AT A GLANCE: The Yankees begin a six-game road trip tonight with the first game a three-game series at Cleveland (through Wed.)...will also travel to Toronto for a three-game series this weekend (Fri.-Sun.)...went 2-3 on their recent homestand, dropping two-of-three games vs. Cleveland and splitting their rain-shortened two-game series vs. Boston.

- ▶ Their 38-26 (.594) record is the second-best in the American League and the fifth-best record in the Majors.
- ▶ **Are 8-4 in their last 12G (since 5/24)** and 10-7 in their last 17G (since 5/18)...**are 30-19 in their last 49G (since 4/13)**.
- ▶ The Yankees'+96 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the fourth-best in the Majors...have outscored their opponents, 72-41, over their last 12 games (since 5/24).

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Red Sox, 6-1, on Sunday at Yankee Stadium...**RHP Cam Schlichter** (5.2IP, 4H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 5K, 0HR) started and did not record a decision despite allowing only 1R/ER in 5.2IP...**1B Paul Goldschmidt** (2-for-4, 1RBI) hit a go-ahead RBI single in the fifth inning...**LF Cody Bellinger** (2-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI) hit his ninth HR of the year with a go-ahead solo shot in the eighth inning...**CF Trent Grisham** (3-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 1RBI, 1SB) recorded a season-high-tying 3H, including an RBI single in the eighth inning...**2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 3RBI) hit his eighth home run of the year with a three-run shot in the eighth inning...**C Ali Sánchez** (0-for-2) made his Yankees debut...**Yankees relievers** tossed 3.1 scoreless innings (2H, 1K)...**LHP Tim Hill** (1.0IP) tossed a perfect eighth inning to earn his third win of the year.

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger hit his ninth HR of the year with a go-ahead solo shot in the eighth inning on Sunday vs. Boston...five of his 9HR this season have either tied the game (one) or given the Yankees the lead (four).

- ▶ Has recorded 9RBI in his last 11 games (since 5/25).
- ▶ Is hitting .299/.391/.551 (38-for-127) with 20R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 6HR, 27RBI, 21BB, 45B and 3SF over his last 35G (since 4/28).
- ▶ Has hit .305/.330/.524 (25-for-82) with 8R, 3 doubles, 5HR, 13RBI, 5BB, 4SF and 45B in 21 career games vs. Cleveland.
- ▶ According to FanGraphs and Sports Info Solutions, leads all Major Leaguers in DRS (15)...is tied for fourth in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (12, tied for third in AL).

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt recorded two hits on Sunday vs. Boston, including a go-ahead RBI single in the fifth inning...has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games (since 5/25), batting .319/.347/.511 (15-for-47) with 7R, 3 doubles, 2HR, 10RBI, 2BB and 1SB over that span.

- ▶ Is batting .308/.373/.551 (33-for-107) with 17R, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 6HR, 21RBI, 9BB, 2HP and 1SB over his last 30G (since 4/26).
- ▶ Has hit .400/.559/.720 (10-for-25) with 2 doubles, 2HR, 18RBI, 7BB and 2HP with RISP this season...as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .328/.425/.455 (44-for-134) with 8 doubles, 3HR, 52RBI, 21BB/51BB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.

MERRY GRISHMAS: OF Trent Grisham recorded a season-high-tying 3H on Sunday vs. Boston, including an RBI single in the eighth inning (also 3H on 5/7 vs. Texas, 5/22 vs. Tampa Bay and 5/26 at Kansas City)...has hit safely in 12 of his last 15 games (since 5/19), batting .375/.444/.571 (21-for-56) with 9R, 5 doubles, 2HR, 6RBI, 7BB and 2SB over that span.

- ▶ Has reached base multiple times in seven of his last 10 games (since 5/26) and 10 of his last 15 games (since 5/19).

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. hit his eighth home run of the year with a three-run shot in the eighth inning on Sunday vs. Boston...has hit 2HR in his last four games (since 6/3) and 3HR in his last eight games (since 5/26).

- ▶ Is batting .306/.363/.556 (22-for-72) with 13R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 4HR, 11RBI, 7BB, 1SF and 5SB over his last 19 games (since 5/13).

