THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 5
1971: Houston shows off their new orange and navy uniforms in a 5-2 Opening Day win against Los Angeles...**Larry Dierker** earns the complete-game victory.
2006: **Craig Biggio** scores his 1700th run in a 6-5 win vs. the Marlins...Biggio also moves into 10th place all-time with his 606th double.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros continue their 10-game road trip with the third game of a three-game series against the Athletics at Sutter Health Park in West Sacramento, CA...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** will be on the mound for the Astros this afternoon opposite **LHP Jacob Lopez** and the Athletics.

ABOUT MCCULLERS: **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** is set to make his second start of the season...in his season debut against the Boston Red Sox on March 30, he allowed one run on four hits and one walk with nine strikeouts in seven innings...was his longest outing since Sept. 21, 2022 at TB, where he also went 7.0 innings...was his first quality start and win since July 4, 2025 at LAD...he made his return to the mound in 2025 after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...he worked around four IL stints in 2025 to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP in 16 games (13 starts).

JOE'S RETURN TRIP: This series is a return trip to West Sacramento for Astros manager **Joe Espada**, who played for the Triple A Sacramento River Cats for part of the 2000 season as an A's minor leaguer...this series is especially unique for Espada, who played in the first-ever game at Sutter Health Park on May 15, 2000...Espada started at second base that game, going 1x3 with a double in the River Cats 2-1 loss to the Edmonton Trappers, then the Triple A affiliate of the Angels.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 12 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (982), trailing only the Dodgers (1,042).

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market...they also added a Rule 5 pick in **RHP Roddery Muñoz**, the Astros first Rule 5 selection since the 2017 Rule 5 Draft.

AT THE HELM: Manager **Joe Espada** is in his third season as the Astros skipper...in 2025, for the second consecutive season, Espada and his staff were forced to deal with an extremely high number of injuries...despite an ever-changing roster that often was missing key players, to his credit, Espada managed to navigate his club to an 87-75 record, finishing in a tie for the final AL Wild Card berth (lost tiebreaker to DET).

SATURDAY SHUTOUT: The Houston Astros recorded their first shutout victory of the season, yesterday against the Athletics at Sutter Health Park by a score of 11-0...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** (5.2 IP, 3 H, 3 BB, 9 K) recorded his first Major League win...**C Christian Vázquez** (3x6, 2 2B, 2 RBI), **1B Christian Walker** (3x6, HR, 3 R, 2 RBI) and **RF-LF Joey Loperfido** (3x4, 2 R, 2 RBI, 2 BB) each recorded a three-hit game.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE: The Houston Astros placed **RHP Hunter Brown** on the 15-day IL today (retro 4/2) due to a right shoulder strain...to take his place on his active roster, Houston recalled **RHP Christian Roa** from Triple A Sugar Land.

AGAINST THE ATHLETICS: The Astros and A's are facing each other today for the third of 13 scheduled games in 2026...the Astros went 5-8 vs. the A's in 2025, including a 3-4 record at Sutter Health Park...the Astros have own a 121-107 all-time record against the Athletics.

MR. 500: **LF Yordan Alvarez** recorded his 500th career RBI on Friday night on a sac-fly RBI in the third inning...became the 15th player in franchise history to record 500 RBI...is also the fastest player in franchise history to record 500 career RBI doing so in just 685 games, passing **1B Jeff Bagwell**, who recorded 500 RBI in 717 games.

WALK THIS WAY: **LF Yordan Alvarez** walked a career-high tying four times yesterday at ATH...marked the second time in his career, he's recorded a four-walk game, also Aug. 20, 2019 vs. DET...Alvarez also tied the franchise record for walks in a nine inning game...the last Astros player to record four walks in a nine inning game was **3B Alex Bregman** on June 3, 2023 vs. LAA...**1B Jeff Bagwell** holds the franchise record for walks in a single game with six on Aug. 20, 1999 at MIA, but the game went 16 innings.

YORDAN'S UPCOMING MILESTONES: **LF Yordan Alvarez** has recorded 173 career home runs, which makes him just one home run shy of matching franchise icon **OF George Springer** (174 HR) for the seventh on the Astros all-time list.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Astros lead the Majors in runs (60), doubles (27) total bases (147), hits (87), walks (50), (OBP (.391), SLG (.479) and OPS (.870)...individually, **LF Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in OBP (.590) and OPS (1.474), while ranking tied for first in runs (9)...**1B Christian Walker** leads the Majors in doubles (6).

HOT START: The Astros have scored 60 runs this season, which is the most in the Majors...the 60 runs are also the second-most in the first nine games to begin a season in franchise history, behind only the 2004 season, where the Astros scored 66 runs.

DOWN ON THE FARM: The Astros Single A affiliate Fayetteville Woodpeckers defeated the Wilson Warbirds, 6-5 yesterday at SEGRA Stadium...Astros number one overall prospect, **OF Kevin Alvarez** went 4x5 with two runs, two RBI and a double...Astros number seven overall prospect **RHP Ethan Pecko** made a rehab start in the game, allowing two hits and striking out four in two scoreless innings.

