AT A GLANCE: The Yankees begin a seven-game homestand tonight with the first game of a four-game set vs. Toronto (through Thurs.)...will also face Tampa Bay in a three-game set this weekend (Fri.-Sun.)...went 2-7 on their recent nine-game road trip after being swept by Milwaukee in a three-game series and dropping two-of-three games at Baltimore and at the Mets.

- **Their 28-19 (.596) record is the second-best in the American League and the sixth-best record in the Majors.**
- Have lost seven of their last nine games (since 5/8) and eight of their last 11 games (since 5/6) after winning 15 of their previous 17 games from 4/17-5/5...**are still 18-10 in their last 28 games (since 4/17), 19-11 in their last 30 games (since 4/15) and 20-12 in their last 32 games (since 4/13).**
- Have lost each of their last three series (since 5/8) after winning or splitting their previous seven series (6-0-1)... have still won or split 10 of their 15 series this season (9-5-1).
- The Yankees'+68 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the third-best in the Majors.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees fell to the Mets in a 7-6 "walk-off" loss in 10 innings on Sunday at Citi Field...**RHP Elmer Rodriguez** (4.1IP, 5H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 1K, OHR) started and did not record a decision...**1B Ben Rice** (1-for-5, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI) hit his 15th home run of the year with a go-ahead solo shot in the third inning...**SS Anthony Volpe** (2-for-3, 1R, 3RBI, 2BB) reached base a career-high-tying four times, including a go-ahead two-run single in the sixth inning and a bases-loaded walk in the seventh inning...**LF/RF Cody Bellinger** (1-for-2, 2R, 3BB) reached base a season-high-tying four times...**PH Amed Rosario** (0-for-0, 1RBI, 1SF) hit a pinch-hit sac fly in the sixth inning...**RHP David Bednar** (1.0IP, 3H, 3R/ER, 1BB, 1K, 1HR) allowed a game-tying three-run HR to Tyrone Taylor in the ninth inning.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice hit his 15th home run of the year with a go-ahead solo shot in the third inning on Sunday at the Mets...**has hit 2HR in his last three games (since 5/15), 3HR in his last six games (since 5/11), 5HR in his last 12 games (since 5/1), 7HR in his last 18 games (since 4/24) and 11HR in his last 25 games (since 4/16).**

- Six of his 15HR this year have given the Yankees the lead, including three of his last 4HR and four of his last 6HR.
- Has hit .301/.406/.671 (44-for-146) with 35R, 9 doubles, 15HR, 31RBI, 25BB/21BB, 2HP, 2SF and 25B in 42 games this season... has reached base safely in 32-of-38 starts.
- 24 of his 44H this season have been XBH (9 doubles, 15HR).

DYNAMIC DUO: OF Aaron Judge (16HR) and C/INF Ben Rice (15HR) are only the third pair of Yankees teammates in franchise history to each hit at least 15HR in the club's first 47 games of a season, joining Roger Maris (15HR) and Mickey Mantle (15HR) in 1961 and Yogi Berra (15HR) and Mantle (21HR) in 1956...are only the second pair of Major League teammates in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) to accomplish the feat, joining Boston's Mookie Betts (15HR) and J.D. Martinez (15HR) in 2018.

HIGH VOLTAGE: INF Anthony Volpe reached base a career-high-tying four times on Sunday at the Mets, including a go-ahead two-run single in the sixth inning and a bases-loaded walk in the seventh inning...has reached base in 9-of-16 PA over his first four games (2H, 7BB), posting a .563 OBP.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Yankees have gone 9-1 in their last 10 home games (since 4/17)...have gone 14-6 (.700) at home this season, the third-best home record in the Majors this season... trail only Chicago-NL (18-5, .783) and Tampa Bay (16-5, .762).

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a 3.10 ERA (255.1IP, 88ER) and 256K in 47 starts this season...marks the third-best ERA in the Majors, trailing only Atlanta (2.88) and Tampa Bay (2.94)...have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 25 of their last 28 starts (since 4/17), including 2ER-or-fewer in 21 of those starts and 1ER-or-fewer in 14 starts...have posted a 2.90 ERA (152.0IP, 49ER) over that span.

