No Saves

The Braves yesterday played their 31st consecutive game without converting a save, extending a franchise record since the stat became official in 1969.

Atlanta went 25 straight games without a save between the 1970 and 1971 seasons.

The Braves most recent save came on May 16 at Boston, when Raisel Iglesias completed a 4-2 win. Every other team has multiple saves in that span, and the Brewers have a majorst-most 14.

Since that May 16 date the Braves are 12-19, and 10 of their 12 wins in that span have been by at least four runs. In the two others, Atlanta allowed a run in the ninth to beat Colorado, 4-1, on June 14, and walked off against the Mets, 5-4, on June 17.

TONIGHT’S GAME: The Braves and Mets tonight open a four-game mid-week series with what is the fourth of 13 scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...The two are set to meet seven times over a 10-day span, following three games in Atlanta last week.

 The Braves swept the Mets in those three games in Atlanta, and have won four straight against New York dating to the end of last season...The Braves outscored the Mets, 16-1, over the final 21 innings of the series last week.

 Atlanta won four of the final five games between the clubs last season and went 7-6 in 13 total games versus New York for the year...The Braves have taken the season series from their NL East rivals for seven consecutive seasons dating to 2018, and are 71-44 (.617) against the club overall in that stretch.

 The Braves have won 26 of the last 36 games with New York dating to the 2022 season, outscoring the Mets 217-136 (+81) over the stretch.

 Atlanta went 4-3 here at Citi Field last season, and is 79-61 (.564) all-time in this building since it opened in 2009...The Braves’ 79 wins here are the most by any visiting team in stadium history, and their .564 winning percentage trails just the Dodgers (32-17, .653) in the National League.

 RH Paul Blackburn has made three prior starts against Atlanta in his career, including five days ago at Truist Park, and is 0-1 with a 2.63 ERA (4 ER/13.2 IP) against the club...The 6-foot-1, 196-pound Californian took the loss last week in Atlanta, after allowing four hits and four runs, three earned, over 3.2 innings....In four appearances, two starts, with the Mets this season, the right-hander is 0-1 with a 6.92 ERA and one save.

INTRADIVISION SCHWELLY: RH Spencer Schwellenbach starts for Atlanta tonight and faces the Mets for the second consecutive turn...He took a no-decision last Tuesday night at Truist Park, allowing six hits and four runs over 7.0 innings in the Braves’ eventual 10-inning win, 5-4.

 The right-hander has completed 7.0 innings in all four of his career starts against New York, and owns a 2-0 record with a 1.93 ERA (6 ER/28.0 IP) and 28 strikeouts against the club.

 Schwellenbach made his major league debut on May 19 of last season versus Washington, and took the loss that night...In 11 starts against the NL East since his debut, he is a perfect 6-0 with a 2.06 ERA (17 ER/74.1 IP) versus intradivision opponents...Atlanta has gone 9-2 in these turns.

 In total since the start of 2024, Schwellenbach’s .857 winning percentage, 2.27 ERA, 0.81 WHIP and 6.2 average innings per start are all the best by any qualified NL East pitcher versus divisional opponents.

 The Michigan native has completed at least 6.0 innings in eight straight starts, going 4-1 with a 2.77 ERA since May 8.

ALL-STAR UPDATE: Major League Baseball today released its second update on voting totals for the 2025 MLB All-Star Game presented by Mastercard, and OF Ronald Acuña Jr. has jumped two spots in the NL outfield to rank fourth overall with 1,140,061 total votes... Acuña Jr. is trying for a fifth career fan election, which would match Hall-of-Famer Hank Aaron and Dale Murphy for the most in franchise history.

 Acuña Jr. trails leaders Pete Crow-Armstrong of the Chicago Cubs (2,005,630), two-time All-Star Teoscar Hernández of the Los Angeles Dodgers (1,366,537) and three-time All-Star Kyle Tucker of the Cubs (1,219,866).

 The voting period for Phase 1 concludes this Thursday at 12:00 p.m. ET...The top two vote-getters at each position (and the top six outfielders) in each league will be revealed on MLB Network at 6:00 p.m. (ET), and they will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who makes the All-Star teams and starts for each league.

