**AT A GLANCE:** The Yankees continue their final homestand of the season tonight with the final game of a three-game set vs. Toronto (0-2 thus far)...will also play a three-game series vs. Arizona this weekend (Fri.-Sun.)...went 5-2 on their recent seven-game road trip, winning three-of-four games at Boston and winning two-of-three at Pittsburgh.

- Have lost three straight games after winning their previous three games...are 6-4 in their last 10 games (since 9/10).
- **Have posted a 14-8 (.636) record since 8/28, tied for the second-best record in the Majors in that span**, trailing only Toronto (14-7, .667).
- Are 16-11 in their last 27 games (since 8/23).

**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Yankees fell to the Blue Jays, 6-1, on Wednesday at Yankee Stadium...**RHP Michael King** (7.0IP, 5H, 1ER, 0BB, 13K, 1WP) took the loss despite allowing just 1ER in 7.0IP and striking out a career-high 13 batters...**C Austin Wells** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 double 1HR, 1RBI) hit his first Major League home run with a solo shot in the ninth inning...**2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-3, 1BB) extended his on-base streak to nine games (since 9/12-G1)...**RF Aaron Judge** (0-for-2, 2BB) walked twice...**LF Oswaldo Cabrera** (2-for-4) recorded two of the Yankees' five hits...**Yankees relievers** allowed 5ER in 2.0 innings of relief (4H, 6BB, 1K, 2WP).

**AUSTIN POWERS:** **C Austin Wells** hit his first Major League home run on Wednesday with a solo shot in the ninth inning...five of his seven Major League hits have gone for extra bases (4 doubles, 1HR).

**GLEYBER DAY:** **INF Gleyber Torres** has reached base in each of his last nine games (since 9/12-G1), batting .333/.450/.455 (11-for-33) with 3R, 4 doubles, 4RBI and 7BB over that span.

- Has reached base multiple times in 13 of his last 20 games (since 8/28) and 15 of his last 24 games (since 8/24).
- Is batting .315/.408/.558 (52-for-165) with 27R, 13 doubles, 9HR, 22RBI, 24BB, 2HP and 5SB in 44 games since 8/1...has hit safely in 31 of those games and has reached base safely in 37 of those contests...**his .966 OPS since 8/1 is the seventh-highest in the AL (min. 140PA).**
- Since 7/6, is batting .309/.378/.523 (75-for-243) with 37R, 14 doubles, 1 triple, 12HR, 30RBI, 27BB, 2HP, 3SF and 6SB in 63G.
- Has recorded a career-high 63BB in 149G this season.
- Has hit .342/.366/.526 (26-for-76) with 10R, 5 doubles, 3HR, 17RBI, 3BB, 2SF and 1HP in his last 19 games against Toronto (since 5/11/22)...in his last 30 games vs. the Blue Jays (since 9/28/21), has hit .322/.344/.539 (37-for-115) with 15R, 7 doubles, 6HR, 23RBI, 4BB, 1HP and 2SF.

**ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge** has reached base in 29-of-67 plate appearances over his last 15 games (since 9/5), posting a .433 OBP in that span (11H, 18BB).

- Has reached base multiple times in 50 of his 98 games this year, including 38 of his last 69 games (since 5/12).
- Despite missing 51 games on the injured list this year, **his 32HR this season are the fifth-most in the AL and his 80BB rank sixth.**
- Since being reinstated from the injured list on 7/28, leads the AL with 45BB and ranks second in the Majors, trailing only Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber (55).

**FOR STARTERS:** **Yankees starters** have posted a 3.10 ERA (154.0IP, 53ER) in their last 29 games (since 8/20)...have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 26 of those 29 starts and 2ER-or-fewer in 21 of those starts.

**KING OF THE HILL:** **RHP Michael King** allowed just 1ER in 7.0IP on Wednesday...**his 13K were a career high and the most by a Yankee this season**...were the most by a Yankee since Gerrit Cole struck out 14 batters on 9/7/22 vs. Minnesota (Game 2).