- **Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 40 of their 47 starts this season, tied with Milwaukee for the most starts in the Majors...also marks their second-most in franchise history through their first 47 games of a season,** trailing only their 43 starts in 2022.
- **Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.317), opponents' OPS (.597) and HR/9.0IP (.74),** rank second in opponents' BA (.208, first in AL), third in ERA (3.10, second in AL), opponents' OBP (.281, second in AL) and WHIP (1.09, second in AL), fourth in strikeout rate (24.7%, second in AL), sixth in strikeouts (256, fourth in AL) and K/9.0IP (9.02, third in AL), seventh in innings pitched (255.1, fourth in AL) and K/BB (3.01, third in AL), and 10th in BB/9.0IP (3.00, sixth in AL).

ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge has reached base in 38 of his last 41 games (since 4/3), batting .290/.434/.634 (42-for-145) with 36R, 8 doubles, 14HR, 27RBI, 35BB/51BB, 2HP and 5SB over that span.

- Has reached base multiple times in nine of his last 16 games (since 5/1) and 16 of his last 25 games (since 4/21).
- 24 of his 45H this season have been extra-base hits (8 doubles, 16HR).
- Has hit .333/.538/.778 (9-for-27) with 4HR, 15RBI, 11BB/51BB and 1HP with RISP this season.
- His 41HR vs. the Blue Jays are the most by a Yankee against Toronto in franchise history...also marks the second-most HR by any player vs. a single opponent since 2017, trailing only his own 53HR vs. Baltimore...has hit 6HR in his last 17 games (since 6/30/24) against Toronto and 13HR in his last 35 games vs. Toronto (since 5/15/23).

SUPER ROSARIO: INF/OF Amed Rosario hit a pinch-hit sac fly in the sixth inning on Sunday at the Mets...has hit .318/.333/.727 (7-for-22) with 3HR, 14RBI, 2BB and 3SF with RISP this year.

- Over his last 11 games as a starter (since 4/18), has batted .297 (11-for-37) with 8R, 2 doubles, 2HR, 9RBI, 4BB and 1SF... has hit safely in each of his last eight starts (since 4/22).
- Since 2025, has hit .288/.321/.494 (45-for-156) with 12 doubles, 1 triple, 6HR, 9BB and 3SF vs. left-handed pitchers.

TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT: The Yankees are 10-5 when facing a left-handed starter this season...have won eight of their last nine games when facing a left-handed starter (since 4/18) and nine of their last 12 games (since 4/13).

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt has hit .366/.447/.683 (15-for-41) with 9R, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 3HR, 8RBI, 4BB and 2HP over his last 13 games (since 4/26).

- Has hit .625/.769/1.125 (5-for-8) with 1 double, 1HR, 8RBI, 3BB and 2HP with RISP this season...as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .333/.424/.444 (39-for-117) with 7 doubles, 2HR, 42RBI, 17BB/51BB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.
- As a Yankee (since 2025), has batted .324/.413/.584 (60-for-185) with 16 doubles, 1 triple, 10HR, 23BB and 5HP vs. left-handed pitchers.
- Has hit .429/.529/.786 (6-for-14) with 2 doubles, 1HR and 3BB in his career vs. Toronto's LHP Patrick Corbin.

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger reached base a season-high-tying four times...has reached base at least three times in 12 games this season, tied for the seventh-most in the Majors.

- **Has hit safely in each of his last 13 home games (since 4/13), batting .458/.542/.958 (22-for-48) with 12R, 8 doubles, 2 triples, 4HR, 18RBI, 10BB, 1SB and 1SF over that span...** has hit safely in 17-of-19 home games this year, batting .377/.477/.783 (26-for-69) with 16R, 9 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 22RBI, 15BB, 2SF and 1SB.
- Has hit .350/.420/.550 (14-for-40) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 2ORBI, 7BB and 3SF with RISP this season.
- Has hit .417/.481/.458 (10-for-24) with 1 double and 3BB in his career vs. Toronto's LHP Patrick Corbin.
- As a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .329/.398/.575 (68-for-207) with 15 doubles, 3 triples, 10HR, 27BB, 1HP and 5SF against left-handed pitching.
- According to FanGraphs and Sports Info Solutions, leads all Major League LF in DRS (nine)...is tied for fourth in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (nine, tied for second in AL).

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. reached base a season-high-tying four times and recorded his third straight multi-hit game on Sunday at the Mets...his three-game multi-hit streak is tied for the third-longest of his career, trailing only a four-game streak from 8/31-9/3/24 and 6/8-11/21 (also 3G from 9/11-13/25 and 5/11-13/24).

