**HOME SWEET HOME:** The D-backs averaged 30,701 per game vs. Athletics, totaling 92,102 for the 3-gamer, highlighted by Saturday's 39,843, a season-high for a Saturday and the seventh-largest Saturday crowd since 2018.

TO LEAD NL ALL-STARS: Torey Lovullo and his coaches will lead the NL for the 2024 All-Star Game on Tuesday, July 16 in Texas: Jeff Banister (Bench), Dave McKay (1B), Tony Perezchica (3B), Brent Strom (Pitching), Mike Fetters (Bullpen), Dan Carlson (Asst. Pitching), Joe Mather (Hitting), Damion Easley (Asst. Hitting), Rick Short (Asst. Hitting), Drew Hedman (Asst. Hitting) and Ryan DiPanfilo (Athletic Trainer). SNAKEBITES

**THE NL CHAMPS:** The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs took the series with a 5-1 win vs. Athletics on Sunday thanks a 3-run seventh inning on **Blaze Alexander's** pinch-hit, 2-run single followed by **Christian Walker's** RBI single.

- Brandon Pfaadt had a quality start (6.0 IP, 1 R, 5 H, 2 BB, 8 K).
- Joe Mantiply, Ryan Thompson and Paul Sewald each tossed a scoreless frame to seal the win.
- Ketel Marte had 2 walks to extend his on-base streak to 7 games.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs had a series of roster moves:

- Reinstated C **Gabriel Moreno** from the 10-day Injured List (sprained left thumb).
- Reinstated OF Alek Thomas from 10-day Injured List (strained left hamstring).
- Recalled RHP Gavin Hollowell (No. 62) from Triple-A Reno.
- Optioned INF **Blaze Alexander** to Triple-A Reno.
- Placed LHP Jordan Montgomery on the 15-day Injured List (right knee inflammation) [retro to June 29].
- Designated C Tucker Barnhart for assignment.

**#VOTE4KETEL FOR NL STARTING 2B:** Ketel Marte has 55 percent of the votes in Phase 2/Finalist voting to be the NL's starting second baseman, ahead of Luis Arraez/Padres (45%), with voting live through tomorrow at 9:00 a.m. PHX at <u>MLB.com/vote</u>.

- ESPN then full rosters anounced on Sunday at 2:30 p.m. PHX on ESPN.
- Marte was a fan-elected starter in 2019 and looks to join Paul Goldschmidt as the only D-backs with multiple fan elections.
- Marte was the leading vote-getter in Phase 1 Voting (1,853,424 votes) to become a finalist, ahead of Luis Arraez/Padres (1,760,593 votes).

MARTE'S PART-AY CONTINUES: Ketel Marte leads all second basemen with a 4.4 bWAR, .521 SLG, .873 OPS, 17 homers, 38 extra-base hits, 49 RBI and 165 total bases, is tied for first with 11 defensive runs saved, second with 19 doubles, third with 91 hits and tied for third with a 1.4 dWAR.

♦ His 4.4 bWAR is second in the NL to Shohei Ohtani/ LAD (4.8) and seventh in the Majors.

**SERIES WINS:** The D-backs have won or split 7 of their last 9 series overall since May 30, going 5-2-2, including 1-1-2 on the road with series splits @ Mets and Padres then a series win @ Nationals and a series loss @ Phillies.

JOE GETS THE NOD: Joe Mantiply is making his fifth career "opener" start, second of the season (also: May 20 @ Dodgers)...had 3 such starts last season - Aug. 15 @ Rockies, Aug. 21 vs. Rangers and Sept. 10 @ Cubs.

**OPENERS:** Joe Mantiply (once), Scott McGough (twice) and Brandon Hughes (twice) have combined for 5 opener starts this season:

VS. DODGERS: The D-backs are 3-3 vs. Dodgers this season.
 In their last series @ Dodgers from May 20-22, the D-backs took 2-of-3, outscoring them 17-9.

VS. NL WEST: The D-backs are 6-3 in their last 9 games vs. NL West, 2-1 at home and 4-2 on the road.

• Over the last 2 seasons, the D-backs are 44-35 (.557 win pct.) vs. NL West, with a 24-15 home record and 20-20 road mark.

**BASH BROS IN JUNE: Ketel Marte** and **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** anchored the offense with a strong June, ranking among NL leaders:

- Marte was fourth with a .341 AVG, .431 OBP and 1.069 OPS, fifth with a .637 SLG, tied for sixth with 7 home runs and 20 RBI.
- Gurriel was fifth with a .337 AVG, 13th with a .547 SLG and .907 OPS.
  In their last 11 games, since June 18, have combined to hit .357 (30-for-84)/1.017 OPS with 11 extra-base hits (5 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR), 16 RBI, 6 walks and 13 runs.

VS. NL WEST: Ketel Marte, in 26 games vs. NL West, is batting .330 (37-for-103)/.848 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI and 11 walks.

- Christian Walker, in 27 games, is batting .302 (29-for-96)/.960 OPS with 8 doubles, 6 home runs, 19 RBI and 13 walks.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr., in 24 games, is hitting .320 (32for-100)/.916 OPS with 7 doubles, 6 homers and 22 RBI.

**RACKING UP THE K'S:** D-backs' pitchers have a season-high-tying 3 straight 10+ strikeout games (also: April 6-8 and May 15-18), totaling 38 strikeouts vs. A's with a season-high 15 on Friday, 10 on Saturday and 13 on Sunday, and have 52 strikeouts in their last 5 games). The last time the D-backs had 4 consecutive dou-

ble-digit strikeout games was July 25-28, 2020.
