NOS VEMOS, MIAMI: The Chicago Cubs today continue their seven-day, six-game road trip against the Miami Marlins (1-1) and the Cincinnati Reds (May 23-25) ... Chicago today will play the rubber match against Miami (1-1) and wrap up their season series against the Marlins ... last night the Cubs slugged their way to a 14-1 victory, scoring eight runs in the sixth inning and five runs in the ninth with 21 total hits on the night ... **Seiya Suzuki** and **Kyle Tucker** recorded their 12th and 11th home runs of the season, respectively, finishing the night with three hits each, including four RBI by Suzuki and Tucker's 300th-career extra-base hit ... **Justin Turner** also recorded three hits last night, his first three-hit game since Aug. 31, 2024 at Los Angeles-A.L. ... **Jameson Taillon** picked up his third win of the season, pitching 7.0 innings and allowing just one run on four hits.

- © The Cubs are currently in first place in the N.L. Central, 2.0 games ahead of second-place St. Louis.
- © The Cubs are 11-7 in the month of May.
- © Following their road trip, the Cubs will host the Colorado Rockies (May 26-28) and the Cincinnati Reds (May 30-June 1) at Wrigley Field.

VS. MIAMI: The Cubs and Marlins square off against each other for the second time this season (3-2), concluding the six-game season-series this week at loanDepot Park (1-1) ... Chicago is 122-114 all-time vs. Miami (since 1993), including 54-58 in Miami and 19-22 at loanDepot Park (since 2012).

- © Chicago went 4-3 against Miami in 2024, splitting a four-game series at Wrigley Field and taking two of three in Florida.
- © Chicago is 13-15 against Miami since 2021, after going 19-9 from 2016-19.
- © Cubs manager **Craig Counsell** played three seasons for the Florida Marlins from 1997-99, winning the 1997 World Series with the club ... he scored the walk-off run in Game 7 of the World Series on **Edgar Renteria's** single.

YOU GET A HIT! YOU GET A HIT!: Last night the Cubs tallied 21 hits, the team's third 20-plus hit game this season ... Chicago is the only team in the majors to achieve the feat more than once ... **Pete Crow-Armstrong's** 55 hits lead the club and are good for sixth-most in the N.L.

MANY, MANY RUNS: The Cubs have scored at least three runs in an inning 42 times this year, including seven such innings in the last five games, which is the most for the franchise through 49 games since 1930 (43 times) ... what's more, Chicago has scored four-plus runs in an inning 24 times this season, tying the most times the Cubs have achieved the feat since 1887 and the most since 1885 (35 times) through the first 49 games of the season. (credit: Ed Hartig).

- © In addition, Chicago has recorded at least five runs in an inning 14 times, the most since 1887 when the club recorded 5+ runs 15 times.
- © The Cubs lead the majors in runs scored (291) ... Chicago's 291 runs scored in their first 49 games are the third-most to start a season since 1901 (also 1929-294 runs scored and 1930-315 runs scored).
- © The Cubs have three players that rank in the top-10 in the majors in runs scored this season with **Pete Crow-Armstrong** ranking fifth (38 runs), **Kyle Tucker** tied for sixth (37 runs) and **Dansby Swanson** coming in at tied for eighth (35 runs) ... Chicago's three players in the top-10 are the most out of any team in the majors.

EVEN MORE RUNS!: Last night, the Cubs recorded their 10th game of the season with at least 10 runs scored ... the last time the Cubs had at least 10 games with 10+ runs scored through the first 49 games was in 1898 (11 times).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Chicago hitters have grounded into double plays 21 times this season, tied with the Boston Red Sox for the fewest in the majors this season ... the club's 21 double plays in their first 49 games of the season are the lowest in team history (since 1901).

- © On the defensive side, the Cubs have turned the second-most double plays (42) in the National League, also good for the sixth-most in the majors.
- © **Michael Busch** (33), **Dansby Swanson** (31) and **Nico Hoerner** (25) rank second, fourth and eighth in the National League in infield double plays, respectively.

RIBBIES!: The Cubs' pace the majors with 285 RBI this season ... **Seiya Suzuki** is tied with Aaron Judge for the major league lead in ribbies (43) and Pete Crow-Armstrong is tied for the fourth with 39.

