**CHILDHOOD CANCER AWARENESS DAY CUSTOM CLEATS RAISE OVER \$8,000:** The D-backs’ custom-designed cleats by Phoenix Children’s patients and worn by D-backs’ players and staff during Sunday’s Childhood Cancer Awareness Day raised \$8,800 benefiting childhood cancer research programs.

**RACE AGAINST CANCER 5K REGISTRATION NOW OPEN:** The D-backs’ 12th annual Race Against Cancer 5K presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute and benefitting cancer research and patient care is on Sunday, September 28 at Chase Field...register at [dbacks.com/race](https://dbacks.com/race).

**SNAKE BITES:** Since August 1, the D-backs’ 21-15 (.583) record is the fifth-best record in the Majors, behind the Brewers (25-12, .676), Phillies (23-13, .639), Red Sox (21-14, .600) and Yankees (20-14, .588).

- On August 1, the D-backs were a season-high 13.0 games back in the division and 10.0 games back in the NL Wild Card. . . now the D-backs are 8.5 back in the division and 4.5 back in the NL Wild Card.
- The D-backs have won 4 of their last 6 games, 8 of their last 12, since Aug. 27, and 12 of their last 19, since Aug. 19.
- The D-backs have 6 straight series wins or splits and 8 series wins in their last 11.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 11-5 @ Giants last night in the series opener.

- Ketel Marte** reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 games...recorded his seventh 3+–hit game of the season...since June 3, his 7 games of 3+ hits are tied for sixth-most in the NL (also: 8 others).
- Jake McCarthy’s** bases-loaded triple in the first inning resulted in a season-high-tying 3 RBI (also: 3 on July 1 vs. Giants).
- Gabriel Moreno** went 2-for-3 with a walk, including his career-high eighth homer with a solo homer in eighth inning...has 1+ RBI in 6 of his last 8 games and reached safely in 11 of his 13 starts since being reinstated off the injured list on Aug. 22.
- Corbin Carroll** went 0-for-4, only reaching base on a force out, ended his 24-game on-base streak (Aug. 13-Sept. 8), the second longest of his career. . . recorded his 26th stolen base in the fifth inning.
- Blaze Alexander** had a RBI single in the fourth inning and has reached base safely in 13 of his last 17 games and has recorded an RBI in 5 of his last 7 games (5 RBI) and 7 in his last 12 (9 RBI).
- Brandyn Garcia’s** 99.8 MPH fastball on Willy Adames’s single in the fifth inning was the hardest-thrown pitch by a D-back lefty in the Statcast Era (2015).

**VS. GIANTS:** The D-backs are 0-1 in a stretch of 6 games in 10 days vs. Giants (Sept. 8-10 on road, Sept. 15-17 at home).

- The D-backs have won 2 straight road series @ Giants and won or split 4 of their 5 series vs. Giants overall (won 3, split 1).
- The D-backs (72-73) are sixth in NL Wild Card) and sit 1.5 games back of the Giants (73-71), who are fourth in NL Wild Card.
- The D-backs went 2-1 in their initial road series from May 12-14 before splitting their 4-game home series from June 30-July 3.
- Corbin Carroll** has homered 3 times in his last 4 games @ Oracle Park (2 on May 12, 1 on May 13)...has reached multiple times in 7 of his last 8 games @ Oracle Park (15 times total)...has also hit safely in 9 of his last 11 games vs. Giants.
- Blaze Alexander**, in 9 career games vs. Giants, is hitting .400 (12-for-30)/1.053 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 9 RBI and 1 walk...in his first career game @ Giants on April 19, 2024, he hit his first career grand slam (8th inning off Nick Avila) and had a career-high 5 RBI...became the fourth player ever in a game @ Oracle Park to record 2+ extra-base hits, 1+ home runs and 5+ RBI, joining Josh Donaldson/OAK (May 18, 2012), Paul Lo Duca/LAD (June 26, 2001) and Jeff Kent/SF (Aug. 3, 2000)...also was the youngest player ever to do so @ Oracle Park at age 24-313.

**STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE:** The D-backs currently face the second-hardest remaining strength of schedule: Cardinals (.556), **D-backs (.525)**, Twins (.525), Red Sox (.522) and Reds (521).

- QUALITY STARTS:** D-backs’ starting pitchers have quality starts in 6 of their last 7 games, 8 of their last 10 and 9 of their last 12.
- D-backs starting pitchers’ streak of 6 straight quality starts from Sept. 1-7 tied their longest since 2017 (also: 6 from April 8-15, 2025), behind 8 straight from Sept. 9-16, 2017.

**AGAINST THE SOUTHPAW:** The D-backs feature 4 players in the Top 11 OPS leaders vs. lefties since the All-Star break: 1. Freddie Freeman/LAD (1.223), 2. Ozzie Albies/ATL (1.199), 3. Andrew Vaughn/MIL (1.117), 4. Jakob Marsee/MIA (1.005), **5. Ketel Marte/AZ (.974)**, **6. Geraldo Perdomo/AZ (.954)**, **7. Blaze Alexander/AZ (.944)**, 8. Trea Turner/PHI (.914), 9. Brice Turang/MIL (.880), 10. Shohei Ohtani/LAD (.878), **11. Corbin Carroll/AZ (.873)**.

