THE LATEST:

- The Blue Jays took the loss in the opener of their three-game set against the Braves at Truist Park last night, by a 3-1 final score...Moved to 67-75 overall this season, 33-40 on the road, 2-6 against NL East opponents, and 20-26 in series openers.
- Toronto has still won nine of its last 18 games, and has gone 12-11 over the last 23, and 20-19 over the last 39 contests...Needs a win tonight to avoid dropping to 7-13-4 in series played on the road, 16-24-6 in series play overall, and 15-21 in interleague contests.

ON A GUERRE-ROLL:

- Vladimir Guerrero Jr. brought home the Blue Jays lone run of last night's contest with an RBI groundout in the 3rd inning...Later singled in the 6th inning, finishing the night 1-for-4.
- *Since the All-Star break, the Montreal, QC, native is batting .415 (68-for-164) with 19 doubles, a triple, 14 home runs, 36 RBI, a .799 SLG, and a 1.283 OPS... Over that span, leads the Majors in hits, doubles, AVG, SLG, OPS, extra-base hits (34), and total bases (131), while also ranking 2nd in OBP (.484), T-6th in RBI, and T-6th in home runs...Leads the Majors in hard-hit balls (258) this season, 15 more than any other player (Shohei Ohtani 243), while his career-best 56.7% hard-hit rate sits 3rd in MLB.

NATE THE GREAT:

Nathan Lukes made his fourth start of the season in last night's contest, singling in the 3rd inning and later coming around to score the Blue Jays lone run of the game, before singling again in the 9th...Finished the night 2-for-4 with a run scored, his second career multi-hit game...In his nine career MLB starts, is batting .333 (10-for-30) with a double, two triples, two RBI, five walks, a .500 SLG, and a .929 OPS...In 58 games between the Majors and Triple-A Buffalo this season, is batting .342 (76-for-222) with eight doubles, a triple, seven home runs, 33 RBI, a 15.7% strikeout rate, a 10% walk rate, a .414 OBP, an .896 OPS, a .391 wOBA, and a 17% barrel rate.

HE'S THE GAUS-MAN:

★Kevin Gausman made his 28th start of the season, 14th on the road, taking the loss in last night's contest...The right hander threw 6.0 innings allowing three runs on six hits and three walks with five strikeouts...Marked his 14th quality start of the season...Over his last 11 starts, has gone 6-4 while posting a 3.25 ERA (26 ER/72.0 IP) with 59 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .210 opponent batting average...In his 14 starts on the road this season, has gone 7-5 with a 2.67 ERA (24 ER/81.0 IP), 73 strikeouts, a 1.15 WHIP, and a .228 opponent batting average.

CAPTAIN ON THE BRIDGE:

*Alejandro Kirk made his 76th start behind the plate in last night's contest, throwing out his 22nd runner of the season, after catching Michael Harris II attempting to steal second base in the 1st inning...Also singled in the 6th, finishing 1-for-4...Since July 27th, has played 31 games (29 starts), batting .284 (31-for-109) with six doubles, three homers, and 19 RBI for a .772 OPS.

INTERTAINMENT VALUE:

- ◆Toronto is playing its 13th interleague series of the year (15-20 so far)...Since the beginning of the 2021 season, the Blue Jays have gone 72-49 in interleague games (.595%), the 4th-best winning percentage in the Majors over that span.
- The Blue Jays have hit 727 home runs all-time in Interleague Play, trailing only the Yankees (734) for the most among all 30 teams in the Majors.

GEORGIA ON MY MIND:

- The Blue Jays are on the road for a quick three-game, weekend trip to Atlanta, before returning home for a six-game homestand on Monday (3G vs. NYM, 3G vs. STL)...Have gone 33-40 away from Rogers Centre this year (.452%), ranking 10th in the AL in road winning percentage.
- Blue Jays hitters rank 5th among AL clubs in road OBP (.312) this year, while sitting 8th in road OPS (.696), 8th in road AVG (.236), and 9th in road SLG (.384)... The pitching staff currently ranks 9th in the AL in road ERA (4.16), 11th in road opponent average (.243), and 12th in road WHIP (1.31).

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

▶Toronto hitters rank 3rd among AL clubs in doubles (253) this season...The Blue Jays also sit 4th in the AL in walks (446), 4th in fewest strikeouts (1,075), 6th in extra-base hits (419), 6th in OBP (.313), 7th in AVG (.241), 7th in OPS (.708), 8th in hits (1,141), 8th in pitches/PA (3.87), and 9th in SLG (.395).

