RECENT REDBIRDS: The City of St. Louis celebrates "Yadier Molina Day" as the 2022 National League Central Division Champion St. Louis Cardinals play the second game of a three-game series versus Pittsburgh tonight at PNC Park ... Tonight's game is the 5th of six straight between the Cards and Bucs to end the regular season ... For the first time in the expansion era (since 1961), last night was the first time that St. Louis suffered a walk-off loss by walking the last four batters in the final inning. - *Elias*.

POSTCARDS: St. Louis enters the NL postseason as the #3 seed and will host the third NL Wild Card (#6 seed) in a best-of-three Wild Card series this weekend at Busch Stadium from Oct. 7-9 ... The Cardinals will play Philadelphia in the 1st round with a Phillies loss (at Houston) *AND* a Padres win (vs. Giants) tonight.

DIVISION DANDIES: The 2022 Cardinals are NL Central Champions for the 13th time since three Division Play began in 1994, including five times in the last 10 seasons (2013, 2014, 2015, 2019, 2022) ... St. Louis has won 16 Division titles overall, with the first three coming in the NL East (1982, 1985, 1987).

MILESTONE WATCH: With two games remaining, St. Louis is in reach of a establishing new single-season team records for fewest errors committed (64) and most home runs hit by rookies (47), while also approaching season highs in most homers hit (197), groundball double plays induced by pitchers (152), and double plays turned overall (176).

AHOY, MATEY!: St. Louis is 29-7 (.806) in its last 36 games in the city of Pittsburgh since May 26, 2018, and 9-0-1 in its last 10 series at PNC Park ... Its .591 overall win pct (110-76) since PNC Park opened in 2001 is 3rd-best among annual NL visitors behind the Dodgers (.622, 46-28) and Padres (.618, 42-26).

BURIED TREASURE: St. Louis owns MLB's best overall win percentage against the Pirates (.592, 106-72) dating back to 2013 when the two teams squared off in the Division Series ... The Cards have reached 12 or more wins over the Buccos in the season series for the 2nd consecutive season (2021-22).

PNC PUNISHER: Albert Pujols has hit 35 homers at PNC Park, tied for 14th-most in stadium history, most all-time among visiting players, and active Pirates, and his most at any ballpark ... Pujols is the all-time PNC Park leader (2001-present) in batting (.373), slugging (.731), and OPS (1.177), while pacing all visiting players in hits (146), doubles (33), homers, RBI (99), runs (89), extra-base hits (69), and total bases (286).

BACK WHERE IT ALL STARTED: As St. Louis placed Mike Matheny on the 15-day injured list with a strained muscle in his right side, 21-year-old catcher **Yadier Molina** makes his MLB debut on June 3, 2004 in a 4-2 win over the Pirates at PNC Park, batting 6th in between **Hector Luna** and **So Taguchi** ... Yadi catches five Cardinals pitchers beginning with 6.0 shutout innings from 37-year-old **Woody Williams**, throws out **Jack Wilson** at second, tags out **Abraham Núñez** at the plate, scores a run, and records two hits **Oliver Pérez**.

THREE OF A KIND: According to *ESPN & Elias*, the number of days between the first game **Adam Wainwright**, **Yadier Molina**, and **Albert Pujols** played together (Sept. 11, 2005) and the final game (Oct. 2, 2022) reached 6,230 days, longest gap between the debut & finale of a baseball teammate trio in MLB history.

MORE TRIOS: The 2022 Cards trio of **Paul Goldschmidt** (7.9), **Nolan Arenado** (7.9), and **Tommy Edman** (6.3) is the first MLB team since the 2011 Red Sox of **Jacoby Ellsbury** (8.3), **Dustin Pedroia** (8.0), **Adrian Gonzalez** (6.9) to feature at least three players with a 6.0+ bWAR ... Only three Redbirds teams in history have featured three players with 6.0+ bWAR: the 2004 MV3 of **Scott Rolen** (9.2), **Albert Pujols** (8.5), and **Jim Edmonds** (7.2), and the 1998 Cards threesome of **Mark McGwire** (7.5), **Brian Jordan** (7.0), **Ray Lankford** (6.2).

