WE'RE TALKING BAAAASEBALL: Down 0-2, the Giants will try to get back in the series tonight in the third game of this four-game set at Citizens Bank Park.

- ▶ SF is 1-4 through the first four games of its longest road trip of the season after going 1-2 in Boston and 0-2 so far here in South Philly...the Giants wrap up their 10-game trip with three games in Denver Tuesday-Thursday.
- ▶ With last night's defeat, the Giants fell to four games under .500, matching their season low.

ROSTER MOVES: C Tom Murphy has been placed on the 10-day IL with a left knee sprain and RHP Mitch White has been designated for assignment.

- ▶ C Jakson Reetz (#50) had his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento and RHP Daulton Jefferies (#56) has been recalled from Triple-A Sacramento...both are active for tonight's game in Philly.

MOVING ON: Giants pitching walked 10 batters yesterday...SF had one game last season where they walked 10 batters but that was in México City on April 29 at elevation vs. San Diego.

- ▶ Prior to that, the last time it happened in a 9.0-inning game was August 11, 2019 vs. the Phillies (11 walks).
- ▶ More specifically, the Giants bullpen walked eight of the 10 batters last night...the last time a Giants bullpen walked eight or more batters in a 9.0 inning game was also the August 11, 2019 game vs. Philadelphia (also eight walks).

EXORCISE THE DEMONS: Over their last nine games the Giants offense is slashing .215/.283/.319 and have scored a total of 22 runs...they are averaging 2.4 runs/game in that span and are 3-6 as a team in the win-loss column.

- ▶ They haven't scored more than three runs in any of those nine games, which is the longest stretch since a the 2018 Giants scored three runs or fewer in 11 straight games from September 4-16.
- ▶ Entering play today, the Giants rank 27th in 1st inning OPS (.567) and tied for the fewest 1st inning runs with the Nationals (nine)...they also rank 28th in 2nd inning OPS (.573) and tied for 19th in 2nd inning runs (13) (S/S).

COUNTRYMEN: Last night IF Wilmer Flores slugged the 150th home run of his career...he now has 73 home runs as a Giant since joining the team prior to the 2020 season, most on the team just ahead of OF Mike Yastrzemski (70)

- ▶ With his homer last night, Flores became the 20th Venezuelan-born player to reach the 150 -homer mark.

LOGAN: RHP Logan Webb makes his seventh start of the season tonight and his second of this road trip...Webb opened this trip in Boston on Tuesday and allowed four runs in 3.2 innings, matching his shortest outing of the season.

- ▶ Despite the rough outing, Webb still has a 1.93 ERA (7er, 32.2ip) over his last five outings dating to April 7...the 1.93 ERA in that span is fifth-best in the NL (min. 25.1ip).
- ▶ Each of Webb's two career starts against the Phils have come here at Citizens Bank Park...he has a 5.25 ERA here in those two outings but SF has won both games.
- ▶ He didn't face the Phillies at all in 2023 but in his only start against them in 2022 on May 30 here at CBP he struck out 10 in 8.0 innings while allowing three runs (on three solo homers).

MIKEY'S PIGGY BANK: OF Michael Conforto owns a career .883 OPS with 20 doubles, 23 homers and 73 RBI against the Phillies (102 games), most of that coming in his time with the New York Mets.

- ▶ Conforto's 73 career RBI vs. the Phillies are third-most among active players behind Freddie Freeman (130) and Marcell Ozuna (77).
- ▶ In this ballpark, Conforto has a .281/.353/.552 slash line (.906 OPS) with 12 doubles and 15 homers...his 15 homers here are the most he's hit at any stadium outside of Citi Field (66), his home ballpark with the Mets from 2015-2021.

THAIRO TIME: IF Thairo Estrada is 5-for-9 in the first two games of this series with a double and three RBI.

- ▶ Estrada has hit safely in each of his last 10 games against the Phillies dating to September 2, 2022...in that time he's slashed .419/.458/.512 with two doubles, one triple, seven RBI, six runs scored and three walks.
- ▶ All told, Estrada has hit safely in 12 of his 13 career games against the Phillies overall, batting .419 (21x51).
- ▶ In seven games at CBP, Estrada is 13-for-27 (.481) with five RBI.

LOOKING FOR LENGTH: Giants starters logged at least 6.0 innings in five of six games from April 22-28 with the lone exception being an opener going 1.0 inning...in five games on this trip (since April 30), no Giants starter has finished 6.0 innings.

- ▶ When the Giants get at least 6.0 innings from their starter this year they are 12-4.

