RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals opened the post All-Star break portion of their schedule last night with the 1st of three games against the Arizona Diamondbacks at Chase Field...the Cardinals will visit the Colorado Rockies next week (July 21-23) to conclude the six game roadtrip...the Cardinals wrapped up their pre-break schedule by splitting a six game home-stand with Washington (2-1) & Atlanta (1-2).

BIRD WATCHING: St. Louis posted 51 wins before the All-Star Break,their most since 2015 (56)...it marked the first time the Cardinals had logged 50+ victories prior to the Break in back-to-back years since 2014-15 (52 & 56)...the Cardinals began today tied with Cincinnati for 3rd place in the NL Central, 7.5 games behind first place Chicago and 2.5 games behind San Diego for the 3rd and final NL Wild Card spot.

GORMAN ON INJURED LIST/SAGGESE RECALLED: The Cardinals placed INF **Nolan Gorman** (lower back pain) on the 10-day Injured List, retroactive to July 13, prior to today's game, and recalled INF **Thomas Saggese** (#25) from Memphis (AAA).

WESTWARD HO: This weekend's series marks the Cardinals 1st games played west of the Central Time Zone in 2025...beginning with last night's game, the Cardinals will play 12 consecutive road games west of the CTZ and 17 of their remaining 32 road games will be played to the west...the Cardinals will play a combined 31 of their 65 games following the All-Star break against Western Division teams.

WHEN A MARATHON BECOMES A SPRINT: The Cardinals played 97 games before the All-Star break, matching the 1969 Cardinals for their most games prior to the break...the team is slated to play 65 games after the break...four (2022, 2004, 2002, 2001) of the team's top-15 runs over the final 65 games have taken place since 2000, including a 42-23 finish in 2022 as the NL Central Division Champions.

SOUTHERN COMFORT: Alabama native **Brendan Donovan** added to his MLB Jewel Event exploits in Tuesday's All-Star Game in Atlanta...Donny's 2 hits led all players, making him just the 4th Cardinal to do so and the 1st since **Ken Boyer** (3) in 1956; **Stan Musial** (3, 1949) & **Joe Medwick** (4, 1937) were the others to lead All-Star batters (*Elias*)...Donovan enjoyed a 3-hit game, including a two-run HR, in MLB's Rickwood Field game last June in Brimingham, AL.

SCRAMBLED EGG: The Cardinals used a 3-run 9th inning last night to prevent being shut out...St. Louis has only been handed goose eggs 5 times in 96 combined regular season & postseason games played at Chase Field, including a 1-0 three-hit loss to **Curt Schilling** in 2001 Division Series Game 1.

IT'S WHACKING DAY: The Cardinals .615 win pct. (112-70) against the Diamondbacks is their best against any opponent (min. 25 games) and the highest in MLB vs. the Snakes among National League and common inter-league opponents. **RAZING ARIZONA:** St. Louis is 53-38 (.582) all-time at Chase Field, the best win pct. by any annual visitor and the club's 3rd-best winning pct. in any road city.

SONNY THE STOPPER: Today's starter **Sonny Gray** is 6-3 in his 13 starts following Cardinals losses this season & 13-8 in such games as a Cardinal since 2024...St. Louis is 15-4 overall in games started by Sonny this year.

Nolan Gorman was born in Phoenix...graduated from Sandra Day O'Connor High School in Glendale...signed his letter of intent to the University of Arizona before being drafted by the Cardinals.

Matthew Liberatore was born in Peoria, Ariz.... graduated from Mountain Ridge High School in Glendale...signed his letter of intent to the University of Arizona before being drafted by the Rays.

Daniel Descalso played two seasons for the Diamondbacks (2017-18)... served as a Special Assistant to Baseball Operations for Arizona in 2023.

Jon Jay played 84 games for Arizona in 2018.

JoJo Romero played college baseball at Yavapai College in Prescott, Arizona.

Jordan Montgomery pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2022-23).

Shelby Miller pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2012-14)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the first round (19th overall) in the 2009 MLB Draft.

Dbacks Hitting Coach **Joe Mather** was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2001 MLB Draft... played parts of two years in St. Louis (2008, '10).

Dbacks 1B Coach **Dave McKay** served in the same position for St. Louis for 16 seasons (1996-2011).

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a Dbacks Baseball Operations Executive for parts of four seasons (2014-17).

Randal Grichuk played parts of four MLB seasons in St. Louis (2014-17)...joined the Cardinals via trade with the Angels with **Peter Bourjos** for **David Freese** and **Fernando Salas** (Nov. 22, 2013).

Athletic reporter **Katie Woo** graduated from Arizona State University.

Brandon Allen played parts of three seasons (2009-11) with the D-Backs...made his MLB debut with Arizona (Aug. 22, 2009 at Minute Maid)... singled off **Brian Moehler** for first career hit.

Zac Gallen was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft...pitched two seasons in Cardinals minor league organization before traded to Miami as part of the package to acquire **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

John Mozeiliak attended the University of Arizona before graduating from the University of Colorado at Boulder.

