YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the Giants, 5-3, in walk-off fashion to avoid the series sweep...
Marked their seventh walk-off win of the season and first since July 14 vs. New York-AL...Snapped a threegame losing streak, the team's second three-game skid this month...Zach Effin notched his 13th quality start
of the year after allowing two runs on six hits (1 HR) and one walk with five strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Has
gone at least 5.0 innings and allowed three or fewer runs in all eight of his starts to begin his Orioles career...
Anthony Santander blasted his 42nd home run of the season, a walk-off, two-run shot, marking his third
career walk-off home run and his first since July 28th, 2023 vs. New York-AL...Gunnar Henderson stole his
20th base of the year in the first inning, marking his first career 30/20 season.

6) Santander became the fourth Oriole to deliver a walk-off home run this season and the first since
Adley Rutschman on May 15 vs. Toronto.

7) Henderson became the fourth Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to tally a 30/20 season,
joining Cedric Mullins (2021), Manny Machado (2015), and Brady Anderson (1996).

6) Cedric Mullins became the fourth player in Orioles history (since 1954) to record at least 30 stolen
bases in three different seasons, joining Brian Roberts (4x), Brady Anderson, and Al Bumbry.

WHAT'S TRENDING: Baltimore holds the top AL Wild Card spot ahead of the Royals (+3.0 games) and Tigers and Twins (+5.0 games)... The Orioles have the head-to-head tiebreaker with Kansas City (4-2), need to win all three games this series against Detroit (1-2) to clinch that tiebreaker, and need to win one of the final three matchups with Minnesota (3-0) to end the season from September 27-29 to clinch that tiebreaker... The O's have lost five of their last seven and eight of 11 to fall 4.0 games behind the Yankees in the AL East... The Birds are 32-37(.464) since July 1, 27-30 (.474) since the All-Star break, and 20-24 (.455) since August 1... Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 186-129 (.590), the best record in the AL and the third-best winning percentage in MLB behind the Dodgers (.606, 191-124) and Braves (.594, 187-128) during that time.

New York leads the division at 89-64 (.582); an AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since 2015-17; Boston won the divison in 2017 and 2016, as did Toronto in 2015, with a 93-69 (.574) record.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are second in MLB with 219 home runs behind the Yankees (223)...The Dodgers (217) rank third...Baltimore led MLB in homers through June with 139, 16 more than New York-AL, but have hit 80 home runs since, tied for 15th in MLB...The 0's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and this year marks the most by the club since 2017 (232).

**Observed Baltimore has nine players with at least 10 homer runs, tied with the Dodgers for the most in MLB this season: Anthony Santander (42), Gunnar Henderson (37), Colton Cowser (20), Adley Rutschman (19), Jordan Westburg (18), Cedric Mullins (15), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (15), and Ramón Urias (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

**Observed Baltimore are one of two duos with at least 35 homer runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (53) and Juan Soto (40); the 0's did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (Trumbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

**Observed Baltimore Bal

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson is three homers shy of becoming the fourth shortstop (11th occurrence) in MLB history to hit 40 home runs, joining Alex Rodriguez (6x, 1988–2003), Rico Petrocelli (1969), and Ernie Banks (4x, 1957-60)... He passed Cal Ripken, Jr. (1991) and Miguel Tejada (2004), who held the 0's record by a shortstop with 34 entering this season... With three more long balls, he would be the second player in Orioles history to hit 40 homers and steal 20 bases, along with Brady Anderson (50 HR, 2158) in 1996.

6. He was named the AL Player of the Week on September 9, the second such award of his career; Henderson slashed .417. 464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games.

7. Henderson's 114 runs scored are tied for third in the AL and for fifth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since Roberto Alomar set the club record with 132 in 1996; he's the sixth player in 0's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining Manny Machado (2, 2015-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Brian Roberts (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

7. He's on pace to score 121 times; Alomar, Frank Robinson (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.

7. He ranks tied for third in the AL and MLB with 7.8 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; eight Orioles (13 occurrences) have ended a season with at least 7.0 fWAR and four 0's (six occurrences) have finished with an 8.0 fWAR.

7. Henderson has hit 31 of his home runs when batting leadoff, the second most in Orioles history, behind Brady Anderson (35) in 1996.

MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander is the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to hit 40 home runs in a season and the first since Mark Trumbo in 2016 (see chart at right)...He's the eighth switch-hitter (12" occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season, along with New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2: 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Modely (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4: 1956, 58, 60-61)... Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

Met Strees RBI shy of 100 for the season; no Oriole has reached that mark since Jonathan Schoop (105) in 2017; the last Baltimore switch-hitter to do so is Bobby Bonilla (116) in 1996.

Santander has hit 33 home runs since the start of June, tied with New York-AL's Aaron Judge and four behind Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani for the most in MLB during that time; his 42 home runs rank third in MLB behind Judge (53) and Ohtani (51).

Dy. His 103 home runs since the start of 2022 rank sixth in MLB during that time and are second in the AL, behind only Judge (152).

He's the ninth player in 0's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining Manny Machado (3, 2015-17), Chris Davis (4, 2012-13, 15-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Rafael Palmeiro (4, 1995-98), Eddie Murray (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), Boog Powell (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), Frank Robinson (3, 1966-67, 69), and Jim Gentile (2, 1961-62).

HOLY COWSER: Colton Cowser leads AL rookies and is tied for third among MLB rookies with 20 home runs with Chicago-NL's Michael Busch, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (24) and Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio (21)...He's the 10th rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since Gunnar Henderson (28) last year...He also the ninth rookie in 0's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Among rookies, Cowser is second in the AL and fifth in MLB with 3.6 fWAR, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (4.9), Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (3.9), and Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio and New York-AL's Austin Wells (3.7)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1st, 72), extra-base hits (2st, 46), walks (2st, 50), total bases (2st, 203), RBI (3st, 62), doubles (3st, 23), OPS (3st, 759), and slugging percentage (4st, 455).

Oh His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other 0's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; Detroit's Riley Greene is the next closest left fielder with four OAA.

THE FINAL HOMESTAND: Baltimore's final homestand of the regular season began on Tuesday with the first of three games against the Giants through yesterday...The home schedule concludes with three games against the Tigers beginning tonight...The Birds are 43-35 (.551) at Camden Yards this season, but 14-18 (.438) at Oriole Park since the beginning of July...The Orioles are 92-67 (.579) at home since 2023.

AGAINST THE TIGERS: The Orioles and Tigers begin their second and final series of the year tonight at Oriole Park...The two teams faced off for three games in Detroit last weekend, with the Tigers taking two of three and winning the series...The 0's won the season series against Detroit in 2023, going 6-1, including a threegame sweep in Baltimore from April 21-23...The 6-1 record last season marked Baltimore's first time winning more than five games in a single season against Detroit since the 2004 club swept the six-game season series...The Birds went 3-1 at Comerica Park in 2023 after going 5-12 in 17 games from 2017-2022.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore... Yesterday, he earned his 400th career win, all with Baltimore... Four previous managers have won 400 games at the helm of the Orioles: Earl Weaver (1,480), Buck Showalter (669), Paul Richards (517), and Hank Bauer (407).

DOCUMENT IT: A documentary focused on the city of Baltimore and the Orioles to air on a streaming network or digital carrier in Spring of 2025...The story of the city coming back from an economic and human catastrophe (the Key Bridge collapse), while a new ownership group and President usher in the next chapter of Oriole excellence...A team that has long been part of the city's DNA and mirrors its resilience...Interwoven are stories from our neighborhoods, our fans, and our schools (starting with Harlem Park Elementary, which the Orioles have adopted)...All combining to tell the riveting story of a City, State, and Major League team making a run for a Championship.

O: The project is being filmed and produced by Mike Tollin Productions; creator of projects such as "The Last Dance", "The Captain", and "Justice USA", Mike Tollin Productions is the nation's premier production house for sports documentaries and storytelling.

