QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 13th start and 15th appearance of the season tonight against Cleveland...Had a career-high 22.2-inning scoreless streak from April 15 to May 10 earlier this season...Made his fifth Opening Day roster... Began the 2023 campaign in the starting rotation with the big-league club; had four stints with the Orioles after being optioned to Triple-A Norfolk on April 14, May 21, and September 13; recalled from the Tides on May 16, June 10, and October 1...Owned a 1-4 record with a 4.81 ERA (31 ER/58.0 IP) in 12 starts and pitched to a 3.26 ERA (7 ER/19.1 IP) in 12 relief appearances with the O's... Did not appear on the ALDS roster...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Kyle Virbitsky from the Oakland Athletics in exchange for INF Darell Hernaiz on January 26, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision on June 20 at New York-AL after allowing a season-high-tying five runs on five hits (2 HR) and two walks with two strikeouts in 4.2 innings...The two home runs mark a season high and his most since September 1, 2023 at Arizona...Received 11 runs of support, the second-most runs of support for an Orioles starter this season, only behind Grayson Rodriguez on March 30 vs. Los Angeles-AL (12)...Threw 84 pitches, 56 strikes.

AGAINST THE GUARDIANS: Owns a lifetime 0-1 record and a 4.50 ERA (6 ER/12.0 IP) across three appearances (2 GS) against Cleveland...Four of his six earned runs allowed to the Guardians came in his last start against the team on June 12, 2022; took the loss after allowing five runs (4 ER) on six hits and one walk with three strikeouts in 5.2 innings.

AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL: Owns a 6-4 record with a 2.70 ERA (30 ER/100.0 IP) in 18 career appearances (17 GS) against the AL Central; the 2.70 ERA is his lowest mark against any division...Opponents are slashing .244/.297/.375 (93-for-381)...Has gone 1-1 with a 3.31 ERA (6 ER/16.1 IP) in three starts against the division this season; has held AL Central teams to two runs or fewer in his last two starts.

HOME SWEET HOME: Slated to make his eighth home start of the season...Has pitched to a 3-2 record with a 2.97 ERA (13 ER/39.1 IP) in his seven prior starts at Oriole Park this year...Has held visiting opponents to two runs or fewer in five of his seven starts at home.

DAY 'N' NITE: Scheduled to make his seventh night start of the season...Has gone 3-1 with a 4.18 ERA (15 ER/32.1 IP) across his six night starts compared to 3-1 with a 2.55 ERA (10 ER/35.1 IP) across his six day starts this year.

LOVING LEFTIES: Has held lefties to a .172/.197/.234 (11-for-64) slash line through his 14 outings this season compared to .290/.329/.464 (65-for-224) against righties.

WHAT A RELIEF: Irvin has made two relief appearances for the O's this season, pitching to a 5.06 ERA (3 ER/5.1 IP) in those games...Credited with his second career hold in his first relief appearance of the season on May 19 vs. Seattle (2.0 IP)...Worked a season-high 3.1 innings of relief on May 22 at St. Louis, allowing a season-high-tying five runs (3 ER) on six hits (1 HR) with two punchouts.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Tossed a career-high 4.0 innings of relief on July 18 vs. Los Angeles-NL...Did not allow more than one earned run in five straight starts from June 26-August 19, the longest such streak of his career...Pitched for Norfolk in Game Two of the International League Championship Series on September 27 vs. Durham; tossed 3.0 scoreless innings with two hits and five strikeouts.
