**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals and San Diego Padres play the third game of a four-game weekend series tonight at Busch Stadium as the two teams face off seven times over a 10-game span (July 24-Aug. 3) ... St. Louis has won the first two games of the series and are winners of 13 of its last 16 over the Padres at Busch Stadium since April 7, 2019 ... The Miami Marlins visit St. Louis on Monday for three games leading up to Thursday’s MLB trade deadline.

**BIRD WATCHING:** St. Louis begins the day in 4th place in the NL Central, 8.0 games behind division leader Milwaukee, and 1.5 games behind San Diego for the 3rd and final NL Wild Card spot ... The Cardinals have won back-to-back games for the first time since a three-game sweep of Cleveland (June 27-29) ... St. Louis is 11-4 (.733) on Saturdays, with a .733 win pct. that ranks 3rd in MLB behind the Marlins (.765, 13-4), and Cubs (14-3, .824).

**WHO’S YOUR PADRE:** The Cardinals all-time .667 (174-87) home win pct. in St. Louis over the Padres (1969-present) is the 2nd-best by one home team vs. any visitor in MLB history (min. 100 games). - *Elias*

- Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals .698 home win pct. (44-19) vs. the Friars is their 2nd-best against any visitor behind only Colorado (.734, 47-17).
- The Cardinals all-time .588 (304-213) win pct. over San Diego is their 4th-best against any opponent (min. 50 games), while no NL team has higher all-time win pct. over San Diego than St. Louis.

**BIG WILLY STYLE:** Willson Contreras has scored in seven straight games vs. the Padres, longest streak among active players and longest by a Cardinal since **Paul Goldschmidt** (7 straight in 2022) ... The Cardinals longest streak of games scoring a run vs. the Friars is held by **Mark McGwire** (12 from 1999-2000).

- Willson connected on his 28th double last night, most among National Leaguers and a new single-season high ... The last Cardinal to lead the NL in doubles at the end of the season was **Matt Carpenter** (44 in 2015 and 55 in 2013).
- Contreras has doubled in a career-high five straight games, longest active streak in MLB, and tied with White Sox **Miguel Vargas** for the longest this season in MLB overall ... The last Cardinal to double in six straight was **Paul Goldschmidt** from Aug. 29-Sept. 3, 2024.

**ALLEN TO BE INDUCTED INTO HALL OF FAME:** Former Cardinals All-Star outfielder **Dick Allen** will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame tomorrow at 12:30 p.m. CT in Cooperstown, N.Y., joining fellow Class of 2025 members **CC Sabathia**, **Ichiro Suzuki**, **Billy Wagner**, and **Dave Parker**, who was a Cardinals coach in 1998 ... Allen batted .279/.377/.560 (128-459) with 34 home runs, 101 RBI, and a .937 OPS in 122 games in 1970 during his lone season in St. Louis ... Notable former Cardinals scheduled to attend the ceremony include **Ozzie Smith**, **Joe Torre**, **Tony La Russa**, **Dennis Eckersley**, **Jim Kaat**, **Scott Rolen**, **Ted Simmons**, and **Lee Smith**.

#### SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

**Fernando Tatis**, father of Padres outfielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

**Miles Mikolas** was selected by San Diego in the 7th round of the 2009 MLB draft...pitched parts of two seasons with the Padres (2012-13), where he made his MLB debut.

**Thomas Saggese** was born in and resides in Carlsbad, CA...graduated from Carlsbad High School.

**Phil Maton** pitched parts of three seasons with the Padres (2017-19)...selected by San Diego in the 20th round of the 2015 MLB Draft...Made MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. KC at Petco Park...struck out first batter faced, **Lorenzo Cain** (swinging).

**Mike Shildt** coached and managed parts of 18 seasons in the Cardinals organization (2004-21)...served as area scout (2004-07) and coach (2005-08) before transitioning to minor league manager (2009-16)...Joined St. Louis coaching staff in 2017 and was Cardinals manager for parts of four seasons (2018-21)...led Cardinals to three postseason berths...2019 NL Manager of the Year.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 26 games for San Diego in 2008...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for **David Freese** (Dec. 14, 2007).

FanDuel broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played parts of four seasons in San Diego (1997-98, 2002, 2005) and appeared in the 1998 World Series... was a part of the Padres broadcasting team for 12 seasons (2012-23)...resides in San Diego.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft... played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)... traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach **Mike McCoy** was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002 MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Hitting Coach **Victor Rodríguez** played two minor league seasons (1986-87) for the Louisville Redbirds (AAA) in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor **Allen Craig** played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for **Woody Williams** (Aug. 2, 2001).

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** played 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with **Nate Tebbs** from the Padres for **Heathcliff Slocumb** and current Memphis (AAA) manager **Ben Johnson**.