- VS. NL WEST:** The D-backs are 22-19 (.550) vs. NL West foes...their .537 interdivision win pct. is sixth among NL clubs, behind the Dodgers (.675, 27-13), Brewers (.628, 27-16), Padres (.578, 26-19), Cubs (.571, 24-18) and Phillies (.565, 26-20).
- Since August 1, **Corbin Carroll’s** 1.098 OPS vs. NL West [min. 10 G] ranks third among NL opponents, behind Jared Triolo/PIT (1.112) and Jung Hoo Lee/SF (1.105).
  - Since August 1, **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely 2+ times in 10 of his last 11 games vs. NL West since Aug. 8, hitting .395 (15-for-38) with 5 doubles, 6 RBI, 7 walks and 5 strikeouts.

- TRENDING OFFENSE:** Since August 8, the D-backs’ 5.37 runs per game rank fourth in MLB, behind the Mets (6.31), Yankees (5.79) and Athletics (5.43).
- Since August 1, the D-backs’ 81 RBI with 2 outs rank tied for second in MLB with the Phillies, behind the Mets (82).
  - The D-backs lead the Majors with 45 homers this season in the 8th inning or later while their 164 runs are second most in the same category, behind the Red Sox (166).

**OPPOSING STARTERS VS. D-BACKS OFFENSE:** Since August 1, opposing starters vs. D-backs’ offense have combined for a 5.88 ERA (117 ER in 179.0 IP), .264 AVG/.788 OPS with 32 doubles, 7 triples, 28 homers, 68 walks (3.42 BB/9.0 IP) and 165 strikeouts.

- CARROLL’S EXTRA BASES:** **Corbin Carroll** has a MLB second-best 75 extra-base hits, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (77)...no D-back has ever led a MLB season in the category.
- His 75 extra-base hits are tied for ninth in franchise history in a single season (with 4 others), behind Luis Gonzalez (100 in 2001), Gonzalez (80 in 2000), Ketel Marte (77 in 2019), Gonzalez (76 in 2003), Aaron Hill (76 in 2012), Stephen Drew (76 in 2008), Steve Finley (76 in 1999) and Jay Bell (76 in 1999).

- CARROLL NEARING A 30-30 SEASON:** **Corbin Carroll**, at 30 homers and 26 stolen bases, is looking to become the first-ever D-back to have a 30+–homer/30+–stolen base season...since his debut year in 2022, only 6 players have accomplished the feat: Bobby Witt Jr./KC (2x - 2023-24), José Ramírez/CLE (2024), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (2024), Ronald Acuña Jr./ATL (2023), Francisco Lindor/NYM (2023) and Julio Rodríguez/SEA (2023).
- Since 2022, he is 1 of 3 players with 2+ consecutive 20+–HR/30+–SB seasons: **Corbin Carroll** (2 - 2023-24), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (4 - 2022-25) and José Ramírez/CLE (2 - 2024-25).

- SPREADING THE SAVES:** The D-backs’ **8 pitchers with 2+ saves** are tied for the most all-time/since 1969 (*when saves became an official stat*) with the 2024 Rays, 2022 Rays, 2003 Tigers, 1979 Dodgers, 1973 Braves and 1970 Indians...the D-backs’ **6 pitchers with 3+ saves** are tied for second most all-time/since 1969 with the 2022 Rays, 2021 Reds, 1992 Braves, 1991 Brewers, 1991 Pirates, 1990 Pirates, 1984 Mariners, 1983 Athletics, 1973 Braves, 1980 Angels and 1970 Indians...the record is 7 pitchers set by the 2003 Tigers [source: Elias Sports Bureau]:
- 2+ SAVES:** Shelby Miller (10), Justin Martinez (5), A.J. Puk (4), Kevin Ginkel (3), Andrew Saalfrank (3), Jake Woodford (3), Anthony DeSclafani (2), Taylor Rashi (2).

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (7-8, 5.22)

- The D-backs are 6-1 in his 7 starts since the trade deadline.
- Has tossed 2 straight quality starts (@ Dodgers, vs. Red Sox), going 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 ER in 12.0 IP), opponent .195 AVG (8-for-41)/.591 OPS, 6 walks and 8 strikeouts.
- Will make his fourth career start vs. Giants...the D-backs won 8-7 in his last start on May 14 @ Giants (4 ER in 4.0 IP, 5 H, 3 BB, 4 K).

**AT A GLANCE:** Seventh season with the D-backs.

- D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona BBWAA the last 3 seasons (2022-24) and 4 of the last 5 seasons (2020, '22-'24).
- 2023 NL All-Star starting pitcher.
- Finished in Top 5 in NL Cy Young Voting in 2023 (3rd) and 2022 (5th).