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice has hit .299/.392/.640 (64-for-214) with 47R, 15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR, 45RBI, 32BB/21BB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 59 games this season...has reached base safely in 45-of-55 starts.

- ▶ 35 of his 64H this year have been XBH (15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR).

WHAT A RELIEF: Yankees relievers tossed 3.1 scoreless innings (2H, 1K) on Sunday vs. Boston...have not allowed a run in their last 10.1 innings (since ninth inning on 6/3).

CRUZ CONTROL: RHP Fernando Cruz retired 2-of-3BF and stranded an inherited runner on Sunday vs. Boston (0.2IP, 1H)...has stranded 23 of his 27 inherited runners this season, including 19 of his last 20 inherited runners (since 4/24).

- ▶ Has not allowed a run in 18 of his last 20 games (since 4/25), going 2-1 with a 0.93 ERA (19.1IP, 2ER) and 20K during that stretch.
- ▶ Has not allowed a run in 26 of his 31 games this season, going 3-1 with a 1.95 ERA (27.2IP, 6ER) and 33K.

GOOD WILL WARREN: RHP Will Warren will make his 13th start of the season tonight at Cleveland...has gone 7-1 with a 3.22 ERA (64.1IP, 23ER) and 70K in 12 starts this season, allowing 2ER-or-fewer in 10 of his starts...is tied for third in the AL in wins and tied for sixth in the Majors.

- ▶ The Yankees are 10-2 in his starts...his 10 team wins are tied for the most in the Majors this season.
- ▶ Since 2025, has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 32 of his 45 starts, tied for the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors over that span.

FAST AND FURIOUS: Yankees baserunners have recorded 135B over their last six games (since 5/31)...their 64SB this season are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the fourth-most in the Majors.

- ▶ **Their 64SB this season are their most through their first 64 games of a season in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) and most since recording 71SB in 2001**...marks only the third time in the last 37 years (since 1990) the Yankees recorded as many stolen bases through their first 64 games of a season (71SB in 2001 and 84SB in 1998).

- ▶ **INF Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (16SB) is tied for sixth in the Majors in stolen bases and **INF/OF José Caballero** (15SB) is tied for eighth in the Majors...**are only the fourth pair of Yankees teammates in the last 110 years (since 1917) to each record at least 15SB through the club's first 64 games of a season**, joining Chuck Knoblauch (23SB) and Alfonso Soriano (18SB) in 2001, Rickey Henderson (23SB) and Steve Sax (17SB) in 1989, and Willie Randolph (23SB), Mickey Rivers (23SB) and Roy White (16SB) in 1976.

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 11 of their last 15 starts (since 5/20), posting a 2.74 ERA (88.2IP, 27ER) over that span...have allowed 1ER-or-fewer in nine of their last 14 starts (since 5/21).

- ▶ Have posted a 3.12 ERA (354.1IP, 123ER) and 344K in 64 starts this season...have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 52 starts this season, the most in the AL and the fourth-most in the Majors...marks their third-most in franchise history through their first 64 games of a season, trailing only their 56 starts in 2022 and 54 starts in 2024.
- ▶ Have tossed at least 6.0 innings in 11 of their last 15GS (since 5/20).
- ▶ Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.336), rank second in ERA (3.12, first in AL), WHIP (1.10, first in AL), opponents' BA (.212, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.280, first in AL) and opponents' OPS (.615, first in AL), fifth in HR/9.0IP (0.89, second in AL) and K/BB (3.02, second in AL), sixth in strikeout rate (23.9%, third in AL), seventh in innings pitched (354.1, fourth in AL) and BB/9.0IP (2.90, third in AL), and eighth in strikeouts (344, fourth in AL).

SCHLITZ'S CREEK: RHP Cam Schlichter allowed only 1R/ER over 5.2IP in a no-decision on Sunday vs. Boston (4H, 1BB, 5K, 0HR)...his 1.87 ERA this season is the second-lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher through his first 14 starts of a season in the last 42 years (since 1985) and the seventh-lowest in the last 82 years (since 1945), trailing only Ron Guidry (1.45 ERA in 1978), Allie Reynolds (1.52 ERA in 1952), Whitey Ford (1.55 ERA in 1958 and 1964), Phil Niekro (1.77 ERA in 1984) and Max Fried (1.84 ERA in 2025).