ACUÑA JR. ON BASE: Ronald Acuña Jr. collected two more hits yesterday afternoon, going 2-for-4 with a double and two runs scored...He has three straight multi-hit efforts and has reached in 59 of his 117 plate appearances this season (50.4%).

 Acuña Jr. has collected 38 hits and worked 21 walks in 117 trips to the plate this season...Since his season debut on May 23, he is the only qualified batter in baseball with an OBP over .500.

 Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, Acuña Jr. is just the second player in franchise history to carry an on-base percentage over .500 through their first 27 games (min. 100 plate appearances) of a season...He joins Jeff Burroughs in 1978, who reached in 58 of his 113 plate appearances (.513 OBP) over 27 games to open the season.

ON-BASE STREAKS: Atlanta batters own each of the two longest on-base streaks in baseball, with Matt Olson reaching in an MLB-best 23 straight games and Ronald Acuña Jr. getting on in 18 straight to rank second.

 Olson’s run is the longest single-season streak of his career...He had reached in 21 straight in a single season three times prior, first in 2021 while with the A’s and again in 2023...He also reached in the final 21 games of 2024 and the first three games this season, for a career-best streak of 24 total games.

 He has batted .289/.412/.506 with three home runs, nine doubles, 20 RBI, 14 runs and 17 walks during his current run, which dates to May 29.

 Acuna Jr.’s run dates to June 3, and he has batted .435/.557/.726 during his own streak, reaching base in 44 of his 79 trips to the plate.

 He has four hits and four walks in the first inning in his current streak, reaching base safely in eight of the 18 games leading off...His six first-inning runs during the streak are two more than any other leadoff batter in baseball.

Making his 16th start of the year and fifth career appearance against New York (NL).

Faced the Mets in his last start, allowing four runs while fanning eight over 7.0 innings pitched.

Is 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA, 28 strikeouts and three walks in three career outings against New York.
- 🔪

Struck out 11 hitters while scattering two hits over 7.0 scoreless frames in a win last year in his only other start at Citi Field.

His streak of of eight consecutive games with at least 6.0 innings pitched is tied for the second-longest active streak in baseball and the second longest this year.

His 96.2 innings pitched on the year are tied for the sixth most in baseball this season and third most in the National League.

Pitching to a 1.01 WHIP this year, the third-lowest mark in the NL.
- 🔪

Recording strikes on 68.8% of pitches thrown, the highest rate in the National League and second-highest in the majors among qualified pitchers.
- 🔪

Producing a 34.0% chase rate on all of his pitches, tied for the third highest percentage in baseball and third highest in the National League among qualifiers... Tied with teammate Chris Sale and trailing Matthew Liberatore (34.4%) in the NL.

Since the 2024 All-Star Break, Schwellenbach has pitched to a 3.02 ERA in 28 starts, seventh lowest in the National League (min. 25 starts).

Made his first Opening Day roster with Atlanta in his third professional season.
- 🔪

Had a scoreless streak of 16.0 innings to open the season, which covered his first two starts of the season (14.0) and first 2.0 innings of his start against the Phillies...In the Atlanta-era (since 1966), it's tied for the fifth-longest scoreless streak by a Braves hurler to begin a season, along with Jim Britton (1968) and Terrell Wade (1996).

His five games with at least 10 strikeouts through a player's first 33 games are the second most in Braves franchise history, trailing only teammate Spencer Strider.
- 🔪

Through 33 career games, Schwellenbach's 198 strikeouts were the most by any pitcher in major league history through as many outings with 35 walks or less issued (1901).
- 🔪

Schwellenbach has not walked a batter in any of his five career double-digit strikeout performances...His five outings with 10-or-more strikeouts and zero walks are the most by any pitcher through their first 33 career appearances in MLB history, surpassing the previous high of four, held by former New York (NL) teammates, Matt Harvey (2013) and Noah Syndergaard (2014-15).

