 Φ Ober is 0-1 in three career starts against the Reds, posting a 6.19 ERA (16.0 IP, 11 ER) with seven walks, 11 strikeouts and a .246 (15-for-61) opponent batting average.

 Φ Took his third loss of the season (and second consecutive loss) in Minnesota's 3-16 defeat in his last start on June 12 vs. Texas...allowed seven runs off six hits (career-high 4 HR), with a career-high six walks and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings.

 ₹ Recorded his third career balk and second of the season (also, May 25), which marks the Twins' seventh balk of the season, tying the Arizona Diamondbacks for most in the majors.

TWO STARTS AG0: Pitched on June 6 against the Blue Jays, opposite Paxton Schultz, taking the loss in Minnesota's 4-6 defeat, his first loss at home this season...allowed five runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 7.0 innings...retired nine of his first 10 batters before plunking Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (his third hit batter of the season), then allowing a two-run shot to Addison Barger in the fourth...in the fifth, allowed a two-run RB1 single to B0 Bichette, and finally a solo homer to George Springer in the sixth...marked his first 6.0-plus inning non-quality start of the season, and fourth of his career.
Retired the first six batters of the game in order on 15 pitches; needed 21 pitches to get through the first inning in his previous outing on May 31 in Seattle.
Caught B0 Bichette attempting to steal second base in the seventh inning, Ober's first pitcher caught stealing of the season and the third of his career.

WORKING THE BIG RED MACHINE: Ober is 0-1 in three career starts against Cincinnati, posting a 6.19 ERA (16.0 IP, 11 ER) with seven walks and 11 strikeouts...faced the Reds once in 2024, where he took the loss in Minnesota's 4-8 defeat, allowing five runs on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and six strikeouts in 6.2 innings.
His career 6.19 ERA is his third highest among teams he has faced at least twice, behind the Cardinals (12.15) and Rangers (7.32).
Ober is 5-5 in 20 career Interleague starts, posting a 5.37 ERA (104.0 IP, 62 ER) with 20 home runs, 31 walks, 95 strikeouts and a .249 (99-for-397) opponent batting average.
Is his second start at Great American Ball Park...in his last start in Cincinnati on June 22, 2021, he allowed four runs on six hits, two walks and two strikeouts in 4.1 innings.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 14 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .272/.314/.449 in 147 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .273/.335/.500 in 150 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.1 mph and a whiff rate of 21.7 compared to righties' 92.2 mph and 28.5 percent. posted all average one concern, and the percent. mph and 28.5 percent. **Φ** His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its highest since 2021, 29.8 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 54.2 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 37.9% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

 ♥ HIS 4-seamer and slider strikeout percentages are at all-time lows of 11.6 and 10.2 percent respectively, while his sweeper is at an all-time high of 36.4 percent.
 ♥ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 200 sliders, Bailey has the highest opponent batting average (.365) and slugging percentage (.635), third highest hard hit percentage (56.5) and third lowest strikeout percentage (10.2).

EXTENSION # 6-9: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is tied with Aaron Slegers (2017-18) and Alex Meyer (2015-16) as the second-tallest players to pitch for the Twins in franchise history (since 1901), trailing only Jon Rauch (6-11, 2009-10)...on average this season, Ober has released his pitches 7.4 feet off the mound, the eighth-longest extension in baseball, which puts him in the 98th percentile according to Baseball Savant...teammates Chris Paddack and Louis Varland also have one of the longest extensions in baseball (7.0 feet), both ranking in the 92nd percentile.

THRILL OF THE CHASE: Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owns a 33.3 chase percentage this season, ranking in baseball's 91st percentile; ranks second on the Twins pitching staff, behind Griffin Jax (41.4) who ranks first in all of baseball.

THE BEARDED NIGHTMARE: So far this season, Bailey is 3-1 in five night game starts, with a 3.30 ERA (30.0 IP, 11 ER), a .250 (29-for-116) opponent batting average, a .405 slugging percentage and a .678 opponent OPS; compared to 1-2 in nine daytime starts, with a 5.15 ERA (43.2 IP, 25 ER), a .287 (52-for-181) opponent batting average, a .519 slugging percentage and a .876 OPS.
