RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a season-long, 10-game, 10-day homestand against the Nationals (2-1), Royals (0-1, three to play), and Diamondbacks (three to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...are 6-7 in their last 13 games (June 8–pres.) since dropping 10 of their previous 13 (May 24–June 7), which came on the heels of a 22-4 stretch (April 22–May 22)...have lost 7.5 games on the AL East-leading Yankees during that timeframe, whom they now trail by 2.0 games for the division lead...are 2-2 on a stretch of 23 games in 24 days leading into the All-Star break (June 19–July 12), with the lone off day coming on June 29...had the best record in the AL for 35 straight days between May 9–June 12, which included eight consecutive days atop the majors from May 18–25...have spent 41 days in first place in the AL East, 35 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- ★ The Rays dropped the series opener with the Royals last night, 2-1...despite the loss, they have still won eight of their last 10 series openers at Tropicana Field.
- ★ Each of their last five losses have been by one run, with eight of their 12 losses in June coming in one-run contests...only the Tigers have lost more one-run game in a month this season, dropping nine in May.
- ★ **Drew Rasmussen** suffered the loss in his ninth quality start of the year...he is 2-2 despite a 1.00 ERA (27.0IP, 3ER) in the month of June...Rasmussen ranks highly in June among AL arms in several categories (see table on the right).
- ★ The Rays pitching staff allowed four hits in the loss, their fewest in a loss since Aug. 25, 2025 at CLE (3H) and their fewest in a loss at home since Aug. 14, 2024 vs. HOU (2H).
- ★ Each of the last eight meetings (July 4, 2024–pres.) between the Rays and Royals have been taken by the visiting team (see more in "Real Royalty" note below).
- ★ Tonight's probable starter, **Shane McClanahan**, enters the contest one strikeout shy of **Tyler Glasnow** (526) for eighth most in franchise history...see more in "Mac Attack" note below.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Today, the Rays acquired **RHP Chris Roycroft** from the Cardinals in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations...Roycroft was optioned to Triple-A Durham...to make room on the 40-man roster, **C Dom Keegan** has been designated for assignment.

- ★ Over three big league seasons (2024-26), Roycroft has made 54 relief appearances for the Cardinals to a 6.41 ERA (60.1IP, 43ER) with 52 strikeouts and 37 walks...he has posted a 15.19 ERA (5.1IP 9ER) in seven appearances over two major league stints this year (Opening Day–April 5 & June 12-17).
- ★ Keegan was selected by the Rays in the fourth round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt (Tenn.) University...in 51 games with the Bulls this season, he has hit .191 (34-for-178) with 1 3B, 6 HR, 23 RBI, and 6 SB.

MAC ATTACK—**Shane McClanahan** enters tonight's game with 39 career wins, one shy of tying **Jeremy Hellickson**, **Jeff Niemann**, **Jake Odorizzi**, and **Ryan Yarbrough** for seventh most in Rays history...he is also one strikeout shy of tying **Tyler Glasnow** (526) for eighth most in team history and is 45 strikeouts behind **Alex Cobb** for seventh most.

- ★ McClanahan has won each of his last five starts at Tropicana Field (April 6–pres.), tied for the third-longest streak in ballpark history and tied for the second-longest single-season streak (6x, last: McClanahan, May 17–June 9, 2022) behind only **Zach Eflin** (8G, April 1–June 23, 2023)...with a win tonight, he would tie **BAL/SEA Erik Bedard** (6G, April 10, 2006–April 8, 2008) for the second-longest streak in ballpark history.
- ★ The southpaw has made six starts this season with no extra-base hits allowed, tied for the most in the AL and tied for the second most in the majors...only **MIL Jacob Misiorowski** (9) has more such starts.

BALLOT BOXING—Yesterday, MLB announced the second voting update for 2026 All-Star balloting...**Junior Caminero** paces all AL third basemen with 1,310,879 votes, **Yandy Diaz** ranks third among AL designated hitters with 459,371 votes, and **Jonathan Aranda** is eighth among AL first basemen at 193,544 votes...all three are chasing their second career All-Star nods, with Caminero and Aranda aiming for their second consecutive selections...Caminero is looking to become the first Ray to start back-to-back All-Star games.