WEBB GEMS: SF's Opening Day starter is in his sixth season with the Giants and made his fifth Opening Day roster here in 2024...SF's ace signed a contract extension in April 2023 that keeps him in a Giants uniform through the 2028 season.

LAST TIME OUT: Scuffled in his last outing against the Red Sox on Tuesday night at Fenway Park to start this road trip in SF's 4-0 loss...allowed four runs in a season-low matching 3.2 innings on the hill...struck out four and walked a season-high three batters while throwing 91 total pitches...Webb entered the start with a career-best 19.0 inning scoreless streak that was halted immediately in the 1st inning as Boston plated a run.

LAST FIVE: Even with his tough outing Tuesday in Boston, Webb still has a 1.93 ERA (7er, 32.2ip) in his last five starts dating to April 7 vs. San Diego...he's struck out 20 and walked six in that span...his 1.93 ERA since April 7 is fifth-best in the NL (min. 25.1ip) trailing STL's Sonny Gray (0.89), CHC's Shota Imanaga (0.94), PHI's Ranger Suárez (1.00) and ATL's Max Fried (1.37).

LET'S PLAY IN THE YARD: SF's righty enters today's game having not allowed a homer in his last 33.1 innings, the 11th-longest active streak in the Majors...he's only allowed one home run this year through six starts with a 0.6 HR% in 2024 (1 homer to 175 batters faced)...last season, Webb had a 2.4 HR% after allowing a career-high 20 homers in 850 batters faced.

EL CAMBIO: Webb dominated hitters last year with his changeup, using the pitch 41.6% of the time with opponents hitting .225 with a .309 SLG% off the pitch...according to Statcast, Webb's changeup was the second-most valuable pitch in the Majors in terms of run value at +28...only the Yankees Gerrit Cole had a more valuable pitch (+29 with his four-seam fastball) ...in his first three starts of this season it was not as good with hitters batting .324 off the pitch and only two strikeouts...in three starts with it from April 13-23, he found it with hitters going 10-for-47 (.213) and five strikeouts...last time out against the Red Sox he gave up seven hits on the changeup and only recorded five outs with the pitch...Sox hitters were 7-for-11 in AB's that ended with the changeup last Tuesday.

VS. PHILADELPHIA: Faces the Phillies tonight for the first time since May 30, 2022 after not facing them at all in 2023...in fact, Webb has made both of his career starts against the Phillies in this ballpark...he's given up seven runs in 12.0 innings (5.25 ERA) over the two starts but SF has won both games...in that May 30, 2022 here he struck out 10 Phillies without a walk while allowing three runs in SF's 5-4 win in 10 innings.

BAND TOGETHER: The Giants as a team are 58-40 (.592) in Webb's 98 regular season starts since 2021...SF went 15-18 in his 33 starts in 2023 and gave him two or fewer runs of support in 22 of those 33 starts (66.7%)...Webb had the lowest run support average of any qualified starter in baseball last year (3.21)...Webb went 9-1 in 2023 when receiving at least three runs of support...SF is 4-3 in his seven 2024 starts and he's received more than three runs of support in two of those seven starts.

0-1 IS MUCH BETTER THAN 1-0: Webb's first pitch strike percentage is 66.9% through seven starts in 2024 but was hovering right near 70% entering his last start vs. Boston (69.9%)...in the Red Sox start, Webb only had a 45.5 first pitch strike percentage, his lowest in a start since June 20, 2022 at Atlanta (42.3%).

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Webb's 62.7% ground-ball rate led the Majors in 2023, and was up from 2022's 57.8% mark...his 62.7% mark last season also established a career-best, slightly upping his 62.2% total from his breakout 2021 campaign...through seven starts this year he owns a 59.7% ground ball rate (fourth-best in MLB entering play today)...below is a chart of Webb's groundball breakdown by start so far in 2024.

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 5/2 at BOS; S, 1.0ip, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Has pitched once in the last six days after throwing in three straight from April 26-28.
- ▶ Is 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA and 6-for-6 in save opportunities over his last 11 outings.
- ▶ Has struck out 15 batters over 11.2 innings of work (11.6 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 12 of his 15 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Righties are just 2-for-19 (.105) off him, while lefties are 7-for-25.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season and wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/3 at PHI; 2.0ip, 4k (28 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Three of his four outings with SF have been scoreless.
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ The 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/4 at PHI; 0.2ip, h, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Has made four appearances since being reinstated (5.0ip, 6h, 0r, bb, 3k).
- ▶ Batters are 8-for-21 (.381) with two walks and three strikeouts vs. Jackson in his six appearances at the MLB level this year.
- ▶ Allowed all four of his inherited runners to score so far in 2024.

#56 DAULTON JEFFERIES ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Changeup, Cutter, Curveball