D-Backs Player & Media Relations Coordinator **Kat Ritter** previously worked as a Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate in 2019.

Arizona Pitching Strategist **Dan Haren** was selected by St. Louis in the 2nd rd. of the 2001 MLB Draft...pitched two seasons with the Cardinals (2003-04)...traded by St. Louis with **Daric Barton** & **Kiko Calero** to Oakland for **Mark Mulder** (Dec. 18, 2004).

TODAY'S GAME:

- The Cardinals Opening Day starter is set to make his 20th start of the season (326th career appearance/317th start). Today marks only his 2nd appearance at Chase Field after starting on Aug. 28, 2015 with Oakland.
- His 19 starts before the All-Star Break tied his single-season most (2014).
- Has not allowed a home run over his last 7 home starts (38.1 IP); last was Pete Alonso on May 2.
- Has not allowed a home run to a left-handed batter in his last 10 starts (133 batters faced). Joins **Jose Berrios** as the only two MLB pitchers since May 20 without a HR vs. a left-handed batter (100 TBF).
- Leads the Cardinals staff in percentage of Swings That Miss (26.8%) - 11th-best in the NL.
- Has 20 career double-digit strikeout games, including three since May 19. Since his career began in 2013, ranks 28th among his peers in 10+ K games.
- Is 6-1 with a 2.84 ERA (4 HR) in 12 home starts and 3-2 with a 4.57 ERA (6 HR) in seven road starts.
- Issued one-or-fewer walks in 14-of-19 starts this season; Cardinals are 12-3 in those games.
- Has six scoreless starts of 6.0 innings or more, tied for 2nd-most in MLB behind Detroit's LHP Tarik Skubal (8)**
- The Cardinals are 15-4 in his 19 starts this season, with two of his defeats coming in starts against the Mets.
- Sonny's 15 wins at home the past two seasons (2024-2025) are tied for 3rd-most in the majors behind **Tarik Skubal** (18) and **Zack Wheeler** (16). **The Cardinals are 11-1 in his 12 home starts (only loss vs. NYM 5/2). most in MLB for team home wins in starts by a singular pitcher this season.**
- Is one of 11 pitchers in Busch Stadium III history with 200+ strikeouts (219 K). **Trevor Rosenthal** ranks 10th with 244 strikeouts.
- 10 of his 98 hits allowed in 2025 have been homers and **17 of his 44 runs (38.6%) allowed this season have come via HR's.**
- His 10 HR's allowed have surpassed his season total (8) for all of the 2023 season.
- Over past two seasons since joining St. Louis (2024-25, ranks among MLB leaders in strikeouts (321, T-7th), SO/9 IP (10.53, 9th), and wins (22, T-6th).
- St. Louis is 32-15 (.681) in his 47 starts with the club since joining in 2024; His record stands at 22-12 while wearing the Birds on the Bat.

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed one run over 3.0 innings while fanning 5-of-12 batters faced before a rain delay washed away his outing (36 pitches/29 strikes) on the final day before the All-Star Break; St. Louis came back and beat Atlanta, 5-4, at Busch Stadium between two rain delays totaling four hours and two minutes.

2025:

- Authored a one-hit complete-game shutout masterpiece at CLE (6/27) striking out a season-high 11 Guardians on only 89 pitches in the 5-0 Cardinals win. His only blemish was a two-out Nolan Jones single in the bottom of the 5th inning.
- Marked Gray's 5th career shutout and first since July 28, 2015 at Los Angeles Dodgers. It was the 11th time a Cardinal threw a one-hitter, one batter over the minimum since 1901, and first since **Jordan Montgomery** at Wrigley Field on Aug. 22, 2022.*
- Since pitch counts were accurately kept in 1988, Gray joined **David Cone**'s perfect game (July 18, 1999) as the only two pitchers to throw shutouts of one hit or fewer with 10+ strikeouts in 89 pitches or fewer.*

- Ranks in the Top 10 among active pitchers in wins (120, 7th), games started (317, 9th), innings pitched (1,845.1, 10th), strikeouts (1,842, 9th) and ERA (3.48, 7th).

GRAY vs. ARIZONA

- Will be making his 3rd career start against Arizona and 2nd this season (May 25 at Busch Stadium).
- Needs to record a win against the Diamondbacks and Rockies to complete the MLB 30-team circuit.
- Despite making 121 starts against National League opponents in his career, with 93 as a member of a National League team, has only faced the Rockies and D-Backs twice over his time (his fewest among the 30 MLB teams).
- Scattered nine hits over 6.0 innings in a quality start and no-decision in the Cardinals come-from-behind 4-3 win over Arizona at Busch Stadium on May 25, 2025.
- A span of 3,558 days occurred between his first two career appearances (Aug. 28, 2015-May 25, 2025).
- ***In his only career appearance at Chase Field***, initially faced the Snakes on Aug. 28, 2015 with Oakland in an Interleague game, taking the loss after allowing four runs over 6.1 innings in a 6-4 defeat.
- Lifetime 8-7 with a 2.82 ERA in 22 career starts against National League West opponents.