- ★ Caminero ranks highly among AL third basemen (min. 200PA, min 50% of games at 3B) in OPS (1st, .846), on-base pct. (2nd, .369), slugging pct. (2nd, .477), OPS+ (2nd, 133), hits (3rd, 78), home runs (3rd, 15), average (4th, .276), and RBI (4th, 34).
- ★ Diaz ranks highly among AL hitters in average (1st, .326), hits (2nd, 90), on-base pct. (3rd, .407), OPS (6th, .918), RBI (8th, 50), total bases (T8th, 141), and slugging pct. (10th, .511)...he has hit safely in 55 of 72 games and reached base safely in 67 of them.

ARANDA & ARAÑITA—Through the team's first 75 games this season, **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely 129 times and **Jonathan Aranda** has reached base 123 times...Diaz's 129 TOB are the most in team history through this point of the season, while Aranda's 123 TOB are tied for fifth most (see table on the right)...the duo have combined for 101 RBI (Aranda, 51 & Diaz, 50), the first Rays pairing to reach that mark through 75 team games since **Evan Longoria** (52) & **Carlos Peña** (49) in 2010...only four pairings have accomplished the feat in team history (Longoria/Peña in 2010 & 2009, **Fred McGriff**/**Gerald Williams** in 2000, **Jose Canseco**/**McGriff** in 1999).

- ★ Diaz (446) tied **Brandon Lowe** last night for seventh-most RBI in franchise history...he is one shy of **B.J. Upton** (447) and three shy of **Aubrey Huff** (449) for fifth most.
- ★ After going 0-for-11 in the series against the Tigers between June 1-3, Aranda has recorded a hit in 12 of 15 games (June 5–pres.) with four multi-hit contests and has reached base safely in 14 of the 15.

HOME SWEET HOME—The Rays MLB-leading 26-11 (.703) home record ties 2008 for the second-best home start in team history behind 2023 (30-7)...they have won 22 of their last 29 games at Tropicana Field...since May 13, the Rays are 12-7 at home (2nd in AL/T3rd in MLB) compared to 3-12 in road affairs (30th in MLB)...on the year, the 256-point discrepancy between their home (26-11/.703) and road (17-21/.447) winning percentages is the third largest in MLB behind the White Sox (.301) and Tigers (.279)...the Rays are in a stretch of 19 home games within a 28-game span from May 29–June 28, going 10-12 thus far (7-6 at home)...they have several notable active home streaks:

- ★ The Rays are 12-0 against the AL East at Tropicana Field, MLB's longest season-opening, home winning streak over division rivals since the 2009 Dodgers won their first 12 home games vs. the NL West...among AL clubs, only the 2003 Royals (13-0) have had a longer streak in the divisional era (since 1969)...they are 14-11 against all other opponents at home.
- ★ **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely in 20 straight home games (May 5–pres.), tied with **SD Fernando Tatis Jr.** for the longest active streak in the majors...he is slashing .408/.477/.763 (31-for-76) with 6 2B, 7 HR, and 23 RBI at Tropicana Field during that stretch.
- ★ **Kevin Kelly** has recorded 17 scoreless outings (18.0IP) at Tropicana Field, the third-longest season-opening streak at home by a Rays reliever behind **Jake McGee** (19G) in 2012 and **Trevor Miller** (17G) in 2008...per Stats Perform, the 18.0-IP streak at home is the third longest to begin the season in MLB this year, trailing NYY **Brent Headrick** (19.2, active) MIA **Tyler Phillips** (18.1), and is the longest to open a campaign in Rays history (see table on the right).

SPEEDING THE GAME UP—After starting the month 3-for-35 (.086) between June 1-17, **Chandler Simpson** is batting .375 (6-for-16) in his last four games (June 18–pres.)...with a hit tonight, he would extend his hitting streak to five games, tied for the seventh longest of his career (also: Aug. 19-24, 2025)...despite the skid to open June, he is still tied for ninth in the AL with 22 multi-hit games...Simpson swiped his first stolen base since May 11 at TOR earlier this homestand (June 20 vs. WSH), snapping a career-long 26-game streak without a stolen base (May 13–June 19).

REAL ROYALTY—The Rays and Royals will complete a seven-game season series over the course of 11 days from June 22–July 2...this marks the Rays first four-game series this season—they were scheduled to play four at Fenway Park from May 7-10, but the third contest of the series was postponed due to inclement weather...the Rays and Royals have split their last two season sets (3-3 in 2024-25), but the Rays have not lost a season series to Kansas City since 2017 (4-3), going undefeated in the previous seven (5-0-2; clubs did not meet in 2020)...dating back to July 4, 2024, the road team has won eight straight games between the Rays and Royals.

