NATIONALS NEWS

SWEEP DREAMS
The Washington Nationals wrap up a six-game road trip with the last of a three-game series with the Cincinnati Reds at Great American Ballpark today...The Nationals erased a five-run, first-inning deficit last night to defeat the Reds, 8-7, in 10 innings.

- **Daylen Life** homered in the 10th inning, his third home run in the last three games, to give the Nationals their first lead, one they would not relinquish...**Mitchell Parker** (3.0 IP), **Richard Lovelady** (1.0 IP), **Orlando Ribalta** (1.0 IP) and **Gus Varland** (Win, 1.0 IP) all offered scoreless relief and **PJ Poulin** collected his second save of the year.
- The Nationals have won five of seven, six of nine and 10 of 16 games since April 25... They have also won four of their last six series overall and six of the first eight series on the road this year.
- Today will be the third of 16 straight games for the Nationals without an off day...Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28.
- Following today's game, the Nationals will return home for a three-game series with the Baltimore Orioles, during Major League Baseball's Rivalry Weekend, followed by a four-game set with the New York Mets.

THE BLUEGRASS BOMBER

Daylen Life has hits in six straight games: 10-for-23 (.435), two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, a hit by pitch and three runs scored...He has also recorded multi-hit efforts in three straight.

- Playing in front of friends and family in the Major League stadium closest to where he grew up in Louisville, KY, Life has homered three times in two games in Cincinnati...Life recorded his first career multi-home run game (2 HR) against the Reds on Tuesday...He followed it with his second career go-ahead home run in extra innings on Wednesday night to cement the Nationals victory.

GREAT AMERICAN NATIONALS

Since the Nationals began playing at Great American Ball Park in 2005, Washington has homered 110 times in 69 games, including five five-home games as a team...Tuesday night's six-homer effort by the offense was just the 12th in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

- The Nationals average 1.59 home runs per game at Great American Ball Park, the highest average of any team that has played more than 20 games in the stadium...It is the highest average home runs per game of any stadium the Nationals play in on a yearly basis...The Nationals average 1.64 home runs at T-Mobile Park in Seattle (23 HR in 14 games).
- A Nationals hitter has recorded a multi-home run game 197 times since 2005...14 of those have come at Great American Ball Park...Only Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia (15) has seen more multi-homer efforts from a Nationals player...The Nationals have played 68 games at Great American Ball Park...They have played 184 at Citizens Bank Park.

ROAD SWEET ROAD

The Nationals come into today's game with a 15-9 record on the road, tied for the second-highest win total away from home in Major League Baseball, trailing only the Atlanta Braves (16 wins)...Washington has taken at least a share of five of the last six series away from home.

- The Nationals rank second in MLB with 135 runs scored on the road.

OUT OF THIS WORLD

CJ Abrams is 19-for-55 (.345) with five doubles, a triple, two homers, 15 RBI, six walks, two stolen bases and 10 runs scored over his last 14 games...He's reached safely in 11 of the 14 (.410 OBP) and has hits in 10 of the 14.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (3rd, 36), OPS (4th, .930), wRC+ (5th, .404), wOBA (6th, .160), on-base percentage (5th, .391) and slugging (8th, .539).

GOOD WOOD

James Wood leads Major League Baseball with an average exit velocity of 96.3 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (95.9).

- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 52 batted balls over 100 MPH rank tied for second in Major League Baseball.

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank second in Major League Baseball (2nd in NL) with 235 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 39 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 86 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 26 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.
- **Luis Garcia Jr.** is 9-for-17 (.529) with a double, triple, two home runs, six RBI and four runs scored over his last four games.

SO GOOD THIS NOTE BARELY FITZ

Wilmington infielder **Devin Fitz-Gerald** hit a grand slam last night, his third home run in the last two nights and sixth in his last seven games...Over his last seven games, Fitz-Gerald is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with a double, a triple, six home runs, 12 RBI, four walks (.471 OBP) and nine runs scored...He leads the Nationals organizations in home runs (9), RBI (28), slugging (.656), OPS (1.099), extra-base hits (20), triples (3) and runs scored (35).

LAST START

Posted a career high in strikeouts and matched a career high in innings pitched with nine punchouts over 7.0 innings against the Miami Marlins at loanDepot park...He surrendered just one earned run on four hits to earn his fourth win of the season.

DIFFERENT PLACES, SAME GUY

Griffin has a 2.12 ERA (7 ER/29.2 IP) in five games on the road and a 2.12 ERA in three games at home (4 ER/17.0 IP) this season.

- Griffin has set new career highs in strikeouts in each of his last two road starts (8 at CWS, 4/26 and 9 at MIA, 5/8).
- Griffin has allowed just one earned run (two total) in his last two road starts, pitching to an 0.64 ERA.

HARD TO HIT

Foster Griffin ranks second in Major League Baseball with a .129 opponents' average (9-for-70), a .186 opponents' slugging percentage and third with a 0.45 ERA (1 ER/20.0 IP) in three starts since April 26.

WINNING WAYS

Griffin won three of his first five starts without taking a loss, becoming just the third pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to win at least three of his first five starts with Washington without suffering a loss...He joins **Luis Atilano** (3-0 in 2010) and **Micah Bowie** (3-0 in 2007).

LUCKY 7

Griffin has the ability to throw seven pitches, including: cutter (31.0%), four seamer (15.5%), sweeper (13.8%), changeup (11.7%), curveball (8.6%), split finger (7.3%) and sinker (12%).

NPB Central League All-Star in 2025...Went 6-1 with a 1.52 ERA, 87 strikeouts, 22 walks and just one home run allowed in 89.0 innings across 17 starts.
