RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a six-game, seven-day homestand against the Mariners (2-1) and Nationals (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...have won three of four, six of eight, seven of 10, and nine of their last 15 games...went 9-10 during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26...after traveling to Kansas City and Texas from July 2-7, the Rays will conclude their pre-All-Star break schedule by hosting two of the AL's top three teams in the Yankees and Guardians from July 9-14...tonight, the Rays look to return to the .500 mark for the 16th time this season...they have not been above .500 since entering play on May 21 (25-24).

On Wednesday afternoon, the Rays were unable to complete a three-game sweep over the Mariners in a 5-2 loss...all five Seattle runs were scored with two outsover their last 15 games since June 11, Rays pitching has recorded an AL-worst .301 (55-for-183) two-out opp. average vs. 181 (58-for-320) with one or zero outs.

Tampa Bay pitching collected 38 strikeouts in the series against Seattle, its most in a set of three games or fewer since Sept. 19-21 vs. LAA (39SO).

However, the Rays yielded a homer for the 12th consecutive game—only the Rangers (16G, June 3-21) have a longer streak in 2024...it marks Tampa Bay's longest streak since permitting a home run in 13 straight from April 17-May 1 (G2), 2019.

The Rays have scored first in 11 of their last 12 games since June 14, with the exception being June 24 vs. SEA...they are 7-5 over that span.

Tampa Bay has not comitted an error in a season-high eight consecutive games, its longest streak since Aug. 22-Sept. 2, 2023 (10G).

The Rays 15-8 (.652) mark in Interleague play is the best in the majors...they have split their last eight games vs. NL clubs (4-4) on the heels of a six-game winning streak (May 3-June 11).

Tampa Bay has won three straight series, matching its longest streak of the season (April 5-14 vs. COL, LAA, SF)...it is 6-2-0 in series play against NL opponents (3-0-0 at home), winning four of the last five sets.

CELEBRATING HISTORY—Tonight, the Rays host their second annual Black Legacy Game, which aims to bring together prominent community leaders to celebrate the culmination of St. Petersburg's rich Black history and the tie it has to baseball in the region...the Rays Baseball Foundation will present the Black Sports Business Academy with a \$10,000 donation for the work they do within Historically Black Colleges and Universities and sports communities.

REWRITING RECORD BOOKS—Yandy Díaz is riding a 19-game hitting streak, batting .365/.379/.506 (31-for-85) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 11 RBI...it ties Jason Bartlett (May 15—June 25, 2009) for the longest streak in franchise history...since the streak began on June 7, Díaz leads the majors with 11 multi-hit games while ranking second in the AL in hits (31) behind MIN Carlos Correa (32)...his .365 average is third behind Correa (.427) and CLE Steven Kwan (.391)...it marks the second-longest active streak in the majors behind PIT Bryan Reynolds (23G) and is fourth longest in MLB this season...the Rays are the only MLB franchise that has not seen player record a hitting streak of 20+ games.

He has tallied an RBI in eight consecutive games, tying the frachise record shared by Rocco Baldelli (2004), Carlos Peña (2008), Evan Longoria (2009) and Ben Zobrist (2009)...with an RBI tonight, he would join LAD Shohei Ohtani (10G, active streak) as the only players in the majors with RBI streaks of 9+ games in 2024.

Díaz also has a career-high 28-game on-base streak, the second-longest active streak in MLB behind BAL Gunnar Henderson (34G)...it ties the ninth-longest streak in franchise history and is the longest since Wander Franco (43G) in 2021.

Díaz has collected 35 hits in June, fifth most in the month in Rays history...Randy Winn (2002) holds the club record with 42 hits...Díaz's career high for hits in a calendar month is 36, done in August 2023.

