TONIGHT'S TILT... the Mariners continue their final series of the 2024 season tonight with the second of 3 games against the Oakland Athletics (1-0)...Seattle is coming off a 4-2 road trip at the Rangers (2-1) and Astros (2-1)...tonight's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** and broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners opened their final series of the 2024 season with a 2-0 win over Oakland, securing their 15th shutout victory of the season, the most in the American League.

- Last 10 Series Seattle is 19-13 over its last 32 games (8/23-c) since Dan Wilson took over as manager and Edgar Martinez as hitting coach...Seattle owns a 6-2-2 series record during that span.
- Winning Season The Mariners have secured a winning record for the fourth consecutive season (2021-c), tying the franchise record for most consecutive seasons with a winning record (also: 4 seasons, 2000-03).
- Wraparound Series Seattle will play their 2nd of 7 consecutive regular season matchups against the
 Athletics tonight, with the Mariners scheduled to open the 2025 season against the A's from March
 27-30 at T-Mobile Park...it marks the 6th time Seattle has closed a season and opened the following
 one against the same team, the 3rd time they have done it against the A's (also: 2010-11 and 2011-12).
- Shared History 121 players have played for both the Seattle Mariners and the Oakland Athletics.
- Taylor of Troy Righty Troy Taylor (23 years, 18 days) collected his first career save last night, becoming the youngest Mariners pitcher to record his first career save since Edwin Díaz (22 years, 133 days) in 2016.

THE PITCHING STAFF...Seattle's overall pitching staff <u>leads the Majors</u> in ERA (3.48), attempting to lead the American League in ERA in back-to-back seasons, and the *Majors* in ERA for the second time in team history (other: 3.54 ERA, 2001)...this season, the Mariners also <u>lead MLB</u> in opponent batting average (.220), WHIP (1.08), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.83), fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.32), fewest hits-per-9 innings (7.36), opponent OBP (.275) and opponent OPS (.649).

ROTATION GOING FOR TEAM RECORD...the Mariners starting rotation <u>leads the Majors</u> in ERA (3.39), on pace to set a <u>franchise record for lowest starting pitcher ERA</u> in a season which would supplant the 2014 season (3.48 starter's ERA)...this season, Seattle's starting rotation also <u>leads MLB</u> in opponent batting average (.223), WHIP (1.03), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.86), fewest walks-per-9 innings (1.75), fewest hits-per-9 innings (7.53), opponent OBP (.266), opponent OPS (.642) and quality starts (92).

JULIO: AL PLAYER OF THE MONTH?...in 24 September games, Julio Rodríguez is batting .324 (36x111) with 21 runs, 5 doubles, 7 home runs, 21 RBI, 6 stolen bases and 5 walks, getting on base at a .348 clip, slugging .559 with a .906 OPS...among American League players since Sept. 1, Julio ranks 1st in hits (36), 1st in total bases (62), T-1st in home runs (7), T-1st in RBI (21) with Aaron Judge-NYY, 2nd in runs scored (21) and T-2nd in fWAR (1.4).

RALEIGH AROUND THE SILVER & GOLD...catcher Cal Raleigh leads MLB catchers in home runs (32) for the third consecutive season, the first catcher to lead his position in HR in 3+ consecutive seasons since Hall of Famer Mike Piazza (4x, 1999-2002)...Raleigh (97 RBI) also has a chance to become the first Seattle catcher to reach 100+ RBI in a season...defensively, Raleigh leads the Majors in catcher caught stealing (26) ahead of Will Smith-LAD (25) and Alejandro Kirk-TOR (25)...after leading MLB in CCS (24) in 2023, Cal is trying to become the third catcher to lead the Majors in CCS in consecutive seasons (since it was tracked in 1974), joining Jim Sundberg in 1975-76 (Sundberg tied for the ML lead in '75) and Hall of Famer Gary Carter in 1982-83...Cal also leads American League catchers in fWAR (5.2), defensive runs saved (17) and catcher framing runs (13).