- **Is batting .533/.611/.733 (8-for-15) with 3R, 3 doubles, 2RBI, 3BB and 1SB over his last four games (since 5/13).**
- Has recorded a hit in 12 of his last 15 starts (since 5/1).
- His 12SB are tied for the fifth-most in the AL and tied for the eighth-most in the Majors this year.

WALK IT OUT: Yankees batters walked nine times on Sunday at the Mets...marked the Yankees' sixth game this season with at least 9BB...no other team has more than three...marks their most such games in a single season since 2021 (seven games).

- Have walked an AL-best 216 times this season, their most walks through their first 47 games of a season in the last 22 seasons (since 2005) and most since recording 216BB in 2004.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP RYAN WEATHERS (2-2, 3.00 ERA)

LHP Ryan Weathers will make his ninth start of the season in tonight's series opener vs. Toronto...the 26 year-old will make the start on extended six days' rest...made his last start on 5/11 at Baltimore and did not record a decision despite allowing just 2R/ER over 6.1IP (1H, 3BB, 9K, 0HR)...did not allow a hit to his first 20BF before surrendering a single to Adley Rustchman to lead off the seventh inning...also tied his career high with 101 pitches (also 4/9/26 vs. ATH)...has gone 2-2 with a 3.00 ERA (45.0IP, 37H, 17R/15ER, 13BB, 54K, 6HR) in eight starts this season...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in seven of his eight starts, including 1R-or-fewer in three starts...has recorded at least 7K in five of his starts...**in his last six starts (since 4/9), has gone 2-2 with a 2.68 ERA (37.0IP, 11ER) and 43K**...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in five starts over that span...went 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (38.1IP, 37H, 20R/17ER, 12BB, 37K, 7HR) in eight starts with the Miami Marlins in 2025...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in six of his eight starts and 1ER-or-fewer in four of his starts...missed the majority of the season due to two injured list stints (3/24-5/14, 6/9-9/11)...over the last three seasons (2024-26), has gone 9-10 with a 3.55 ERA (170.0IP, 152H, 76R/67ER, 49BB, 171K, 24HR) in 32 starts...during that stretch, has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 26 of those 32 starts...since 2021, his 18 pickoffs are fourth-most in the Majors...has pitched in over parts of six Major League seasons with the San Diego Padres (2021-23), Miami Marlins (2023-25) and the Yankees (2026)...has made four career Opening Day rosters (2021 and '23 with San Diego, '24 with Miami and '26 with the Yankees)...began the 2025 season on the injured list...is the son of David Weathers, who pitched in parts of 19 seasons in the Majors (1991-2009), including two seasons with the Yankees from 1996-97, where he won the World Series with the club in '96...became the fifth father/son duo in Yankees history to both play for the club, joining Clay Bellinger and Cody Bellinger, Mark Leiter and Mark Leiter Jr., Ron Davis and Ike Davis, and Yogi Berra and Dale Berra...was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the first round (seventh overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...was acquired by Miami from San Diego in exchange for INF Garrett Cooper, RHP Sean Reynolds and cash considerations on 8/1/23...was acquired by the Yankees from Miami in exchange for OF Dillon Lewis, OF Brendan Jones, INF Dylan Jasso and INF Juan Matheus on 1/13/26.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his eighth start of the season on 5/11 at Baltimore and did not record a decision despite allowing just 2R/ER over 6.1IP (1H, 3BB, 9K, 0HR)...did not allow a hit to his first 20BF before surrendering a single to Adley Rustchman to lead off the seventh inning...also tied his career high with 101 pitches (also 4/9/26 vs. ATH)

- Became the first Yankees left-hander to not allow a hit through their first 20BF in a game since Nestor Cortes did not allow a hit to his first 26BF on 5/9/22 vs. Texas.
- His 1H allowed marked his fewest in a start since 5/27/21 at Milwaukee with San Diego (also 1H).

HOME SWEET HOME: In five starts at Yankee Stadium this season, has gone 2-2 with a 3.10 ERA (29.0IP, 26H, 12R/10ER, 8BB, 34K, 5HR)...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in four of his five starts.