THE D-JAYS:

- Entering play on Saturday, the Blue Jays lead all Major League teams in Defensive Runs Saved (91), while sitting 5th in Outs Above Average (22)...The Blue Jays have also turned 108 double plays this year, 7th most in the Al
- Daulton Varsho has tallied an MLB-leading 27 Defensive Runs Saved this year, six more than any other player (12 in LF, 15 in CF)...Also sits T-7th in Outs Above Average (15).
- Ernie Clement has recorded 16 DRS this season, 7th most in the Majors...Of those 16 runs saved, 11 have been at the hot corner, 2nd most among MLB third basemen.
- Alejandro Kirk has registered 12 DRS this year...Has thrown out a career-high 22 attempted basestealers, the most by a Blue Jays backstop since Russell Martin (25 in 2015), and trail only Cal Raleigh (24) for the most in MLB this year...Ranks T-4th in MLB in catcher framing runs (9), 5th in strike rate (50.6%), 3rd in SLAA (106.36), and 4th in SL+ (106.1).

- The Blue Jays won all three meetings with the Braves at Rogers Centre last season, outscoring their opponents by a combined score of 14-7...Have won nine of their last ten games vs. Atlanta, including sweeping a three-game set at Truist Park from May 11-13, 2021.
- ◆George Springer has hit safely in 13 of his 14 career games against Atlanta, batting .351 (20-for-57) with two doubles, six homers, and 11 RBI for a .702 SLG and a 1.114 OPS...His only two previous games at Truist Park came on July 4 & 5, 2017 as a member of the Astros, going 7-for-10 (.700) with two extra-base hits and three RBI (1.827 OPS)...His first two home runs in a Blue Jays uniform came on May 1, 2021 vs. ATL at TD Ballbark in Dunedin. FL.
- ◆Vladimir Guerrero Jr. hit safely in all three games against the Braves last season, going 4-for-11 (.364) with a pair of doubles and a trio of RBI (.930 OPS)... Over 16 career games vs. ATL, has batted .300 (18for-60) with six extra-base hits and 11 RBI (.819 OPS).
- Alejandro Kirk recorded his first career multi-home run game against the Braves on April 30, 2021 at TD Ballpark, taking both Drew Smyly and Edgar Santana deep for two-run shots in the 4th and 5th innings, respectively...In his five career games against the Braves, has posted an .894 OPS with a pair of home runs, four RBI, and a .600 SLG...This is his first career trip to Truist Park.

TODAY'S GAME:

- Making his 29th start of the season (16th on the road)...In his last time out, on 8/31 at MIN, earned his career-high-tying 14th win of the year after tossing 6.0 shutout innings on just 63 pitches, scattering 3 hits and a walk with 5 strikeouts...Has pitched at least 6.0 inningsand allowed 2 ER or fewer in 5 straight games, the 2nd time he has done so this season (5G from March 28-April 20).
- Over his last seven starts, has gone 6-1 with a 2.31 ERA (12 ER/46.2 IP), 42 strikeouts, a 0.99 WHIP, and a .216 OPP AVG.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Earned his 4th straight win on 8/26 at BOS, throwing a season-high 7.2 innings while surrendering 3R/2ER on 8 hits with 6 strikeouts.
- Earned the victory on 8/9 vs. OAK, after allowing a run over 7.0 innings of work, scattering 6 hits and a walk with 8 strikeouts...Struck out Brent Rooker swinging in the 6th inning, the 1,300th punchout of his career... Became the 3rd Puerto-Rican born player ever to reach the mark, joining Javier Vazquez (2,536) and Juan Pizarro (1,522).
- Was named the American League Pitcher of the Month for March/April, his 1st career Pitcher of the Month Award, and the 1st Blue Jay to win one since Alek Manoah in Sept./Oct. 2022.
- Took the loss on 4/30 vs. KC, pitching 7.0 innings while allowing a pair of runs on 5 hits with a walk and 3 strikeouts...Surrendered 2 runs or fewer in 7 straight starts to begin a season, the most by a non-opener in franchise history.
- His 1.23 ERA through his first 6 starts was the lowest in franchise history.
- Pitched the Blue Jays Home Opener on 4/8 vs. SEA, tossing 6.2 scoreless innings scattering 4 hits with a walk and 6 strikeouts...Began the season with 3 conseuctive quality starts for the 3rd time in his career (also: 2017) & 2019).
- Was the Opening Day starter for the Blue Jays on 3/28 at TB, marking the 4th time in his career and the 2nd time as a Blue Jay...Earned the win on the day, allowing a pair of runs on six hits and a walk over 6.0 innings... Recorded six strikeouts, the most by a Blue Jays starter in the season opener since Marcus Stroman (7) in 2019.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

Ranked 9th among AL pitchers in innings pitched (189.2), 10th in ERA (3.65), and 12th in strikeouts (184)...Has made exactly 32 starts in each of the last five full seasons...Won his 1st career Gold Glove Award... Recorded a career-high 26 assists while keeping a .953 fielding percentage.
