FLO RIDA AND HALFWAY TO THE PHOENIX OPEN ON SEPT. 5: The D-backs will give fans the ultimate Friday night on Sept. 5 headlined by a free postgame concert featuring Flo Rida and celebrating the halfway mark to the WM Phoenix Open with Golf Night...The Thunderbirds will be at the ballpark for the occasion for a special check presentation to the Arizona Alliance of Boys & Girls Clubs, a ceremonial first pitch from 2025 Tournament Chairman Matt Mooney and exciting golf-themed activations throughout the game

2026 SCHEDULE ANNOUNCED: The D-backs 2026 schedule features the Opening Homestand vs. Tigers (March 30-April 1) and Braves (April 2-5), holiday weekends for Mother’s Day vs. Mets (May 9-10), Father’s Day vs. Twins (June 19-21), Fourth of July vs. Brewers (July 3-5), Interleague Play vs. Blue Jays (April 17-19) and Yankees (September 19-20), and marquee NL West matchups...for more information, visit dbacks.com/2026.

SNAKE BITES: The D-backs have won 4 of their last 5 games, since Aug. 27, and 8 of their last 12 games, since Aug. 19, all against teams in a postseason position (Brewers and Dodgers) or within 4.0 games of a Wild Card berth (Guardians and Reds).

- 5 of the D-backs’ last 7 games and 16 of their last 24, have been decided by 2 or fewer runs.
- Since August 8, the D-backs’ 5.43 runs per game rank fifth in MLB, behind the Mets (6.77), Yankees (6.00), Braves (5.57) and Brewers (5.54).
- The D-backs’ 68 RBI with 2 outs since August 1 rank third in MLB, behind the Phillies (73) and Mets (70).
- The D-backs’ 41 homers in August were fourth in the NL, behind the Mets (53), Brewers (45) and Phillies (44)...are 1 of 3 NL teams with 4 30+-homer months (April, May, June, August) with the Cubs and Dodgers.
- The D-backs lead the Majors in the 8th inning or later with 159 runs and 43 home runs.

LAST GAME: The D-backs tied the game 4-4 in the eighth inning on **Corbin Carroll’s** 3-run home run but lost 5-4 @ Dodgers on a walk-off home run in the ninth inning.

- The final pitch of the game was the only home run the D-backs surrendered during the 3-game set.
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 18 consecutive games since Aug. 13, tied with Isaac Paredes/HOU for the third-longest active streak in the Majors, behind Jackson Chourio/MIL (24), Wyatt Langford/TEX (20).
- **Ketel Marte** recorded 2 hits and has reached safely in 6 consecutive games...has reached base safely in 25 of his last 26 starts since Aug. 1, batting .310 (31-for-100)/.877 OPS.
- **Brandyn Garcia** notched career highs with 2.2 innings and 3 strikeouts in a scoreless relief outing.

ROSTER MOVES: With rosters expanding to 28 players for September, the D-backs reinstated RHP **Ryan Thompson** from the 15-day injured list (strained scapular) and recalled OF **Jorge Barrosa** from Triple-A Reno.

- VS. RANGERS:** The D-backs face the Rangers for the second time, having taken 2 of 3 from Aug. 11-13 on the road.
- The D-backs have won 4 of their last 5 games vs. Rangers, since Sept. 10, 2024, and 7 of their last 10 regular-season meetings, since May 3, 2023.

SCHEDULE ODDITY: The D-backs and Rangers are second 3-game series of the season marks the eighth time in franchise history the D-backs have played multiple 3-game series vs. AL opponents: 2021 vs. Mariners, 2020 vs. Astros, 2015 vs. Astros, 2007 vs. Orioles, 2005 vs. Tigers, 2000 vs. Rangers and 1999 vs. Rangers.

COUNTRY GRAMMAR ERA NELLY: **Ryne Nelson** has won 5 of his last 6 decisions since June 13, going 5-1 with a 2.93 ERA (26 ER in 80.0 IP), an opponent .221 AVG (66-for-299), 17 walks and 70 strikeouts.