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** His 996 strikeouts are 4 shy of becoming the third D-back pitcher to reach the 1,000 mark.

- Owns a 12.2 scoreless-inning streak...has allowed 7 hits (2 extra-base hits) and 4 walks with 13 strikeouts.
- Has quality starts in 6 of his last 7 starts, including 4 straight, going 4-1 with a 2.20 ERA (10 ER in 41.0 IP), opponent .213 AVG (33-for-155)/.596 OPS, 10 walks and 33 strikeouts.
- Has had 3 straight quality starts vs. Giants, going 3-0 with a 0.95 ERA (3 R-2 ER in 19.0 IP), opponent .113 AVG (7-for-62), 0.68 WHIP, 6 walks and 29 strikeouts.
- Has tossed 6.0+ innings in 4 straight starts, 8 of his last 9 starts and 10 of his last 12 starts.
- His 63 wins are third in franchise history, ahead of Merrill Kelly (62) and behind Brandon Webb (87) and Randy Johnson (118).
- Among NL starting pitchers since July 1, his 71.0 innings are tied for sixth with Logan Webb/SF (leader is Cristopher Sánchez/PHI at 82.2 IP).
- His 7 starts of 100+ pitches rank third in his career, behind 2022 (9), 2023 (8) and 2021 (8).

**LAST START:** Had his second straight scoreless outing and fourth straight quality start on Sept. 3 vs. Rangers, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with 4 hits, 1 walk and 5 strikeouts.

**VS. GIANTS:** 18th career start, 10th @ Oracle Park.

- Won his last start on July 1, allowing 2 runs (1 earned) on 5 hits and 0 walks with 10 strikeouts over a season-high-tying 7.0 innings.
- Has struck out 10+ batters in consecutive starts (21 strikeouts) and 8+ in 3 straight starts (29 strikeouts).
- In 10 starts (7 quality) since 2022, is 6-1 with a 2.77 ERA (21 R-19 ER in 61.2 IP), opponent .208 AVG (45-for-216)/.615 OPS, 0.99 WHIP, 16 walks and 75 strikeouts.

**APPROACHING 1,000TH K AS A D-BACK:** With 4 strikeouts, will become the third pitcher to reach 1,000 strikeouts as a D-back...his 996 strikeouts currently rank fourth in franchise history, behind Randy Johnson (2,077), Brandon Webb (1,065) and Robbie Ray (998).

- Recorded his 1,000th career strikeout on July 21 vs. Astros in the fourth inning (Brice Matthews).
- Second pitcher to debut in 2019 and reach 1,000+ career strikeouts, joining Dylan Cease (source: Elias Sports Bureau).
- Among all pitchers since 2019, his 1,039 strikeouts are 11th...Top 3 are Zack Wheeler/PHI (1,289), Aaron Nola/PHI (1,261) and Gerritt Cole/NYY (1,241)...teammate Corbin Burnes/AZ (1,079) is 10th.

**10+ WINS:** Is 1 of 4 D-backs to have 4+ consecutive 10+-win seasons with Randy Johnson (1999-2002), Brandon Webb (2005-08) and Zack Greinke (2016-19).

**VS. NL WEST:** Has won 5 consecutive starts vs. NL West opponents...in those starts, has a 2.70 ERA (11 R-9 ER in 30.0 IP) with 8 walks and 38 strikeouts.

- In 8 starts in 2025, has gone 5-1 (team is 6-2) with a 4.40 ERA (25 R-23 ER in 47.0 IP) and 54 strikeouts.
- In 30 starts from 2022-24 vs. NL West went 13-4 with a 3.37 ERA (69 R-66 ER in 176.1 IP), an opponent .212 AVG (137-for-645)/.630 OPS, 50 walks and 201 strikeouts.

**ON THE ROAD:** The D-backs are 3-0 in his last 3 road starts (2 quality)...is 2-0 with a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP), opponent .239 AVG (16-for-67), 5 walks and 12 strikeouts.

**VS. RIGHTIES:** In his last 8 starts, is holding righties to a .172 AVG (16-for-93)/.499 OPS with 7 walks and 26 strikeouts.

**VS. LEFTIES:** In his last 4 starts, is holding lefties to a .200 AVG (9-for-45)/.583 OPS with 3 walks and 10 strikeouts.

**INNING BREAKDOWN:** In his last 6 starts, in innings 3-6, has limited opponents to 5 runs in 23.0 innings with an opponent .146 AVG (12-for-82)/.467 OPS, 4 walks and 17 strikeouts.

**RUNNERS ON BASE:** In his last 6 starts with runners on base, has held opponents to 2 runs and a .105 AVG (2-for-19)/.454 OPS with 2 walks and 9 strikeouts.

**AUGUST RECAP:** In August, the D-backs went 4-2 in his 6 starts (5 quality), going 3-1 with a 2.57 ERA (10 ER in 35.0 IP), an opponent .220 AVG (29-for-132)/.626 OPS, 9 walks and 28 strikeouts.