- **Has recorded 30K over his last three starts (16.2IP).**
- His 7.0 innings and 101 pitches were also career highs (previous: 6.0IP on 4/4/21 vs. Toronto and 87 pitches on 9/14/23 at Boston-G1).
- **As a starter this season, has gone 1-3 with a 1.78 ERA (30.1IP, 6ER) and 45K.**
- **Since 7/21, has gone 2-3 with a 1.87 ERA (43.1IP, 9ER) and 64K in 16 games (seven starts).**

**WHERE'S WALDO:** **INF/OF Oswaldo Cabrera** is batting .313/.405/.469 (10-for-32) with 4R, 2 doubles, 1HR, 3RBI, 5BB and 1SB in his last nine games (since 9/10).

**BATTERS' EYE:** **Since the All-Star break, the Yankees lead the Majors with a 9.27 PA/BB ratio and a 4.05 pitches per plate appearance ratio**...prior to the All-Star break, ranked 20th in the Majors in PA/BB (11.90) and P/PA (3.86).

**HISPANIC HERITAGE COMMEMORATION:** The Yankees will host a Hispanic Heritage Commemoration for Spanish language media today...this event is a new, regular season-ending culmination of the monthly Spanish language press conferences that the Yankees have hosted throughout the last two decades and recognizes the gratitude the Yankees have for the Spanish language media in their service to fans and the community.

**COLE TRAIN:** **RHP Gerrit Cole** will make his 32nd start of the season and 299th of his career tonight...**is 13-4 with a 2.81 ERA (192.0IP, 60ER) and 208K in 31 starts this season.**...owns the lowest ERA in the American League and the second-lowest in the Majors, trailing only San Diego's Blake Snell (2.33)...*if he were to finish the season with the lowest ERA in the AL*, he would be the 10th Yankee (14th time) to win an AL ERA title...would join Rudy May (1980), Ron Guidry (twice: 1978 and '79), Whitey Ford (twice: 1956 and '58), Bobby Shantz (1957), Ed Lopat (1953), Allie Reynolds (1952), Spud Chandler (twice: 1943 and '47), Lefty Gomez (twice: 1934 and '37) and Wilcy Moore (1927).

- **Has allowed 2R-or-fewer in 24 of his 31 starts this season**, tied with San Diego's Blake Snell for the most such starts in the Majors...**is one of just three pitchers in franchise history to record at least 24 starts of 2R-or-fewer in a single season**, joining Jack Chesbro (28 in 1904) and Ron Guidry (26 in 1978).

- Ranks second in the Majors in ERA (2.81, first in AL) and quality starts (22, first in AL), third in winning percentage (.765, second in AL), WHIP (1.05, third in AL), innings pitched (192.0, first in AL) and opponents' OPS (.610, first in AL), tied for fourth in starts (31, tied for first in AL), fifth in strikeouts (208, third in AL), opponents' OBP (.273, fourth in AL) and opponents' SLG (.337, second in AL), seventh in opponents' BA (.217, second in AL) and tied for eighth in WAR (4.4, tied for third in AL - FanGraphs)...also ranks fourth in the AL in BB/9.0IP (2.25) and HR/9.0IP (0.94), tied for fifth in wins (13) and sixth in K/9.0IP (9.75) and K/BB (4.33).

- **Has allowed more than 3R just five times this season**, allowing 27 of his 63R in those five starts...**in his other 26 starts, has allowed just 36 runs, averaging just 1.38 runs per game in those starts.**

- Tonight will mark the 15th time this season Cole has started after a Yankees' loss...the Yankees are 11-3 in those games with Cole going 7-2 with a 2.72 ERA (89.1IP, 27ER) in those starts.

- **The Yankees are 21-10 in his starts this season...the Yankees' 21 wins in Cole's starts match the third-most by any team in the Majors in a pitcher's starts** (tied for second-most in AL), trailing only Atlanta's 24 wins in Spencer Strider's starts and Baltimore's 23 wins in Dean Kremer's starts.