- In 14 home games (8 starts), is 5-1 with a 2.42 ERA (17 ER In 63.1 IP), an opponent .204 AVG (48-for-235), 11 walks and 54 strikeouts.
- In 8 home starts, is 4-1 with a 2.09 ERA (11 ER in 47.1 IP), an opponent .209 AVG (36-for-172), 10 walks and 39 strikeouts.

WINNING IN AUGUST: The D-backs went 17-12 (.586) in August, their highest winning percentage of any month this season...their winning percentage last month ranked fourth in the Majors behind the Brewers (21-9, .700), Phillies (18-11, .621) and Red Sox (17-11, .607).

EXTRA! EXTRA!: **Corbin Carroll’s** 72 extra-base hits (27 doubles, 16 triples, 29 home runs) are the most in the NL and second most in the Majors to Aaron Judge/NYY (73).

- With a month remaining in the season, Carroll’s 72 extra-base hits this season are already seventh most all-time by a D-backs left-handed hitter, behind Luis Gonzalez in 2001 (100) and 2000 (80), Stephen Drew in 2008 (76), Steve Finley in 1999 (76), and Gonzalez in 2003 (76) and 1999 (75).
- With 27 doubles, 16 triples, 29 home runs and 21 stolen bases this season, he is 4 triples shy of becoming the fifth player in Major League history to record a 20+ double, 20+ triple, 20+ homer, 20+ stolen base season (20-20-20-20), joining Frank Schulte/CHC in 1911, Willie Mays/NYG in 1957, Jimmy Rollins in 2007 and Curtis Granderson in 2007...Mays and Rollins accomplished the feat with 30+ homers.

DEAR LOURDES, WHAT A MONTH: **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.’s** 32 RBI were a club record for August, ahead of Paul Goldschmidt (31 in August 2017), and third most all-time in any month: 36 – J.D. Martinez – September 2017 35 – Luis Gonzalez – June 2001 **32 – Lourdes Gurriel Jr. – August 2025** 31 – Paul Goldschmidt – August 2017, Steve Finley – May 2000 30 – Martin Prado – August 2013

- His 32 RBI in August were the most in a month in his career, the second-most in MLB behind Kyle Schwarber/PHI (33), and the third most in any month this season by a player, behind Rafael Devers/BOS-SF (33 in May) and Schwarber this month.
- It was the second time in his career with 30+ RBI in a month (also: 30 RBI in 26 G in Sept./Oct 2021).

HISTORY INDICATES IT MAY CONTINUE....: **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** is a lifetime .311 (131-for-421)/.355 OBP/.533 SLG/.909 OPS hitter during the month of September, the fourth-best average, seventh-best slugging pct. and eighth-best OPS among active players during the final month of the season [min. 300 PA] .

BLAZING A TRAIL: **Blaze Alexander** has hit all 7 of his home runs and 13 of his 17 extra-base hits this season in his last 27 games since August 3 (.537 SLG/.897 OPS).

- The D-backs are 12-3 when he has an extra-base hit and 6-1 when he homers.
- Posted a 19.0 pct. chase rate (swinging at pitches outside the zone) in August, the best single-month rate of his professional career, Major or Minor Leagues.

NO HOMERS CLUB: The D-backs starting rotation has allowed just 2 home runs in their last 11 games (53.0 IP).

NEXT STARTER: RHP NABIL CRISMATT (2-0, 1.84)

- Fourth appearance and third start with the D-backs.
- Earned the win in his last start on Aug. 28 @ Brewers, working 5.2 innings with 4 runs (2 earned) on 8 hits and 1 walk with 2 strikeouts.
- In 3 outings (2 starts), has allowed 5 runs (3 earned) over 14.2 innings.

HOW HE STARTED: D-backs’ second-round pick (No. 56) in the 2019 draft.

