PITTSBURGH PIRATES (34-31) vs. ATLANTA BRAVES (44-21) June 7, 2026 - Truist Park - Atlanta, GA - 1:35 EDT - Game #66/Road #33 LHP Mason Montgomery (1-1, 4.74 ERA) vs. RHP Bryce Elder (5-3, 2.63 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have won two of the first five games on this six-game, seven-day road trip to Houston (2-1, June 2-4) and Atlanta (0-2, Friday-Sunday)...Have not lost three straight road games all season (they last did that when they lost five straight games away from PNC Park last season from August 31-September 12)...Will have the day off on Monday before beginning a six-game homestand vs. Los Angeles-NL (Tuesday-Thursday) and Miami (June 12-14)...Have scored the fourth-most runs (331) in all of Major League Baseball, behind Washington (351), Atlanta (341) and Los Angeles-NL (340)...Have 64 stolen bases, tied with Cleveland for the third-most in all of Major League Baseball, behind Miami (72) & Milwaukee (67).

DODGER DOMINANCE: Pittsburgh will host Los Angeles (NL) for three games at PNC Park this week (Tuesday-Thursday)...The Pirates swept the Dodgers in three games at PNC Park last season (September 2-4), their first sweep of the Dodgers in Pittsburgh since a three-game sweep from August 7-9, 2015...Pittsburgh has won four straight home series against Los Angeles (they also took two of three games from May 9-11, 2022, two of three games from April 25-27, 2023 and two of three games from June 4-6, 2024)...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the Pirates have won at least five straight home series against the Dodgers four times in series history...Those came from September 26, 1901-September 10, 1903 (eight straight series), July 21, 1910-July 27, 1911 (five straight series), June 17, 1925-July 24, 1926 (five straight series) & July 24, 1943-August 22, 1944 (five straight series).

PIRATING: The Pirates have stolen at least one base in six of their last eight games (since May 29 vs. Minnesota)...Pittsburgh's 15 stolen bases in that span lead Major League Baseball (New York-AL, 12 stolen bases, ranks second)...Oneil Cruz' 21 stolen bases this year rank fourth in Major League Baseball, behind Washington's Nasim Nuñez (23), Cleveland's José Ramírez (23) and Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. (23)...The Pirates' 86.5 stolen base percentage (64-for-74) is second in all of MLB, behind Philadelphia (87.7).

GOOD AS GONZO: Nick Gonzales went 2-for-4 with a double, an RBI and a run scored on Saturday at Atlanta, extending his hitting streak to eight straight games (since May 29 vs. Minnesota)...He is batting .424 (14-for-33) with two doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, two walks, 11 runs and a 1.124 OPS during the streak...Gonzales' streak is two games shy of his career-high, 10-game hitting streak, which he set from April 19-29...His .315 batting average (69-for-219) ranks seventh in all of Major League Baseball.

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz drew three walks and stole a base on Saturday at Atlanta...He is 13-for-38 (.342) with three home runs, 10 RBI, 12 walks, five stolen bases, eight runs and a 1.089 OPS over his last 12 games (since May 25 vs. Chicago-NL)...He ranks second throughout all of Major League Baseball in both OBP (.510) and walks and third in stolen bases during that stretch.

INDISPENCEABLE: Spencer Horwitz singled leading off Saturday's game at Truist Park, extending his on-base streak to 14 straight games (since May 23 at Toronto)...He is batting .296 (16-for-54) with a double, three home runs, four RBI, eight walks and eight runs during the streak...Horwitz' only longer such streak in his career was a 15-game streak last season from June 9-28.

LET'S GO REYNOLDS: Bryan Reynolds doubled and scored on Saturday at Atlanta, extending his on-base streak to 14 straight games (since May 23 at Toronto)...He is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with five doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, 11 walks, 12 runs and a 1.058 OPS during the streak...Reynolds ranks sixth in Major League Baseball in OBP (.475), tied for sixth in walks, tied for eighth in doubles and tied for ninth in runs in that time...It is his second on-base streak of at least 14 straight games this year (also March 31-April 15)...The last Pirates to have multiple such streaks in a season were himself and Andrew McCutchen in 2023.

K COLLECTORS: Pirates pitchers have at least seven strikeouts in 13 straight games (since May 24 at Toronto)...That is their second-longest such streak of the year (15 games, April 18-May 3)...Pittsburgh has struck out at least 10 batters in seven of the 13 games during the streak...The Pirates' 593 strikeouts rank fourth in Major League Baseball, behind Cleveland (605), Philadelphia (600) and Milwaukee (599)...They are also Pittsburgh's most through its first 65 games of a year in the Modern Era (since 1901).

