RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a nine-game, 11-day homestand vs. Boston (0-3), Kansas City (0-2, 1 to play) and Oakland (3 to play) today at Tropicana Field...the Rays have lost a season-high six straight games, their longest skid since dropping seven in a row from July 1-8, 2023...entering the streak, they had gone 11-4 in their previous 15 games from May 3-18 on the heels of a 2-8 stretch from April 21-May 1...Thursday's off day began a stretch of four in a span of 15 days from May 23-June 6...the Rays are a season-high 11.5 games back in the AL East standings, their largest deficit since concluding the 2022 season 13.0 games back...they have spent the entire season within four games of the .500 mark.

In vesterday's 7-4 11-inning loss the Rays never led but overcame three separate

In yesterday's 7-4, 11-inning loss, the Rays never led, but overcame three separate deficits (1-0, 3-1, 4-3)...it marked the second time in 2024 they have lost despite rallying from multiple deficits, joining April 17 vs. LAA (trailed 1-0, 3-1; lost 5-4).

Jonny DeLuca recorded a game-tying single in the 10th inning with the Rays down to their final strike...there have been a total of six game-tying/go-ahead hits with a team down to its final strike in MLB in 2024—along with Randy Arozarena's game-tying HR on May 5 vs. NYM, the Rays are the only club with multiple such hits. The setback secured the Rays first home series loss to the Royals since May 8-11, 2017, snapping a five-series unbeaten run (4-0-1)...they have dropped three straight home series for the first time since July 4-23, 2023 (PHI, ATL, BAL). Tampa Bay has dropped six consecutive games, all by 3+ runs, for the first time since a six-game skid from June 19-25 (G1), 2016...the club record is eight consecutive losses, set from July 21 (G1)-28, 2007.

The six-game skid is tied with the Rangers for the longest active losing streak in the majors...during the streak, the Rays are averaging 2.3 runs per game and have been outscored, 38-14 (-24)...they are slashing .170/.255/.247 (33-for-194) collectively with only 9 XBH.

This marks the sixth time in club history the Rays have followed a winning streak of 4+ games with a losing streak of 6+...the last instance came in June 2021, when they won four straight before dropping seven in a row (Elias).

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

Record their first win since May 18 at TOR and first at home since May 11 vs. NYY.

Avoid being swept by the Royals for the 10th time in club history, including the third at Tropicana Field, joining series from May 13-14, 1998 and Aug. 21-23, 1998.

Evade being swept in back-to-back series for the first time since July 29-Aug. 22, 2020 (at ATL, at BAL)...it would also mark their first time suffering consecutive home sweeps since April 1-6, 2011 (BAL, LAA).

Avoid falling a season-high-tying four games below .500, joining their 14-18 mark entering play on May 3.

TROP TROUBLES—The Rays six-game home losing streak is their longest since also dropping six straight from March 30–April 15, 2018...they have not had a longer streak since a nine-game skid from April 25–May 10, 2002...the Rays 14-17 mark at Tropicana Field is their worst through 31 home games since 2015 (14-17)...last season, they held an MLB-leading 25-6 home record at this point, the best mark in franchise history...the Rays 31 games played at home lead the majors, ahead of the Dodgers/Phillies (30).

WHAT'S THE DIFF?—The Rays -50 run differential is third worst in the AL, better than only the Athletics (-60) and White Sox (-113)...it signals their lowest mark through 53 games since 2007 (-82)...the Rays have a +22 (76-54) run differential in innings 1-3. fourth best in the AL behind the Yankees (+43), Royals (+29) and Orioles (+23)...their -61 (117-56) mark in the 4th-6th frames is the worst in the majors, with the White Sox (-45) being the next closest club...they own a -11 (89-78) differential from the 7th inning on.

Each of the Rays last five wins have come by two runs or fewer, while each of their last eight losses have been by 3+ runs, their longest streak since June 16-July 7, 2016 (9)...their 18 wins by two runs or fewer are tied with the Orioles for most in the majors, and their .692 (18-8) winning pct. in such contests ranks second behind the Philles (14-6/700)...conversely, Tampa Bay is 7-20 (259) in games with a differential of 3+ runs, second worst in MLB, ahead of the White Sox (6-23/207).

