- The Nationals have 48 wins, tied for the most by a Nationals club prior to the All-Star break with the 2018 Nationals...The next highest win total belongs to the 2017 Nationals (52 wins).
- Washington will open the season's second "half" on Friday, July 17 against the Athletics in Sacramento...They will then travel to Colorado for a three-game series July 21-22 before returning home on July 24 for a weekend series against the Arizona Diamondbacks.

ROSTER MOVE

The Nationals recalled first baseman **Abimelec Ortiz** and designated left-handed pitcher **Matt Krook** for assignment on Sunday...Ortiz's first appearance will be his Major League debut.

- Ortiz, 24, joins the Nationals after hitting .239 with 17 doubles, 17 home runs, 60 RBI, 31 walks and 49 runs scored in 71 games for Triple-A Rochester this season...He ranks in Washington's system in doubles (T2nd, 17), RBI (2nd, 59), home runs (T3rd, 16), extra base hits (4th, 33) and slugging percentage (7th, .481).
- He is tied for second in all of Minor League Baseball with 92 home runs and third in RBI with 313 since the start of the 2023 season.

ALL STARS!

Nationals shortstop **CJ Abrams**, outfielder **James Wood** and left-handed pitcher **Foster Griffin** will represent the organization in the 2026 Major League Baseball All-Star Game in Philadelphia on July 14...Abrams was voted in by the fans and will start at shortstop for the National League, Wood was selected through player voting and Griffin was added to the roster yesterday...Abrams and Wood will make their second career All-Star appearance, while it will be the first for Griffin...See boxes to the right for a summary of their rankings this season.

POP FROM THE TOP

James Wood is 19-for-44 (.432) with a .576 on-base percentage (15 BB, 8 SO) and a 1.023 slugging percentage (3 2B, 3B, 7 HR) in his last 12 games...He's reached safely in 30 of his last 45 plate appearances (17 H, 13 BB, 3 SO).

- He clubbed his Major League leading ninth leadoff home run on Saturday vs. New York...His nine leadoff homers are tied for the most in a season in Nationals history (2005-pres.) with **Alfonso Soriano** (9 in 2006).

HOMERS EVERYWHERE

The Nationals have clubbed 99 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball and 14 more than the Phillies (85), Astros (85) and Pirates (85)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in Major League Baseball.

- Washington's 136 home runs are second-most in Major League Baseball behind the Yankees (142) and the second most in team history (2005-pres.) through 96 games behind only the 2017 Nationals (142 HR).