INSTANT IMPACT: Tyler Callihan had an RBI double and a walk (he also stole his first Major League base) on Saturday at Truist Park...He is 2-for-6 with two doubles, two RBI, three walks, a stolen base and a run in four games since making his team debut on May 28 vs. Chicago (NL)...He has drawn a walk in each of his first three games with a plate appearance...The only Pirates in the 21st century to draw a walk in at least each of their first four games with a plate appearance in a season were Brian Giles (2003, four), Gregory Polanco (2016, six), Andrew McCutchen (2024, four), Joshua Palacios (2024, four) and Bryan Reynolds (2024, five).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

June 7, 2004: The Pirates selected 18-year-old catcher Neil Walker out of Pine-Richland High School with the 11th overall pick in the First-Year Player Draft. The switch-hitting catcher became the first player out of the WPIAL selected in the first round since Gateway High School's Tim Conroy in 1978. Walker went on to hit .272 (833-for-3063) over 836 regular-season games with Pittsburgh from 2009-15.

LAST TIME OUT: Montgomery pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief on Saturday afternoon at Atlanta...Today's outing at Truist Park will mark his third time pitching in back-to-back games (with one coming as a starter and one as a reliever) this season... Montgomery also did it on April 14 vs. Washington (reliever)/April 15 vs. Washington (starter), as well as on May 14 vs. Colorado (starter)/May 15 vs. Philadelphia (reliever).

THE SPLITS: Montgomery has struck out five batters over 3.0 scoreless innings of work in his three starts, which came on April 15 vs. Washington (1.0ip/1k), April 27 vs. St. Louis (1.0ip/1k) and May 14 vs. Colorado (1.0ip/3k)...He has posted a 5.40 ERA (21.2ip/13er) and 27 strikeouts over his 22 appearances out of the bullpen this season.

HIGHS AND LOWS: Montgomery had a 9.64 ERA (4.2ip/5er) in his first five games from March 26-April 5...He pitched 12.0 scoreless innings in 12 games (three starts) from April 10-May 14...He has a 9.00 ERA (8.0ip/8er) in his last eight games (since May 15).

SUNDAY FUN: Montgomery has a 1.69 ERA (5.1ip/1er) & nine strikeouts in four Sunday games...He tossed 1.2 scoreless innings in his last Sunday outing (May 24 at Toronto).

FIRST TIME: Montgomery pitched 1.0 inning in his first Major League start on April 15 vs. Washington (his 75th Major League game)...It was his first start at any level since August 4, 2024 with Durham (Rays' Triple-A) vs. Memphis (made 74 minor league starts from 2021-24)...Montgomery also pitched in relief in Pittsburgh's game on April 14 vs. Washington...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he was one of six Pirates in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to pitch in relief one game & start the team's next game, joining Bob Friend (July 9-13, 1961), Billy O'Dell (Sept. 26-28, 1966), Bruce Kison (June 2-3, 1979), Pat Mahomes (August 24-26, 2003) & Kevin Correia (August 19-20, 2012).

WELCOME TO TOWN: Montgomery was acquired from Tampa Bay, along with infielder Brandon Lowe and outfielder Jake Mangum, in a three-team, six-player trade last year on December 19...The Pirates sent right-handed pitcher Mike Burrows, who had a 3.94 ERA (96.0ip/42er) in 23 games (19 starts) last year, to Houston in the deal.

K COLLECTOR: Montgomery struck out 63 batters over 46.0 innings in 2025...The 63 strikeouts were the fourth-most among all left-handed rookie relief pitchers in Major League Baseball (they also ranked 11th among all rookie relief pitchers in the league).

2025 IN REVIEW: Montgomery went 1-3 with a 5.67 ERA (46.0ip/29er) in 57 appearances with Tampa Bay last year (his first full season in Major League Baseball)... He secured his first Major League save on May 13 at Toronto, while also earning his first Major League win on June 18 vs. Baltimore...Montgomery also went 1-0 with two saves, a 2.00 ERA (9.0ip/2er) and 15 strikeouts over nine games with Triple-A Durham.

RAISE IT UP: Montgomery struck out all six batters he faced on September 24, 2024 at Detroit (his eighth Major League appearance)...He joined Jorge Sosa (June 22, 2004 at Toronto) as the only relievers in Rays history (since 1998) to record at least six strikeouts in 2.0 or fewer innings (he was also the only one to not allow a baserunner).

MEET MASON: Montgomery was originally selected by Chicago (AL) out of Leander (TX) High School in the 39th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, but he did not sign...He attended Texas Tech University (he had 128 strikeouts during his time there from 2019-21) before being selected by Tampa Bay in the sixth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft...His father, Bobby, played collegiately at Howard Payne (TX) College.

 Hit a two-run blast on 5/31 vs. Minnesota (first home run since last season on 7/28 at San Francisco & first at home since 6/6/24 vs. Los Angeles-NL).