- ★ In 46 career games against the Royals, **Yandy Diaz** has slashed .305/.412/.504 (43-for-141) with 11 2B, 1 3B, and 5 HR...Diaz has hit safely in seven of his last eight games (April 29, 2025–pres.) against the club with 4 XBH (3 2B, 1HR) over that span.

TONIGHT'S START—Shane McClanahan will toe the rubber for his 15th start of the season and seventh at home...will be making his 89th career start and 47th at Tropicana Field...is seeking his first win this month (0-2 in June)...has yielded 2 ER or fewer in 10 of 14 starts...missed the last two years after his second Tommy John surgery wiped out his 2024 season and nerve-related issues sidelined him for 2025...selected by the Rays in the Compensatory Round (31st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of South Florida.

He enters tonight's start with 525 career strikeouts, one shy of tying **Tyler Glasnow** (526) for eighth in franchise history...among left-handers, he ranks fourth behind **David Price** (1,048), **Scott Kazmir** (874), and **Blake Snell** (648)...he is also 2 SO shy of reaching 300 career strikeouts at Tropicana Field—he would become the eighth pitcher in the ballpark's history to reach the mark. McClanahan is seeking his 40th career victory, which would tie four other pitchers for seventh most in club history: **Jeremy Hellickson**, **Jeff Niemann**, **Jake Odorizzi**, and **Ryan Yarbrough**...Snell ranks sixth with 42 wins...his 26 career wins at Tropicana Field are tied with **Scott Kazmir** for third in ballpark history to **James Shields** (47) and **Price** (35).

The Rays are 40-4 in his career when he receives three runs of support or more (6-0 in 2026) and 13-31 with two runs or fewer (2-6 in 2026).

LAST TIME OUT—Walked a career-high five batters and was unable to complete the 4th inning in his shortest start of the campaign on June 17, at LAD (ND, 3.2IP, 3H, 2ER, 5BB, 3SO)...spun a perfect 1st inning on 12 pitches and worked around a pair of baserunners to a scoreless 2nd...retired 3 of 4 BF in the 3rd to preserve a 0-0 stalemate...ran into trouble in the 4th, yielding a leadoff walk before retiring his next two batters...the next four Dodgers reached safely (1B, BB, 1B, BB) to chase McClanahan from the game after a 34-pitch inning, his second most in a frame this season behind the 3rd on April 25 vs. MIN (35)...was his fourth time in 88 career starts recording more walks than strikeouts, first since June 30, 2023 at SEA (3BB, 1SO)...it was his sixth time tossing 3.2 IP or fewer in a start.

McClanahan did not allow an extra-base hit for the sixth time in 14 starts, tied with rotation-mate **Griffin Jax** and **LAA José Soriano** for the most such starts in the AL...in all of MLB, only **MIL Jacob Misiorowski** (9) has more.

He has tallied 8 BB over three starts in June, and his 5.68 walks per 9.0 IP this month is the seventh-highest mark in the AL (min. 10.0IP)...he recorded 1.69 walks per 9.0 IP over six starts in May, second lowest among AL pitchers (min. 30.0IP)—only **CLE Gavin Williams** (1.36) had a better mark.

CROWNS CAPSULE—All three of McClanahan's previous starts opposite the Royals have come at Tropicana Field, most recently a 6-5 loss on June 22, 2023...he has a 2.30 ERA (15.2IP, 4ER) and 0.89 WHIP in the previous three starts, holding Kansas City hitters to a .164/.246/.255 (9-for-55) line, include a 6-for-46 (130) clip vs. right-handed batters...his first career scoreless start of 5.0 IP or more came against the Royals on May 27, 2021 (W, 5.0IP, 3H, OR, 6SO).

KC **Salvador Perez** is 1-for-7 (.143) with 4 SO lifetime vs. McClanahan, tying the southpaw's most career strikeouts against any batter who has never appeared for an AL East club...it matches **MIL Luis Rengifo**, **LAA Jorge Soler**, **Max Stassi**, and **LAA Mike Trout**.