- Made his first start at Yankee Stadium with the Yankees on 4/4 vs. Miami, allowing 3R/ER over 3.2IP without recording a decision (6H, 3BB, 4K, 0HR).
- Made three starts at home with the Marlins in 2025, going 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA (16.0IP, 15H, 5R/ER, 3BB, 15K, 2HR)...tossed at least 5.0 innings in all three starts...allowed 1R-or-fewer in two of his three starts.
- **Over the last two seasons (2025-26), has gone 3-3 with a 3.00 ERA (45.0IP, 41H, 17R/15ER, 11BB, 49K, 7HR) in eight home starts.**

2026: Is 2-2 with a 3.00 ERA (45.0IP, 37H, 17R/15ER, 13BB, 54K, 6HR) in eight starts this season...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in seven of his eight starts, including 1R-or-fewer in three starts...has recorded at least 7K in five of his starts.

- Among Major League starters this season, ranks 10th in strikeout rate (29.8%, fourth in AL)...also ranks fifth in K/9.0IP (10.80) among AL starters.
- **In his last six starts (since 4/9), has gone 2-2 with a 2.68 ERA (37.0IP, 11ER) and 43K**...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in five starts and 1ER-or-fewer in three starts over that span.
- Has recorded at least 7K in four of his last six starts (since 4/9).
- Is holding opponents to a .222/.278/.365 (37-for-167) slash line this season.
- Has received 2R-or-fewer of run support in six of his eight starts this season, including 0R of support in his first four starts (3/30-4/14), recording a 3.40 run support average this year.
- Has allowed one-or-zero HR in seven of his eight starts, including five starts without allowing a HR.
- Made his Yankees debut on 3/30 at Seattle, allowing only 1R/ER over 4.1IP without recording a decision (4H, 2BB, 7K, 0HR).
- Made his third start of the season on 4/9 vs. the Athletics, suffering his first loss of the year despite allowing 1R/ER in 8.0IP (7H, 1R/ER, 0BB, 7K, 0HR, 1WP)...set a career high with 101 pitches and tied his career high with 8.0IP (also 5/14/24 at Detroit with Miami)...became the first Yankee to toss at least 8.0 innings and not allow a walk in a regular season game since Clarke Schmidt on 5/16/24 at Minnesota (8.0IP).
- Made his fourth start of the season on 4/14 vs. Los Angeles-AL, taking the loss after allowing 5R/ER in 5.0IP (5H, 2BB, 10K, 4HR, 1WP)...recorded his third career double-digit strikeout game (also a career-high 11K on 6/1/24 vs. Texas with Miami and 10K on 4/16/24 vs. San Francisco with Miami)...marked the first double-digit strikeout game by a Yankee since Max Fried recorded 13K on 9/18/25 at Baltimore.
- Earned his first win as a Yankee after tossing 7.1 scoreless innings on 4/19 vs. Kansas City (5H, 1BB, 8K)...recorded his first scoreless start of the season and first scoreless start since 9/11/25 vs. Washington with Miami (5.0IP)...also marked the second-longest scoreless start of his career, trailing only his career-high-tying 8.0 scoreless innings on 5/14/24 at Detroit with Miami.

VS. TORONTO: Will make his second career start vs. the Blue Jays tonight...made his first career start on 9/29/24 at Toronto with Miami, earning the win after allowing just 1R/ER over 6.1IP (3H, 2BB, 6K, 0HR).

2025: Went 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (38.1IP, 37H, 20R/17ER, 12BB, 37K, 7HR) in eight starts with the Marlins...missed the majority of the season due to two injured list stints (3/24-5/14, 6/9-9/11)...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in six of his eight starts and 1ER-or-fewer in four of his starts.

- Missed the first 41 games of the season on the injured list...was placed on the 15-day I.L. on 3/27 (retroactive to 3/24) with a left flexor muscle strain...combined to make three rehab starts with Single-A Jupiter and Triple-A Jacksonville, going 1-1 with a 1.69 ERA (10.2IP, 4H, 2R/ER, 4BB, 13K, 0HR)...was reinstated from the I.L. on 5/14.
- Made his season debut on 5/14 at Chicago-NL and earned the win (5.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 5K, 1HR).
- Went 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA (15.1IP, 2ER) and 15K over his first three starts (5/14-26).

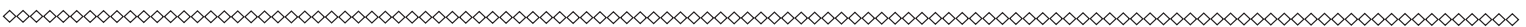
