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BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles open a nine-game road tonight against the Cardinals (3 to play), Athletics (3 to play), and Rockies (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-4 homestand, having been swept by the Yankees before taking two of three from the Rays...The O's are in last place in the AL East, but are 2.5 game behind the Guardians for the final Wild Card spot.

🦅 **Colton Cowser** was responsible for both of Baltimore's two hits on Sunday afternoon, going 2-for-3 with a double and home run...It marked his first multi-extra-base hit game since June 27, 2025 vs. Tampa Bay (3 2B)...Cowser owns a 1.024 OPS in 45 day games, the fourth-highest clip among qualified hitters in MLB behind PIT's Esmerlyn Valdez (1.085), ATH's Nick Kurtz (1.075), and BOS' Masataka Yoshida (1.028)...Among all MLB hitters with at least 175 plate appearances in night games, his .471 OPS is the lowest in the majors, with the next closest being TEX's Logan O'Hoppe (.518).

🦅 The Orioles saw their streak of 121 consecutive games with a walk come to an end on Sunday...It was the third-longest run in franchise history (since 1954), trailing stretches of 172 games (7/2/24-7/12/25) and 155 games (6/23/55-6/24 [G1]/56)...It was the longest single-season streak in club history, surpassing a 112-game run in 1995.

🦅 **Pete Alonso** saw his career-high 14-game hitting streak come to an end Sunday...He was the first Oriole to hit safely in 14 straight contests since **Gunnar Henderson's** 14-game streak from June 5-20, 2025.

SOUTHPAW SPEAK: Since August 18, the Birds are batting .127 (8-for-63) with one double, one home run, and a .370 OPS against left-handed pitching...From July 20-August 17, the O's hit .272 (80-for-294) with 17 doubles, two triples, 14 home runs, and an .831 OPS off southpaws...The .831 OPS during that period ranked third highest in MLB behind the Cubs (.907) and Diamondbacks (.839).

🦅 **Coby Mayo** is slashing .306/.364/.741 (33-for-108) with eight doubles, 13 home runs, and 24 RBI against left-handed pitching, ranking among MLB in slugging percentage (1st), OPS (1st, 1.105), and home runs (2nd).

🦅 Despite a current 0-for-5 skid against southpaws over his last four games, **Tyler O'Neill** is slashing .333/.393/.843 (17-for-51) with two doubles, eight home runs, and 12 RBI against lefties since July 1...The eight home runs during that period lead MLB, ahead of teammate **Coby Mayo**, CLE's Jo Adell, LAD's Shohei Ohtani, and ATL's Matt Olson (all 6).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Orioles have homered in 12 straight games, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Cardinals and Yankees (both 7 G)...It marks Baltimore's longest streak since going deep in 16 straight from August 4-21, 2024.

🦅 The Birds have hit 25 homers since August 9, second most in MLB behind the Cubs (30).

🦅 The O's have hit multiple home runs in six of their last eight road games (17 HR total).

POLAR VORTEX: In 20 career games at Busch Stadium, **Pete Alonso** is slashing .333/.442/.708 (24-for-72) with six doubles, seven home runs, 19 runs, 14 RBI, and 11 walks...Among all active players with at least 75 plate appearances at the venue, his 1.150 OPS is the highest in the majors, outpacing LAD's Freddie Freeman (1.078).

🦅 Alonso has hit safely in each of his last nine road games, batting .529 (18-for-34) with two doubles, five home runs, 10 RBI, and six walks against five strikeouts.

🦅 Alonso hit his 30th home run on August 21 vs. Tampa Bay, becoming the fifth player in MLB history to hit 30+ homers in at least seven of his first eight seasons, joining Ralph Kiner, Eddie Mathews, Albert Pujols, and Mark Teixeira...The lone year he did not hit 30+ homers was during the 60-game 2020 season.

🦅 Alonso became the eighth Oriole (since 1954) to hit at least 30 home runs in his first season with the team, joining Mark Trumbo (47 in 2016), Nelson Cruz (40 in 2014), J.J. Hardy (30 in 2011), Mark Reynolds (37 in 2011), Miguel Tejada (34 in 2004), Albert Belle (37 in 1999), and Frank Robinson (49 in 1966).

🦅 Overall this season, ranks among AL leaders in RBI (2nd, 85), home runs (4th, 30), slugging percentage (6th, .500), OPS (7th, .860), and runs scored (T-7th, 79).

'PEN PALS: **Cam Sanders** has not permitted a hit in each of his last five appearances, tied for the longest active streak in the majors along with LAA's Sam Bachman, NYM's Nate Lavender, and TEX's Chase Silseth...Sanders has not allowed a hit to any of the last 21 batters he has faced...According to *STATS Perform*, it is the second-longest active streak in MLB (min. 1 BF in 2026) behind AZ's Justin Martínez (29 BF).

🦅 **Yennier Cano** has gone 43 consecutive appearances (33.1 IP) without allowing a home run...It is the fifth-longest active streak among all MLB relievers behind SD's Mason Miller (73 G), MIL's Trevor Megill (59 G), CLE's Colin Holderman (50 G), and LAD's Edgardo Henriquez (44 G).

TWO OUT TENDENCIES: Over the last nine games since August 15, Orioles pitching has allowed opponents to hit .295 (31-for-105) with two outs...Over the first 12 games of the month, Baltimore held the opposition to a .131 (14-for-107) clip with two outs.

🦅 **Chris Bassitt** is holding opponents to a .244 average with two outs, compared to .352 with zero outs and .307 with one out.

