**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**APRIL 4**  
**1994** - On Opening Day at the Astrodome, the Astros debut their new navy and gold uniforms with the leaning, broken star logo...the Astros would wear these uniforms through the 1999 season and the move to Minute Maid Park...the game does not disappoint, as **Ken Caminiti** hits a two-run double in the 12th to give Houston a 6-5, walk-off win vs. MTL...this marks the Astros last walkoff win in an Opening Day game.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Astros continue their 10-game road trip with the second game of a three-game series against the Athletics at Sutter Health Park in West Sacramento, CA...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** will be on the mound for the Astros this afternoon opposite **RHP Luis Morales** and the Athletics.

**STREAKING:** The Astros went on a five-game winning streak from March 28-April 1, which matched their season-high from 2025 (reached twice last June).

**TODAY'S ASTROS STARTER:** **RHP Tatsuya Imai** is set to make his second career start in the Majors today after a stellar Spring Training, in which he worked a combined 9.2 scoreless innings across four starts...in his Major League debut on March 29 vs. Los Angeles (AL), he allowed four runs on three hits and four walks with four strikeouts in 2.2 innings...in January, the Astros signed Imai to a three-year deal...in 2025, he was an All-Star for the Seibu Lions in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB), where he went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games.

**SWEEPSTAKES:** In their last series, The Astros swept the Boston Red Sox, their first three-game sweep of the season and their first since Sept. 15-17, 2025 vs. TEX...it is their first sweep of the Red Sox since a three-game sweep from Aug. 9-11, 2024, at Fenway Park...is the Astros' first sweep of the Red Sox at Daikin Park since a three-game sweep from July 21-23, 2015.

**JOE'S RETURN TRIP:** This series is a return trip to West Sacramento for Astros manager **Joe Espada**, who played for the Triple A Sacramento River Cats for part of the 2000 season as an A's minor leaguer...this series is especially unique for Espada, who played in the first-ever game at Sutter Health Park on May 15, 2000...Espada started at second base that game, going 1x3 with a double in the River Cats 2-1 loss to the Edmonton Trappers, then the Triple A affiliate of the Angels.

**AGAINST THE ATHLETICS:** The Astros and A's are facing each other today for the second of 13 scheduled games in 2026...the Astros went 5-8 vs. the A's in 2025, including a 3-4 record at Sutter Health Park...the Astros have own a 120-107 all-time record against the Athletics.

**SUSTAINED SUCCESS:** Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 12 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (981), trailing only the Dodgers (1,041).

**ON THE MEND:** **RHP Enyel De Los Santos** continued his rehab assignment with Double A Corpus Christi last night...in his outing, he struck out one in one scoreless inning.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Triple A Sugar Land defeated Triple A Jacksonville, 5-0 last night at VyStar Stadium after the Space Cowboys pitching staff carried a no-hitter into the ninth inning...the Space Cowboys are 6-1 to begin the Triple A season.

**LAST NIGHT'S GAME:** The Houston Astros were defeated by the Athletics, 4-11, at Sutter Health Park last night in West Sacramento, CA...**RHP Cristian Javier** (3.2 IP, 6 H, 6 ER, 5 BB, 2 K) made the start for the Astros...**C Yainer Diaz** (2x3, 2B, RBI, BB) and **3B Nick Allen** (2x2, 2 R) each recorded a multi-hit game...**DH Yordan Alvarez** went 0x1 with a sac-fly RBI for the 500th RBI of his career.

**THE LUCKY 6:** The Astros scored six-plus runs in five straight games (March 28-April 1) for the first time since July 26-31, 2021...the offense scored 43 runs in those five games, while hitting .306 (52x170) with 16 doubles and eight homers in that span...the Astros franchise record is 11 straight games with six-plus runs, accomplished just once, from Aug. 27-Sept. 7, 2004.

**LEAGUE LEADERS:** The Astros lead the American League in runs (49), doubles (21) total bases (117), hits (69), OBP (.357), SLG (.440) and OPS (.797), while ranking second in walks (37)...individually, **1B Christian Walker** leads the AL in doubles (5) and **2B Jose Altuve** and **LF Yordan Alvarez** ranks tied for second in the AL in runs scored (8).

**MR. 500:** **LF Yordan Alvarez** recorded his 500th career RBI last night on a sac-fly RBI in the third inning...became the 15th player in franchise history to record 500 RBI...is also the fastest player in franchise history to record 500 career RBI doing so in just 685 games, passing **1B Jeff Bagwell**, who recorded 500 RBI in 717 games.

**YORDAN'S UPCOMING MILESTONES:** **LF Yordan Alvarez** has recorded 173 career home runs, which makes him just one home run shy of matching franchise icon **OF George Springer** (174 HR) for the seventh on the Astros all-time list.

**SHOWRREA:** **IF Carlos Correa** went 1x4 with a three-run home run on Wednesday vs. BOS...was his 140th career homer as an Astro, breaking a tie with **Bob Watson** for the 11th-most in franchise history...was his 65th career home run at Daikin Park, tying **IF Morgan Ensberg** for the 9th-most in the venue's history.

**NEW FACES:** The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market...they also added a Rule 5 pick in **RHP Rodderly Muñoz**, the Astros first Rule 5 selection since the 2017 Rule 5 Draft.

