TODAY’S START—Freddy Peralta is slated to make his ninth start as a Ray and fourth at Tropicana Field today, his 31st start of the season and the 193rd (242nd outing) of his career...marks his fourth straight season with 30 starts or more, joining CHC/TOR **Kevin Gausman** as the only arms to do so since the start of 2023...was acquired from the Mets on Aug. 2 in exchange for minor leaguers **RHP Gary Gill Hill**, **INF Emilien Pitre**, and **OF Aidan Smith**...was traded to the Mets from the Brewers on Jan. 21, 2026.

- ✦ His career .201 (281-for-1,559) opp. average following the All-Star break ranks second among active MLB starters (min. 1,500AB) behind **LAD Blake Snell** (.191/397-for-2,347).
- ✦ Has won four straight starts (Aug. 26–pres.), his longest winning streak of the season and his longest winning streak since going 7-0 between June 13–July 19, 2025 with the Brewers.
- ✦ In 42 career appearances (25 starts) in September, Peralta is 12-8 with a 2.97 ERA (145.1IP, 53ER), 188 strikeouts, and a .205 (111-for-591) opp. average.
- ✦ Since the start of 2023, Peralta’s 760 strikeouts are the fifth most in the majors, trailing **TOR Dylan Cease** (892), **PHI Zack Wheeler** (808), **SEA Logan Gilbert** (776), and **CHC Kevin Gausman** (765)...his 124 starts in that span are tied with Gausman for second most in the majors behind Cease (127).

LAST TIME OUT—Earned his fourth straight win on Sept. 13 vs. HOU after turning in 5.0 hitless innings (W, 5.0IP, OER, 3BB, 4SO)...retired his first six batters before issuing walks to **Christian Walker**, **Cam Smith**, and **Yordan Alvarez** in the 3rd inning...set down his final seven batters faced before handing the ball over to the bullpen to begin the 6th inning.

- ✦ Across his last five starts (Aug. 21–pres.), Peralta is 4-1 with a 2.10 ERA (30.0IP, 7ER), 23 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP, and a .163 (17-for-104) opp. average...ranks first among AL qualifiers during that span in WHIP, and third among MLB arms behind **MIL Logan Henderson** (0.70) and **PHI Jesús Luzardo** (0.71).

BAHSTON TO THE BAY—The veteran right-hander will make his third career start against the Red Sox today...is 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA (15.0IP, 9ER), 16 strikeouts, a 1.60 WHIP, and a .246 (14-for-57) opp. average in those outings...Boston is one of four clubs Peralta has yet to earn a win against in his career alongside Milwaukee (0-1), New York-AL (0-1), and Philadelphia (0-3).

- ✦ In 15 career appearances (15 starts) against AL East foes, he has fashioned a 5-7 record with a 3.60 ERA (80.0IP, 32ER) and 86 strikeouts...in five starts against the division this season, Peralta is 0-4 with a 4.68 ERA (25.0IP, 13ER) and 22 strikeouts.
- ✦ Has gone 20-14 with a 3.17 ERA (275.2IP, 94ER), 325 strikeouts, and a .200 (189-for-1,126) opp. AVG in 58 career appearances (27 starts) against AL opponents...this season, he is 4-5 with a 3.00 ERA (60.0IP, 20ER) and a .209 (45-for-248) opp. average across 11 starts against the AL.

SOMETHING IN THE ORANGE—Peralta has made three starts at Tropicana Field this season, going 2-1 with a 1.72 ERA (15.2IP, 3ER), a 0.64 WHIP, and an .080 (4-for-50) opp. average in those outings...in 16 home starts with the Mets and the Rays, he is 5-5 with a 3.66 ERA (83.2IP, 34ER), a 1.27 WHIP, and a .219 (69-for-315) opp. average...across 128 career home appearances (100 starts), he is 45-24 with a 3.26 ERA (582.1IP, 211ER), 706 strikeouts, and a .194 (411-for-2,120) opp. average...his teams are 81-47 lifetime in his home appearances.