🦅 The Birds have permitted 171 walks with two outs, seventh most in MLB.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 41-45 (.477) in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the fourth-most such games in the league this season and 20th in winning percentage in those situations this year...The club is 33-32 (.508) in games decided by two runs or fewer and 13-19 (.406) in one-run games...The team's winning percentage in one-run games is tied for the fourth lowest in the majors ahead of the Giants (11-23, .324), Tigers (12-22, .353), and Mets (14-21, .400).

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 34 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (27)...The O's are one of six teams in the majors this year with at least six pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (8).

🦅 **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962).

🦅 **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season.

🦅 The team record for most pinch-hit RBI in a season is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

QUICK HITS: Bassitt is scheduled to make his 13th start (15th appearance) of the season tonight in the series opener at St. Louis... Signed a one-year major league contract with Baltimore on February 13, 2026, to mark his fifth MLB team, following Toronto (2023-25), New York-NL (2022), Oakland (2015-21), and Chicago-AL (2014)...Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 16th round (No. 501 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

- Was placed on the 15-day Injured List (low back discomfort) on June 8, retroactive to June 5, and transferred to the 60-day IL on July 17...Reinstated from the 60-day IL on August 14.
- Reached 10 years of major-league service time in May.

LAST TIME OUT: Bassitt didn't factor into the decision on August 19 vs. New York-AL, allowing three runs on eight hits (1 HR) and one walk with six strikeouts in a 5-3 Orioles loss...Threw 95 pitches, 62 strikes.

Has allowed at least one walk in a career-high-tying 22 consecutive starts (also 7/30/15-4/22/19) since July 28, 2025.

MEET ME IN ST. LOUIS: Over five career starts opposite St. Louis, he is 2-1 with a 6.92 ERA (20 ER/26.0 IP)...Allowed a career-high nine earned runs and a career-high four homers in 3.1 innings at Busch Stadium on April 2, 2023 with the Blue Jays...However, holds a 4.37 ERA (11 ER/22.2 IP) in his four other starts against the Cardinals.

Earned the win in his last start at St. Louis on June 10, 2025 with Toronto (7.0 IP, 4 R, 6 H, HR, 2 BB, HBP, 3 K).

Over 50 career Interleague starts, Bassitt is 21-12 with a 3.32 ERA (105 ER/284.2 IP)...However, he has lost his last four decisions (7 GS) against Interleague opponents since August 9, 2025 over which he holds a 6.19 ERA (22 ER/32.0 IP).

A TALE OF TWO PITCH TYPES: Hitters are slashing .214/.316/.286 (18-for-84) with three doubles and one homer off Bassitt's breaking balls (curve, sweeper, slider) compared to .345/.405/.508 (61-for-177) with 11 doubles and six homers on his fastballs (sinker, cutter, four seamer).

However, his .237 opponent average (14-for-59) on his curveball this season is the second-highest mark of his career ahead of 2015 (.255)...In 2025, his .172 opponent average (17-for-99) on the pitch was fourth lowest in MLB among 20 pitchers that threw 400 or more curveballs.

TO THE LEFT: Bassitt has allowed 18 of his 22 extra-base hits (15 2B, 7 HR) this season to lefties, who are slugging .524 against him compared to a .301 mark for right-handed batters...In 2025, he allowed 38 extra-base hits (22 2B, 3 3B, 13 HR) to left-handed batters, more than double his 18 extra-base hits (9 2B, 9 HR) given up to righties.

WEAK CONTACT: Only 10 of Bassitt's 229 batted balls (4.4%) have been barreled this season...The 4.4 percent barrel rate is the lowest mark of his career (since tracking began in 2015) and ranks in the 92nd percentile of MLB.

His 35.8 percent hard-hit rate ranks in the 70th percentile of MLB while his 87.9 mph average exit velocity is in the 69th percentile.

ROADHOUSE BLUES: Bassitt's 7.28 road ERA (24 ER/29.2 IP) is the fifth-highest mark among MLB pitchers with at least five road starts this season, ahead of leader LAA's Jack Kochanowicz (8.39)...Holds a .333 (41-for-123) opponent average in away games with a 1.96 WHIP.

TIME OF THE SEASON: Bassitt is 27-19 with a 3.18 ERA (157 ER/445.0 IP) over 83 career games (75 GS) in the months of August and September compared to 60-49 with a 3.95 ERA (392 ER/892.1 IP) in 161 career games (153 GS) from March-July...He holds a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP) in two August starts this season after pitching to a 5.27 ERA (33 ER/56.1 IP) over his first 12 games (10 GS).

Held a 4.24 ERA (58 ER/123.0 IP) with a .274 opponent average (135-for-492) in his first 23 games (22 GS) last season from March-July...Recorded a 3.23 ERA (17 ER/47.1 IP) and .223 opponent average (39-for-175) in nine starts from August-September.

WORK HORSE: Bassitt is one of 28 active MLB pitchers to have reached 1,300 career innings, which he did on April 22 at Kansas City... Entering the 2026 campaign, he was one of seven MLB pitchers to have made at least 30 starts in each of the past four seasons, joining Toronto's José Berrios, Dylan Cease, and Patrick Corbin, Chicago-NL's Kevin Gausman, Washington's Miles Mikolas, and SF's Logan Webb.

His 93.8 pitches per game between 2022-25 were tied for the 13th-best mark in MLB, trailing leader NYY's Gerrit Cole (97.5)...He's averaging 83.0 pitches per game this season.