FABULOUS FRESHMAN: Oliver Marmol's 92 wins tie **Bob O'Farrell** (1927), **Gabby Street** (1930), and **Ray Blades** (1939) for the 5th-most victories in the first full season among Cardinals first-year managers with two games to go ... **Eddie Dyer** (98), who piloted the 1946 Cardinals to a World Series title, holds the Cardinals record.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (October 4, 1967): The Cardinals win Game 1 of the 1967 World Series, 2-1, over the Boston Red Sox at Fenway Park ... **Bob Gibson** fans 10 in a complete game, while leadoff hitter **Lou Brock** goes 4-for-4 with a walk while scoring both runs.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st Rd. of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Yadier Molina (June 3, 2004 at PNC Park) and **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch) made MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (A).

Andrew Knizner's uncle, **Matt Knizner**, was a quarterback at Penn State Univ. and was on the 1986 National Championship Nittany Lion squad.

Mike Maddux signed with Pittsburgh in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before released in May.

Corey Dickerson played parts of two seasons in Pittsburgh (2018-19) ... Won a 2018 Rawlings Gold Glove award in left field.

José Quintana signed with Pittsburgh before the season, while **Chris Stratton** pitched parts of four seasons with the Pirates (2019-22)...the duo was traded to St. Louis for **Malcom Nunez** and **Johan Oviedo** (Aug. 2, 2022).

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Tyler Heineman played in 21 games for Memphis (AAA) last season.

Derek Shelton was born in Carbondale, Ill... caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois University.

Johan Oviedo signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22).

José Godoy signed with St. Louis as an international free agent (July 2, 2011) and played parts of eight minor league seasons with the Cardinals (2012-19).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956... played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60)...traded by Pittsburgh with **Ed Bauta** to St. Louis for **Dick Gray** and **Vinegar Bend Mizell** (May 28, 1960).

NL Ranks: Walks (59, T-5TH), Ground Into Double Plays (25, T1st), GDP situations (133, 11th).

- Makes his 2nd start since Game 1 of 9/17 twinbill vs. CIN when he was 29th player.
- Was optioned to Memphis (AAA) on Sept. 5 and made a pair of starts (9/6 & 9/11) for the Redbirds, both against Norfolk. Was 1-1 with a 1.69 ERA (16.0 IP/3 ER) and worked 8.2 IP on 9/6 in 12-0 win and 7.1 on 9/11 in 9-2 defeat.
- Tonight's start marks his 26th of the season (67th career) and 96th career appearance. It also marks his 8th start since coming off the 15-day I.L. (neck strain) on Aug. 30.
- Worked 3.0 scoreless innings in relief vs. the Dodgers (9/24) in his last appearance 10 days ago.
- Tonight's start is his 1st meeting with the Pirates since leaving his 9/17/20 start at PNC Park with elbow injury that resulted in "Tommy John" surgery.
- Ranks 3rd on the Cardinals in starts (25), innings pitched (137.0), 4th in wins (8), and 4th in strikeouts (77).
- Ranks T1st in the NL in grounded into double plays (25). Would lead in GDP/9 IP (1.64) but does not meet innings qualifications. Has induced a double play in 13 of his last 16 appearances (18 GDP's total).
- Has not lost three straight decisions dating back through his freshman year at Mississippi State (2014) through Minor and Major League Baseball.
- Received one run or fewer in five of his last 10 starts (July 4-present). He was ranked 6th in MLB in Run Support Avg (6.30) from the start of the season through the end of June, receiving 5+ runs of support four times.
- Missed two weeks while on the 15-day I.L. (neck strain) from July 15-29. Made one rehab start at Memphis (AAA) vs. Gwinnett on July 24.
- Allowed just one home run in the month of August (25.0 IP), a two-run shot by his former batterymate Austin Romine on 8/30 at Great American Ball Park.
- Has allowed just 5 HR's in his last 20 games (106.2 IP). Had a career-best 46.1 homerless IP streak from 5/8-6/23. It was longest for the Cardinals since Trevor Rosenthal's 54.0 IP in 2015.
- Allowed his 3rd HR at Busch Stadium snapping a streak of 48.2 IP without one, when he surrendered one against Gavin Lux on 7/14 vs. LAD. Was his first longball allowed at STL since a pair in the 2nd inning of his 2022 season debut vs. KC (4/12).
- The Cardinals are 28-13 (.683) in his starts during which he does not allow a home run.