- Named D-backs’ 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 7-4 with a 3.17 ERA (41 ER in 116.1 IP) with 163 strikeouts (T-4th in MiLB) over 22 starts between High-A Hillsboro and Double-A Amarillo.
- Attended the University of Oregon...as a junior in 2019, was First-Team All-Pac-12, led the conference with 104 strikeouts and finished fourth in the nation with a 14.40 K/9 IP.
- A Nevada native, attended Basic High School in Henderson where he was a shortstop and pitcher.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Making his 19th start (ninth @ home).

- In his last 4 home starts (3 quality), is 2-0 (team is 3-1) with a 2.55 ERA (7 ER in 24.2 IP), opponent .200 AVG, 0.93 WHIP, 5 walks and 23 strikeouts.
- Has not walked a batter in 3 of his last 4 starts (0.76 BB/9.0 IP) and 4 of his last 6 (1.04 BB/9.0 IP).
- Has thrown 6.0+ innings in 3 straight starts and 7 of his last 11 (team is 6-1).
- His 7 starts of 6.0+ innings with 90 pitches or fewer are tied for third most among NL starters (also: 9 others), behind Nick Pivetta/SD (10) and Sonny Gray/STL (9).

LAST START: Tossed his second consecutive quality start on Aug. 27 @ Brewers, allowing 1 run on 6 hits and 0 walks with 3 strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

- Was his first win since July 19 vs. Cardinals.

VS. RANGERS: Third career start, first @ Chase Field.

- Did not factor in the decision in his last start on Aug. 11 @ Rangers (5 ER in 5.1 IP).

VS. AL WEST: First career home start vs. an AL West opponent.

- In 6 career starts, is 1-1 with a 5.23 ERA (19 ER in 32.2 IP), opponent .238 AVG, 14 walks and 26 strikeouts.
- In his first 2 starts from May 17-July 1, 2023, went 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA (1 ER in 12.2 IP), opponent .098 AVG, 0.71 WHIP, 5 walks and 12 strikeouts.
- In 3 starts from May 17, 2023-May 29, 2024, held opponent to an opponent .143 AVG and 0.91 WHIP.

HOME COOKIN: In 8 home starts (5 quality), is 4-1 (team is 6-2) with a 2.09 ERA (12 R-11 ER in 47.1 IP), opponent .209 AVG, 0.97 WHIP, 10 walks and 39 strikeouts.

- Has allowed 2 or fewer earned runs in 7 of his 8 starts, including 2 starts with 1 earned run and 2 starts with 0 runs allowed.
- Has walked 1 or fewer batters in 5 of his 7 starts (0.57 BB/9.0 IP).

FREE PASSES ARE LIMITED: Has allowed 1 walk or fewer in 10 of his 18 starts.

- Has yielded 2 walks or fewer in 29 of his last 33 starts since June 14, 2024 (1.99 BB/9.0 IP, 190.1 innings, 760 BF).

LIMITING LEFTIES & RIGHTIES: In his last 18 starts, is holding lefties to a .206 AVG (33-for-160)/.603 OPS with 31 strikeouts and righties to a .227 AVG (47-for-207)/.716 OPS with 50 strikeouts.

SLIDE TO THE LEFT: Throwing his slider 13.3% of the time and holding opponents to a .188 AVG (12-for-64).

- Has held lefties hitless in his last 44 starts (7 BF, 25 P) dating back to Sept. 17, 2023.

GIVE 'EM THE HEATER: Throwing his fastball 62.4% of the time and holding opponents to a .212 AVG (64-for-302), his highest and lowest marks respectively since 2022.

GETTING SWINGS: His 52.1 swing pct. since June 13 ranks second among NL starters (7th in MLB), behind Shota Imanaga/CHC (53.3%).

INNING INSIGHT: From innings 2-5, has a 2.11 ERA (19 R-16 ER in 68.1 IP), and is holding opponents to a .194 AVG (48-for-247)/.603 OPS with 57 strikeouts.

FROM THE SECOND TIME THRU: From the second time thru the order on, is holding opponents to a .197 AVG (43-for-218) with 46 strikeouts.

RISPY BUSINESS: In his last 8 starts, with runners in scoring position, opponents are hitting .200 AVG (7-for-35)/.571 OPS.