- **According to Elias, his 2.81 ERA is the lowest by a Yankees starter through his first 31 starts of a season in the last 45 years (since 1979)**...the last Yankee to record as low of an ERA through 31 starts was Ron Guidry in 1978 (1.71)...**the last time a qualified Yankee finished a non-strike season with as low of an ERA was 1980 when Rudy May recorded a 2.46 ERA in 41 games/17 starts** (Tommy John had a 2.63 ERA in 20 starts in 1981 and Ron Guidry posted a 2.76 ERA in 23 games/21 starts in 1981).

- **Needs 8.0IP to reach 200.0 innings for a second straight season and for the sixth time in his career** (2015, '17-19, '22)...would be reaching the 200.0IP mark for the fifth time in his last six 162-game seasons...would be the only pitcher to throw at least 200.0 innings in five different seasons since 2017...no other pitcher has recorded more than three such seasons in that span...would also be the only Major League pitcher to record six such seasons since 2015 (no other pitcher has more than four in that span)...is the only Yankee in the last 10 years (since 2014) to throw at least 200.0IP in a season and would be the first to do so in back-to-back seasons since CC Sabathia (five straight from 2009-13) and Hiroki Kuroda (2012-13).

- **Has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 24 of his 31 starts, the most such starts in the AL and the second-most in the Majors**, trailing only San Francisco's Logan Webb (26)...has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 12 of his last 14 starts (since 7/2) and in 17 of his last 20 starts (since 5/28).

- **His next win will mark his 50th win as a Yankee.**
- Has gone 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (31.2IP, 6ER) and 38K over his last five starts (since 8/25)...has allowed 2R-or-fewer in each of those five starts...has walked just five of his 123BF over that span...the Yankees are 5-0 in those games.

**GOT YOUR NUMBER: OF Aaron Judge** has hit .364/.423/.727 (8-for-22) with 2 doubles, 2HR and 3BB in his career against Toronto's RHP José Berríos...**INF DJ LeMahieu** has hit .368/.368/.526 (7-for-19) with 3 doubles vs. Berríos...**INF/OF Oswaldo Cabrera** has hit .556/.556/.778 (5-for-9) with 2 doubles against Berríos.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP GERRIT COLE (13-4, 2.81 ERA)

**RHP Gerrit Cole** will make his 32nd start of the season in tonight's series finale vs. Toronto...the 33-year-old will start on extended five days' rest due to Monday's team off day...last started on Friday at Pittsburgh and did not record a decision in the Yankees' 7-5 win despite allowing 2R/ER in 5.0IP (6H, 3BB, 4K, 0HR)...**is 13-4 with a 2.81 ERA (192.0IP, 60ER) and 208K in 31 starts this season...owns the lowest ERA in the American League and the second-lowest in the Majors**, trailing only San Diego's Blake Snell (2.33)...**has allowed 2R-or-fewer in 24 of his 31 starts this season, tied with San Diego's Blake Snell for the most such starts in the Majors**...started for the American League in the 93rd Midsummer Classic on 7/11 and retired all 3BF, becoming the 12th pitcher in franchise history (20th time) to start an All-Star Game...was named to his sixth career All-Star team via the player ballot...reached 10 years of Major League service on 5/29...recorded his 2,000th career strikeout on 5/23 vs. Baltimore (Jorge Mateo swinging), becoming the third-fastest pitcher in Major League history to reach the milestone (in terms of games and innings pitched)...his Major League-leading 257K last season were the most by a Yankees pitcher in a single season in franchise history, surpassing Ron Guidry's previous record of 248K in 1978...the six-time All-Star (2015, '18-19, '21-23) has finished in the top-five of Cy Young Award voting five times (second in 2021, fourth in 2020, second in 2019, fifth in 2018, fourth in 2015)...his career 10.45 K/9.0IP ratio (2,138K/1,842.0IP) is the eighth-highest in Major League history (min. 1,000.0IP)...in 106 starts with the Yankees, is 49-23 with a 3.14 ERA (647.0IP, 226ER) and 802K...since 2018, leads the Majors in wins (84), strikeouts (1,404), and innings pitched (1,059.2), ranks second in K/9.0IP (11.92), tied for second in WAR among pitchers (27.6 - FanGraphs), third in winning percentage (.718, min. 60 decisions), fourth in opponents' BA (.205), WHIP (1.00) and K/BB (5.24), and seventh in ERA (2.96)...was originally selected by the Yankees in the first round (28th overall) of the 2008 MLB First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play at UCLA for three seasons (2009-11)...was the first overall pick of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft, the 15th pitcher (and 11th right-hander) to be chosen first...is the fifth player selected first overall to play for the Yankees, joining Alex Rodriguez, Darryl Strawberry, Tim Lincecum and Ron Blomberg...signed a nine-year contract extending through the 2028 season with a player opt-out following the 2024 season on 12/18/19.