Athletic reporter **Katie Woo** spent the 2018 season covering the Padres as an associate reporter for MLB.com.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

Cardenales broadcaster **Polo Ascencio** was born in nearby Tijuana, Mexico...considers Padres Eduardo Ortega as a broadcasting mentor.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Southpaw will be making his 19th start of the season (43rd career) in his 110th career game.
- Is working on 14 days rest as the team gave him an extended pause combined with benefit of the All-Star break.
- Ranks T-2nd on the Cardinals in wins (6) and strikeouts (80), and 5th in IP (100.1) - all career-highs.
- His 6 wins this season are the most by a Cardinals lefty starter since **Jordan Montgomery** also won 6 in 2023 as a starter; the last to win more was **Jaime Garcia** (10, 2016)
- Owns the most wins (6) in MLB among lefty starters age 25 or younger this season along with **Mitchell Parker** (WSH); Ranks T-4th most among any pitcher 25 or younger this season (**Priester-MIL, 9; Woo-SEA-8; Schwellenbach-ATL, 7**).
- Is the youngest Cardinals lefty starter age 25 or younger to win 6 games since **Jaime Garcia** won 13 in 2010 at age 23.
- Held left-handed batters to a .190 BA (11-58) with one extra base hit (Sal Frelick double on 4/25) in his first 13 starts; lefties batting .348 (8-23) with 4 doubles and a home run (M. Busch) in his last four starts.
- His 18 starts this season are a career-high, and seven more then he made in 2023 (11 starts).
- Held the opposition to two runs or fewer in eight straight starts (April 13-May 24), longest streak by a Cardinal since **Jack Flaherty** ran off nine straight in 2019 (7/7-8/23).
- Is 4-3 in home games (4.59 ERA) this season & 2-4 on the road (3.65 ERA); Won back/back road starts (6/17 at CWS & 6/29 at CLE) after starting the year 0-4 away from home.
- Has worked 6.0 innings or more in 11 of his 18 starts this season; his start on 5/1 at CIN was cut short (3.0 IP) by a lengthy rain delay.
- Is a career 11-16 with a 5.00 ERA in his 42 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA in 67 relief appearances.

LAST TIME OUT: Matched his season-high allowing nine hits with six runs allowed in a 6-5 loss to Atlanta on July 11 at Busch Stadium. Did not strike out a batter for the first time this season & matched his season-high allowing two home runs.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Has established single season-highs in wins, losses, games started, strikeouts and innings pitched this season.
- Cardinals won each of his four starts (6/17-7/5) scoring 35 runs over those games. Held his opposition to two runs or less in each start (3-0, 2.25 ERA).
- Ran a career-high win streak to three games after recording three-straight winning decisions to close out the month of June.
- Held the opposition to two runs or fewer in a career-best eight straight starts this season (4/13-5/24).
- Surpassed 200 career strikeouts vs. Arizona (May 24).
- Earned his first road win of the season, and his single-season high 4th win on 6/17 at the White Sox, pitching 6.0 innings and allowing just two runs in 12-2 Cardinals win.
- Was dazzling in a 2-1 win over the Pirates and Paul Skenes on May 6 at Busch Stadium as matched his career high in strikeouts with 8 and limited the Buccos to just 3 hits while he logged a season-high 7.0 IP (99 pitches); It was his 4th consecutive winning decision in a Home start dating to last season (3-0 in 2025).
- Made his 3rd career start against Milwaukee on 4/25 and posted a 3-2 win as he limited the Brewers to just 5 hits and 1 earned run over his 6.0 IP; Improved his career mark vs. MIL to 3-0 with a 1.14 ERA.
- Blanked the Phillies on just 3 hits over his 6.0 IP (88 pitches) on 4/13 at Busch Stadium and was credited with his 1st win of 2025 (7-0).
- Pitched 6.0 innings allowing three runs for a quality start in his first start of the 2025 season vs. LAA (4/1); surrendered all his runs in the 3rd inning vs. LAA after retiring the first eight batters of the game.

CAREER:

- Is 8-7 career in 20 career starts at Busch Stadium and has a 4.09 ERA; won each of this 1st three career starts at Busch Stadium; Cardinals are 10-10 in his starts.
- Acquired by the Cardinals from the Tampa Bay Rays with C Edgardo Rodriguez and Rays Compensation draft pick B (RHP Tink Hence) in exchange for OF José Martínez, OF Randy Arozarena and Cardinals Compensation draft pick A (INF Alika Williams), January 9, 2020.

LIBERATORE vs. SAN DIEGO:

- Making his first career start against the Padres (6th app.) after five relief appearances between 2023 & 2024.
- Is 0-1, 3.38 ERA career in his 5 relief appearances vs. SD with a pair of Holds.
- Is making only his 3rd career start against an N.L. West opponent, starting vs. SF (6/12/23 at STL) and vs. ARI (5/24/25).
- Is unscored upon in his three career outings against the Padres at Busch Stadium, allowing just 1 hit over 3.2 IP.
- His lone HR allowed to Padres batter was to Manny Machado on 9/22/23 at Petco Park (2-run HR in 8th to break 2-2 tie).
