TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **Steve Gilbert's Diamondbacks** and the first game of a 6-game homestand that includes an upcoming 3-game series vs **NYM** (Mon-Wed).

- Cin is coming off a 1-5 road trip (0-3 at **StL**, 1-2 at **SD**).
- Following Wed's game here vs the **Mets**, the Reds will return to **New York** for a brief 3-game road trip against the **Yankees** (6/19-6/21).

TOUGH SLEDDING: The Reds have dropped 6 of their last 7 games and 10 of their last 13.

- Following Sat's (6/6) loss at **StL**, fell below .500 for the first time since they were 0-1 to open the 2026 season.
- Went 20-11 (.645) to begin the year...entered May a season-high 9 games over .500 and in first place in the NL Central (+1.0)...ended the month 2 games over .500 and in fifth place (-6.0).
- Beginning 5/1, have gone 12-24 (.333).
- Have endured 4 walkoff losses, including Wed at **SD** and 3 straight at **Chc** (5/4-5/6).

STRUGGLING AGAINST PEERS: The Reds are 2-13 (.133) vs their NL Central counterparts and 15-25 (.375) vs all National League opponents.

- Of their 28 games remaining until the All-Star break, 22 will be against National League teams, including 13 within the Central Division.

LOSSES AFTER LEADING: The Reds have lost 16 games this season in which they held a lead, including all 5 losses on the road trip.

- 14 of those 16 total losses have occurred since 5/2.

OUR PAL SAL: **INF Sal Stewart** belted a go-ahead, 2-run homer in Tue's 11th inning to beat the **Padres**, 5-3...it was the first go-ahead HR by a Red in extra innings since teammate **Spencer Steer** hit a 10th-inning grand slam in the 6-3 win on 4/1/24 at **Phi**.

- **Sal's** team-leading 13 home runs this season are the most by a Reds rookie through the club's first 67 games of a season since Hall of Famer **Frank Robinson** (17) in 1956.
- His 18 career home runs are the most through his first 84 Major League games since **Aristides Aquino** (23, 2018-21).
- Has appeared in each of Cin's 67 games this year...is the longest run of consecutive team games played by a Reds rookie to open a season in the expansion era.
- Is on pace to set a Reds rookie record with 101 RBI (since 1920, when RBI became an official stat)...is also on pace for 31 HR, which would be the second-most by a Cin rookie since 1900 (**F. Robinson**, 38, 1956).

BLEDDAY IN THE LIFE: **OF JJ Bleday**, the National League Player of the Month for May, ranks third on the team with a 1.5 WAR (**Chase Burns** 3.5, **Elly De La Cruz** 2.2).

- Since being recalled from AAA-Louisville on 4/26, he's slashing .270/.363/.568 with 11 HR, 29 RBI, and a .930 OPS in 39 games.

RUNNIN' REDLEGS: In Tue's 11-inning, 5-3 win at **SD**, the Reds collected a season-high 7 stolen bases, their most in a single game since 6/3/23 vs **Mil** (9), and their most steals in a road game since 8/10/74 at **NYM** (7).

- Went 7-for-7 in stolen base attempts on Tue...was just the seventh time since 1951 (when caught stealing was first tracked in the NL) that the club had 7 or more steals in a game without being caught, the last time being the aforementioned 6/3/24 game.
- Have been successful in each of their last 13 stolen base attempts, dating back to 5/31 vs **Atl**.
- Cin ranks ninth in the majors with 55 stolen bases and seventh with a 79.7% success rate (55-for-69).

NO. THANKS: The Reds and **Diamondbacks** are 2 of 5 teams without an ABS challenge from their pitching staff (also: **Twins**, **Blue Jays**, and **Rays**).

SERIES NOTES:

- Cin won the 2025 season series, 4-2...the Reds swept the **Diamondbacks** in a 3-game series from 6/6-6/8 in **Cincinnati**...it was the Redlegs first sweep of **AZ** since 7/21-7/23, 2023 at **GABP**.
- The June 2025 series between these clubs included the rain-soaked suspended game on 6/6 that was made up on 6/7.
- Each of Cin's last 2 suspended games at **Great American Ball Park** involved **AZ** (6/6/25, 4-3 win in 10 innings completed on 6/7/25; 4/20/21, 5-4 loss completed on 4/21/21).
- **AZ** has won 10 of the last 16g vs Cin and 4 of the last 6 series.
- Cin's 13-1 victory vs **AZ** on 6/7 marked the eighth time the Reds plated 13 or more runs in a game vs the **D-backs**, the first time since 3 years ago to the exact day, a 14-8 win on 6/7/22 at **GABP**.
- In 179 games vs **AZ** since 1998, the Reds are 90-89 and slashing .252/.320/.407 and average 4.31 R/G while pitching to a 3.97 ERA.