**LAST START:** Did not record a decision despite allowing just 2R/ER in 5.0IP on Friday at Pittsburgh (6H, 3BB, 4K, 0HR)...marked his first start at PNC Park as an opposing pitcher...allowed a run in the first inning on a sac fly to Jack Suwinski and a run in the second inning on an RBI single to Bryan Reynolds.

**ON A ROLL:** Has gone 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (31.2IP, 6ER) and 38K over his last five starts (since 8/25)...has allowed 2R-or-fewer in each of those five starts...has walked just five of his 123BF over that span...the Yankees are 5-0 in those games.

**EYES ON 200: Needs 8.0IP to reach 200.0 innings for a second straight season and for the sixth time in his career** (2015, '17-19, '22)...would be reaching the 200.0IP mark for the fifth time in his last six 162-game seasons...**would be the only pitcher to throw at least 200.0 innings in five different seasons since 2017...no other pitcher has recorded more than three such seasons in that span**...would also be the only Major League pitcher to record six such seasons since 2015 (no other pitcher has more than four in that span).

- Is the only Yankee in the last 10 years (since 2014) to throw at least 200.0IP in a season and would be the first to do so in back-to-back seasons since CC Sabathia (five straight from 2009-13) and Hiroki Kuroda (2012-13).

**STRIKEOUT MACHINE:** Has recorded at least 200K for the sixth time in his career (also 2015, '18-19, '21-22)...has reached the 200K plateau for his fifth straight 162-game season (also 2018-19, '21-22; recorded 94K in the abbreviated 60-game season in 2020)...is the first Yankee in franchise history to record at least 200K in three different seasons (previous: twice by Luis Severino in 2017 and 2018, David Cone in 1997 and 1998, and Ron Guidry in 1978 and 1979)...is just one of two Major League pitchers since 2015 to record at least six seasons with at least 200K, joining Max Scherzer (also six).

- Has recorded at least 8K in 13 starts this season and has notched five double-digit strikeout games this year...his five such games are tied for the third-most in the AL and tied for the sixth-most in the Majors this season.
- Has recorded double-digit strikeouts in 47 games since the start of 2019, marking the most in the Majors over the span (next: Max Scherzer-49)...his 55 games with at least 10K since the beginning of 2018 are also the most in the Majors over that stretch (next: Max Scherzer-49).
- Recorded his 2,000th career strikeout on 5/23 vs. Baltimore (Jorge Mateo swinging)...became the third-fastest pitcher (in terms of games and innings pitched) in Major League history to reach the milestone (278th career game and 1,714.2IP).

**30 FOR 30:** Has made at least 30 starts for the seventh time in his career (also 2015, '17-19, '21-22), the most such seasons by any Major League pitcher since 2015.

**2023:** Is 13-4 with a 2.81 ERA (192.0IP, 60ER) and 208K in 31GS this season...**has allowed 2R-or-fewer in 24 of his 31GS this year, tied with San Diego's Blake Snell for the most in the Majors...is one of just three pitchers in franchise history to record at least 24 starts of 2R-or-fewer in a single season, joining Jack Chesbro (28 in 1904) and Ron Guidry (26 in 1978)**.