- ▶ **Has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 13 of his 14 starts this season, including 1R-or-fewer in nine starts**...his 13 starts of 3R-or-fewer are the most in the AL and tied for the most in the Majors.
- ▶ **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in a Major League-best 10 of his starts this season, including eight of his last 10GS (since 4/17)**.

- ▶ According to Elias, his 2.38 ERA is the fourth-lowest by a Yankees pitcher (since 1913) through their first 28 career starts (ignoring relief appearances and excluding openers), trailing only Stan Bahnsen (2.16 ERA in first 28 career starts from 1966-68), Bill Stafford (2.30 ERA in first 28 career starts from 1960-61) and Mel Stottlemyre Sr. (2.35 ERA in first 28 career starts from 1964-65)...**also marks the lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher whose first 28 career appearances were all starts and the third-lowest by any Major League pitcher since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), trailing only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.14 ERA) and Miami's José Fernández (2.19 ERA).

PEN PAL: LHP Brent Headrick has not allowed a run in 25-of-31 appearances this season, going 4-1 with a 1.78 ERA (30.1IP, 6ER) and 34K...has stranded 20 of his 23 inherited runners this season.

- ▶ As a Yankee (since 2025), has not allowed a run in 38-of-48 games, going 4-1 with a 2.36 ERA (53.1IP, 14ER) and 64K.

HIP HIP JOSÉ: INF/OF José Caballero has reached base safely in 31 of his last 39 games with a PA (since 4/13), batting .291/.348/.465 (37-for-127) with 20R, 7 doubles, 5HR, 12RBI, 8BB, 3HP and 10SB over that span.

GLOVE STORY: Yankees fielders have made only three errors over their last 18 games (since 5/17), posting a Major League-best .995 fielding percentage (3E/636TC) over that span.

McMAHON OF THE HOUR: INF Ryan McMahon has hit .289/.289/.553 (11-for-38) with 5R, 1 double, 3HR, 7RBI and 15B over his last 11 starts (since 5/19)...since 4/25, is batting .357/.379/.571 (10-for-28) with 2HR, 12RBI and 1BB with RISP.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP WILL WARREN (7-1, 3.22 ERA)

RHP Will Warren will make his 13th start of the season in tonight's series opener at Cleveland...the 26-year-old will pitch on extended seven days' rest...made his 12th start of the season on 5/31 at the Athletics and recorded his seventh win of the year after allowing 3R/0ER over 6.0IP (6H, 3BB, 5K, 0HR)...**is 3-0 with a 2.78 ERA (22.2IP, 19H, 10R/7ER, 8BB, 17K, 1HR) over his last four starts (since 5/12)...****the Yankees are 4-0 in those starts...**...is 7-1 with a 3.22 ERA (64.1IP, 58H, 31R/23ER, 19BB, 70K, 7HR) in 12 starts this season...**his 32 starts of 2ER-or-fewer are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors since 2025...****the Yankees' 27 wins in his starts since 2025 are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the fourth-most in the Majors...**...last season, went 9-8 with a 4.44 ERA (162.1IP, 158H, 90R/80ER, 65BB, 171K, 22HR) in 33 starts, allowing 2ER-or-fewer in 22 of those starts...**according to Elias, his 22 starts of 2ER-or-fewer were the second-most by a Yankees rookie in a single season**, trailing only Stan Bahnsen (25GS in 1968)...is 9-4 with a 3.45 ERA (127.2IP, 120H, 65R/49ER, 37BB, 124K, 18HR) over his last 24 starts (since 7/25/25) after going 6-8 with a 5.92 ERA (121.2IP, 129H, 83R/80ER, 57BB, 146K, 16HR) over his first 27 career games (26 starts) from 7/30/24-7/19/25...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 19 of his last 24 starts...saw his first Major League action with the Yankees in 2024, going 0-3 with a 10.32 ERA (22.2IP, 33H, 27R/26ER, 10BB, 29K, 5HR) in six games (five starts) over five stints with the club (7/30, 8/7, 8/14, 8/21-31, 9/28)...was selected by the Yankees in the eighth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Southeastern Louisiana University.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 12th start of the season on 5/31 at the Athletics and recorded his seventh win of the year after allowing 3R/0ER over 6.0IP (6H, 3BB, 5K, 0HR)...marked his second start of the season without allowing an ER (also 4/13 vs. Los Angeles-AL).

