THE TWINS: Have gone 0-4 on their six-game roadtrip, getting swept in Houston over the weekend, followed by a loss in Cincinnati last night...tonight, they will continue the trip with the second of three at Great American Ball Park and finish the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's finale, Minnesota will travel home to begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Brewers this weekend followed by four against the Mariners from Monday-Thursday. **✦** Twins have lost five-straight for the first time since June 4-8, 2024 (also 5)...they are looking to avoid losing six-straight for the first time since May 14-20, 2024, when they dropped seven-straight. **✦** Minnesota's last victory was one week ago, last Wednesday night, June 11 vs. Texas (6-2).

SEEING RED AGAIN: The Twins lost to the Reds last night by a score of 6-5, dropping their fourth-straight series opener...David Festa was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs (2 earned) on two hits in 3.2 innings pitched, with three walks and four strikeouts...the bullpen tied a season-high with five walks in 4.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, two coming from both Ryan Jeffers and Trevor Larnach...Byron Buxton hit his team-leading 12th home run of the season and Harrison Bader hit his seventh of 2025.

RED LIGHT SPECIAL: Minnesota and Cincinnati are playing each other for the 38th, 39th and 40th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 18-20 all-time against the Reds, going 7-11 in Cincinnati (6-6 at Great American Ball Park and 1-5 at Cinergy Field) and 11-9 in Minnesota (4-7 at Target Field and 7-2 at the Metrodome). **✦** Harrison Bader is hitting .294 (52-for-177) with seven doubles, 10 home runs, 28 RBI, 31 runs scored, 27 walks, a .396 on-base percentage and an .899 OPS in 70 career games vs. Cincinnati...10 home runs and 27 walks are his most against any opponent...in his last 16 games at Great American Ball Park, he is hitting .346 (18-for-52) with five home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.087 OPS. **✦** Willi Castro is hitting .308 (8-for-26) with one double, two home runs, five RBI and a .977 OPS in eight career games vs. the Reds...he has two home runs in his last three games here.

THE OTHERS: Twins have gone 7-9 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18) and 0-1 at Cincinnati...Twins are 5-2 vs. NL teams after starting the season 2-7...after this series, their next series against an NL opponent will be three against the Brewers at Target Field this weekend.

BUCK NATIONAL: In his last nine Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with one double, two triples, two home runs, five RBI and a .963 OPS...below are Buck's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1997):

WE'RE ON ONE: The Twins have gone 7-13 in one-run games this season, dropping each of their last seven: one at Kansas City (May 25), two in Seattle (May 31 & June 1), one vs. Toronto (June 7), two at Houston (Saturday and Sunday) and last night at Cincinnati...their last one-run win was on May 24 vs. Kansas City, a 5-4 victory at Target Field...they went 22-20 in one-run games in 2024.

SOUTHPAW STUFF: Today marks the 14th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 5-8 against lefty starters...they lost their last four games started by left-handers: May 25 vs. Kansas City (Kris Bubic), June 12 vs. Texas (Patrick Corbin), Sunday at Houston (Brandon Walter) and last night at Cincinnati (Andrew Abbott)...their last win was on May 23 vs. Kansas City, a game started by Noah Cameron. **✦** Byron Buxton is slashing .308/.378/.615 (.993 OPS) against left-handed pitchers this season...in his last 17 games vs. lefties, he is slashing .387/.459/.774 (1.234 OPS). **✦** Willi Castro is hitting .310 (18-for-58) with a .586 slugging percentage and a .920 OPS against lefties this season...over his last 11 games vs. lefties, he is hitting .458 (11-for-24) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs and a 1.480 OPS. **✦** Brooks Lee is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with an .840 OPS in his last nine games against LHP.

BREAKING BAD GOOD: Twins have posted a .301 wOBA against breaking pitches this season, the sixth-highest in baseball (league avg. .281)...additionally, they rank fifth in baseball in slugging percentage (.409) vs. breaking pitches and sixth in hits (150). **✦** Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with a .673 slugging percentage against breaking pitches...the slugging percentage ranks ninth-highest in baseball (min. 250 pitches). **✦** Kody Clemens has a .733 slugging percentage, second-best in baseball (min. 100 pitches).

SIMP-LEE THE BEST: Brooks Lee has hit safely in 16-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high...the streak is the longest by a Twin this season and the longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long as by Carlos Correa, who hit in 16-straight from June 26-September 18, 2024...the last longer than 16 was by Brian Dozier, who hit in 24-straight from September 22, 2017-April 23, 2018 — covering two seasons...the last by a Twin as long as a *single season* was also Dozier for 24 games, from August 27-September 22, 2016...the longest streak in baseball this season was 22 by Bobby Witt Jr., from April 8-May 1. **✦** During the current streak, Lee is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and an .879 OPS.

WILL POWER: In his last 27 games, Willi Castro is hitting .352 (32-for-91) with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 12 RBI, 11 walks, 17 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .427 on-base percentage, a .626 slugging percentage and a 1.054 OPS. **✦** In his last 11 road games, since May 30, he is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with five home runs, seven RBI, an .762 slugging percentage and a 1.199 OPS.

BIRTHDAY SHOUTS: Third base/outfield coach Tommy Watkins is celebrating his 45th birthday today...he shares a birthday with Pioneer Press beat writer Betsy Helfand, National Baseball Hall of Famer Lou Brock, former Twin Jason Castro, NBA Hall of Famer George Mikan and rock legend Paul McCartney.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2019, the Twins beat the Red Sox by a score of 4-3 in 17 innings, marking the longest game in Target Field's history...eight pitchers relieved starter Michael Pineda that night, combining to allow just two hits and one walk in 11.0 innings...Max Kepler hit the game-tying home run in the 13th and the walk-off single in the 17th, becoming the first player to have a game-tying RBI and a walk-off RBI in the 13th inning-or-later in the same game since Milwaukee's Willie Randolph on May 1, 1991.
