**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Phillies continue a four-game set tonight with the 15th of 19 meetings between the clubs this season...The teams will conclude the season series with three games in Atlanta next week, September 17-19.

*A* The Braves need to win the next two games to split the 10 games in Philadelphia this season and avoid losing the season set here at Citizens Bank Park for the third consecutive season and for the fourth time in the last five years...They went 5-4 in nine games here during the 2016 season.

*A* After getting swept in a season-opening, three-game series here in Philadelphia, the Braves have won seven of the last 11 games with the Phillies, outscoring their division rival 91-50 over the stretch.

*A* LHP Dallas Keuchel is set to face the Phillies for the fourth time in his career and for the second time this season...The lefty dropped a 2-0 decision on July 2 at SunTrust Park after going 7.0 innings and allowing two runs, earned, while striking out three Phillies hitters...Overall, Keuchel is 1-1 with a 1.40 ERA (3 ER/19.1 IP) in his career against Philadelphia.

*A* RHP Zach Eflin is 2-2 with a 5.02 ERA (16 ER/28.2 IP) in five games, all starts, against Atlanta...In two starts this season, is 0-2 with a 19.06 ERA (12 ER/5.2 IP), and has allowed 17 total runs...Started against Atlanta here at Citizens Bank Park on July 27, and allowed 10 runs (six earned) over just 2.2 innings.

**90 WINS:** The Braves earned their 90th win on the season here on Monday night, reaching the mark for the second consecutive season...Atlanta went 90-72 in 2018 to capture the National League East title.

*A* Atlanta has won 90 games in consecutive seasons for the first time since 2012 (94) and 2013 (96).

*A* This season marks the franchise's 19th 90-win season since Major League Baseball went to a 162-game schedule for both leagues in 1962.

*A* The 19 total 90-win seasons since 1962 are the second most in the National League...The Dodgers lead with 25 such seasons, including one this year...St. Louis has 18 such seasons, and needs to go at least 9-9 over their last 19 games to win 90 games again.

*A* The Braves are on pace for 100 victories this season...They need go 10-6 or better in their last 16 games to reach the ninth triple-digit win season in franchise history...The 1998 team had the most regular season wins going 106-56 (.654) on their way to a loss in the NLCS to San Diego.

*A* The 1897 Boston Beaneaters had the best regular season mark, going 93-39 (.705), to become one of 31 teams in baseball history to have .700 win percentage or better.

**JOSH DONALDON:** Drew his 94th walk of the season last night, sixth most in the majors and second most in the National League...He has walked in each of his last eight games, a new career-long streak.

*A* Just six players in Atlanta-era history (since 1966) have walked 100 times in a season, with Chipper Jones being the last to do so in 2009 (101 walks).

*A* Jones and Darrell Evans each had three seasons of 100+ walks, while Jeff Burroughs, J.D. Drew, Dale Murphy and Jimmy Wynn each had one.

*A* Donaldson also hit his 37th home run of the season here on Monday night...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Donaldson's 37 home runs are the fifth most homers hit by a player in his first season for the Braves in franchise history...The four higher: Andres Galarraga (44 in 1998), Davey Johnson (43 in 1973), Jeff Burroughs (41 in 1977) and Wally Berger (38 in 1930).

**HOME RUNS:** OF Johan Camargo drove the first pitch of the eighth inning out to right field last night for his seventh home run of the season, and Atlanta's 230th as a team.

*A* The Braves' 230 home runs this season are tied for the fifth most in baseball and are the second most in the National League...The Braves are now five home runs away from tying the single-season mark, set by the 2003 team.

*A* Atlanta has homered at least one time in each of its last six games, its eighth streak of at least that many games this season...The Braves are 79-38 (.675) when hitting at least one home run this year.

**VS. THE NL EAST:** The Braves are in the middle of 14 consecutive games against the NL East, specifically Washington (seven games) and Philadelphia (seven games)...The Braves are 42-23 (.646) against the division this season, the third-best mark by an Atlanta team since divisional play began in 1969.

*A* The Braves went 35-16 (.686) against the East in 1999, the club's best ever intradivision record...They won a franchise-record 51 games in 2004 (51-25, .671) against their division.

*A* Atlanta went 49-27 (.645) against the East last season...No other NL team has been better against their own division the last two seasons than Atlanta (91-50, .645)...The Astros have the best intradivision record in the majors for the last two seasons at 93-46 (.669).

**KUECHEL RUNNERS:** Tonight's starter Dallas Keuchel is allowing opponents to bat .263/.332/.419 against him on the season, but just .184/.295/.329 in 76 at bats with runners in scoring position.

*A* Opponents are batting .106 points lower with runners in scoring position than they are with no one on base (.290, 54-for-186).

#### Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his 16th start of the season and the 199th of his career...Is his 208th career appearance.
- A* Has won each of his last four starts, and Atlanta has won each of his last five turns.
  - A* Allowed just three earned runs during the stretch, pitching to a 0.87 ERA (3 ER/31.0 IP)...Has struck out 27 in 31 innings.
  - A* Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings in his last start, September 6 vs. Washington, allowing six hits and two walks while striking out three.
  - A* The five starts come after he allowed a season-most 10 hits and eight runs on August 8 at Miami.
- A* Is allowing opponents to bat .263 (91-for-346) against him on the season, with a .332 on-base percentage and .419 slugging.
  - A* With runners in scoring position, is holding opponents to a .184/.295/.329 line, with 14 hits in 76 at-bats...Opponents are batting .106 points lower with runners in scoring position than they are with no one on base (.290, 54-for-186).
  - A* In 39 opponent at-bats with runners in scoring position and two outs, has allowed just seven hits (.179) and eight RBI.
- A* Makes his eighth start of the season on the road, and is 3-4 with a 5.26 ERA (23 ER/39.1 IP) over his first seven turns...Is 4-1 with a 2.10 ERA in eight starts at SunTrust Park.
  - A* Has just two quality starts in his seven turns on the road, and averages just 5.2 innings per start.
  - A* Last started away from home, August 25 at the Mets, and pitched 7.0 scoreless innings, his only scoreless start on the road this season.
- A* Set for his fourth career start against the Phillies, and his second this season...Is 1-1 with a 1.40 ERA (3 ER/19.1 IP) in his first three turns.
  - A* Pitched against them once this season, July 2 at SunTrust Park, and allowed five hits and just two runs over 7.0 innings.
  - A* Has made just one career start here at Citizens Bank Park, August 5, 2014... Allowed one earned run over 7.0 innings in a no-decision.
  - A* Despite his 1.40 ERA, Keuchel's teams are just 1-2 in his three starts against the Phillies...He has received just five runs of support over the three games.

#### 2019 Recap

- A* Started, 8/20 vs. MIA, and allowed six hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his fourth win of the season.
  - A* Struck out opposing pitcher Elieser Hernandez leading off the third inning for the 1,000th strikeout of his major league career.
  - A* Became the 49th active pitcher to have 1,000 career strikeouts, and the second on the Braves staff (Julio Teheran).
- A* Pitched against the Mets, 8/14 at SunTrust Park, and tossed 6.0 scoreless innings.
  - A* With that start, has pitched against 27 of the 30 major league clubs...Has never faced either Atlanta or Houston, the two teams he has played for, and the Los Angeles Dodgers.
- A* Started, 7/23 vs. KC, and logged his sixth career double-digit strikeout game... Fanned 12 Royals over 6.0 innings, one off his career high.
  - A* The last Atlanta pitcher to fan more batters in a single start was Kris Medlen, who struck out 13 Nationals over 7.0 innings on September 14, 2012.
  - A* Keuchel also doubled in the fifth inning, and became just the third pitcher in Atlanta history to strike out at least 11 batters and double in the same game, joining Greg Maddux (4/24/94 vs. PIT) and Julio Teheran (8/1/13 vs. COL).
- A* Beat the Padres on 7/12, allowing just six hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
  - A* Earned the win in Atlanta's final start before the All-Star break, 7/7 vs. MIA, and in Atlanta's first game after the break, 7/12 at SD...Became the third Braves pitcher to start and win consecutive regular season games for the Braves in the modern era (since 1900) and the first since Johnny Sain on September 6 and September 11 of 1948.
- A* Pitched at least 7.0 innings in each his three starts from 7/2-12, going 2-1 with a 2.11 ERA (5 ER/21.1 IP) in that span.
  - A* Was the first Atlanta starter to pitch at least 7.0 innings in three consecutive turns since 2017, when Jaime García did so from 5/31 to 6/11.
- A* Signed by the Braves to a one-year major league contract on 6/7...Was recalled to Atlanta on 6/21.
  - A* Became the first former Cy Young winner to join Atlanta midseason since the Braves acquired reliever Mark Davis from the Kansas City Royals in 1992.

#### Career Recap

- A* Selected by the Houston Astros in the seventh round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft...Signed by Jim Stevenson.
- A* Is a four-time Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner (2014-16, 18), two-time American League All-Star (2015, 2017) and the 2015 AL Cy Young Award winner. Has pitched in parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues (2012-18).

- Is 1-0 with 3.86 ERA (12 ER/28.0 IP) in 38 games with Atlanta...Thirty-one of his 38 appearances have been scoreless, including 18 of his last 22.
- Converted his first save chance of the season, 8/14 vs. NYM...Was the seventh save of his career.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.
- Has a 27.00 ERA (6 ER/2.0 IP) against LAD this season...Has a 2.08 ERA (6 ER/26.0 IP) against all other teams.
- Twenty-one of his 38 appearances have been less than 1.0 inning.
- Holding left-handed batters to a .157 (8-for-51) average with 18 strikeouts...Righties are 13-for-53 (.245).
- Atlanta acquired him from the Oakland A's on 4/28 in exchange for cash considerations...Was designated for assignment by Atlanta on 5/14 and re-signed to a major league contract on 5/18.

- Is 0-1 with a 4.42 ERA (9 ER/18.1 IP) in 20 games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.24 ERA (14 ER/56.1 IP) in 58 games on the season...He has converted 23 of 28 save opportunities.
- Snapped a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless appearances on 9/7 vs. Washington...Held opponents to just four hits while striking out 14 through 13.0 innings during the streak...Logged his first save with Atlanta, 9/6 vs. WSH.
- Allowed runs in four of his first six appearances with the Braves, and allowed all four inherited runners to score.
- Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save.
- Acquired from Detroit on 7/31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...At the time ranked fourth in the AL with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball among qualifying relievers.
- Was 0-2 with 22 saves and a 1.18 ERA (5 ER/38.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 12 walks in 38 games out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season.

- Is 8-2 with a 3.97 ERA (29 ER/65.2 IP) in 63 games this season...Has converted 18 of his 25 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019...His seven blown saves are tied for third most in the majors.
- Has eight wins in relief this season, the most by a Braves reliever since Oscar Villarreal also had eight in 2006.