McClanahan is 8-5 with a 3.12 ERA (86.2IP, 30ER) in 16 career starts opposite AL Central opponents...he has permitted 2 ER or fewer in seven straight starts against the division (Aug. 19, 2022-pres.), going 4-0 with a 2.39 ERA (37.2IP, 10ER) in those outings.

Half (4) of his eight intraleague starts have been scoreless, but he has a 4.19 ERA (19.1IP, 9ER) in his last four starts vs. the AL compared to a 0.87 ERA (20.2IP, 2ER) in his first four...overall, his five wins against the Junior Circuit are tied for fourth most among AL pitchers, one shy of co-leaders **CLE Joey Cantillo**, **TEX Nathan Eovaldi**, and **NY Yankees Will Warren** (all 6).

TROP TALK—McClanahan has won each of his last five starts at Tropicana Field, tied with nine other streaks, including his own run from May 17–June 9, 2022, for the third-longest streak in the ballpark's history...he trails streaks by **Zach Eflin** (8, April 1–June 23, 2023) and **Erik Bedard** (6, April 10, 2006–April 8, 2008)...McClanahan has turned in a 1.69 ERA (26.2IP, 5ER) during the streak, a stretch that included 20.2 consecutive scoreless innings in home games (April 6–May 18).

Min. 30.0 IP, his 2.05 ERA (45.0IP, 10ER) in home starts ranks fourth in the AL, trailing **CWS Davis Martin** (1.01), **LAA Walbert Ureña** (1.85), and **SEA Bryan Woo** (2.00).

Opponents have gone 3-for-25 (120) against him with RISP at the Trop compared to 15-for-43 (.349) in eight road starts.

KEEP THE CHANGE—He has held opponents to a .155 (13-for-84) clip on his changeup, third in the AL (min. 75AB) to teammate **Nick Martinez** (.133) and **LAA Walbert Ureña** (.153) and fifth in the majors, also trailing **ATL Martín Pérez** (.133) and **PHI Christopher Sánchez** (.140)...min. 100 swings, only four AL southpaws have better changeup whiff rates than McClanahan (35.9%); **DET Tarik Skubal** (47.0%), **ATH Jeffrey Springs** (40.7%), **CLE Parker Messick** (40.1%), and **CLE Joey Cantillo** (38.9%)...he has allowed only 1 XBH on his changeup: a **Taylor Ward** double on May 18 vs. BAL.

LIMITING THE LONG BALL—He has yielded only 2 HR across his last 56.0 IP and 1 HR in his last 23.0 IP...McClanahan has allowed only 3 HR in 14 starts overall, including 2 HR in his last 11 starts and 1 HR in his previous five...min. 50.0 IP, his 0.40 HR per 9.0 IP ranks second in the AL to **NY Yankees Max Fried** (0.15) and fifth in the majors...he has permitted only 1 HR over innings 1-4...he has not yielded a homer to a left-handed batter in any of his last 44 starts (July 31, 2022-pres.).

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS—Left-handed hitters have gone 6-for-46 (.133) against McClanahan, including 2-for-20 (.100) across his last eight starts...min. 40 AB, the .133 opp. average vs. LHB is tied for seventh lowest in the AL/tied for ninth in the majors...he has walked only two of 33 (6.1%) left-handed batters faced in his last 11 starts (April 19-pres.) while striking out 11 of them...excluding his start on May 1 vs. SF (3-for-6 vs. LHB), lefties are batting .077 (3-for-39) against him in his other 13 starts.

MASTERPIECE OF A MONTH—During May, McClanahan went 4-0 with a 1.41 ERA (32.0IP, 5ER) across six starts, the lowest ERA among AL pitchers (min. 30.0IP)...he also ranked highly among AL starters in WHIP (4th, 0.84), opp. on-base pct. (5th, .231), and run support average (6th, 7.03)...it signaled the fourth-lowest May ERA in franchise history (min. 30.0IP), trailing **Rich Hill** (0.78) in 2021, **Scott Kazmir** (1.15) in 2008, and **Jeremy Hellickson** (1.36) in 2011.

He was one of three MLB starters and the lone AL starter to post four starts or more of 5.0 scoreless innings or more in May, joining **MIL Jacob Misiorowski** (5GS) and **PHI Christopher Sánchez** (5GS).

He joined teammate **Nick Martinez** (1.52ERA/29.2IP, 5ER) as the only Rays duo in club history to both turn in a 1.55 ERA or lower during May (min. 25.0IP).