ROSTER MOVES: The 0's reinstated left-handed pitcher **Danny Coulombe** from the 60-day Injured List (left elbow surgery) and placed righty **Burch Smith** on the 15-day Injured List (right abductor groin strain) today... The Orioles' 40-man roster currently has 38 players.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 31st start of the season tonight against the Tigers...Will be his second straight start against Detroit...Has made 30 starts for the third straight season, joining 2023 (32) and 2022 (33)...Has set a career high with 14 wins and tied a career high with eight losses (2022 & 2023)...Started for the AL in the 2024 All-Star Game in Arlington, becoming the fifth 0's pitcher to start a Midsummer Classic...Placed on the Paternity List on June 28 for the birth of his twin daughters, Charlotte and Harper...The 0's are 19-11 in his starts this year...Has allowed a careerhigh 41 stolen bases this season, most in MLB, and the most by an Orioles pitcher in team history...A four-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his 14th win, extending his career high, after tossing 7.0 scoreless innings on two hits and a walk with seven strikeouts on September 14 at Detroit...Marked his first scoreless start of the season, 28th scoreless start of his career, and the 16th of his career of at least 7.0 innings...Colt Keith recorded both hits for the Tigers...Threw 97 pitches, 59 strikes.

AGAINST THE TIGERS: Scheduled to make his fifth career appearance (4 GS) against Detroit...Is 2-0 with a 0.82 ERA (2 ER/22.0 IP) with 10 hits (1 HR) and four walks with 27 strikeouts vs. the Tigers in his career...Last faced the club in his last start...Will face the same opponent in back-to-back starts for the first time since July 7 and 14, 2023 vs./at Cincinnati.

AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL: Will be making his 25th appearance (22 GS) against the AL Central...Is 12-1 with a 2.92 ERA (43 ER/132.2 IP) against the division in his career, including 4-0 with a 3.41 ERA (13 ER/34.1 IP) in six starts this season.

STEAL MY SUNSHINE: Burnes has allowed a career-high 41 stolen bases, the most in MLB this season and the most by an Oriole in team history...It's the most by a major leaguer since New York-NL's Noah Syndergaard (42) in 2019; Syndergaard also surrendered 48 in 2016.

HIGH QUALITY: Burnes has tied his career high with 21 quality starts, joining 2022... Is one of seven pitchers in MLB this season with at least 20 quality outings...His 79 quality starts since 2021 are the second most in MLB behind Zack Wheeler (81)...He's the first Oriole with 21 quality outings since Chris Tillman, who also had 21 in both 2013 and 2014; an Oriole has not had more than 21 since Mike Mussina (25) and Scott Erickson (22) in 1997...Burnes tossed a career-high 10 consecutive quality starts from April 26 to June 16, the longest such streak by an Oriole since 2007 (Guthrie, 5/8-6/26).

SUPPORT SYSTEM: Burnes has received no runs of support six times this year...The team has been shut out five times when he starts, the most such starts by an Oriole since Wade Miley in 2017; the most in one season for an Oriole is six by Dave McNally in 1973...Despite this, his 127 runs of support are second most in MLB behind Tarik Skubal (132) and his 6.27 RS/9 is the third-best mark in MLB behind Skubal (6.42) and Atlanta's Chris Sale (6.38).

MR. RELIABLE: Burnes is one of 11 pitchers to have made at least 30 starts in each of the last three seasons since 2022...His 745.0 innings since the beginning of 2021 are tied for third in MLB with Zack Wheeler, behind Aaron Nola (767.2 IP) and Logan Webb (755.1 IP)...Burnes' 841 strikeouts since the start of 2021 trail Nola (843) and Dylan Cease (887).

STREAK SNAPPER: His start on August 4 at Cleveland snapped a streak of 17 straight games going at least 6.0 innings, the longest such run in MLB since 2022...Marked the longest such stretch by an 0's pitcher since Mike Mussina's 19-gamer from June 17 to September 22, 1998.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Selected to his fourth consecutive All-Star Game and made his first start...Became the fifth Orioles pitcher to start the Midsummer Classic, joining Steve Stone (1980), Jim Palmer (1978, 1977, 1972, 1970), Milt Pappas (1965), and Jerry Walker (1959)...Pitched a scoreless first inning, allowing a walk to Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani and a double to Philadelphia's Bryce Harper; left both runners stranded in scoring position...Caught by Adley Rutschman, the first all-Oriole starting battery in an All-Star Game.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes has eight Postseason appearances (2 GS) in his career while posting a 2.84 ERA(6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.
