**RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD**  
The Washington Nationals square off against the Minnesota Twins in the third and final game of this three-game series on Thursday afternoon...Washington is 3-2 in rubber games this season, including two straight...With a win today, the Nationals will have won three of their last four series.

- In the battle of franchises that have called Washington, D.C. home, the Nationals (2005-pres.) are 7-4 against the Minnesota Twins (1901-60) since 2005 when playing in the nation's capital...A win today would give Washington its sixth series win of the last seven against Minnesota since the 2013 season.
- Following today's game, Washington will embark on a six-game, seven-day road trip to Miami this weekend and Cincinnati next Tuesday-Wednesday.

**EXTRA! EXTRA!**  
The Nationals beat the Twins, 15-2, on Wednesday night, their largest margin of victory this season...Washington slugged a season-high 10 extra base hits (5 2B, 3B, 4 HR), the most in a single game since April 22, 2025 vs. Baltimore (10)...The 15 runs scored, five doubles and four home runs also marked season bests.

**OUT OF THIS WORLD**  
**CJ Abrams** is 12-for-30 (.400) with three doubles, two homers, 12 RBI, four walks, two stolen bases and six runs scored over his last eight games...He's reached safely in seven of the eight (.471 OBP) and has hits in six of the eight.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (T1st, 33), on-base percentage (5th, .401), OPS (4th, .960) and slugging (7th, .559).

**PRETTY OFFENSIVE**  
The Nationals rank fourth in Major League Baseball (3rd in NL) with 198 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 33 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 76 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 22 times this season, tied for second most in Major League Baseball.

**GOOD WOOD**  
**James Wood** leads Major League Baseball with an average exit velocity of 96.5 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (96.2).

- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 45 batted balls over 100 MPH rank tied for third in Major League Baseball.

**PITCH PERFECT**  
**Simon Mathews'** pitching staff ranks second in the National League (4th in MLB) with a 2.91 ERA in 11 games since April 24...The staff has pitched to a 3.80 ERA in 21 games since April 14 after entering play that day with a 6.21 ERA through the first 15 games of the season...Since April 25, the staff has surrendered just six home runs, fourth-fewest in Major League Baseball over this span (0.59 HR/9.0 IP).

- The starters lead the National League (2nd in MLB) with a 3.04 ERA and rank second in the NL (5th in MLB) with a .207 opponents' batting average in 10 games since April 24.
- The bullpen has pitched to a 2.13 ERA in nine games since April 26, the second-best mark in the National League.

**SPECIFICALLY...**  
Some pitching performances of note include:

- Foster Griffin** ranks sixth in the National League with a 2.27 ERA, while **Cade Cavalli** ranks 10th in the NL (min. 30.0 IP), with 10.38 strikeouts per 9.0 innings.
- Richard Lovelady** has offered scoreless relief in his last six games (6.0 IP), going 1-0 with a save, two holds, six strikeouts, three walks (all intentional) and five hits allowed.
- Left-handed batters are 3-for-22 (.136) with zero extra-base hits against **Mitchell Parker** this season.
- PJ Poulin** has been The Opener five times...He's allowed just one earned run on five hits with five strikeouts and one walk in 6.1 innings pitched.
- Over his last nine games, **Gus Varland** has pitched to a 1.93 ERA (2 ER/9.1 IP) with three holds, three saves, nine strikeouts and one walk.

**HIGH DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY**  
Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.5 runs per game more than the league average team...Washington has faced 23 teams with a record of .500 or better, tied for the most in Major League Baseball with the Pittsburgh Pirates.

- 13 of the Nationals 18 home games have come against teams .500 or better.
- Washington is 10-13 (.435) against teams .500 or better this season and has already played four teams in the top six in wins in Major League Baseball.

**FARM REPORT**  
**KING ME**  
Harrisburg shortstop **Seaver King** has reached base safely in all 27 games this season, the third-longest streak in Minor League Baseball and the third-longest active streak...He's hitting .318 with a .411 on-base percentage and a .589 slugging percentage this season...He ranks among Nationals farmhands in extra-base hits (T1st, 17), doubles (T1st, 10), hits (T2nd, 34), slugging percentage (3rd, .589), RBI (T3rd, 22), OPS (4th, 1.000) and average (4th, .318).