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have avoided being swept in 42 consecutive home series (min. 1g)...it's their longest such streak since 9/19/11-9/25/13 when the Reds eluded a series sweep at **Great American Ball Park** in a franchise-record 52 consecutive home series.

- The Reds avoided the sweep in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**...only the Cin teams of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012 ran the home schedule without being broomed.

POWER SURGE: The Reds have homered 63 times over their last 44 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), seventh-most in the majors during that time.

- Are on pace to hit 205 homers this season, which would be the 10th time in franchise history they'd reach the 200-HR mark.
- Have produced 5 sets of back-to-back home runs this season, including Sun at **StL** (**McLain** & **Stephenson** in the 3rd inning)...only the **White Sox** (6) and **A's** (6) have more...last year, the Reds had 2 sets of back-to-back homers, tying them with **Det** for fewest in the majors.
- Have hit 18 homers to the opposite field this year, most in the majors.
- Have hit 2 or more HRs in a game 23 times this season.
- Have hit 48 homers at **Great American Ball Park** in 2026, T5th-most by any Major League team at its home venue.
- 131 of their 286 runs scored this year have come via HR (45.8%, 5th).
- Are the only team in the majors to boast 5 players with 9 or more HR.

ALL-STAR BALLOTS: Major League Baseball opened fan voting for the 2026 All-Star Game, using a 2-phase system to select all starters.

- Fans can cast their ballots online and via mobile devices on all MLB platforms, including the MLB App, the MLB Ballpark App, and at MLB.com/Vote.
- Phase 1 runs 6/3-6/25 with up to 5 votes per day; top finalists advance.
- League leaders in Phase 1 automatically earn starting spots.
- Phase 2 runs 6/29-7/2 with reset totals to choose the rest of the starters.
- Full All-Star rosters will be announced on 7/4.
- The 2026 Midsummer Classic will be held on 7/14 in **Philadelphia**.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision in the 6-5 loss on Sat, 6/6 at StL (5.0ip, 9h, 4r/4er, 1bb, 3k, 1hr, 95TP).

- Was in line for his third win but was the victim of Sam Moll's blown save (2-run go-ahead HR in the 8th, Lars Nootbar).
- Threw 28 of his 95 pitches in the 2nd inning (7 batters faced, 5h, 3r/3er).
- Allowed a season-high 9 hits, 53 swings (7 misses) and 21 pitches in play.
- 10 of his 25 batters reached.

MAY 31 vs ATL: Earned the 6-4 win vs Atl on Sun, 5/31 (6.2ip, 5h, 3r/3er, 4bb, 4k, 2hr, 100TP).

- Was his longest start of the season and his longest since throwing a 9-inning shutout on 7/23/25 at Wsh.
- Was his second consecutive quality start, the 33rd of his career.
- Reached the 100-pitch mark for the first time since that 7/23/25 CG at Wsh (105TP).
- Threw 41 pitches combined in the 5th and 6th innings.
- Allowed 2 of his 13 batters to reach when ahead in the count....overall allowed 9 of his 28 batters to reach.
- Faced 3 batters in the 7th inning (2 flyouts and a walk) before turning it over to Brock Burke.

MAY 25 at NYM: Earned the 7-2 win at NYM on Mon, 5/25 (6.0ip, 6h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 7k, 1hr, 2hb, 98TP).

- Was his 32nd career quality start, his first this season and his first since 9/25/25 vs Pit.
- Was his first outing in which he didn't walk a batter since 9/14/25 at Ath (5.1ip).
- 8 of his 25 batters reached.
- Was his first outing in which he hit 2 or more batters since 5/3/25 vs Wsh (2hb).
- Held the Mets scoreless until Marcus Semien led off the bottom of the 6th with a home run...retired the next 3 batters before he was relieved by Brock Burke.

LAST TIME OUT: Was activated from the 15-day injured list on Sun, 6/7 and made that day's start at StL....did not factor in the 5-3 loss (3.0ip, 1h, 0r, 5bb, 4k, 70TP).

- Issued a career high 5 walks...became the seventh pitcher in the majors this season to walk 5 batters in a scoreless appearance...was the first Reds pitcher to do it since Luis Castillo on 5/10/19 at SF.
- Threw 30 pitches in the 1st inning, 20 pitches in the 2nd, and 20 pitches in the 3rd.
- Allowed 7 of his 16 batters to reach.

INJURED LIST: Was placed on the 15-day injured list with right shoulder pain on 5/10...the Reds went 10-13 in his absence.

- Made 1 appearance while on a rehabilitation assignment at AAA-Louisville (6/2 at Memphis)...allowed 3 runs (3er) on 6 hits over 5.0 innings for the Bats (0bb, 8k, 0hr, 70TP).
