baseball Minor League Pitcher or the Year LHP Quinn Mathews has been announced as the Cardinals starting pitcher.

MARCHING AHEAD: Two weeks from today, the Cardinals host the Minnesota Twins on Opening Day on March 27. the earliest in franchise history.

- St. Louis has played on March 28 twice: at Milwaukee in 2019 and at the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2024.
- The earliest opener in St. Louis was March 30, 2023 vs. Toronto, the only other time playing an Interleague team on Opening Day.
- The 2020 Opening Day was scheduled for March 26 at Cincinnati before the COVID-19 pandemic postponed

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cardinals were awarded the 5th overall pick in the upcoming 2025 MLB Draft thanks to the offseason MLB Draft Lottery at baseball's Winter Meetings ... The 5th overall pick is the franchise's highest since outfielder J.D. Drew (No. 5 in 1998), and marks the first time in franchise history having consecutive top 10 selections ... Last season, St. Louis drafted infielder JJ Wetherholt with the 7th overall pick from West Virginia.

'S PITCHERS

#32 STEVEN MATZ (LHP) · L/L · 33 yrs · 6-3, 205 lbs

- Joined the Cardinals on a four-year contract (2022-25) after previously pitching for the New York Mets (2015-20) and Toronto Blue Jays (2021) organizations
- Since joining the Cardinals, has gone 10-12 with a 4.47 ERA in 52 appearances (34 starts).
- Began the 2024 season in the Cardinals five-man rotation. Appeared in 12 games, making seven starts.
- Was placed on the 15-day Injured List (lower back strain) on May 1, following his start on 4/30 [Game 2] at DET. Missed 108 games during the season and was transfered to the 60-day Injured List on June 28. Had injury rehabilitation assignments to Springfield (AA) and Memphis (AAA).
- · Has landed on the Injured List 14 times over his Major League career, missing time in every season except for 2021 in which he missed time for a positive COVID-19 te
- Returned from the Injured List on Sept. 1 and made one start and five relief appearances in September to finish out the season.

#59 JOJO ROMERO (LHP) · L/L · 28 yrs · 5-11, 210 lbs

- · Acquired at the 2022 trade deadline from the Philadelphia Phillies in exchange for infielder Edmundo Sosa on July 30.
- Made the Opening Day roster for the first time with the Cardinals in 2024 and posted career-high marks in appearances (65), innings (59.0), strikeouts (51) and wins (7).
- Became the Cardinals left-handed stopper in 2024, ranking 3rd among National League pitchers with 30 Holds behind Andrew Kittredge (37) and Tyler Rogers (33).
- His 30 Holds ranked 2nd among Cardinals relief pitchers and T-5th all-time for single season in franchise history with Kyle McClellan (2008). Only Ray King (31) in 2004, had more among Cardinals southpaws all-time.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .172 BA (29-169) with four home runs allowed in his career. Since 2022, his .150 opponent BA (19-127) vs. LH batters ranks 5th in MLB (min. 140 batters faced).

#62 KYLE LEAHY (RHP) · R/R · 27 yrs · 6-4, 220 lbs

- Pitched parts of two Major League seasons for the Cardinals (2023-24), making 36
- Ranked in the Top 10 among NL rookies in ground into double plays (0.92, 5th), GIDP (5, T-5th), home runs/9 IP (0.74, 10th), walks/9 IP (1.85, 2nd), baserunners/9 IP (9.43, 3rd) and SO/BB ratio (3.30, 4th),
- Led Cardinals relief pitchers in Inherited Runners Scored Pct. (11.8%) stranding 15-of-17 of those with 10 or more Inherited Runners.
- Pitched 2.2 perfect innings for his first Major League win at LAA (5/13) retiring all eight batters faced in a 10-5 win. Recorded his first Major League save at ATL (7/20) with two scoreless innings in the night cap of a doubleheader.
- Established Springfield (AA) single-season record with 144 strikeouts in 2022, surpassing Austin Gomber (140) in 2017.

#58 CHRIS ROYCROFT (RHP) · R/R · 27 yrs · 6-7, 240 lbs

- Signed by the Cardinals as a minor league free agent, two days after his 25th birthday, following playing two seasons in the independent leagues for Joliet Slammers of the Frontier League, the local team near his hometown and college
- Profiled the lowest hard hit percentage (exit velocity of 95 MPH or more) on a four-seam fastball (13.0%) of pitchers facing 40 or more batters in 2024.
- Climbed three levels during the 2023 season from Peoria (High-A) to Memphis (AAA)
- before making his Major League debut in 2024. • Appeared in a career-high 63 games between Memphis (36) and St. Louis (27).
- Began the season in Memphis (AAA) before his contract was selected on May 7 and made his MLB debut that night against the Mets. Struck out the side in the 9th inning while allowing one run. Fanned Francisco Lindor swinging for his first Major League strikeout. Surrendered a home run to two-time All-Star Game Home Run Derby Winner, Pete Alonso, as the next batter, challenging him on a 1-2 pitch.
- · Was a two-sport athlete in high school and college, playing basketball.