HALFWAY THERE—Tampa Bay is below .500 at the halfway point of the season for just the fourth time in 15 seasons since becoming the Rays in 2008, joining 2018 (40-41), 2016 (33-48) and 2014 (33-48)...the Rays -56 run differential is their lowest at this juncture since 2007 (-105)...since MLB established a 162-game schedule in 1961, only seven other clubs have won at least 40 of their first 81 games while posting a -56 or worse run differential, most recently accomplished by the Orioles (40-41/-68) and Twins (41-40/-59) in 2017.

RED-HOT RAYS—Ben Rortvedt is batting .359/.405/.692 (14-for-39) with 4 2B, 3 HR and 14 RBI over his last 12 games...the 14 RBI since June 13 are tied for third most in the AL behind BAL Anthony Santander (16RBI) and NYY Aaron Judge (15RBI)...he has hit safely in a career-high-tying five straight games (also April 3-10, 2024) and has a four-game RBI streak, the longest by a Rays catcher since Mike Zunino (5G) from Aug. 11-17, 2021.

Randy Arozarena is batting .306/.447/.556 (11-for-36) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 6 BB and 4 HBP during an 11-game on-base streak, his longest since May 16-27, 2023 (12G).

Over his last 13 games, Jose Siri is batting .306/.382/.571 (15-for-49) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 5 RBI, 6 BB and 13 R...he has turned in a club-leading .899 OPS in his last 26 games since May 26.

Josh Lowe is 11-for-33 (.333) with 5 XBH a 1.072 OPS over his last nine games...he entered that stretch batting .189 (14-for-74) with a .594 OPS in his first 23 contests.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS—The Rays are 12-7 (.632) when opposed by left-handed starting pitchers, the fourth-best mark in the majors behind the Guardians (17-5/.773), Dodgers (22-8/.733) and Twins (15-8/.652)...they have won eight of their last 11 such games after splitting their first eight (4-4)...the Rays are averaging 4.9 runs per game in 19 contests opposed by LH starters compared to 3.8 in 62 games vs. RH starters.

Yandy Díaz is batting .353 (18-for-51) vs. LHP since April 17, tied with DET Andy Ibáñez for third in the AL (min. 50AB) behind BAL Adley Rutschman (.451) and MIN Willi Castro (.354)...Jose Siri is 7-for-18 (.389) against lefties in his last 20 games...Amed Rosario is 8-for-23 (.348) vs. LHP in June.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays own the majors' best record in one-run games (16-7/696) and games decided by two runs or fewer (28-12/700)...since April 29, they are 19-6 in games decided by two runs or fewer and 8-19 in all other contests...they are 12-4 in one-run games over that timeframe...six of their last eight wins have come by two runs or fewer.

The Rays and Nationals are tied for second in the majors with 22 comeback wins, trailing the Brewers (23)...Tampa Bay has come from behind in six of nine and 12 of its last 16 victories.

Tampa Bay ranks among MLB leaders in last at-bat wins (T2nd, 12), wins after the opponent scores first (T3rd, 17) and walk-off wins (T4th, 5)...the Rays have the most wins in the majors when trailing after six (10) and seven (8) frames.

D.C. DEALINGS—The Rays and Nationals meet for their lone series of 2024 this weekend, their first meeting at Tropicana Field since a two-game split from June 8-9, 2021...last season, the Rays recorded a three-game sweep at Nationals Park from April 3-5 as part of their modern era-record-tying 13-game season-opening winning streak...Tampa Bay posted a +13 (23-10) run differential in the series, plating 6+ runs in each contest...since the franchise moved to the nation's capital in 2005, the Rays are 8-3 against them at Tropicana Field.

The Rays can win their fourth straight game over the Nationals tonight, which would match the longest streak in franchise history (June 12, 2009–June 21, 2012).

Tampa Bay is 6-2 against NL East opponents, including 3-0 at home.

TONIGHT'S START-Eflin will take the mound for his 15th start of the season, including his sixth at home...marks his fifth start since his May 20–June 5 stint on the 15-day IL (lower back inflammation), posting a 4.43 ERA (22.1IP, 11ER) in the previous four...marks his fifth straight start against an NL opponent, having last faced an AL foe on May 18 at Toronto.

