PITTSBURGH PIRATES (14-16) vs. OAKLAND ATHLETICS (13-17)

APRIL 30, 2024 at Oakland Coliseum, Oakland, CA – 6:40 PDT – GAME #31/ROAD #19 RHP MITCH KELLER (2-2, 5.14 ERA) vs. LHP ALEX WOOD (1-2, 6.59 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...lost 5-1 in the opener of their three-game series at Oakland last night...Won nine of their first 11 games before losing nine of their next 11 from 4/9-21...Have been charged with one error in their last five games and three in their last eight contests...Have had six of their last eight games decided by one or two runs (are 5-3 in one-run

games and 2-5 in two-run contests this season)...Have gone 4-0 in extra innings this season, which is tied for the most wins in extra frames in MLB...It is Pittsburgh's longest win streak in extra-innings games to begin a season since 2012 (also 4-0)...The last start to a season with a longer streak was 1960 (7-0).

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Mitch Keller gets the start in the middle game of this series against Oakland...Keller had a no-decision (5.0ip/4r) in his last start Thursday against the Brewers at PNC Park.

GIMME FIVE: Mitch Keller tossed 5.0 innings on Thursday against the Brewers, giving him 37 straight starts of working at least 5.0 innings in a game...It's the longest active streak in all of MLB coming into today...It's also the longest streak by a Pirate since A.J. Burnett made 49 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings from May 8, 2012, to August 10, 2013.

LOVING LEFTIES: The Pirates have gone 6-3 in games started by opposing lefties...The Pirates began the 2024 campaign with five straight games against opposing left-handed starters, which was the first time in club history the Bucs faced a starting lefthander in each of their first five games...Bryan Reynolds comes into today tied with the fifth-best OPS (1.107) among all National League players against left-handed pitchers.

BACK AT THE BEST BALLPARK IN AMERICA: Tonight PNC Park will host the Pitt-WVU baseball game at 7 p.m. eastern time...lt will be the fourth time the two teams face each other at PNC Park (also 2019, 2022 and 2023)...The game will be televised on ESPN2 and broadcast on KDKA Radio.

CRUZING ALONG: Oneil Cruz has hit safely in each of his last seven starts after singling in his final at-bat last night...Cruz is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with a pair of doubles and two RBI in his last seven starts.

GO JOE: Coming into tonight Connor Joe has a triple-slash line of a .450 average, .522 OBP and .700 slugging percentage with runners on base this season...Joe ranks third in all of MLB in batting average and OBP and seventh in slugging percentage with runners on base...Courtesy of StatsPerform.

PIRATES AND YANKEES COMPLETE TRADE: The Pittsburgh Pirates today acquired minor league infielder Keiner Delgado from the New York Yankees as the player to be named from the March 29 trade of pitcher JT Brubaker...The 20-year-old Delgado was rated as the 20th-best Yankees prospect by MLB Pipeline at the time he was acquired by the Pirates.

START ME UP: Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded a 2.98 ERA (42.1ip/14er) in the team's last eight games...Pittsburgh's starting rotation ranks ninth in all of MLB in ERA (3.65), fifth in innings pitched (165.1) and 10th in batting average against (.238).

<u>CALL TO THE PEN:</u> Roansy Contreras and Kyle Nicolas recorded a combined five strikeouts in 3.0 scoreless innings Monday night...Pittsburgh's bullpen has recorded a 2.02 ERA (35.2ip/8er), 42 strikeouts and .197 batting average against in the team's last nine games.

THE RENEGADE: David Bednar has converted each of his last four save opportunities and comes into today with 66 as a member of the Pirates...Bednar's next save will tie him with Matt Capps for the eighth-most in team history.

LIKING ALIKA: Alika Williams brings an eight-game hitting streak into today, which is the longest by a Pirate this season (it's also tied for the fifth-longest active streak in the National League)...Williams is 8-for-24 during his current streak and has been held hitless just once this season.

KE'S TO THE GAME: Ke'Bryan Hayes singled in his first at-bat while batting leadoff on Monday for the second straight game (he hit leadoff 45 times in the starting lineup in 2023)...Hayes is now 11-for-34 (.324) in his last nine games.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 30, 1960: The Pirates scored 10 times in the second inning, beating the Reds 12-7 while extending their winning streak to eight games. The Pirates pounded out eight hits in the second inning, including two by Bill Mazeroski, who ended the game 4-for-5 with a home run and three RBI. Roberto Clemente also connected for his third homer of the year with a two-run shot in the second inning. The win improved Pittsburgh's record to 11-3 on the season.

QUINN PRIESTER: The 23-year-old righthander will make his third start of the season tomorrow afternoon in the finale of this three-game series and six-game road trip...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings but had a no-decision in the team's 3-0 walkoff loss Friday night at San Francisco...Allowed five runs (4er) in 4.1 innings while losing his season debut on 4/19 against the Red Sox...Began the season with Triple-A Indianapolis, where he went 1-1 with a 3.95 ERA (13.2ip/6er), 20 strikeouts and .226 batting average against in three starts...Entered this season rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh's No. 8 prospect...Was rated among Baseball America's top 100 prospects in both 2022 (No. 88) and 2021 (No. 58)...Made his big league debut last year on 7/17 against Cleveland and suffered the loss before winning each of his next two starts.