ON-BASE PAREDES—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 22 of his last 23 games since May 7, hitting .341/.439/.512 (28-for-82) with 5 2B, 3 HR, 13 RBI, 13 BB and 13 SO... he ranks among AL leaders during that span in OBP (3rd) and AVG (4th)...Paredes has reached safely in 32 of his last 35 games overall since April 14, posting the AL's second-best average over that timeframe (.326/42-for-129) behind TOR Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.331).

Few hitters possess Paredes' blend of contact and power...he is one of three qualified AL hitters with a .490+ SLG (.496) and sub-20.0 pct. whiff rate (18.2%), joining HOU Kyle Tucker (.616/19.6%) and CLE José Ramírez (.539/15.7%).

ON THE MOUND—Rays pitching has yielded 5+ runs in six straight games, the club's longest streak since June 16-22, 2021 (also 6G)...prior to that, an eight game run from May 27–June 4, 2017 was their longest such streak...despite the overall struggles, Tampa Bay's rotation has turned in a 3.78 ERA (16.2IP, 7ER) over the club's last four games on the heels of a 5.81 ERA (52.2IP, 34ER) in their previous nine...the Rays bullpen owns a 7.59 ERA (21.1IP, 18ER) over the last four games—however, excluding the eight runs and 5.0 IP registered by bulk reliever Tyler Alexander on Friday, that mark lowers to 5.51 (16.1IP, 10ER)...the bullpen posted an MLB-best 1.59 ERA (62.1IP, 11ER) in their previous 17 contests from May 3-20.

SMALL BALL—Tampa Bay has recorded an AL-leading 67 infield hits, second most in the majors behind Milwaukee (70)...the Rays lead the AL in stolen bases (56), ahead of the Royals (54), and rank highly in times reaching via error (2nd, 17), pitches per plate appearance (2nd, 3.98), hit-by-pitches (3rd, 27), singles (4th, 298) and sacrifice hits (T4th, 5).

José Caballero swiped his AL-leading 19th stolen base yesterday, most by a Ray through the club's first 53 games since Carl Crawford (30) in 2009...Caballero is on page for 50 SP. in Pays history only Crawford (90 Y04) has reached that tatal

The Rays .355 slugging pct. is 14th, ahead of only the White Sox (.330)...it ties the 2002 Devil Rays (.355) for the lowest mark through 53 games in franchise history... their 120 XBH are second fewest in MLB, more than only the Marlins (117). The Rays have allowed 70 HR, second most in the majors behind the White Sox (72), while hitting 43 HR of their own, T12th most in the AL/T23rd in MLB...their -27 HR margin is second lowest in the majors, besting only the White Sox (-36).

ROYAL AFFAIRS—The Rays and Royals meet for the third of six games in 2024 today, concluding the three-game set in St. Pete...Tampa Bay will travel to Kauffman Stadium to conclude the season series from July 2-4...the Rays have won five straight season series over the Royals dating to 2018 (clubs did not meet in 2020), going 23-13 (.639) in that span (4-3 in 2023)...they have won six of 11 and 10 of the last 18 meetings...including the current set, the Rays are 8-2-2 in their last 12 series vs. the Royals since Aug. 2017.

The Rays are 3-8 against the AL Central, going 3-5 at home...this, after posting the AL's best winning pct. against the division in 2023 (.719/23-9).

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will make his fourth start of the season this afternoon, including his third at Tropicana Field...opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) before making his 2024 debut on May 10 vs. NYY...suffered the injury while warming up for his scheduled spring start on March 12 at BAL.

LAST TIME OUT—Facing Boston for the second time in as many starts, he suffered his second loss of the year...tossed a career-high-tying 7.0 IP (also Sept. 24, 2023 vs. TOR) and struck out a season-high 10 batters, but conceded five runs on six hits and two home runs.