LAST TIME OUT—Despite tossing a season-high-tying 7.0 innings (also May 7 vs. CWS), suffered his fifth loss after allowing four runs on five hits and one walk with six strikeouts on June 22 at Pittsburgh...threw a season-high 95 pitches, his most since Aug. 25, 2023 vs. NYY (103)... allowed a 445 ft. solo HR to Oneil Cruz in the 1st inning...permitted three runs in the 3rd frame...Andrew McCutchen started the rally with a one-out triple and was driven in by Bryan Reynolds (1B)...following a walk to Cruz, Rowdy Tellez registered an RBI-single...Nick Gonzales then hit into a force out, plating the third run of the inning.

CAPITAL GAINS—Eflin has made 12 career appearances (11GS) opposite Washington, going 4-5 with a 5.13 ERA (59.2IP, 34 ER)... of the 12 appearances, nine have come at Nationals Park...he last faced the Nationals in a relief appearance on Sept. 30, 2022, recording the second hold of his career (1.0IP, 2H, 1ER, 2SO).

Since joining the Rays in 2023, Eflin is 3-5 with a 3.39 ERA (90.1IP, 34ER) and 0.89 WHIP in 15 Interleague starts...this includes a 3.94 ERA (32.0IP, 114ER) and 0.97 WHIP in six starts vs. the NL East.

TROP TALK—In five starts at Tropicana Field this season, Eflin is 2-1 with a 2.90 ERA (31.0IP, 10ER)...this, compared to 1-4 with a 5.01 ERA (50.1IP, 28ER) in nine road outings.

Since joining Tampa Bay last year, Eflin is 13-5 with a 3.21 ERA (134.2IP, 48ER) in 23 home starts, compared to 6-8 with a 3.21 ERA (124.1IP, 59ER) in 22 road starts...min. 130.0 IP, his 3.21 home ERA since the beginning of 2023 is fifth lowest in the AL behind SEA George Kirby (2.59), TOR José Berríos (2.96), SEA Luis Castillo (3.05) and TOR Chris Bassitt (3.19).

WERE GOING STREAKING—Eflin has walked two batters or fewer in 48 straight starts dating to June 14, 2022, tied with SEA George Kirby for the longest active streak in the majors and tied for seventh longest in the majors since at least 1901...since 2005, only MIN Phil Hughes (64GS, 2014-16) has strung together a longer streak...of the 48 starts, 45 have come with the Rays, surpassing Andy Sonnanstine (42GS, Aug. 5, 2007–Sept. 21, 2008) for the longest streak in franchise history.

From April 26–June 16, he did not issue a walk to 165 consecutive batters spanning 39.1 IP—both streaks are the longest in franchise history (prev. Corey Kluber, 150BF; Kluber/David Price, 35.1IP)...the streak was halted when ATL Matt Olson drew a five-pitch walk to lead off the 4th inning of Eflin's June 16 outing.

The 39.1 IP walk-less streak was the longest in the majors since SF Ross Stripling (42.0IP) from July 2-Aug. 16, 2023, per Elias.

SO CLOSE, BUT SO FAR—Over his last two starts, opponents are hitting .174 (8-for-46) against Eflin with one or zero outs and and .393 (11-for-28) with two outs...on the season, opposing hitters are 40-for-119 (.336) against him with two outs, the highest mark in MLB (min. 100AB), ahead of WSH Patrick Corbin (.330).

QUALITY CONTROL—Min. 80.0 IP. Eflin paces the majors in walk rate (1.6%) and walks per 9.0 IP (0.66), while ranking second in SO/BB (10.50) behind SEA George Kirby (10.67)...he has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 (min. 2,000BF) at 3.7 pct., ahead of Zack Greinke (4.4%)...Eflin has walked one or zero batters in 38 of his 45 starts since the beginning of 2023—only Kirby (42) has more starts.