**JOSE, JOSE, JOSE, JOSE!:** **2B Jose Altuve** went 4x4 with four runs scored and a pair of homers on Monday night, giving him 42 four-hit games since he debuted in 2011, which are by far the most in the Majors in that time frame (**1B Freddie Freeman** ranks second with 31)...Altuve's four runs scored matched his career high, which he's accomplished seven times, most recently on July 4, 2025 at LAD.

**MLB DEBUT:** Made his MLB debut last Sunday vs. LAA, working 2.2 innings while allowing 4 runs on 3 hits with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts (74 pitches-36 strikes)...picked up his first MLB strikeout vs. **OF Mike Trout**, the second batter he faced in his debut...took a no-decision in the Astros' 9-7 win over the Halos....topped out at 97.6 mph in his debut, with only **RHP Hunter Brown** throwing a harder pitch among Astros starters this season.

**JAPAN CONNECTION :** With his MLB debut last week, he became the 33rd Japanese-born pitcher to make a start in the Majors...is the fourth Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining **IF Kazuo Matsui** (2008-10), **OF Norichika Aoki** (2017) and **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** (2024)...Matsui was also the Manager of the Seibu Lions from 2023-24, while Imai was on the team.

**I-45:** Pitched eight seasons for the Seibu Lions (2018-25) in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB)...he went 58-45 overall with a 3.15 ERA (337ER/963.2IP) and 907 strikeouts in 159 career games in the NPB...is a three-time All-Star in the NPB (2021, 2024 and 2025).

**2025 RECAP:** Went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP)...also recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th

in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the second consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed eight innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

**SPRING TRAINING:** Made 3 official Spring Training starts...in those 3 starts, he allowed 2 hits and 1 walk with 7 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...he also pitched in a sim game on March 17, which did not factor into his Spring Training stats.

**PAYING HOMAGE:** Wears jersey number 45 to honor two of his favorite pitchers, Yankees **RHP Gerrit Cole** and Phillies **RHP Zack Wheeler**, who both also wear #45.

**CONTRACT:** Signed a three-year contract with the Astros on Jan. 2, 2026...the contract includes player opt-outs after the 2026 and 2027 seasons.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** recorded his 1st save of the season (and 17th of his career) on Wednesday vs. BOS, striking out 3 batters through 1.0 inning while allowing his lone run and via a solo homer by **OF Roman Anthony** (16 pitches, 12 strikes)...averaged 96.1 mph with his 4-seam fastball, his highest mark among his 3 appearances this season.

**MILESTONE WATCH:** is 1.0 inning from matching **RHP Ryan Pressly** for the 11th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...is also 5.0 innings from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** for 10th-most.

**VS. ATH:** has made 31 career appearances vs. the Athletics, which are the most by a reliever among active MLB players, just 1 ahead of former teammate **RHP Ryan Stanek**...has gone 3-3-1 with a 1.98 ERA (8ER/36.1IP), .151 opponent batting average, 0.85 WHIP and 42 strikeouts (10.4 SO/9IP) in his regular-season career vs. the A's.

**SPRING TRAINING:** finished Spring Training with a 3.86 ERA (3ER/7IP), 7 walks and 5 strikeouts with a .200 opponent average.

**CAREER:** has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last seven seasons (2019-25)...owns a 16-12 record with 17 saves, a 2.77 ERA (102ER/332IP) and 454 strikeouts in 332.0 Major League innings...among relievers in club history, ranks fourth in strikeouts (454), seventh in appearances (320) and 12th in innings (332.0).

**LAST APPEARANCE:** worked a perfect 1.0 inning on Wednesday vs. BOS, striking out 1 batter (14 pitches, 10 strikes)...has posted a 0.37 ERA (1ER/24.1IP), 0.66 WHIP and .100 opponent batting average (8x80) over his last 11 appearances dating back to last season (since Aug. 31, 2025).

**OPENING DAY:** made his 1<sup>st</sup> career Opening Day roster this season...pitched on Opening Day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball, allowing his only run on a solo homer by Mike Trout...dazzled hitters with an uptick in velocity, including throwing a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of Yoan Moncada...marked the hardest pitch thrown in his career.

**SPRING TRAINING:** had a powerful Spring Training, owning a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (1ER/10.2IP) in 6 appearances...walked 3 and struck out 8 with a 0.94 WHIP and a .189 (7x37) opponent batting average.

**2025 SEASON:** went 3-1 with a 1.69 ERA (6ER/32IP), a 0.88 WHIP, .152 opponent average and 9.84 SO/9IP through 11 Major League appearances (three starts)...also made 22 total appearances (19 starts) with Triple A Sugar Land this season, going 5-8 with a 5.27 ERA (58ER/99IP)...recorded a 21.0-inning scoreless streak from Aug. 23 through the end of the 2025 season

**LAST APPEARANCE:** worked the final 3.0 innings of Tuesday night's game vs. BOS to pick up his first career save in the Astros 9-2 win...tossed 50 pitches in the outing (34 strikes) in what was his first pitching appearance of the season...marked the Astros first 3.0-inning save since LHP Colton Gordon (4IP) picked up the save on Sept. 12 at ATL.

**ROSTER MOVE:** was selected to the Major League roster on Monday for his first time on the Astros active roster in the regular season.