Bradley struck out the side on 11 pitches in the 1st inn., the first Rays pitcher to accomplish the feat on 11 pitches or fewer in any frame since Tyler Glasnow on Sept. 11, 2023 at MIN (10 pitches, 1st inn.)...he recorded a career-high 22 swings-and-misses overall, the most by a Ray since Glasnow (22) on Sept. 6, 2023 vs. BOS.

UNFAMILIAR FOE—Bradley will be making his first career start opposite Kansas City...he has made two career starts against AL Central opponents (Sept. 3, 2023 at CLE & Sept. 13, 2023 at MIN) but did not factor into either decision, posting a combined 4.66 ERA (9.2IP, 5ER) across the two outings.

KING OF THE K-Bradley has recorded 151 SO in his first 24 career starts, king OF THE K—Bradley has recorded 151 SO in his first 24 career starts, third most in any pitcher's first 24 starts after joining the Rays, trailing Charlie Morton (174, 2019) and Drew Smyly (162, 2014-16)...Morton (184) also holds the mark through 25 starts, followed by Smyly (168) and Tyler Glasnow (154)...Bradley's 151 SO are the most by a Ray in his first 24 career starts, outpacing Matt Moore (144, 2011-12).

In his last start, Bradley became the second Ray this year to record 10+ strikeouts, joining Ryan Pepiot (11SO) on April 7 at COL...he became one of five pitchers (6 instances) in the majors this season to throw 7.0+ innings, record 10+ SO and issue zero walks.

In 2023, Bradley posted a 28.4 pct. strikeout rate, the highest mark by a rookie in Rays history (min. 300BF), surpassing Shane McClanahan's 27.3 pct. in 2021.

LONG BALL WOES-Bradley's 25 HR allowed as a starter are the most Roberto Hernández (23, 2013)...last season, from his April 12 debut through June 15, his 0.84 HR/9.0 IP was the 12th-lowest mark in the AL (min. 40.0IP)...from that point on, his 2.77 HR/9.0 IP was second highest in the majors (min. 50.0IP) behind MIN Joe Ryan (2.79).

ADVANCED TALK—Of Bradley's 44 batted balls, nine have been barreled (20.5%), the second-highest barrel rate (min. 50BF) in the majors, ahead of only MIA **Roddery Muñoz** (22.5%)...under the same parameters, Bradley's 52.3 pct. hard hit rate is third highest in the AL/eighth in MLB.

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Through his first three starts, Bradley has limited opponents to a 1-for-25 (.040) clip with 15 of his 23 SO the first time through the lineup...opposing hitters are 11-for-25 (.440) the second time through and 2-for-16 (.125) the third time.

ASSET PROTECTION—Prior to his May 10 start vs. Boston, Bradley had not Had a stolen base attempted against him in 25 career games (23GS)...David Hamilton broke that streak with a steal of second base in the 5th inning... among pitchers to debut since 1951 (when CS were officially calculated in the NL), the 23-start stretch was tied with Tyler Alexander (2019-21) for the second-longest career-opening streak in the majors, trailing only KC Yordano Ventura (29GS, 2013-14).

DEEP ARSENAL—Opposing hitters are a combined 5-for-36 (.139) with 14 SO and 1 XBH (2B) hits on Bradley's secondary pitches (cutter, split finger, curveball)...this includes a 2-for-15 (.133) clip on his cutter, a pitch that he recorded a .312 (29-for-93) opp. average on as a rookie.

2023 RECAP—After entering the season ranked as the Rays No. 1 prospect and the No. 16 prospect in the majors (MLB.com), Bradley went 5-8 with a 5.56 ERA over 22 games (21GS) in his first MLB season...had four stints with the Rays: April 11-13, April 18-25, May 18–July 31, and Sept. 3–end of the season...he was the youngest pitcher in the majors to make 20+ starts, becoming the third pitcher (4th instance) in Rays history to make 20+ starts in an age 22 or younger season, joining **Scott Kazmir** (32GS, 2005; 24GS, 2006) and **Joe Kennedy** (20GS, 2001).