- © Chicago's 285 RBI through their first 49 games of the season are the second-most in team history (since 1901) and the most since 1930, when they tallied 298 in their first 49 games.

PICKING RIGHT: Chicago's pitchers are tied for the second-most pickoffs in the National League with six ... their six pickoffs are tied with the Baltimore Orioles and the San Francisco Giants for the third-most in the majors.

- © **Matthew Boyd** is tied with Max Fried and Sean Burke for the third-most pickoffs in the majors (3).

THE EARLY BIRD GETS THE WORM: The Cubs own a .421 batting average (88-for-209) on the first pitch of at-bats, the highest in the majors ... the Cubs also lead the majors with 62 RBI, rank seventh in slugging percentage (.679) and are tied for the ninth-most home runs (11) on the first pitch.

- © **Miguel Amaya** is hitting .545 (6-for-11) on the first pitch and is tied with teammate **Pete Crow-Armstrong** for the seventh-most RBI in the majors (10) ... **Kyle Tucker** is tied for the fourth-most home runs (4) on the first pitch and, among major league players with min. 25 games, **Carson Kelly** has the second-highest batting average (.714/5-for-7).

LIVING ON THE EDGE: The Cubs lead the majors in two-out extra-base hits (59) and RBI (106) ... Chicago is also tied for the second-most homers with two outs (20) and ranks third in runs scored (109) and average (.265, 152-for-573) with two outs.

- © With two outs, Chicago has three players hitting over .300, the most out of any team in the majors: **Nico Hoerner** (.348/24-for-69), **Kyle Tucker** (.333/18-for-54) and **Pete Crow-Armstrong** (.300/21-for-70) ... Hoerner's .348 average is the 10-highest among qualified players in the majors.
- © **Seiya Suzuki** leads the majors in two-out RBI with 21 and PCA is tied for the seventh with 16 ... what's more, Suzuki is also tied for the major league lead in home runs (6) on the final out of the inning.

- Is scheduled to make his second career start (third appearance) today vs. Miami.
- Has not walked a batter and has tallied seven strikeouts in 9.0 innings to begin his major league career.
- Is scheduled to make his first career appearance vs. the Marlins today.

2025 Notes:

- Joined Scott Effross (May 3, 2022) as the second pitcher in Cubs franchise history to make their first career start vs. the White Sox.
- Became the seventh pitcher in Cubs history (since 1901) to record a win in each of their first two major league outings (last - Jordan Wicks in 2023).
- Made his major league debut May 10 in New York vs. the Mets ... became the first Cub to earn a win in relief in their major league debut since Daniel Palencia (July 4, 2023 at Milwaukee).
- Made six starts with the I-Cubs prior to his selection, going 2-1 with a 1.24 ERA (4 ER/29.0 IP) ... his 1.24 ERA was the lowest in the International League (min. 6 GS) at the time of his selection.
- Has allowed one run or fewer and struck out at least five batters in all six of his starts this season at Triple-A.

Career Notes

- Cade is in his fourth professional season with the Cubs, first as a non-roster invitee to major league Spring Training.
- At the beginning of the 2025 season, was ranked by MLB Pipeline as the Cubs' No. 2 prospect and the No. 52 overall prospect in baseball.
- Was named the Cubs Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2023, after going 4-4 with a 2.65 ERA (26 ER/88.1 IP) and 117 strikeouts in 21 starts.
- Following the 2023 campaign, was named a Baseball America Minor League All-Star, All-MiLB Prospect Second Team and MiLB.com Organizational All-Star.
- Was selected by the Cubs in the first round (seventh overall) of the 2022 draft.
- Attended the University of Oklahoma, where he was originally committed to play both baseball and football ... graduated from Norman High School (Okla.)

- Signed by the Cubs as a minor league free agent with an invite to major league Spring Training on Feb. 18.

- Keller has made 11-straight appearances (12.1 IP) without allowing an earned run since April 25 ... the 12.1-inning streak marks the longest of his career as a reliever and the second-longest of his career overall (17.2 IP - Aug. 6-19, 2020).