- ✦ His career .194 opp. average at home ranks third among active major league pitchers (min. 2,000BF) since 2018 behind **TEX Jacob deGrom** (.178) and **LAD Blake Snell** (.192)...it is the fourth-lowest mark under the same parameters in the divisional era (since 1969).
- ✦ In four career appearances (all starts) at Tropicana Field, Peralta has pitched to a 3-1 record with a 1.66 ERA (21.2IP, 6ER) and .125 (9-for-83) opp. average.
- ✦ When pitching in dome or closed retractable roofs during his career, Peralta has an 8-4 (.667) record with a 3.62 ERA (92.0IP, 37ER) across 18 outings (16 starts)...his .667 winning percentage in such games is tied for the ninth-highest mark among active pitchers (min. 10GS).

LET’S CHANGE IT UP—Since Peralta was acquired by the Rays on Aug. 2, he has thrown his changeup at a 30.2 (204-for-676) pct. rate across eight starts, a 9.4 pct. increase in usage from his 20.8 (436-for-2,093) pct. rate in 22 starts with New York-NL...his whiff rate on changeups with the Rays has improved to a 30.4 pct. clip, 2.3 pct. higher than Mets (28.1%).

- ✦ As a Ray, he has fashioned a .106 (5-for-47) opp. average on changeups compared to a .280 (30-for-107) mark with the Mets...since Aug. 2, Peralta’s .106 opp. batting average on the pitch is the lowest mark on changeups by any pitcher in the majors (min. 40BF), ahead of **PHI Andrew Painter’s** .120 (6-for-50) clip.
- ✦ Since being traded to the Rays, he has thrown 60 changeups to right-handed batters across eight starts and has not allowed a hit (0-for-8)...in 22 starts with the Mets, he threw 119 same-sided changeups and posted a .304 (7-for-23) opp. batting average on those pitches...with the Rays, he has thrown the changeup 29.4 (60-for-204) pct. of the time to righties compared to 27.3 (119-for-436) pct. of the time as a member of the Mets.

LEFTY LOOSY—Since his debut in 2018, Peralta has held left-handed batters to a .210 (437-for-2,364) batting average, the third-best mark in the majors during that span (min. 2,000BF) behind **NY Y Gerrit Cole** (.193) and **DET Justin Verlander** (.198)...in 2021, Peralta held lefties to a .157 (43-274) batting average, the third-best mark in a single season by a right-handed pitcher (min. 300 LHB faced) in the expansion era (since 1961)...in 2025 with the Brewers, left-handed batters hit .204 (66-323) off of Peralta, the fourth-lowest mark among right-handers in the NL and the 11th-lowest mark in the majors (min. 300 LHB faced).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING—Peralta boasts a lifetime 16-12 record with a 3.36 ERA (252.0IP, 94ER), a 1.18 WHIP, a .211 (196-for-1,052) opp. average, and 294 strikeouts across 56 outings (46 starts) after his teams have gone down 0-1 in three-game series...in nine such starts this season, he is 2-5 with a 3.38 ERA (48.0IP, 18ER) and a .231 (42-for-210) opp. batting average...since entering the majors in 2018, Peralta’s 294 strikeouts in such games are the 12th most in the majors during that span.

★	Notched his second career multi-homer game on Sun. vs. HOU (also: April 24, 2026 vs. MIN)...he is the 11th Mexican-born player to have multiple multi-homerun games in a season, and the first since TOR Alejandro Kirk and HOU Isaac Paredes (both 2) in 2025.					
★	In May, he led the majors in average (.374/34-for-91) and on-base pct. (.464)...he also ranked highly in OPS (2nd, 1.025) and hits (T2nd)...was the first Ray to lead MLB in average over a month since Diaz in June 2024 (.400)...his 43 RBI were second most in team history through May (Evan Longoria - 2019, 55RBI).

★	He has an RBI in 16 of his last 28 games (Aug. 19–pres.) and 21 of his last 36 (Aug. 10–pres.)...has five home runs in his last 18 games after a career-high-tying 15-game drought (Aug. 12–28) without a long ball.					
★	Through 153 team games, Caminero is on pace to finish the season with 43 homers and 103 RBI...he would become the 15th player in the modern era (since 1900) to have triple-digit RBI in multiple age-22-or-younger seasons, the first since FLA Miguel Cabrera (2004-05)...he has started every game this season and could join Evan Longoria (2014) and Aubrey Huff (2003) as the only Rays to appear in each of the club's games during a single season.