<u>HEROIC HURLERS</u>...the Mariners starting rotation of Logan Gilbert (22 quality starts), George Kirby (20), Luis Castillo (18), Bryce Miller (18) and Bryan Woo (10) is 1 of 2 rotations to have 5 pitchers make 10+ QS this season, along with Atlanta...the quartet for Gilbert, Kirby, Castillo and Miller are the first to each toss 162.0+ innings in a season for Seattle since 2014 (first with all sub-4.00 ERA's since 1990)...the aforementioned quartet is the first each post 175.0+ innings in a season in the Majors since Cleveland in 2018...it's the first time 4+ pitchers recorded 175.0+ innings for the Mariners since 5 pitchers did it in 2003.

COLOSSUS OF CLOUT... the Mariners offense over its last 21 games (9/4-c) has averaged 5.38 runs-pergame, best in the AL and 3rd in MLB behind the Dodgers (6.05) and Diamondbacks (5.62)... Seattle has gone 14-7 (.667) since then, 2nd-best record in MLB trailing only Detroit (16-5/.672)... during that span, Seattle hitters rank T-2nd in hits (201), T-1st in batting average (.275), T-1st in OBP (.354), 2nd in OPS (.802), 3rd in doubles (41), 4th in extra-base hits (70), T-3rd in total bases (328) and 5th in walks (78) across MLB.

<u>JULIO IN HISTORIC TERRITORY</u>...center fielder **Julio Rodríguez** has accumulated 15.8 WAR (*Baseball-Reference*), 4th-most bWAR through a center fielder's first 3 career seasons trailing Mike Trout, Joe DiMaggio and Oscar Charleston, while ranking ahead of Ken Griffey Jr. (15.6)...additionally, Julio's 15.8 bWAR trails only Ichiro Suzuki (16.9) for most bWAR through a Mariners player's first 3 career seasons.

<u>MILLER'S CROSSING</u>...Bryce Miller, who has a 2.94 ERA (59 ER, 180.1 IP) and 0.976 WHIP, is the second pitcher in Mariners history with a sub-3.00 ERA and sub-1.00 WHIP in a qualified season (other: Félix Hernández in 2014).

THROWING A TANDEM...Mariners duo Bryce Miller and Bryan Woo are the 4th duo in MLB history to each have a sub-3.00 ERA and a sub-1.00 WHIP within their first 2 career seasons (min. 100.0 IP), joining Dutch Leonard and Ernie Shore for the 1914 Boston Red Sox, Walter Johnson and Bill Burns for the 1908 Washington Senators and Henry Boyle and Perry Werden for the 1884 St. Louis Maroons.

MINOR LEAGUE AWARDS...outfielder Lazaro Montes was named Ken Griffey Jr. Hitter of the Year for the second-consecutive season...left-hander Brandyn Garcia and righty Michael Morales Jamie Moyer were named Jamie Moyer Co-Pitchers of the Year, infielder Colt Emerson the Alvin Davis Mr. Mariner Award winner, outfielder Curtis Washington the Dan Wilson Community Service Award Winner and Arkansas Pitching Coach Michael Peoples the Dave Henderson Staff Member of the Year Award...infielder Michael Arroyo and RHP Tyler Cleveland were DTZ Tournament Award Winners.

AS YOU KNOW...Cal Raleigh has hit a career-high 32 home runs this season, surpassing his previous career-high of 30 last season, but...DID YOU KNOW?...that Cal is just the 6th player in Mariners history with back-to-back 30+ home run seasons?...he joins Ken Griffey Jr. (1993-94, 1996-99), Nelson Cruz (2015-18), Alex Rodriguez (1998-2000), Jay Buhner (1995-97) and Richie Sexson (2005-06), and...DID YOU ALSO KNOW?...that Raleigh's 91 home runs through his first 4 MLB seasons are the 2nd-most in team history, trailing only Mr. Mariner Alvin Davis, who hit 92 HR in his first 4 seasons (1984-87)?

ABOUT EMERSON HANCOCK...

- The 25-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 12th start of the season, his 1st against the Oakland...he is also scheduled to make the 15th start of his career.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (6th overall) of the 2020 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Scott Hunter on June 25, 2020.
- Spent 3 seasons at the University of Georgia, 2018-20... in 2020, was named Vince Dooley Athlete of the Year as the top male student-athlete at the University of Georgia.
- Was named to CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team in 2020.

