Homers Allowed

Atlanta allowed a season high-tying six homers last night, and both such games have come against New York. The Braves also allowed six on August 12 at Citi Field.

The six home runs Atlanta allowed last night give it 154 surrendered on the season, surpassing its season total from all of last year.

The 2024 Braves, who led Major League Baseball in ERA and paced the NL in homers allowed, surrendered just 150 in total.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Mets today conclude a three-game weekend series with what is the 13th and final scheduled meeting between the clubs this season...New York is the first intradivision opponent against which Atlanta will conclude its season series.

A New York hit six homers and cruised to its second consecutive win in the series last night, but Atlanta is 7-5 in 12 total games between the teams this season...The seven wins have already clinched the season series for the Braves this year, despite what happens this weekend.

A The Braves have now taken the season series from their NL East rivals for eight consecutive seasons dating to 2018, and are 75-49 (.605) against the club overall in that stretch...The Braves have won 30 of the last 45 games with New York dating to the 2022 season, outscoring the Mets 259-196 (+63) over the stretch.

A Atlanta swept all three games versus New York here at Truist Park earlier this season, outscoring the Mets, 17-5 (+12), from June 17 to June 19... Since Truist Park opened in 2017, the Braves are 41-28 (.594) against the Mets here in their home park.

A RH Bryce Elder has never lost to the Mets, going 3-0 with a 4.15 ERA (10 ER/19.0 IP) over five career appearances...The 6-foot-2, 220-pound Texan last faced the Mets just 10 days ago at Citi Field and earned the win, allowing five hits and three runs, two earned, over 7.0 innings in the Braves' victory, 4-3...The right-hander was tagged for nine hits and eight runs over just 4.2 innings in his last start, August 19 vs. the White Sox, his third start this season in which he allowed at least eight earned.

A LH David Peterson has made 12 starts and 13 total appearances in his career against Atlanta, and is 3-5 with a 5.75 ERA (39 ER/61.0 IP) all-time against the club...The 6-foot-6, 240-pound Denver native has faced the Braves twice this season, including 11 days ago at Citi Field when he allowed a season-most six runs over just 3.1 innings...The left-hander rebounded from that effort to toss 8.0 one-run innings in his next start, August 19 at Washington, fanning a season-best 10.

ROSTER MOVES: The Braves today recalled RHP Wander Suero (No. 50) and RHP Hunter Stratton to Atlanta, placed LHP Aaron Bummer on the 15-day injured list with left shoulder inflammation, and released RHP Erick Fedde from the roster.

A Suero returns to Atlanta for his second stint with the Braves this season, after appearing in three games with the club in July...Among pitchers to make at least 40 appearances in Triple-A this season, Suero's 1.39 ERA with Gwinnett is the best in all of minor league baseball.

A Stratton has pitched 6.0 scoreless innings over three games with Atlanta this season, including 3.0 scoreless to earn the save last Sunday.

NACHO ALVAREZ JR.: Doubled in the bottom of last night's third inning, extending his career-best hitting streak to seven games...He also drew a walk, and has reached base multiple times in three straight games.

A During his hitting streak, Alvarez Jr. is batting .407/.448/.556 with three RBI, six runs scored, and four extra-base hits...Each of his last three hits have gone for extra bases, as he also doubled twice on Friday night.

A The 5-foot-10 native of Fontana, CA is batting .261/.343/.352 over a career-most 26 games with Atlanta this season, after appearing in just eight games during his debut campaign last year...He is currently rated by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 6 prospect, and as the No. 3 position prospect in the system.

DAY GAMES: Atlanta completes its series this afternoon with its 41st game in the daytime this season...The Braves are just 15-25 (.375) in the daylight this season, the fifth-worst winning percentage in baseball in such games.

A The club has, however, won each of its last three daytime games, including a win last Sunday, August 17 at Cleveland.

A Only the Nationals (19-35, .352), Angels (13-24, .351), White Sox (21-40, .344) and Rockies (16-36, .308) have lower winning percentages in day games.

A Atlanta's 40 day games this season are the fewest of any team in baseball outside of Los Angeles, CA... The Dodgers have played just 38 day games, while the Angels have played only 37.

A Dating to his first full season in 2018, no player in baseball has more day-game homers than Matt Olson's 105...Kyle Schwarber, with 95, ranks second.

VS. NL EAST: Today's game is Atlanta's third in a 10-game streak against intradivision opponents, and the final of a three-game set versus New York...The Braves tonight head to Miami for a three-game series with the Marlins, before four games versus the Phillies next weekend.

A Against NL East opponents this year the Braves are three games over .500, playing to a 20-17 (.541) record...Atlanta is 4-5 vs. Philadelphia, 7-5 vs. New York, 6-4 vs. Miami and 3-3 vs. Washington.

A Against all other opponents outside of their own division, the Braves are 38-54 (.413), 16 games under .500.

A From 2018 through 2024, during which Atlanta won six NL East division titles and made seven trips to the postseason, the Braves were 102 games over .500 against their own division...Atlanta went 275-173 (.614) in intradivision games in that span, by far the best record of any NL East club in intradivision games.

A After this 10-game run Atlanta has just six division games left, all of which are against Washington.