SEASON DEBUT: Had a spectacular debut to his 2026 season, striking out 9 over 7.0 innings while allowing just 1 run on 4 hits with 1 walk (96 pitches-63 strikes)...was his longest start since also tossing 7.0 innings on Sept. 21, 2022 at TB...was his longest start while allowing 1-or-fewer runs since allowing 1 run through 7.0 innings on July 16, 2021 at CWS...was his longest start in a season debut in his 9-year MLB career and were his most strikeouts in a season debut since striking out 10 batters on March 31, 2018 at TEX...is also the longest start by an Astro and tied for the longest start by an AL pitcher this season.

VS. THE A'S: Including the postseason, has gone 7-3 with a 3.58 ERA (35ER/88IP), 103 strikeouts (10.53 SO/9IP) and a .232 opponent batting average through 16 career starts vs. the A's...his 16 starts vs. the A's (including the postseason) are tied with former teammate **LHP Framber Valdez** for the 3rd-most among active players...in his lone start vs. the A's last season, he matched his single-game career high by striking out 12 batters in just 6.0 innings of work while allowing 3 runs on 5 hits on May 28 at Daikin Park.

ELITE COMPANY: since at least 1901, his 10.53 SO/9IP vs. the A's (including postseason) ranks 4th all time (min. 80 IP), trailing only **RHP Pedro Martinez** (11.29), **RHP Nolan Ryan** (10.99) and **LHP Randy Johnson** (10.61).

2025 RECAP: Made his return to the mound after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...worked around four IL stints to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP through 16 games (13 starts)...made his season debut on May 4 at CWS, marking his first appearance on a Major League mound since Game 3 of the 2022 World Series in Philadelphia, a span of 915 days...logged his 50th career win on June 3 at PIT...became the 23rd pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark...ended the season with 51 wins, directly trailing **RHP Mark Portugal** for No. 22 on the franchise's all-time list.

GROUNDNED: is one of the game's elite groundball pitchers...his 55.4% ground-ball rate ranks 3rd in the Majors among active pitchers since 2015 (min. 700 IP)...trails only **LHP Framber Valdez** (62.4%) and **RHP Logan Webb** (57.9%).

ABOUT MCCULLERS JR.: the 2017 All-Star has made 147 apps. (141starts) in 9 MLB seasons with Houston (2015-18, 2020-22, 2025-26), posting a 52-37 record with a 3.68 ERA (319ER/781IP) and 870 strikeouts (10.03 SO/9IP)...missed the 2023-24 seasons due to injury.

ROAD WARRIOR: On the road in 2025, he recorded a 2.59 ERA (9ER/31.1IP) with 26 strikeouts, two quality starts and a .230 opponent batting average.

MILESTONE WATCH: is 1.0 inning from matching **RHP Ryan Pressly** for the 11th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...is also 5.0 innings from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** for 10th-most.

VS. ATH: has made 31 career appearances vs. the Athletics, which are the most by a reliever among active MLB players, just 1 ahead of former teammate **RHP Ryan Stanek**...has gone 3-3-1 with a 1.98 ERA (8ER/36.1IP), .151 opponent batting average, 0.85 WHIP and 42 strikeouts (10.4 SO/9IP) in his regular-season career vs. the A's.

CAREER: has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last seven seasons (2019-25)...owns a 16-12 record with 17 saves, a 2.77 ERA (102ER/332IP) and 454 strikeouts in 332.0 Major League innings...among relievers in club history, ranks fourth in strikeouts (454), seventh in appearances (320) and 12th in innings (332.0).

LAST APPEARANCE: worked a perfect 1.0 inning on Wednesday vs. BOS, striking out 1 batter (14 pitches, 10 strikes)...has posted a 0.37 ERA (1ER/24.1IP), 0.66 WHIP and .100 opponent batting average (8x80) over his last 11 appearances dating back to last season (since Aug. 31, 2025).

OPENING DAY: made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season...pitched on Opening Day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball, allowing his only run on a solo homer by Mike Trout...dazzled hitters with an uptick in velocity, including throwing a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of Yoan Moncada...marked the hardest pitch thrown in his career.

2025 SEASON: went 3-1 with a 1.69 ERA (6ER/32IP), a 0.88 WHIP, .152 opponent average and 9.84 SO/9IP through 11 Major League appearances (three starts)...also made 22 total appearances (19 starts) with Triple A Sugar Land this season, going 5-8 with a 5.27 ERA (58ER/99IP)...recorded a 21.0-inning scoreless streak from Aug. 23 through the end of the 2025 season.

ABOUT BLUBAUGH: entered the 2026 season as the Astros No. 4 prospect and as having the "Best Slider" according to *Baseball America*.