AST TIME OUT...W#4 on 9/21 at Texas...he tossed 5.0 innings and allowed 2 runs on 5 hits (1 home run) with 0 walks and 3 strikeouts...he has gone 5.0-or-more innings in 9 of his 14 career starts.

THE COMPLETE PACKAGE ... on July 21 vs. Reno, Hancock threw 9.0 inning complete game shutout...it is the only 9.0 inning complete game shutout in Triple-A in 2024 and only 1 of 2 in the full-season minor leagues this year... there have only been 2 complete game shutouts in the Pacific Coast League since the start of 2019.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH...was awarded Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Month for June...held a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA in 4 starts as he allowed 2 runs on 14 hits with 7 walks over 21.1 innings...he tallied 17 strike-

outs and held opponents to a .187 (14x75) average...after allowing 2 runs in the first inning of June, he did not allow another run in his last 20.1 innings in June with Tacoma.

FEELING SUPPORTED...Hancock is 4-0 in 7 games when the Mariners score 3 or more runs while he is in the game...in those games the Mariners are 7-0...he is 0-2 with a 2.70 ERA when given 0-2 runs of run support.

THROWING STRIKES...his 64.9% first strike percentage is the highest of his career and above the league average of 62.3%.

QUALITY TIME...has recorded quality starts in 4-of-11 major league outings... in quality starts this season, he is 2-1 with a 2.16 ERA (6 ER, 25.0 IP) with 13 strikeouts and 5 walks...notched his first career quality start on 4/13 vs. Chicago-NL.

TACOMA TIME ...in 17 starts in Tacoma he pitched 94.1 IP with a 3.43 ERA with 66 strikeouts to 37 walks and a 1.29 WHIP...his 3.43 ERA was the lowest of any Rainier pitcher with at least 10 starts.

ALL-AMERICAN...this will be the right-hander's 1st career appearance against the Athletics and his 9th career appearance against a team from the American League...of the 8 previous starts against American League opponents, 4 have been from the AL Central (Royals, Twins, Guardians and White Sox)... his only other starts against an AL opponent was the Houston Astros, Texas Rangers (2x), and Toronto Blue Jays.

KNOCK 'EM OUT, KNOCK 'EM OUT ... entering 2024, had a career-high 3 strikeouts during his MLB debut vs. San Diego on 8/9/23...he has surpassed that total on 8 occasions this season, including a career-high 6 strikeouts on 4/7 at Milwaukee.

HOME SWEET HOME...through his first 5 career starts at home. is 2-2 with a 2.77 ERA (8 ER, 26.0 IP), 10 walks and 16 strikeouts over his first 5 career starts at T-Mobile park...his 2.77 ERA is the 8th-best mark in franchise history through a pitchers first 5 career starts at home, trailing Joel Piñiero (0.82 ERA), James Paxton (1.45), Sam Gaviglio (2.00), Michael Pineda (2.23), Matt Young (2.45), Hisashi Iwakuma (2.70) and Ryan Franklin (2.70).

HOME SWEET GEORGIA...is 1 of 5 players in MLB history born in Cairo, GA, the same birthplace as Jackie Robinson, Ernie Riles, Willie Harris and Hurston Waldrep...was the 11th Georgia Bulldog in school history to be drafted in the first round...he became the highest Georgia selection since Derek Lilliquist went 6th overall in 1987...1 of 7 Bulldogs to play in MLB this season (also: Jonathan Cannon-CWS, Kyle Farmer-MIN, Jared Walsh-TEX, Alex Wood-OAK, Zac Kristofak-LAA and Aaron Schunk-COL).

NO PLACE LIKE HOME...in 11 games started at home for Tacoma he owns a 2.44 ERA over 66.1 IP with 46 strikeouts and 24 BB...he is also holding opponents to a .212 average (51x241) while also holding a 1.13 WHIP...in 7 games at home for Seattle he owns a 3.41 ERA over 37.0 IP with 23 strikeouts and 11 BB...opponents are hitting .236 (33x140).