2026: Is 7-1 with a 3.22 ERA (64.1IP, 58H, 31R/23ER, 19BB, 70K, 7HR) in 12 starts this season...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 10 of his 12 starts...his 10 starts of 2ER-or-fewer are tied for the eighth-most in the Majors (tied for the fourth-most in the AL).

- ✦ Has allowed 2BB-or-fewer in eight of his 12 starts this season, including 1BB-or-fewer in seven of those starts...his seven starts of 1BB-or-fewer are tied for the 10th-most in the AL...has issued just 19BB to 271 batters faced.
- ✦ Is tied for sixth in the Majors in wins (seven, tied for third in AL)...also ranks sixth in K/9.0IP (9.79) and is tied for ninth in strikeout rate (25.8%) among AL pitchers.
- ✦ Is holding right-handed batters to a .220/.273/.331 (26-for-118) slash line this season.
- ✦ Has recorded at least 6K in seven of his 12 starts this season.
- ✦ Has allowed one-or-zero HR in 10 of his 12 starts this season, including seven starts without allowing a HR...is allowing only 0.98 HR/9.0IP.
- ✦ The Yankees are 10-2 in his starts, tied for the most wins in a pitchers starts in the Majors (tied for the most in the AL).
- ✦ **Is 3-0 with a 2.78 ERA (22.2IP, 19H, 10R/7ER, 8BB, 17K, 1HR) over his last four starts (since 5/12)...****the Yankees are 4-0 in those starts.**
- ✦ Went 4-0 with a 2.39 ERA (37.2IP, 32H, 15R/10ER, 8BB, 46K, 4HR) in his first seven starts of the season (3/28-5/1)...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of those seven starts...the Yankees won six of those seven starts.
- ✦ Allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts this season (3/28-5/1), the most in the Majors in that span (most in the AL)...was only the seventh Yankees pitcher (eighth time) in the last 66 years (since 1961) to allow 2ER-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts of a season (excluding openers), joining Max Fried (first 11GS in 2025), Michael King (first 8GS in 2023), Gerrit Cole (2x: first 8GS in 2021 and first 7GS in 2023), Nestor Cortes (first 7GS in 2022), Michael Pineda (first 9GS in 2014) and Hideki Irabu (first 7GS in 1998).
- ✦ Recorded at least 6K in six straight starts (4/13-5/12), posting a 12.40 K/9.0IP (45K/32.2IP) over that span...marked a career long streak...was one of only three Yankees (fifth time) in the last seven years (since 2020) to record six-or-more strikeouts in at least six straight games, joining Cam Schlitler (9GS from 9/11/25-4/17/26) and Gerrit Cole (3x: 15GS from 8/8/20-G1-4/30/21, 11GS from 6/22-9/1/21 and 12GS from 6/14/22-8/15/22).
- ✦ Made his fifth start of the season and earned his second win of the year on 4/18 vs. Kansas City after allowing only 2R/ER over 7.0 innings (5H, 0BB, 11K, 1HR, 1PO)...**his 11K tied his career high (also 11K on 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL)**...marked his third career double-digit strikeout game (also 11K on 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL and 10K on 5/20/25 vs. Texas)...marked the second time in his career he has recorded at least 10K without surrendering a walk (also 11K and 0BB 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL)...no other Yankee had done so since Warren last accomplished the feat on 6/17/25...his 7.0 innings marked the second-longest start of his career (7.1IP on 5/9/25 at the Athletics)...also marked his sixth career start with 0BB and his second this season (last on 4/3 vs. Miami).

ROAD TRIPPIN': Is making his sixth road start of the season tonight...is 3-0 with a 2.25 ERA (28.0IP, 7ER) and 23K in five road starts this year...the Yankees have won each of his five road starts this season.

- ✦ Has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of his five road starts this season.
- ✦ Is 4-2 with a 2.64 ERA (58.0IP, 17ER) and 44K over his last 11 road starts (since 8/5/25).