Became just the 16th in pitcher in major league history (dating to 1901) to make consecutive starts with at least 11 strikeouts and zero walks issued... Clayton Kershaw and Chris Archer are tied for the most with three.
- 🔪

With his start against Boston on May 31, he became the 16th pitcher in MLB history and first Brave with as many as 11 strikeouts on their birthday.
- 🔪

His fifth-inning strikeout of Boston's Wilyer Abreu came on a 100.2 mph four-seam fastball; the fastest pitch of his MLB career...Registered 14 pitches 98.9 mph-or-faster (10 four-seamers, four cutters); accounting for the top-14 fastest pitches of his career before May 31, 2025 (2,985 total pitches).

On June 6, Schwellenbach struck out San Francisco's Wilmer Flores in the bottom of the second inning for his 200th career punchout.
- 🔪

Joined Brandon Beachy and Spencer Strider as the only pitchers in Braves franchise history to eclipse the milestone in 34 career games or less...Strider did so in 21 starts and 13 relief appearances.
- 🔪

Became just the third player in baseball history to record 200 strikeouts and less than 40 walks in their first 34 career games, first since Noah Syndergaard with New York (NL).
- 🔪

Tossed the first complete game of his career onl June 11 against Milwaukee, scattering five hits and two runs with nine strikeouts over 9.0 innings pitched.
- 🔪

Became just the 31st player in Atlanta franchise history to record a complete game through his first 35 career appearances and first since Bryce Eldeer in 2022.
- 🔪

His nine strikeouts were the most in a CG through as many games since Kevin Milwood fanned 13 in 1998.

In his first year with Atlanta and second professional season, Schwellenbach went 8-7 with a 3.35 ERA (46 ER/123.2 IP) over 21 starts...Made his debut on May 29 against Washington, allowing five hits and three runs while fanning five hitters.
- 🔪

His 122 strikeouts through his first 20 career games were the most by a Braves player through as many games to begin their career in franchise history.
- 🔪

Became the first pitcher in the live ball era to have at least 77 strikeouts and issue 12 walks or less through a player's first 12 career games.
- 🔪

Became the first player in Braves franchise history to strike out at least 10 hitters without allowing a run in one of his first 10 career games.

- His home ERA is 0.55 (1 ER/16.1 IP) but his road ERA is 6.75 (10 ER/13.1 IP)...Among pitchers with at least 15.2 innings pitched in their home venue, his ERA is sxith-best in MLB.
- Before his June 19 outing, had pitched to a 1.59 ERA (3 ER/17.0 IP) in his previous 15 appearances, dating to May 3...It was his best 15–game stretch since joining the Braves organization.
- In his June 1 outing versus Boston, set a new career high with five strikeouts.
- Per Baseball Savant, his xERA is 2.86 (89th percentile)...Also ranks highly in barrel percentage (100th percentile, 1.2%).
- Among pitchers that have faced at least 300 batters since the start of 2024, Bummer’s three barrels allowed are the fewest in Major League Baseball...Every other qualifying pitcher has allowed at least six in that span.
- Has induced a ground ball rate of 58.7%, which ranks in the 95th percentile league-wide...The league-average ground ball rate is 43%...That ground ball rate ranks fifth in the National League (min. 25 IP).

- Has thrown his slider 208 times, and has surrendered just eight hits on it...Among pitchers that have thrown at least that many, those eight hits are tied for the seventh fewest in Major League Baseball.
- In at-bats that end with a changeup, opposing hitters are batting .059 (1-for-17).
- In at-bats that last three pitches–or–fewer, opponents are batting .229...Fourth pitch–and–on, they’re batting .167.
- On April 8, struck out the side (9th inning) for the 13th time in his MLB career and for the first time this season...He last did it as a member of the San Diego Padres on July 28, 2024, at Baltimore.
- Last year, allowed 26% of his earned runs (10) in just five games with the Yankees.
- Tossed an “immaculate inning” on September 27, 2022 vs. the Rays in the seventh inning...Signified the 110th immaculate inning in MLB history, and the fourth in Cleveland’s franchise history.
